

## A Holiday Born from a Daughter's Love

While Mother's Day became official in 1914, it took decades longer for Father's Day to gain the same respect. The idea was sparked in 1909 when Sonora Smart Dodd, the daughter of a Civil War veteran and single father of six, proposed the holiday in Spokane, Washington. Her goal? To honor the strength and sacrifice of fathers like hers.

The first Father's Day was celebrated in 1910, but it wasn't declared a national holiday until 1972, when President Nixon signed it into law. That's a 58-year lag—proof that dads often have to wait their turn.

## It's Big Business

Though it started from humble beginnings, Father's Day is now a multi-billion-dollar industry. According to the National Retail Federation, Americans spend more than \$20 billion each year on the holiday—mostly on clothing, tools, tech, and gift cards. Interestingly, dinner and experiences have started outpacing traditional gifts, showing a shift toward quality time over things.

## Around the World

Not every country celebrates Father's Day in June. In Germany, "Vatertag" falls on Ascension Day and is marked with hiking trips and, often, beer-fueled adventures. In Thailand, it's observed in December on the birthday of the late King Bhumibol Adulyadej. And in some parts of Italy and Spain, Father's Day coincides with St. Joseph's Day on March 19.

While you can get zinc from plant sources like sesame and pumpkin seeds, chickpeas, lentils, and cashews, it's easier for your body to absorb it from animal foods, such as oysters, beef, crab, lobster, and pork.

### History of Father's Day

Far from a "Hallmark holiday," Father's Day has its origins in medieval Europe, when Catholics dedicated a day to honoring fathers, fatherhood, and all paternal relationships. Fast forward a couple hundred years, and it's now a holiday held all over the world — a testament to how important fathers and father figures are in societies everywhere. However, be careful. The date fluctuates around the world. In Spain, for example, it's held on March 19, while in New Zealand, it's the first Sunday in September. If your dad has a hobby, buy something related to that. Gift cards for his favorite store work great as well. In Margate, Lucy the Elephant remains as wonderfully odd and lovable as ever. The six-story structure, open for tours all afternoon, has been a fixture of shore memory-making for generations. If your dad appreciates history, architecture, or just a great photo op, walking through Lucy's curved frame and climbing to the howdah offers something delightfully out of the ordinary.

Of course, some of the best memories come without plans. A walk on the boardwalk. A seat on the beach. A shared plate of fries or a sub from the place he always swears "tastes better here." Whether it's Vic's, Sack O' Subs, or that neighborhood spot you always return to, what matters isn't the name on the napkin—it's who's across the table.

Not every holiday needs to be tightly scheduled. In fact, Father's Day might be better when it's not. Let the day stretch. Wander a bit. Talk more than you usually do. And whatever you end up doing, do it here—where the salt air lingers, the views still surprise you, and the best part of the day is that you spent it together.





## **Fishing in Atlantic County**

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at dep.nj.gov/njf-w/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/. Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/.

#### SALTWATER FISHING

Atlantic City - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



**Ventnor/Ventnor Heights** - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

**Somers Point** - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

**Brigantine** - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Gravelling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

#### FRESHWATER FISHING

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.

# Honoring Freedom: Juneteenth History, Art, and Community in Atlantic County



Juneteenth, observed annually on June 19th, commemorates a defining moment in American history. It marks the day in 1865 when Union troops arrived in Galveston, Texas, to announce that all enslaved people were free—more than two years after the Emancipation Proclamation had been issued. That delayed declaration, and the liberation it represented, is now honored nationwide as the day that freedom finally reached all corners of the former Confederacy.

Formally recognized by the state of New Jersey in 2020 and declared a federal holiday in 2021, Juneteenth continues to evolve. It is both a remembrance and a call to community—especially in places like Atlantic County, where African American heritage runs deep and creative expression plays a central role in telling the story.

#### Tracing the Local Legacy

Atlantic County's Black history is richly woven through sites of resilience, resistance, and cultural pride. During segregation, Missouri Avenue Beach—known widely as Chicken Bone Beach—offered a place where Black families could gather freely. Over time, it became a cradle for jazz and gospel performances, youth programs, and cultural preservation. It remains a symbol of self-determined joy in the face of exclusion.

Just inland, Atlantic City's Northside once pulsed with the energy of Club Harlem's iconic "Smart Affairs" shows. Nearby, restaurants like Wash's served not only food but fellowship, becoming hubs for both locals and visiting performers. These were not simply places of business; they were institutions built on dignity and artistry, critical to the cultural economy of Black Atlantic City in the 20th century.

As Juneteenth gains national prominence, these local landmarks remind residents that the story of emancipation has always had a local chapter. It lives in neighborhoods, in memories, and increasingly—in murals and galleries.





### The Art of Freedom

At the center of Juneteenth's celebration this year is a powerful current of creativity. The African American Heritage Museum of Southern New Jersey, in collaboration with Stockton University and the Noyes Arts Garage, continues to elevate the Black experience through art. This month's exhibits at the Garage feature visual narratives exploring freedom, struggle, and identity—anchoring the holiday in personal storytelling as much as historical fact.

The Garage's programming includes hands-on printmaking workshops and spoken word performances that invite participation across generations. These events serve not just as celebration, but as creative resistance—connecting past to present through artistic engagement.

That thread continues in the city itself. Atlantic City's streets now host over 100 murals thanks to the Atlantic City Arts Foundation, many of which speak directly to themes of liberation, remembrance, and joy. Artists like Yvonne Shortt have contributed temporary marble dust sculptures and visual installations that question who gets remembered and how. These works serve as permanent and ephemeral reminders of how art becomes history.

#### Community Gatherings and Celebrations

This year's Juneteenth programming stretches across multiple days and communities within Atlantic County:

On June 19, a Juneteenth Luncheon at St. Monica's Parish in Atlantic City welcomes residents from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. Sponsored by the Diocese of Camden's Office of Life and Justice, the gathering includes reflections from nationally known soul performer ValLimar Jansen and a shared meal that blends spirituality, solidarity, and culture.



Also on the 19th, Oscar McClinton Jr. Waterfront Park hosts the 8th Annual Ubuntu Juneteenth Cookout, organized by Ubuntu the Community. This free event features live music, DJs, artisan vendors, face painting, and complimentary food, set against the Atlantic City waterfront. It's a joyful, multigenerational celebration that centers community over ceremony and experience over formality.

Also on June 19, the observance continues inland at Gaskill Park in Mays Landing with a Juneteenth Freedom Celebration hosted by AWISH (Agape Water International Safe House). From 2 to 8 p.m., the lakeside park becomes a celebration space filled with music, food trucks, kids' activities, and powerful moments of reflection. It's a reminder that Juneteenth belongs not just to cities and large venues—but to towns, neighborhoods, and parks where community comes alive.

That same weekend, the Noyes Arts Garage will hold a reception for "Clay in Mind," a ceramics exhibition featuring regional African American artists. Though not June-teenth-specific, its focus on cultural expression and identity aligns powerfully with the spirit of the holiday.

#### Looking Ahead

As New Jersey builds its Black Heritage Trail, Atlantic City's Northside stands out as a likely cornerstone. Sites like Chicken Bone Beach, Club Harlem, and the Civil Rights Garden don't just document history—they represent a living legacy. Juneteenth celebrations here do more than commemorate—they actively preserve and amplify stories that too often go overlooked in mainstream narratives.

Atlantic County's Juneteenth events offer more than a look back. They are living, breathing, community-driven expressions of freedom, resilience, and creativity. Whether expressed through a mural, a poem, a shared meal, or a live jazz set, the message remains the same: freedom is an ongoing practice. One built together.

# Kati & Kail

Kati Rhea, a police officer from Lexington, Kentucky, was in a vehicle accident in 2017 that left her in a coma for several months. Less than a year after the accident, Kati came to The Seeing Eye to be matched with George, a sable German shepherd.

"I picked up the handle and I said, 'Forward!'
And that first step, it was just freedom. I knew, in that moment, I was about to get my life back."

Kati had been told she might not bond instantly with her Seeing Eye dog. "But we just clicked. I knew immediately he was not just my partner, but my back-up. This dog will be there with me and keep me safe."



George retired in 2023, and Kati is now working with Kail, a black and tan German shepherd. The photo shows Kati standing next to Kail, who is sitting on an elevated platform.

"We live on a 40-acre farm with sheep, horses, donkeys, llamas, other dogs, and George gets to play with them all," Kati said. "As for Kail, he's a massive goofball. Until he gets into harness. Then he's a fantastic worker."

# "MEET THE PACK!"

97 YEARS AGO...

97 years ago, on June 11, 1928, Morris Frank stepped off a ship in New York City with Buddy, the first Seeing Eye® dog, and made history. Just weeks earlier, Frank had traveled to Switzerland to train with Buddy at a pioneering guide dog school founded by Dorothy Harrison Eustis, an American dog trainer and philanthropist living abroad. Inspired by her article about guide dogs in The Saturday Evening Post, Frank had written to her with a simple goal: to prove that blind Americans could live independent lives.

In front of a crowd of skeptical reporters, Frank and Buddy successfully navigated a dangerous Manhattan street crossing—demonstrating not only Buddy's training, but the revolutionary potential of the human-canine partnership. Afterward, Frank sent Eustis a one-word telegram that said it all: "Success."

The moment helped launch The Seeing Eye, co-founded by Frank and Eustis in 1929, becoming the first guide dog school in the United States—and a lasting symbol of independence, dignity, and trust.



- 1 cup fresh strawberries, hulled and chopped 1/2 cup apple cider vinegar
- 1/4 cup honey or maple syrup 4–5 fresh basil leaves, plus extra for garnish
- Sparkling water or seltzer Ice

Instructions: In a jar or bowl, muddle strawberries and basil together until juicy and fragrant. Stir in the apple cider vinegar and honey. Cover and refrigerate for at least 4 hours, preferably overnight. Strain the mixture through a fine mesh sieve, pressing to extract all the liquid. To serve: fill a glass with ice, add 2–3 tablespoons of shrub mixture, and top with sparkling water. Garnish with a basil leaf and a slice of strawberry.

Why it works: Shrubs—a centuries-old way to preserve fruit—offer a tart, sophisticated drink with a flavor punch. This one balances the sweetness of Jersey strawberries with the brightness of basil and vinegar, making it a standout summer sipper.
