SOMETHING ABOUT PHILLY PRETZELS

Despite attempts to duplicate the flavor and texture, few succeed. Soft pretzels are a special Philadelphia product, plain and simple. Happily, you don't have to drive 60-plus miles to enjoy the real thing. Instead, visit a local Philly Pretzel Factory franchise. Three Atlantic County stores are within 15 miles—Somers Point, Egg Harbor Twp. and Mays Landing.

Norman and I were invited to a Memorial Day barbecue at my friend Nina's home and I wondered what to bring. I'm not a barbecue-type food cook, so we decided on pretzel rivets from the Somers Point location. Besides traditional sleeves of several attached pretzels, trays and buckets of rivets (nuggets) come in multiple sizes.

Several flavored dips are available as condiments. Nina wanted the Brownie Batter dip, claiming everyone loves the chocolate. She must be right since that was the only dip they did not have at pickup. So, I chose honey mustard, butter cream and cinnamon.

Me? I'm a purist. Just give me plain yellow mustard on my pretzel and I'm happy. I grew up a Philly girl at a time when pretzels and mustard were far less exotic.

Don't stop there. The online menu describes dozens of combinations that include wrapped hot dogs, sausage and cheesesteaks.

One tip to smart buying. Do not order thinking everyone at a party will eat multiples. It's pickup finger food and with so much else being served, most people will just try a few. You are better off going for less than more. That avoids too many leftovers, especially since soft pretzels are so perishable. <https://phillypretzelfactory.com>

CRUISIN' ON A SATURDAY AFTERNOON

If you love older cars, and who doesn't, come to Vineland's Landis Avenue for its 30th Cruise Down Memory Lane event next weekend on Saturday, 6/11, from 5 p.m.-9 p.m. The rain date is the next day, Sunday, 6/12, at the same time.

Have you ever done a double-take to look at an antique or vintage car driving by? The owners usually maintain them in beautiful condition. It is fun to actually remember the cars, especially if you drove one yourself.

The Beach Boys and other '60s groups sold millions of records singing about GTOs, T-Birds, Little Deuce Coupes and other cars. Don't forget Corvettes, Firebirds and Camaros with the orange stripes. Motown even entered the car genre with Wilson Pickett's "Mustang Sally" in 1965.

This exhibition celebrates auto beauty and design. These cars from different eras, worth millions of dollars, will line Landis Avenue. More than 1,000 American cars, covering over a mile of space, will be on display. Think of old street rods, muscle cars, stock or custom classics, rat rods and cruisers.

Only American marque cars, manufactured in 1974 or earlier, may participate. The exceptions are highly modified late-model autos or a car entering with a legitimate car club. Motorcycles, bikes, foreign cars, or partially-

THE CIRCUS RETURNS

Animals are now not in the lineup. In past years, the definition of a circus and public opinion have changed dramatically.

Exposure and public outrage of behind-the-scenes abusive treatment and training processes sealed the deal for ending animal performances. Now, many of these elephants, lions, tigers and other animals can live out their lives in peaceful sanctuaries.

If you follow the Wizard's advice in patronizing the best and avoiding the worst casinos, your money will last longer, and you will have a better chance to win. This week's feature is about "Cause and Effect, by the Numbers!"

The "Wiz" does not claim to possess uncanny powers to predict the future, but he does know that the axiom "the past is prologue to the future" applies more often than not. It is all about the numbers and how to read them to establish the cause of subsequent events. Here are a few for your consideration:

Public Safety: When you cut your police department manpower from 404 sworn officers to 195 you get more crime and disorder. The ACPD's budget was cut from \$37.2 million in 2012 to \$19.9 million in 2015. This year it is \$25.9 million that funds 267 officers, still not enough to address the foreseeable risk of crime to visitors and residents.

Casino Safety: A five-year study of serious crime in a large, but now defunct, casino hotel on the Boardwalk revealed that crimes increased by 99% as the budgets for security were cut by 31% during that same period.

High Gas Prices and Inflation: When you cut supply such as the Keystone Pipeline and create increased demand by allowing millions of illegal aliens and hoods to use our highways and byways you get higher gasoline prices. This contributes to inflation because everything we buy or use is related to energy in some way or another.

Baby Formula: When you allow four companies to monopolize this critical nutrition for infants and the largest supplier shuts down because of unsanitary conditions in a supposedly FDA-regulated vital industry, (Abbott Labs = 40%) mothers panic. That enables many goniffs to hike prices.

Winning & Losing: When casinos "loosen" their slots and table game rules you have a greater chance of playing longer which gives Lady Luck more time to visit you. When casinos "tighten" slot odds and replace BJ games with Spanish 21 with higher house percentage games, you get cleaned out faster. The end result is that fewer customers return and the casino goes bust taking away thousands of local jobs. On the other hand, casinos that offer better deals such as the Borgata prosper.

The bottom line is that the laws of supply and demand are constant. So is cause and effect. When will they ever learn?

HISTORY OF NATIONAL OCEANS MONTH

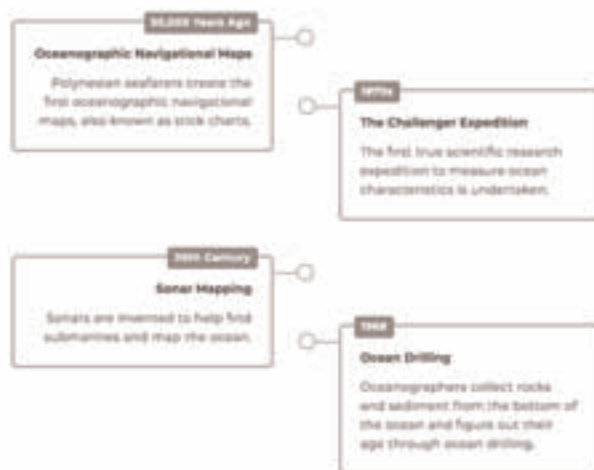

5 FACTS ABOUT THE OCEAN THAT WILL BLOW YOUR MIND

1. **Less than 5% explored** - It is difficult to study ocean life, hence the reason only 5% of the planet's oceans have been explored.
2. **Longest mountain chain in the ocean** - The planet's longest chain of mountains, the Mid-Ocean Ridge, stretching across a distance of 40,390 miles, is almost entirely beneath the ocean.
3. **Pacific Ocean is wider than the Moon** - At its widest point, the Pacific Ocean from Indonesia to Colombia is wider than the Moon.
4. **Half of the U.S. is below the ocean** - The borders of the U.S. extend 200 nautical miles away from the shore and thus half of the country lies below the ocean.
5. **Three million shipwrecks in the ocean** - According to the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization, the oceans have around three million shipwrecks.

- **They provide the oxygen we breathe** - The National Ocean Service states that oceans produce over 60% of the world's oxygen. This makes them extremely important to the well-being of all individuals.

CHEF CHIP'S WILD GAME AND SEAFOOD RECIPE

PAN SEARED GROUPE W/ WHITE WINE SAUCE

INGREDIENTS:

- 2 (6oz.) Grouper Fillets, Skin Off
- 1 cup All-Purpose Flour
- 1/2 cup Canola Oil
- 4 Tbsp Whole Unsalted Butter
- Seasoned Salt to Taste
- Fresh Cracked Black Pepper to Taste

Sauce:

- 2 Tbsp Whole Unsalted Butter
- 1/2 Shallot, Minced
- 1/2 cup White Wine
- 1 tsp Fresh Chopped Lavender
- 1/2 Lemon
- Kosher Salt & Fresh Cracked Black Pepper to Taste

PREPARATION:

Preheat oven to 375°. Preheat oil and butter in a medium size oven safe saute pan over medium high heat, on range top. Season fish with seasoned salt. Pour flour into a ziploc bag. Place fillets into the bag one at a time. Seal the bag and coat the fillet. Repeat process for other fillet. Place fillets flesh side down into hot fat. Sear golden brown. Flip fillets and place pan in oven to finish cooking. While the fish is finishing, make the sauce. Using a small to medium size saute pan, add 1 Tbsp of butter and place on burner over medium heat. When the butter heats up, add in shallot. Cook until translucent. Add in wine and lavender and reduce liquid by half. Remove from heat and whisk in remaining butter. Last, season and squeeze in lemon. Pour sauce over plated fillets. Garnish with lemon wedges. Enjoy!

THE IMPORTANCE OF ORGAN MEAT FOR YOUR DOGS & CATS

A few weeks ago, Bob shared a video by Dr. Marty, a graduate of The Cornell Veterinary School and a practicing vet for over 48 years. He is also a vet for Oprah Winfrey, Martha Stewart, among other celebs and regular people like me. I watched the video for its length of over thirty minutes, and everything he emphasized, I have been telling my readers for decades. Stay away from by-products, soy, wheat, corn, artificial flavor and color, dangerous preservatives (like in Milk Bones) and food manufactured to benefit big companies like Mars, Smuckers, and Procter and Gamble, to name a few.

But what he emphasized, that I had already been giving to my pets, was organ meats. In my case, I was doing some raw, but always added some dehydrated. According to an article I got off the internet by Jodie Gruenstern, DVM, CVA, organ meats are super foods for dogs and cats. Presently, I am giving my cats dehydrated rabbit, and my dogs a variety of dehydrated protein sources. Giving your dogs and cats some liver, kidney, and heart can help their overall health immensely. These are parts of the prey that would be caught and relished in the wild. It is said that the best diet for a cat is a healthy mouse, as the cat will get the benefit of all the tissue, blood and organs.

LIVER is the most widely used because it is so easy to acquire. But it gets some bad publicity because the liver detoxifies. But the liver does not store these toxins, it merely filters them out. When analyzed post-mortem, the liver has no more toxins than the kidneys or muscles. The benefits of liver include added vitamins A, D, E and K, which are all important fat-soluble vitamins, which means they dissolve in fat and are stored in the liver and fatty tissue until required by the body, helping to keep the heart healthy and blood to clot. Some food sources that provide these vitamins (all for humans, most for pets) are liver, dairy, kale, sweet potato, apricots (I am eating some now) tomatoes, carrots, egg yolk, spinach, and cantaloupe.

HEARTS provide the amino acid Taurine (so does sardines) which is vital to healthy functioning of the heart, but the benefits can be destroyed through heating. The highest level for cats is in the heart muscle of mice! Cats will develop DCM if they lack Taurine in their diet. Heart is the best source of CoQ10, which Bob and I take every morning. Bison, venison and beef hearts are really good sources of CoQ10. Eating heart organ (included in frozen and freeze-dried form) provides iron, zinc, selenium and B vitamins, essential for "energy balance and preventing oxidative stress."

STOMACH, is also called tripe and can really be stinky. Treats, and freeze-dried are available, but the best is raw, or raw frozen. Dogs usually love it and it is a great way to get fussy eaters to eat, and it will help disguise medicines or other supplements a pet may need to ingest. Green tripe is full of healthy probiotics, which is vital to a healthy microbiome and immune system.

I will continue with other organ meats next issue. Thank you for helping us and our mini cat shelter. The next few months are crucial for our survival. Please tell your friends about us.

INGREDIENTS

- 1 cup black quinoa
- 2 ripe, Fresh California Avocados, halved, seeded and peeled
- 2 medium firm peaches, seeded and halved
- 3 Tbsp. extra virgin olive oil
- 1/4 cup extra virgin olive oil, for frying
- 1 tsp. kosher salt, separated
- 1 (5 oz.) package wild arugula, 1/2 cup reserved for vinaigrette
- 1/4 cup no-shell chopped pistachios (optional)

PISTACHIO-ARUGULA VINAIGRETTE

- 1/2 cup wild arugula
- 1/2 cup baby spinach
- 5 no-shell pistachio nuts
- 1 1/2 tsp. creamy Dijon mustard
- 1 Tbsp. honey (local if available)
- 1/4 cup apple cider vinegar
- 1/4 cup grapeseed oil (may substitute extra virgin olive oil)
- 1/4 cup extra virgin olive oil
- 1/2 clove garlic
- 1 pinch cayenne pepper
- 1/8 tsp. kosher salt, or to taste
- 1/8 tsp. pepper, or to taste



INSTRUCTIONS

Prepare quinoa according to package directions. Drain well using a fine strainer and spread on a rimmed baking sheet. Let stand, tossing occasionally until dried, about 30 minutes.

While quinoa dries, place all the Pistachio-Arugula Vinaigrette ingredients in a blender. Blend on medium speed until combined. Set aside.

Once the quinoa is thoroughly dry, heat oil for frying in a large skillet on high until waves begin to form in oil. Carefully add the quinoa, reduce heat to medium and fry until puffed, approximately 30 seconds. Drain the quinoa in a fine strainer to remove excess oil and transfer to paper towels. Sprinkle lightly with salt.

On a tray or baking sheet, place avocados and peaches cut side up, drizzle with olive oil and lightly season the avocados with salt. Heat grill to medium high, add avocados and peaches cut side down, reduce heat to low and grill until tender and slightly charred (peaches 5 minutes; avocados 2 minutes).

To assemble salad, toss arugula with a small amount of the vinaigrette and place on the platter. Next, sprinkle quinoa on the platter. Cut avocado and peaches into wedges and place onto the platter. Drizzle with vinaigrette.

Garnish with chopped pistachios if desired.

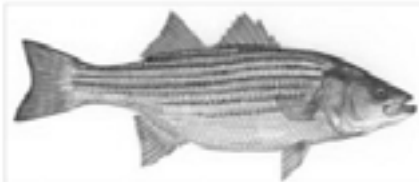

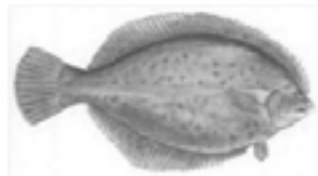

Your Music Supplier – Radio or Streaming?

In today's world when it comes to listening to or discovering new music there are several choices. In the past the dominant way to hear new music would be to tune your radio dial into a station you like whose mission it was to offer new music in their song rotation. You could hear a new rock song on a rock station, a new alternative song on the alternation station, and so on. Radio has survived many challenges to its business model.

The 1979 classic song by The Buggles "Video Killed the Radio Star" pretty much detailed out one of the greatest threats to radio. The song tells the tale of radio stars losing out to the new video-based options of MTV / Music Television. Fortunate for radio station owners that video at that time was not portable or commonplace in cars. That is up until the time of the portable video players in cars and video phones like iPhone. However, before those readily available technologies radio survived for decades. Satellite radio also put a dent in AM/FM radio listeners. Their model including tighter focusses on artists and genres and with a paying audience subscribing satellite radio had a financial advantage over AM/FM radio. While radio made its revenue on advertising, satellite radio had advertising dollars and subscription fees.

Now comes competition from streaming? How has and how will radio stations and radio listeners be affected by people's ability to stream music and discover new music through streaming?

It is still the case that AM/FM radio still has the largest market share at over 30% of Americans saying they still listen to radio regularly. Radio still has much to offer especially as a news source or community connector at a regional level. It may sound counter intuitive to say in talking about growing versus not growing but the smaller markets create value. Even if that value is pieced together with smaller radio markets adding up to more current listeners.

Most people listen to radio "on the go" in their vehicles mostly. And therefore, the pandemic has not helped radio stations since most people were staying home and not driving, working from home rather than commuting, and that lead to more streaming on music.

Of course, during the past few decades physical sales of music were down, and at the same time social media and satellite radio were up. That ultimately led to music labels promotional spending shifting towards streaming. Many people point to 2011 when Spotify, a music streaming service launched in the United States. Once streams started to become a label's main revenue source, the industry continued to pour more dollars behind supporting streaming.

In the past, radio was the place to break a new artist or have a huge popular artist or band debut new music. That just isn't the case anymore. Radio is still part of the equation, but not the only opportunity to reach listeners. AM/FM radio is rarely the place to find a large number of new artists or bands to be played. It is much easier for radio to promote or add songs of established well known artists than to fill an entire rotation or segments with new artists.

The opposite is true with many streaming services. If you stream Dave Matthews Band on a streaming service, there is a high probability you will hear a good number of DMB tunes. In addition to those songs, you will get your fill of similar established artists and bands. However, you will also get a healthy dose of music from ATO Records, a music label that is part owned by Dave Matthews. You will hear songs by artists like The Black Pumas. There is an example of a great new band that unfortunately has not found regular songs played on AM/FM radio stations, despite critical acclaim and audiences gravitating to their music both live and recorded. Once established, radio can help extend the success of songs and increase its popularity to a wider more general audience. In some ways, AM/FM radio still compliments the massive music discovery machine that streaming has become.

Some current research of listeners that consider finding new music important say that radio is one of the places they go, but it is not the most important place for them. The internet is the most common place people searched, then music recommendations from friends and family, then radio and streaming services. The big difference between radio and streaming may come down to personal choice. Consumers have more choice in the way they listen to music with streaming versus AM/FM radio. Plus, they can stream almost anywhere. They can stream via a computer or mobile device. Cars are now equipped with Bluetooth connectivity to mobile devices as well as built-in on-board computer like functions with internet capabilities and applications (Apps).

While streaming is growing in popularity, most of the radio listening (well over ninety percent) is still done via a device that can broadcast reliability of the signal and unlike upgraded streaming services, free to the listener.

No matter where and how you get your fix and get supplied your music, streaming and AM/FM radio are still complementary technologies. Life is difficult enough so the idea that these competitors can make it easier for listeners to tune in to listen, using whatever old school or high-tech device they choose is a really cool way to enjoy a diverse mix of music.

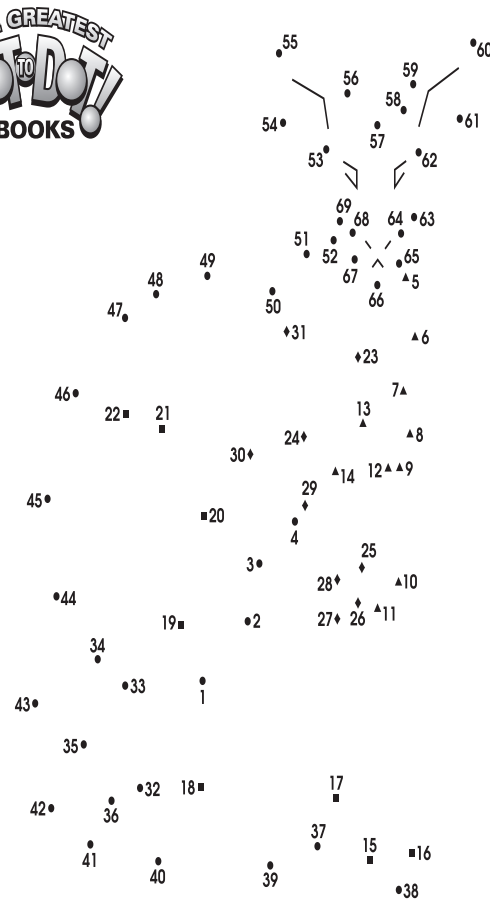

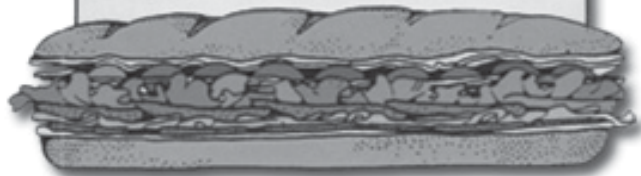
