ATLANTIC COUNTY

Fireworks, Parades and More: Atlantic County Marks the Fourth of July



Independence Day in Atlantic County stretches across two days, from Thursday evening fireworks and live jazz to Friday's parades, concerts, and oceanfront finales. From the back bays to the Boardwalk, each town brings its own flavor to the celebration—whether it's a solemn mile of remembrance, a shoreline concert, or a rooftop view of fireworks lighting up the coast.

Festivities begin on Thursday, July 3, in Ventnor, where the 53rd annual Ventnor Mile hits the Boardwalk at 7:00pm. Runners line up at New Haven Avenue, loop south to Martindale, and finish back at Newport Avenue. Spectators gather near the Newport Avenue Gazebo, where a DJ and food vendors create a festive send-off. After the final runners cross the line, fireworks launch over the ocean around 9:00pm. Full details and registration are at ventnorcity.org.

In Atlantic City, Thursday also marks the start of the Chicken Bone Beach Jazz Series at Kennedy Plaza, just off the Boardwalk. The free concert kicks off at 7:00pm with performances by Chief Adjuah (formerly Christian Scott), Jaleel Shaw, and the Chicken Bone Beach Youth Jazz Ensemble. This series honors the historic Missouri Avenue beach, once the city's only Black-designated beach during segregation, where icons like Ella Fitzgerald and Sammy Davis Jr. drew crowds despite exclusion elsewhere. Today, the series draws an inclusive mix of fans - families, jazz heads, and beachgoers alike. Info at chickenbonebeach.org.





While the jazz continues, Borgata Hotel & Casino lights up the Marina District with a fireworks display at 8:30pm, choreographed to music and visible from the marina walkways, decks, and nearby bridges. It's an early show, often overlooked by weekenders, but cherished by locals who want a head start on the 4th.

The holiday proper kicks off early on Friday, July 4, in Northfield, where the annual Connolly Memorial Mile begins at 8:30am in front of City Hall on Shore Road. The one-mile race honors Sgt. Vincent J. Connolly, a Marine and hometown hero killed in Vietnam. After the race, the city's Fourth of July Parade steps off at 10:00am, traveling from Jackson Avenue down Shore Road to the Burton Avenue Fire Station. Marching bands, fire trucks, decorated bikes, and local groups make it one of the most spirited events in the county. Registration and race info at cityofnorthfield.org.

By midmorning, attention turns to Hammonton, where the town's parade rolls down Bellevue Avenue at 11:00am It's a full civic affair - veterans, classic cars, floats, scouts, and fire departments all march past downtown storefronts lined with spectators. In the evening, families head to Hammonton Lake Park for food trucks, live music, and fireworks launched just after dark from the Little League fields on South Egg Harbor Road. Info at townofhammonton.org.

As the sun begins to dip, Somers Point brings live music to the bayfront with its award-winning Friday Night Beach Concert Series. At 7:00pm, The Dane Anthony Band takes the stage at William Morrow Beach, bringing a set of Motown, funk, R&B, and rock to the sand. Now in its 31st year, the series turns the beach into a dance floor as the shoreline lights up with coolers, folding chairs, and familiar faces. More at somerspointbeachconcerts.com.



By 9:00pm, the shoreline shifts to Margate, where crowds gather near Huntington Avenue Beach for the town's traditional Fourth of July fireworks, presented by the Margate Mothers' Association. The area between Fredericksburg and Clermont Avenues offers prime views. Because parking fills up quickly, many locals opt to bike or walk in from Amherst Avenue or cross over via the Margate Bridge. After the finale, nearby staples like Maynard's Café and Robert's Place stay open late for one last toast.

Fireworks continue in Atlantic City, starting at 9:00pm with Ocean Casino Resort's North Beach display, visible from Steel Pier, the Boardwalk, and Ocean's rooftop lounges. Then at 10:00pm, Tropicana delivers the city's grand finale: its signature Summer Fireworks Series show, launched from the midtown beach with a synchronized soundtrack and Boardwalk light show. Crowds stretch from Caesars to the Irish Pub, with DJs, performers, and night markets extending the party well past the last burst in the sky. More info at visitatlanticcity.com.

Elsewhere in the county, towns like Brigantine, Absecon, Galloway, and Linwood fill out the weekend with their own parades, neighborhood fireworks, and block parties. Together, they stitch the fabric of a county-wide celebration—full of story, sound, and spark.

In South Jersey, the Fourth of July isn't just fireworks and parades—it's corn stands popping up along Route 40, berry crates stacked high in Hammonton, and beach coolers packed with someone's aunt's famous pasta salad. The holiday's real magic is found in the flavors, and this week, Atlantic County's fields are delivering.

July marks the turning point in the summer harvest. The first peaches are soft and fragrant, just ripe enough to slice into salads or spoon over shortcake. Blueberries are at their peak—sweet, juicy, and begging to be baked, blended, or eaten straight from the carton. Sweet corn, plucked before noon, is still warm from the field by the time it hits the grill. Even herbs like basil and dill are growing faster than they can be picked. It's a window of abundance that just so happens to land right on the biggest cookout weekend of the year.

Right now, farm markets and roadside stands are brimming with everything you need for a red, white, and blue menu that doesn't rely on food coloring or flag-shaped trays. Whether you're manning the grill or bringing a dish to share, these two recipes are built from the ground up, with fresh ingredients grown just miles from wherever you're lighting your sparklers.

Red, White & Blueberry Caprese Skewers

Ingredients:

- 1 pint Hammonton blueberries (for "blue")
- 1 pint cherry tomatoes (for "red")
- · 8 oz mozzarella pearls (for "white")
- Fresh basil leaves
- 2 tbsp balsamic glaze (optional)
- Toothpicks or skewers

Stars, Stripes & Sweet Corn: A Locally Grown Fourth of July BBQ

Instructions: Thread one blueberry, a basil leaf, a mozzarella pearl, and a cherry tomato onto each skewer. Repeat until full. Chill and drizzle with balsamic glaze just before serving. They're bright, poppable, and ridiculously easy to make in bulk—ideal for beach coolers or backyard trays.

White Peach & Sweet Corn Summer Pasta Salad

Ingredients:

- 2 ears fresh Jersey corn, grilled and kernels removed
- · 2 ripe white peaches, diced
- 1 cup cherry tomatoes, halved
- 1/2 small red onion, thinly sliced
- 1/2 lb cooked pasta (shells or elbows)
- 1/3 cup crumbled feta cheese
- 1/4 cup chopped basil or parsley
- Juice of 1 lemon
- 1/4 cup olive oil
- Salt and pepper to taste

Instructions: Toss pasta with corn, peaches, tomatoes, onion, feta, and herbs. Whisk together lemon juice, olive oil, salt, and pepper; pour over salad and mix well. Chill before serving. The white peaches add unexpected sweetness, the corn brings crunch, and the whole bowl tastes like July.

These aren't just patriotic plates—they're built from what's growing right here, right now. Jersey Fresh in every sense, made to share and meant to celebrate. Call it red, white, and homegrown—with fireworks on the side.

ATLANTIC COUNTY

Every Fourth of July, Atlantic County skies bloom with color—reds over Ventnor, blues above the Marina, gold crackling behind the Trop. But while we ooh and ahh with funnel cake in hand, there's a whole science (and a surprising amount of history) at work behind those bursts of light.

Let's get loud-and weird-for a minute.

- 1. Fireworks were invented by accident. By a bored Chinese cook. No, really. Over 2,000 years ago, a cook in ancient China supposedly stuffed saltpeter, charcoal, and sulfur into bamboo shoots and tossed them into a fire, Boom—fireworks. Whether that tale's 100% true or not, China was definitely the first to develop firecrackers, and by the 1200s, they'd gone full-blown pyrotechnic. Fast-forward to 1777, and American colonists were lighting up their own skies in honor of independence. It's tradition now—but it started with kitchen chemistry.
- 2. The color comes from metals. And they're surprisingly picky. That deep ruby red? Strontium. Emerald green? Barium. Bright white? Magnesium. Blue is notoriously hard to get right—it requires copper compounds that are sensitive to temperature, which is why you don't see perfect royal blue that often. Fireworks engineers, called pyrotechnicians, literally write recipes to get each color just right.
- 3. If your windows shake, it's doing its job. The boom you feel in your chest is created by timed explosions inside the aerial shell. The size of the shell determines the volume and reach. Atlantic City's big casino shows (like Borgata or Ocean) use 3–5 inch shells that explode hundreds of feet above the crowd—but smaller town shows might use lower, tighter bursts for safety and proximity. Louder doesn't mean more dangerous; it just means more sky real estate,
- 4. New Jersey has one of the country's strictest personal fireworks bans—but some of the best professional shows. While you still can't buy Roman candles or real firecrackers here, the Garden State goes big with licensed displays. Atlantic County's own pyros often work shows across the tri-state area during summer's peak.

Fire in the Sky: What You Never Knew About Fireworks (But Probably Should)

- 5. Those heart-shaped fireworks? They take serious math. Ever seen a smiley face or heart explode in the sky? Those aren't lucky accidents—they're the result of perfectly arranged "stars" (the small pellets that burn to create color) inside the shell. Each star must be placed at just the right angle so that when the shell bursts, the image appears midair. Too early or late and it just looks like a blob. Cue the geometry.
- 6. Timing is everything. So is the guy with the laptop. Gone are the days of a guy with a torch lighting each fuse by hand (though some small-town displays still keep it old school). Now, most major fireworks shows are launched electronically with computer systems that cue each shell by the millisecond. That's how they sync explosions to music, like the Tropicana's Boardwalk show or Ocean's rooftop display. It's fireworks by playlist.
- 7. You don't have to be near the launch site to get the best view. Some of the best vantage points in Atlantic County aren't right at the stage. Locals know to watch Margate's show from Amherst Avenue, Ventnor's from Newport Avenue, and Borgata's from the Golden Nugget promenade. Sound travels slower than light—so that boom you hear a few seconds later? It's chasing you.
- 8. Fireworks shells are biodegradable. Mostly. Many professional-grade shells now use paper casings and cardboard tubes that degrade over time, making them more environmentally friendly than they used to be. Still, cleanup crews hit the beach and parks after every show. So if you're watching, do your part—pick up what you brought.



So next time you're standing under the Atlantic City skyline or lying on the sand in Margate, and the sky explodes in peonies and crackle willows, remember: someone lit that from a laptop. It took rare metals, precision math, international history - and yes, a little magic. Boom,






HAMBURGER, CABBAGE & BARLEY CASSEROLE

3 cloves garlic

- 1 lb. very lean ground beef or bison
- 1 (8 oz) can tomato sauce
- 1 cup low sodium beef broth
- 1 tbsp vinegar
- 2 tbsp paprika
- 1/8 tsp marjoram
- Salt pepper to taste
- 1 small head cabbage, cut in 8ths
- 1/3 guick cooking barley (uncooked)

Brown together onion, garlic, and ground beef until all pink is gone. Add tomato sauce, diced tomatoes, beef broth, vinegar, salt, pepper, marjoram and pa-prika. Cover and simmer 45 minutes. Add cabbage and simmer 15 more minutes. Add quick cooking barley and cover and simmer 10 more minutes. Thicken with cornstarch in cold water if necessary. Makes 6 (1 cup servings)

Stay Safe in the Surf: A Guide to Water Safety at the Jersey Shore

The Jersey Shore is synonymous with summer fun—sunny beach days, refreshing ocean dips, and thrilling surf. But as inviting as the Atlantic Ocean, bays, and inlets may seem, these waters demand respect. Each year, thousands of visitors flock to Atlantic and Cape May Counties to enjoy the shore, and knowing how to stay safe can mean the difference between a great day and a dangerous one.

Respect the Ocean's Power

The ocean at the Jersey Shore can change quickly, with shifting tides, sudden drop-offs, and powerful currents. Rip currents, in particular, pose a significant hazard. Often invisible from shore, these narrow channels of fast-moving water can pull swimmers out beyond the breaking waves. If caught in one, stay calm—don't try to swim directly back to shore. Instead, swim parallel to the beach until you're free of the current, then angle back toward land.

When possible, swim only at guarded beaches. Lifeguards are trained to spot hazards, assist swimmers in distress, and respond quickly in emergencies. Many Jersey Shore towns, including Ocean City, Wildwood, Cape May, Atlantic City, and Brigantine, staff their beaches with lifeguards daily during peak season, typically from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Know the Conditions

Before heading out, check the day's surf and weather reports. Local news, beach patrol websites, and flag systems provide updates on tide times, rip current risks, jellyfish sightings, and storm advisories. Be especially cautious after storms, when surf conditions can remain rough even if skies are clear.

Additionally, always be aware of boat traffic in bays and inlets, where swimmers, kayakers, and paddleboarders share the water with motorized

vessels. Wearing a U.S. Coast Guard-approved life jacket is essential for boating and recommended for inexperienced swimmers in deeper waters.

Supervise Children Closely

Even on calm days, waves can knock over small children or carry them farther out than expected. Stay within arm's reach of young swimmers, and consider outfitting them with brightly colored swimwear or rash guards for visibility. Teach children to recognize lifeguards and seek help if they feel unsafe.


Smart Shore Habits

- Stay sober while swimming or boating. Alcohol impairs judgment, balance, and reaction times.
- Obey posted signs and lifeguard instructions. Many towns prohibit swimming after hours, when no lifeguards are present.
- Don't overestimate your abilities. The ocean is not a pool. If you're not a strong swimmer, stay in shallower water where you can touch bottom.

Enjoy the Water, Respect the Risks

The Jersey Shore's waters offer unforgettable fun but a safe beach day starts with smart choices. By understanding the ocean's power, heeding local guidance, and watching out for one another, visitors can make the most of their time at the shore keeping memories joyful and worry-free.

TO REGISTER

Fishing in Atlantic County

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at dep.nj.gov/njf-w/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/. Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/.

SALTWATER FISHING

Atlantic City - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



Ventnor/Ventnor Heights - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

Somers Point - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

Brigantine - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Gravelling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.







Tim & Hootie

"One time we had a substitute Spanish teacher who was delivering a lecture. The teacher looked down to see a dog under my desk. Without missing a beat the teacher said, 'Hello, there,' politely shook her paw, then resumed the lecture."

WHO'S JUNO, AND WHY DOES SHE WALK SO MUCH?

You may have previously heard the term "Juno Walk" thrown out by guide dog handlers and Seeing Eye instructors, but do you know what the term means?

Part of the science behind the matching process requires our Seeing Eye instructors to be able to understand how fast a potential Seeing Eye student walks and how much of a pull from the harness they need. To do this, instructors will do a "Juno Walk" with the student, acting as the dog and leading the student with a shortened harness handle for a short walk. The instructor will work with the student to determine how fast or slow they want to walk and how much pull they feel comfortable with.

All this information is incredibly helpful for our instructors when deciphering which dog would work best for each student!






Get Grounded: Reconnecting with Nature at the Jersey Shore

In a world of constant notifications and digital noise, one of the greatest luxuries is the chance to step barefoot onto the sand and feel the Earth beneath your feet. The Jersey Shore, with its sun-warmed beaches, tidal flats, and salt marshes, offers an ideal setting for this timeless practice: grounding.

Also called earthing, grounding is the simple act of physically connecting with the Earth's natural surfaces—sand, soil, grass, or water. While the idea is as old as humanity itself, modern research is beginning to uncover why this practice might offer real benefits for mind and body.

The Science Behind Grounding - The surface of the Earth holds a subtle, natural electric charge due to an endless supply of free electrons. When we walk barefoot on sand or stand in salt water, our bodies—also electrical systems—can absorb these electrons. Scientists studying grounding suggest these free electrons may act as natural antioxidants, helping to neutralize excess free radicals in the body.

Early research hints that grounding may reduce inflammation, promote restful sleep, balance cortisol, and calm the nervous system. And beyond the science, generations have known what the studies are starting to show: connecting to nature just feels good.



Mind the Heat: Practical Tips for Barefoot Comfort - The Jersey Shore's natural surfaces invite barefoot connection—but don't forget, summer sun can heat them up fast. By midday, sand, asphalt, and boardwalk planks can become uncomfortably hot or even hazardous to bare feet.

Use the stripes: If you need to cross asphalt or blacktop, step on painted crosswalk stripes or white parking lines—these reflect more heat and stay cooler than the dark pavement.

Check before you step: Touch sand, boardwalk, or asphalt with your hand first. If it's too hot for your palm, it's too hot for your feet.

Time it right: Early morning or evening is the best time for barefoot walks. The sand and streets are cooler, and the light is soft.


Carry backup: If surfaces are burning hot, keep lightweight sandals or flip-flops handy so you can slip them on when needed.

How to Practice Grounding at the Shore

- Take a slow, mindful barefoot walk on damp sand or near the waterline.
- Let the ocean waves wash over your feet and ankles.
- Wade through tide pools or bay shallows for cooling connection.
- Sit or lie on the sand, grass, or dune edge and feel the Earth's support.

Unplug, Unwind, Connect - You don't need an app or gadget — just your bare feet, an open mind, and a little care for where you step. This summer, let the sand, sea, and sun remind you what it means to truly feel grounded.

Beginner's Guide to Surf Fishing at the Jersey Shore

There's something timeless about casting a line into the surf, feeling the tug of the tide, and hoping for that thrilling pull at the end of your rod. Surf fishing is one of the most relaxing—and rewarding—ways to enjoy the Jersey Shore. If you're curious about trying it, here's what you need to know to get started.

Where to Go - The beauty of surf fishing is that you don't need a boat or fancy gear—just access to the shoreline. Popular spots include:

- Brigantine North End and Atlantic City Inlet Known for striped bass, bluefish, and flounder.
- Ocean City and Corson's Inlet A mix of surf species, with easy beach access and plenty of space.
- Wildwood and Cape May Point Great for blues, kingfish, and the occasional drum fish.
- Local Tip: Early morning and dusk tend to offer the best bites—and fewer crowds.

What You'll Need

- Rod & Reel: A medium- to heavy-action surf rod (8–10 feet) paired with a saltwater spinning reel works well for beginners.
- Tackle: Start simple: pyramid sinkers (to anchor your line in the surf), fish-finder rigs, and circle hooks (they're better for catch-and-release).
- Bait: Fresh is best! Bloodworms, squid strips, clams, or cut bunker are popular choices. Many local tackle shops offer ready-to-go options.
- License: You'll need to register with the NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program—it's free and easy to do online. You can sign up or renew at: www.saltwaterregistry.nj.gov

Helpful Hacks for First-Timers

- Cast beyond the breakers, but not too far—many fish feed right in the first trough.
- Fring a sand spike (rod holder) so you can rest your rod and watch the waves.
- Keep a bucket or cooler with ice handy for your catch—or simply enjoy the catch-and-release thrill.
- Check tide charts before you go; fishing during incoming or outgoing tides often yields better results.

Surf fishing at the Jersey Shore is more than just sport—it's a chance to slow down, connect with the water, and experience the coastline in a new way. Whether you land a keeper or just enjoy the serenity of the sea, it's always time well spent.

Novels About Finding Oneself Away from Home

Not all who wander are lost. — J.R.R. Tolkien

It's a sentiment as old as storytelling itself. Sometimes, a person needs to go on a grand journey to discover who they really are. There's something about leaving home — leaving what's known and comfortable — that makes a person reflective and more open to change. New sights, new people, new cultures, new challenges. These new experiences have a way of helping a person reevaluate their lives — and reemerge as someone new. It's hard to narrow down the vast number of stories containing this theme, but I tried my best to curate a varied list of books featuring protagonists that may wander, but are never lost.

The Wayward Bus by John Steinbeck - Best known for his "realistic and imaginative writings" and "keen social perception" — such as in his critically acclaimed The Grapes of Wrath and Of Mice and Men — this Nobel Prize-winning author brings to life an imaginative character-driven tale where a group of strangers embark on a life-changing journey down the California coast. Juan and his bus "Sweetheart" set out from the fictional town of Rebel Corners to Mexico, traveling through backroads as they transport an assortment of characters. The bus ferries the lost and the lonely, the good and the greedy, the stupid and the scheming, the beautiful and the vicious away from their shattered dreams and, possibly, toward the promise of the future.

Nine Days in Rome by Julian Gould - Atticus Winterle, a recently laid-off senior executive, finds himself tackling a different kind of workload as he takes on the job of chaperoning 16 unruly high school students and their three teachers around Rome, Italy. Atticus must call forth all his people skills and knowledge of local resources to keep the kids and teachers on track and out of trouble — to the extent possible. But he soon realizes, in his efforts to keep things from falling apart, he finds the teenagers and adults — including himself — growing closer. Atticus is stretched and challenged beyond his initial expectations as issues of addiction and mental health surface among the group. But romance will also bloom on their journey through the Eternal City.

The Wedding People by Alison Espach - Phoebe Stone arrives in Newport, Rhode Island with a plan. She's finally fulfilling her dream of visiting the grand Cornwall Inn, where for years she'd hoped to shuck oysters and take sunset sails with her husband. But now she arrives alone, at rock bottom but determined to have one last decadent splurge on herself. When she arrives though, she's quickly mistaken by everyone in the lobby as one of the guests for an upcoming wedding. The bride has accounted for every detail and every possible disaster the weekend might yield — except for Phoebe and Phoebe's plan. This absurdly funny and devastatingly tender novel looks at the winding paths we take to places we never imagined and the chance encounters it sometimes takes to reroute us.

Less by Andrew Sean Greer - This bittersweet romance and brilliant satire follows Arthur Less, a failed novelist who's about to turn 50 and just received an invitation to his ex's wedding. What does he do to avoid accepting or rejecting the invite? He accepts a series of half-baked literary event invitations that are piled on his desk. Every, Single. One. What could go wrong? His whirlwind adventure around the globe takes him to Paris (where he almost falls in love), to Berlin (where he almost falls to his death), and to a desert island in the Arabian Sea — where he encounters the last person on Earth he wants to face. Somewhere in there: he turns fifty. Through it all, there's his first love — and there's his last.

The Wild Road Home by Melissa Payne - With his wife fading from Alzheimer's, Mack Anders fakes his death for the insurance money that will keep her cared for and comfortable for the rest of her life. Now, he passes his time off the grid in his cabin, alone in the Wyoming wilderness — until Brandi and Sy show up. Freshly released from juvie, 18-year-old Brandi risked it all to save her younger brother Sy from an unstable home. On the run toward their aunt's house, a flat tire leaves them stranded — and soon leads them to Mack. This quiet stranger may be their only hope of reaching safety — but to help them, Mack will have to come back to life in ways he never imagined.


