National Farm Workers Day – March 31, 2022

National Farm Workers Day is celebrated annually on March 31 to pay tribute to the unsung heroes on a farm who are the hired workforce doing the tougher part of the job such as plowing fields, operator tractors, spreading fertilizers, and trimming hedges. The labor force on a farm plays a pivotal role in bringing crops to fruition. Employed on low wages, they work day and night, crouching on fields under the glaring sun in all kinds of climates. Without their relentless hard work and commitment, farmers wouldn't be able to grow, maintain, and harvest crops on such a large scale. So, on this day, we thank and glorify all farmworkers for making it possible to bring fresh produce to our tables in the face of increasing risks and challenges.

HISTORY OF NATIONAL FARM WORKERS DAY

Farm laborers had a horrible time on fields in the colonial era. Men and women were indentured servants captured by force or trickery with few rights and no promise of eventual freedom. By the 1600s, plantation owners, requiring more farmworkers, started enslaving African immigrants with crueler methods and no hope for liberty. As a result, when the American Revolution came, around 20% of the population in the 13 colonies were African American farm slaves.

The expansion of the nation curbed the culture of farm slavery and the international slave trade but it took another 55 years, the Civil War, and a World War to put an end to this involuntary servitude.

After the Civil War, California became the agricultural center to which farmworkers were imported from Asia. During the 1930s and World War II, the immigrant farmworkers shifted to Mexico. During the 1960s, the Mexican-American community organizer, farmworker, and civil rights activist Cesar Chavez cofounded the National Farm Workers Association, now called the United Farm Workers. The organization fights for the rights of migrant farmworkers and succeeded in its first

mission with the historical 5-year Delano grape strike, eventually leading to long-overdue higher wages for grape pickers on grape farms in California.

WHY NATIONAL FARM WORKERS DAY IS IMPORTANT

- They live in poverty - Farmworkers are feeding the entire country with enough food to export to other places. Ironically, at the end of the month, they have a limited supply of food left for themselves because they make the lowest annual family income in the United States.
- They are essential to us - If weren't for the men and women choosing this field, we don't know what we would be eating right now. Extracting the labor input in agricultural production can cause it to cripple and, therefore, farmworkers are critical to the entire industry.
- They contribute immensely to the U.S. economy - On and off the farm, farmworkers without immigration status are contributing more than \$9 billion annually to the fruit and vegetable industry alone.

5 FACTS ABOUT FARM WORKERS THAT WILL BLOW YOUR MIND

1. They are paid in pennies - For every one pound of sweet potatoes picked, farmworkers are paid only one penny in North Carolina — they pick more than 9,000 pounds every day.
2. Farmworkers are often children - In North Carolina, children as young as six years old are employed in the agriculture industry.
3. Many of them drop out of school - The highest drop-out rate from high schools goes to the farmworker youth.
4. High rates of tuberculosis - The tuberculosis infection rate is much higher in farmworkers than in the general public.
5. More than 3 million agricultural jobs each year - The shortage of farmworkers is real, with more than 550,000 U.S. farmers hiring workers to fill more than 3 million farming jobs — these jobs are filled by only 2.5 million farmworkers of the U.S population each year.

Remember, the use of oil and gasoline can be made for both good and evil purposes. We can significantly reduce demand for gas (and lower the price significantly) if we stop anti-social driving!

This prudent policy will also save many innocent lives to boot! A couple of sad cases that happened a week since my last column on this topic makes my point:

Item: A 13-year-old driver in Texas caused the untimely death of nine persons including members of the New Mexico State golf team in a dreadful crash.

Item: During the same short time six high-school girls, ages 15 to 17, were killed in a horrible truck crash in Oklahoma.

Fifteen young lives were wiped out by two very young drivers in just two needless incidents. There remain strong, data-based arguments in favor of raising the minimum driving age. Did you ever notice how many cars are parked in lots outside of our high schools? Should any operator of a two-ton vehicle be able to do so recklessly? Especially without proving their responsibility such as achieving a high school diploma? Driver training should be an important part of earning such a diploma. Confiscating the cars of unlawful young drivers and the vehicles of other anti-social drivers such as drug pushers, drug buyers, illegal aliens, criminals, drug or alcohol-impaired drivers, and anyone who is operating without proper insurance coverage will eliminate tens of millions of malevolent gas guzzlers from our highways and byways. This proposal will surely cut the demand for gas and our precious fuel resources.

It is an "easy do" for state and local police to perform. In most cases, no arrests are needed. All law enforcement has to do is seize, tow, and impound the vehicle. Treat it like a civil matter. Take the offending vehicle to an impounding lot. No bail is required. No criminal courts are necessary. No criminal trials or incarcerations. Keep the car as long as possible and send the worst and most unsafe gas guzzlers to the chipper. Let them sue and spend lots of legal fees to get their cars back many years later. Charge daily impounding fees and sell the safe/useable vehicles at auction. It is a safe bet that tens of millions of gas-guzzlers will be taken off our streets reducing the demand and lowering gasoline prices. America will also be much safer. Will they, or won't they wake up? Stay tuned.

NATIONAL LOVE OUR CHILDREN DAY – APRIL 2, 2022

National Love Our Children Day takes place every year on the first Saturday in April. As the month of April is also for National Child Abuse Prevention Month, National Love Our Children Day is part of the campaign to raise awareness about all forms of child abuse. HISTORY OF NATIONAL LOVE OUR CHILDREN DAY

National Love Our Children Day was established in 2004 by Love Our Children U.S.A., a non-profit organization that aims to prevent and eliminate all forms of violence against children. Their focus is to tackle issues such as internet safety, cyberbullying, school violence, and family attitudes that impact the lives of children. Since its inception, the organization has reached over five million people through its website. It has also been featured on numerous T.V. and radio programs, spreading awareness about children. Their website contains over 1,600 pages of useful information to assist parents, families, and children on various positive parenting and child safety topics.

The organization also created a program called "Stomp Out Bullying", a national program that focuses on the prevention of cyberbullying, bullying, sexting, and racism among children and teenagers. On the organization's website, over 10 million people have made a commitment to stomp out bullying.

Violence against children is an epidemic that needs to be eliminated from our society. It affects the growth and development of children, with long-lasting effects that creep into their behavioral patterns as adults. To completely eliminate child abuse, prevention is much better than cure. By identifying and curbing all acts that promote child abuse, children are spared from such traumas, leading to a happier, healthier society. This is why National Love Our Children Day is so important to not just families as a unit but to society as a whole.

HOW TO OBSERVE NATIONAL LOVE OUR CHILDREN DAY

- **Love a child** - If you have a child yourself, make it a point of duty to provide a healthy and loving environment for the child to thrive in. If you don't have a child, make a child smile and do whatever you can to make their lives a little easier.
- **Make a commitment** - The celebration of National Love Our Children Day must go beyond one single day. Every day of the year, make a commitment to yourself to stand against all forms of abuse towards children. Speak up when you notice that a child might be in danger.
- **Donate** - If it's within your means, make sure to donate to a child-centered organization, whether it's a charity, orphanage, or school.

1. **Missing children** - Every year, almost 1.8 million children are reported missing.
2. **Online predators** - Every day, 1 out of 7 children is approached by online predators.
3. **Online bullying** - 43% of children have faced bullying online.
4. **Foster care** - In the United States, about 580,000 children live in foster care.
5. **Bullying** - 1 out of every 4 kids experiences some form of bullying.

WHY NATIONAL LOVE OUR CHILDREN DAY IS IMPORTANT

- **Precious children** - Children are precious gems that must be loved and cherished. National Love Our Children Day is a chance to celebrate the little people who make the world a brighter place, reminding us that they deserve to be celebrated every day.
- **Prevention of child abuse** - This day is vital to the campaign against child abuse, providing education about abuse prevention. It is not enough to provide help and support after the abuse has taken place, but to prevent it from happening in the first place.
- **Awareness** - This day raises awareness about the plethora of issues children face on a daily basis. Being aware of these issues is a necessary step towards solving the problem.

Social Worker Visit with Fresh Start

The Fresh Start @ Your Library program, which provides citizens returning from incarceration assistance and access to resources, is getting a reboot at the Atlantic City Free Public Library in March. For the first time since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, a Fresh Start social worker will be available for in-person meetings at the library 11 a.m.-3 p.m. Wednesdays, beginning March 2. Participants in the Fresh Start program will have access to the following at the library:

- One-on-one guidance from an onsite social worker who can perform assessments, provide referrals, and assist with online job searches, applications and resumes
- Computer training and ESL classes
- Library resources related to reentry, educational, employment, health, legal and social topics

As part of the program, the library will host an Expungement Webinar on Friday, March 25, at 3p.m. via Zoom. In this webinar, attendees will learn what it means to have a record expunged, who is eligible for expungement, records required, how to file and how to get help. 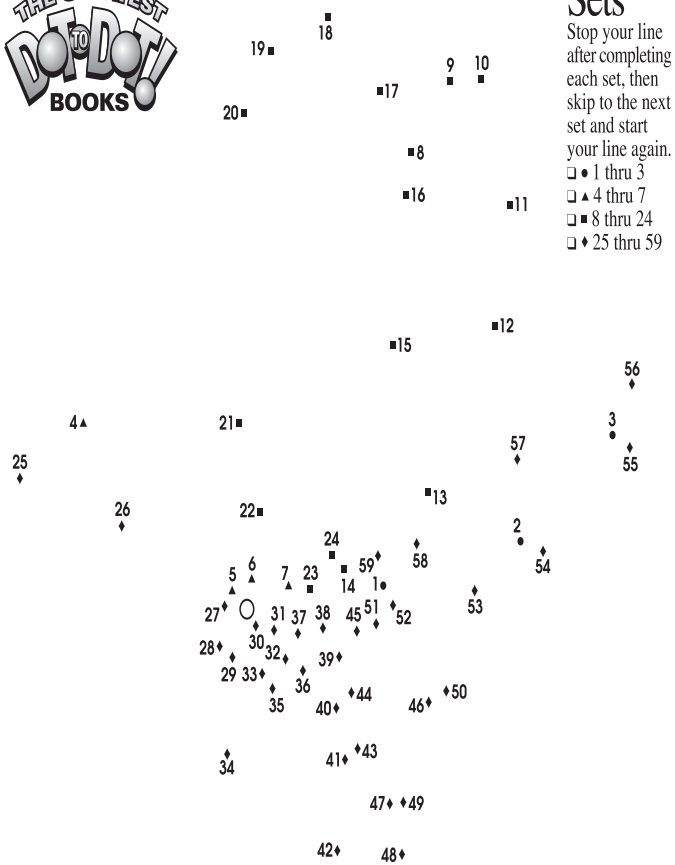

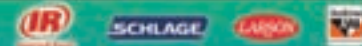

He went on to break another record held by both Elton John and the Grateful Dead when he played his 65th concert at the Garden. He was set to play his 74th consecutive monthly show at MSG when COVID-19 and the pandemic caused a pause in all concerts. Billy Joel resumed touring in 2021 and picked up where he left off. After all he is "The Entertainer".

Through some generosity of friends unable to attend, my wife and I had the chance to head into the city to catch the Billy Joel Madison Square Garden residency for show number 77, Joel's 123rd time playing the venue. I have been fortunate to see Billy Joel in concert 35 years ago in Philadelphia and then again in 2009 when he jumped on stage to help Sir Paul McCartney open Citi Field in New York. For my wife, this would be her first-time seeing Billy Joel live.

Early on in the development of my musical tastes, my older sisters introduced me to Billy Joel. The album *The Stranger* was one of the first of his records that we played on my sister's turntable. During the concert, when he played the songs "Vienna", "Just the Way You Are", "Movin' Out (Anthony's Song)", "She's Always a Woman", "Only the Good Die Young" and "Scenes from an Italian Restaurant" from *The Stranger* album the entire audience, including my wife and me, responded with enthusiasm and appreciation.

Speaking of the audience, from our vantage point just off the side of the stage we could see the crowd was made up of multiple generations of fans from pre-teens to senior citizens. At age 72 with over 50 years in the industry Billy Joel's fanbase continues to grow. Joel also was sure to "play" to every seat in the Garden by having his piano on a rotating mechanism. Throughout the show the piano would rotate to allow everyone to see the man and his piano while the music flowed throughout the night.

As much of a success that *The Stranger* was for his career and acclaim, for me his 1980 follow up *Glass Houses* made a deeper musical impact. When my sisters brought home Billy Joel's seventh studio album right before my birthday in March, as I turned 14 the time was right for my connection to this specific album offering. Not only did *Glass Houses* feature Billy Joel's first song to hit number one on Billboard's Singles chart, the song "It's Still Rock and Roll to Me" spoke to me personally as I started discovering many different genres of music. Through high writing style and references I was set off on a path of seeking out and searching for songs that would create a deep appreciation of music. The album, produced by the legendary Phil Ramone, topped the charts for six weeks and won Billy Joel a Grammy Award for "Best Male Rock Vocal Performance".

From the opening sound of glass shattering, side one of *Glass Houses* offered an amazing mix of music that I played over and over. Side one included "You May Be Right", "Sometimes a Fantasy", "Don't Ask Me Why", "It's Still Rock and Roll to Me" and "All for Leyna". Each of those songs stood on their own as excellent, strung together for me those five songs the created 18 minutes and 6 seconds of musical greatness. If my memory serves me correctly, I only strayed from listening to side one of *Glass Houses* in its entirety to occasional listen to side two's "Sleeping with the Television On".

The night we showed up at Madison Square Garden, Billy Joel catapulted me back to that pivotal time in my discovering and developing my taste in music. As Joel peppered in "Don't Ask Me Why", "Sleeping with the Television On" "It's Still Rock and Roll to Me" and closed the show with "You May Be Right", I sang every word of every song. I realized that night that the music of Billy Joel has been one of the most constant musical presences in my entire lifetime. While he is counted amongst one of the greatest entertainers of all time by critics and fans alike, as I entered my teens Billy Joel was there helping me set the stage for a lifelong love and appreciation for music. No "maybes" about it, it's still rock and roll to me!

The Final Four matchups are set with Duke vs. North Carolina and Kansas vs. Villanova meeting in Saturday's semifinals

The field for the 2022 Final Four is set, and after starting at 68 teams less than three weeks ago, there's only one No. 1 seed remaining who will be making the trip to New Orleans. But there will be plenty of college basketball royalty represented when the action tips off Saturday from the Caesars Superdome as Kansas, Villanova, Duke and North Carolina compete for the national title.

First up on Saturday will be the game between the No. 1 seed Jayhawks and No. 2 seed Wildcats at 6:09 p.m. on TBS. Then, after that one concludes, No. 2 seed Duke will take on No. 8 seed North Carolina.

With legendary Duke coach Mike Krzyzewski aiming for his sixth national title before retiring at season's end, the Blue Devils figure to be a big story. Despite being more reliant on freshmen than any of the remaining squads, Duke is playing its best basketball of the season, which gives Coach K a great shot to go out on top. First, though, the Blue Devils will have to get past the Tar Heels after their biggest rival handed them a 94-81 defeat in Coach K's final home game on March 5.

The 2022 NCAA Tournament has taught us to expect the unexpected this time of year, and a Final Four with this combination of teams is sure to deliver some drama before a champion is crowned on April 4.

Here is the early look at what's ahead for the Final Four.

(2) Villanova vs. (1) Kansas

About the Wildcats -- Villanova never dropped out of the AP Top 25 this season, but the Wildcats did fade to No. 23 in December after a 7-4 start. With losses against UCLA, Purdue and Baylor during non conference play and a lone marquee victory over Tennessee, it seemed like these Wildcats might merely be good instead of great. But over the second half of the season, coach Jay Wright's veteran squad evolved into a national title contender by doing all the little things right. The Wildcats shoot a national best 83% from the free-throw line and commit just 9.9 turnovers per game. Those attributes and a stifling defense were on display in a 50-44 Elite Eight win over Houston in which Villanova shot just 28.8% from the floor but hit 15 of 15 free throws. The Wildcats are not a deep team and could be especially lean in the Final Four after starting shooting guard Justin Moore left the Houston game with an injury. Key reserve guard Jordan Longino is also out due to injury. But Villanova still has veteran stars Collin Gillespie and Jermaine Samuels. Having won 14 of their past 15 games, the Wildcats will be a tough out even with a thin rotation.

About the Jayhawks -- Kansas never left the top 10 during a bounce-back season following the relative disappointment of a 2020-21 campaign that ended in the

second round of the NCAA Tournament. The Jayhawks split the Big 12 regular season title with defending national champion Baylor and then dashed to a Big 12 Tournament title to enter the Big Dance with momentum. Victories over Texas Southern, Creighton, Providence and Miami sent KU to the Final Four from the Midwest Region as the last No. 1 seed standing. Kansas trailed Miami 35-29 at halftime of its Elite Eight matchup but outscored the Hurricanes 47-15 in the second half to make a statement entering New Orleans. With Arizona State transfer Remy Martin beginning to reach his potential at point guard and senior wing Ochai Agbaji enjoying a renaissance season, the Jayhawks are strong in the back court. Their cast of role players, led by dynamic forwards Christian Braun and Jalen Wilson, is deep as well.

About the Tar Heels -- When legendary North Carolina coach Roy Williams announced on April 1 last year that he was retiring immediately, it meant this was going to be a transition season for the Tar Heels. In the end, however, UNC's 2021-22 campaign will end in a familiar setting as the program makes its 21st Final Four appearance under first-year coach Hubert Davis. It was unclear as recently as mid-February whether North Carolina would even make the NCAA Tournament after it lost at home to Pittsburgh on Feb. 16 while on the bubble. But UNC rallied down the stretch with five straight victories to close the regular season, including a 94-81 win at Duke on March 5. The Tar Heels are thriving offensively with a lean rotation with stars such as sophomore guard Caleb Love, junior center Armando Bacot and graduate transfer forward Brady Manek each bringing different scoring specialties to the table. Davis may be a first-time head coach navigating his first season leading the program, but after a decade under Williams and a storied playing career of his own, he's got his squad playing its best basketball at the right time.

About the Blue Devils -- Duke's final season under legendary coach Mike Krzyzewski started with a bang as the Blue Devils knocked off Kentucky in a top-10 showdown to open the season. After also beating Gonzaga, the Blue Devils briefly rose to No. 1 and enjoyed a mostly smooth ride through ACC play until the end. Then, in Coach K's final home game, the Blue Devils lost 94-81 against arch rival North Carolina and squandered the chance to send Krzyzewski out with a regular season sweep of the program's nearby nemesis. A week later, an 82-67 loss to Virginia Tech in the ACC Tournament title game sent the Blue Devils into the Big Dance without much momentum. But Duke's young team has grown up in a hurry with sophomores Jeremy Roach and Mark Williams playing key roles to complement freshman phenoms AJ Griffin and Paolo Banchero. In victories over Texas Tech and Arkansas during the Sweet 16 and Elite Eight, Duke turned in sterling offensive performances. So far in this tournament, Krzyzewski has reached 1,200 career victories, 100 career NCAA Tournament victories and passed UCLA legend John Wooden for most Final Four appearances by a coach with 13. Now the only question is whether Duke can get Krzyzewski a sixth national title.

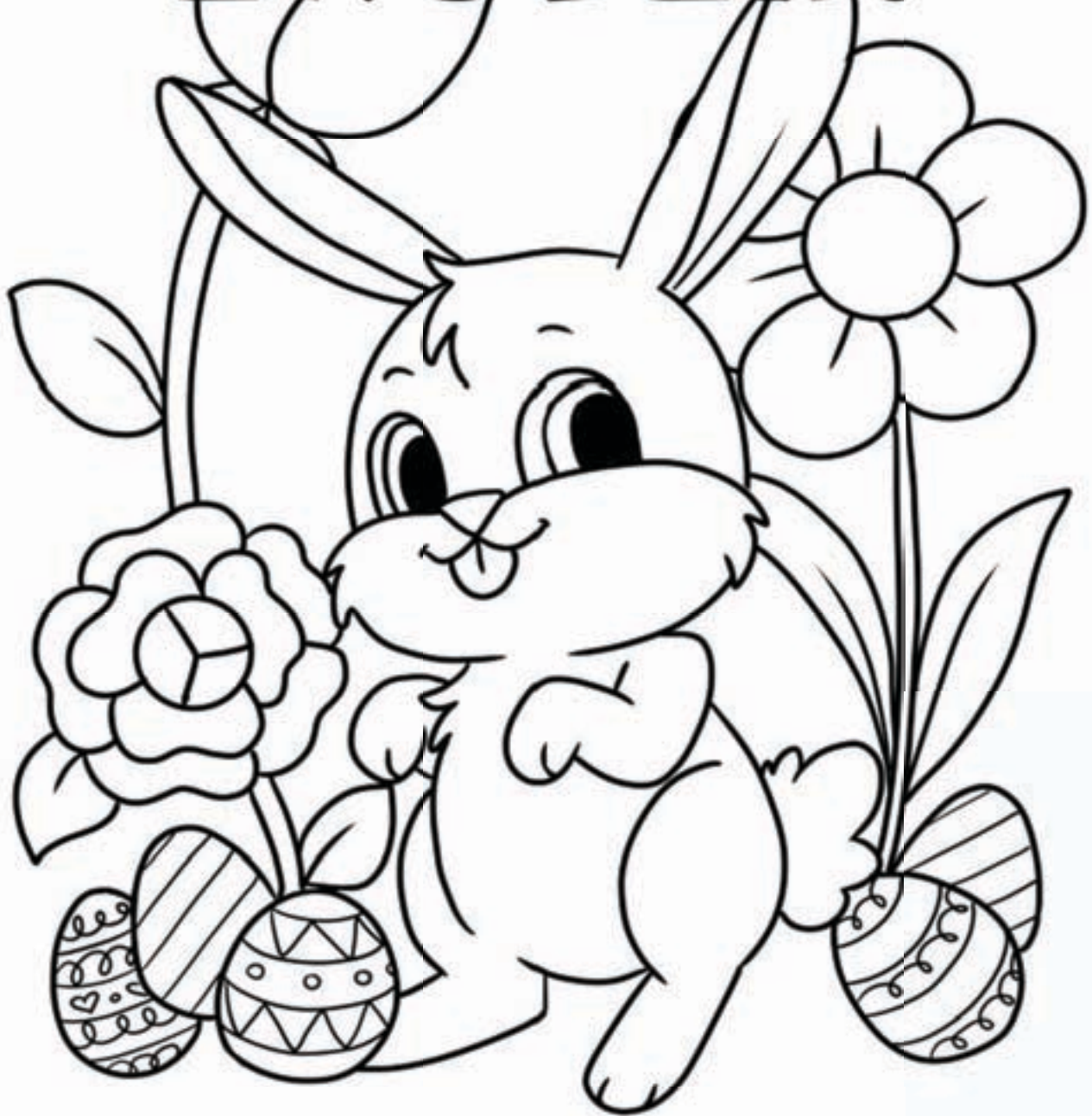

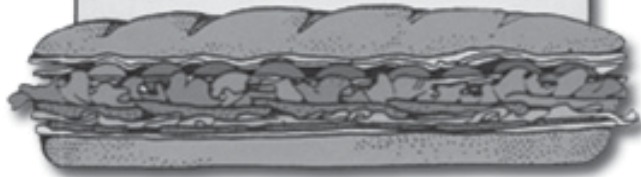

Stockton University will receive \$500,000 from the federal government to support its coastal resiliency and management programs and provide STEM educational and career opportunities for middle and high school students in South Jersey.

The Coastal Resiliency Equipment, Education and Outreach funds were approved as part of the FY22 federal budget and were among a list of New Jersey Community Projects supported by N.J. Senators Bob Menendez and Cory Booker.

"These projects will...make the critical investments so that New Jersey continues to be one of the greatest places to live and work," Menendez said in a press release announcing the grants.

The grant will be administered by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.

Stockton will use the funds to:

- Purchase scientific instruments for remote sensing of southern New Jersey's coastal environment and mapping of the coastal islands, and provide high level student training for Stockton's Master of Science in Coastal Zone Management program.
- Provide STEM field experiences for middle and high school students in Atlantic City and surrounding underserved communities, offering a vital introduction to employment and higher education opportunities regarding the United States' growing blue economy.

\$500,000 Federal grant will help Stockton's coastal resiliency, STEM programming

- Develop a pipeline to underserved K-12 youth to higher education and STEM careers by supporting training for blue economy professions linked to offshore wind development, climate change adaptation and ocean sustainability for tourism, fisheries, recreation, commerce and environmental protection.
- Support training and education in coastal resilience that will inform municipal planning and community outreach along New Jersey's coasts that are threatened by global climate change and rising sea levels.

"Coastal zone management, tourism, and the developing blue economy are important issues in New Jersey," Stockton Dean of the School of Natural Sciences and Mathematics Peter Straub said. "We are losing our coast. These funds will help Stockton do critical research, plus educate and train residents for careers in the industry."

Stockton Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs Leemor Kahanov said the university has been proactive in developing research and academic programs that address the climate issues facing New Jersey.

"This grant helps ensure we are providing students and the public with state-of-the-art equipment and information to do this important work," she said.
