

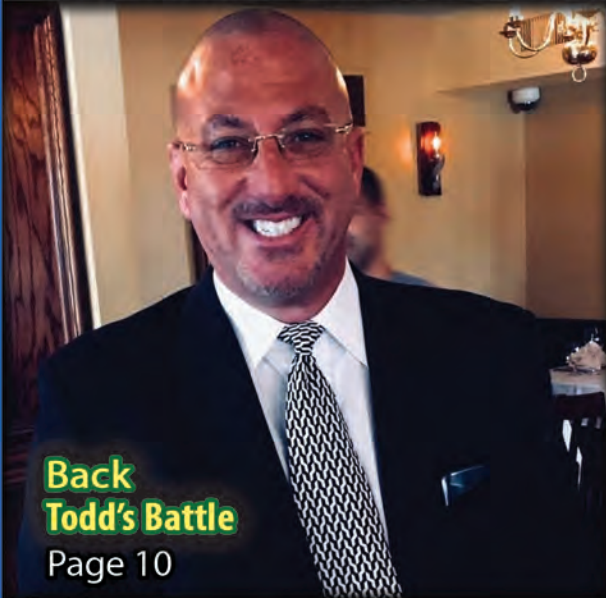

Atlantic County High School Football: Week 6 Roundup

Week 6 arrived with fireworks and separation. Atlantic City aired it out for another statement win, Cedar Creek kept pounding the ground with authority, and Pleasantville's defense stayed airtight while the offense found another gear. Mainland steadied itself on the road, St. Joseph reasserted its bite, and a handful of programs hit turning points as October football took shape across Atlantic County.

Atlantic City didn't just beat Vineland on Thursday - they detonated. Sophomore quarterback Marvin Burroughs Jr. threw a school-record six touchdown passes as the Vikings rolled 55-10 at the Thorofare for their third straight win and a 5-1 mark. The deep-ball connection between Burroughs and Don'Taye Thompson was untouchable, with Thompson hauling in three scores on screen-and-go routes that stretched Vineland sideline to sideline. Kyree Barksdale added two touchdowns of his own and broke loose for a 52-yard catch-and-run that brought the home crowd to its feet. With Ahmad Chambers consistently flipping field position on returns, Atlantic City's special teams kept the gas pedal down. The Vikings head west to face Eastern Friday at 6 p.m., where Burroughs' arm will meet another top-15 offense in a matchup that could light up the scoreboard.



Cedar Creek made its rivalry with Oakcrest a one-sided affair, storming to a 35-6 win behind another dominant night from Amir Dunbar, who followed his 293-yard outburst last week with 171 yards and two touchdowns on 22 carries. Quarterback Jaiden Acevedo went 9-of-11 passing with a touchdown to Malik Hammond, and the defense forced three turnovers, including a strip-sack by Quadir Sneed that set up a short field. It marked Cedar Creek's fifth straight win and fourth straight game topping 30 points. The Pirates return home Thursday to host 5-1 Lower Cape May at 6 p.m. - a collision of heavy hitters that could define playoff seeding across South Group 3.

Oakcrest couldn't match the Pirates' pace, but freshman Zane Forest continued to show composure, throwing for 162 yards and a touchdown to Jaden Harvey, who added 94 yards receiving. The Falcons, now 2-4, have leaned on a defense that averages just 17 points allowed in wins, but they'll need that version Thursday at 5 p.m. in Mays Landing when they welcome a Pleasantville team that's suddenly catching fire.

Mainland's road toughness stayed intact with a 20-7 win over Ocean City, snapping a seven-year drought at Carey Stadium and leveling the Mustangs at 3-3. Quarterback John Franchini managed the game with precision, going 14-of-19 passing and finding Jayden Barrett twice on red-zone slants, while linebacker Luke McCaffrey anchored a defense that allowed just 32 rushing yards. Jake Eckman's fourth-quarter interception sealed it. Mainland now returns home to face Egg Harbor Township Friday at 6 p.m., aiming for a fourth straight win over the Eagles and a chance to re-enter the top-10 power-point mix.



St. Augustine's defense has been its calling card, holding opponents to an average of 8 points per game, and the Hermits spent their bye fine-tuning the ground game before Friday's 7 p.m. trip to Lenape. Expect Matt Reed and Jason Tucker to control the trenches as Prep looks to extend its six-year streak over the Indians.

Holy Spirit, after a slugfest loss to Cedar Creek, gets a non-conference measuring stick Thursday at 6 p.m. against Delsea. Tyler Bell will carry the load behind a revamped line, while Noah Sanchez leads a front seven that has forced turnovers in each of the last three games. A clean night could push the Spartans back over .500.

Egg Harbor Township came back to earth after its 35-point breakout, dropping a 34-6 decision to Lower Cape May. Carter King's second-quarter touchdown run provided the lone scoring drive, and Elijah Brown posted 11 tackles in defeat. The 1-5 Eagles head to Mainland Friday at 6 p.m. looking for their first road win since 2023.

Absegami finally exhaled, blanking ACIT 16-0 to halt a four-game skid behind Dameir Burke's 94 rushing yards and a defense that forced four turnovers. Chris Singleton's pick-six in the second quarter broke it open as the Braves climbed to 2-4. They'll travel to Bridgeton Friday at 7 p.m. to test their red-zone consistency against a Bulldogs defense that's allowing just 14 points per night. ACIT (2-3) returns home Saturday at 1 p.m. to host St. Joseph, hoping Jordan Levy and the linebackers can keep the Wildcats from running wild.

St. Joseph looked sharp in a 34-8 win at Buena, their highest scoring total this season. Quarterback Anthony Salamone threw three touchdown passes - two to Nico Zanine - and the defense forced four takeaways to move to 4-1. The Wildcats carry that rhythm to Mays Landing on Saturday. Buena (1-5) regroup at home against New Egypt on Friday, trying to find offensive footing before the season's final push.

Pleasantville kept stacking clean sheets, blanking Woodstown 40-0 for its third straight win and fourth of the year. The Greyhounds' offense, sparked by Keon Jefferson's 118 yards and Khalil Evans' two touchdowns, finally matched their defense, which hasn't surrendered a point in 12 quarters. They'll look to extend that streak Thursday at 5 p.m. at Oakcrest, where another dominant night could make the Greyhounds one of the county's toughest outs.



Hammonton's frustrations continued in a 33-0 loss to Kingsway, where turnovers doomed early drives. The Blue Devils return home Friday at 6 p.m. against Seneca, hoping the return of Mason Brown under center and a simplified playbook can steady their offense before late-season divisional play.

Week 6 sharpened the picture. Atlantic City's offense hit full throttle, Cedar Creek's run game remains the county's gold standard, and Pleasantville's defense has reached championship level. Mainland and St. Joseph look resettled at midseason, while Absegami's resilience and Oakcrest's youth give the standings some depth. With playoff brackets around the corner, every snap in Atlantic County football now carries weight - and the best teams are proving they can win with style, substance, and timing.

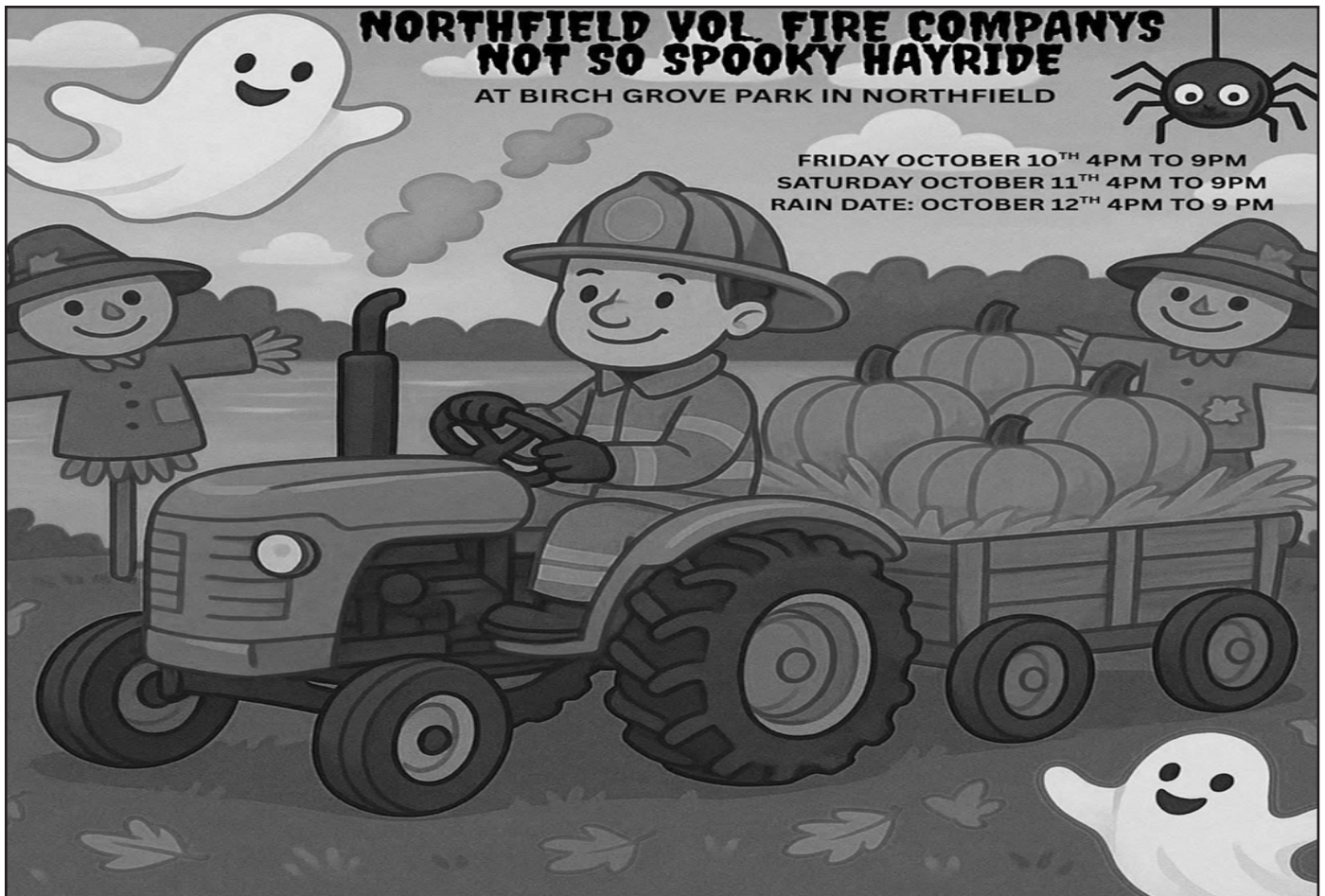

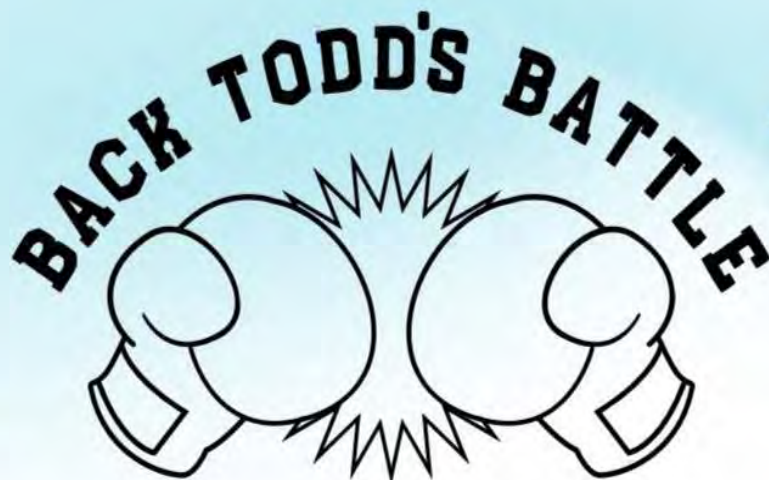

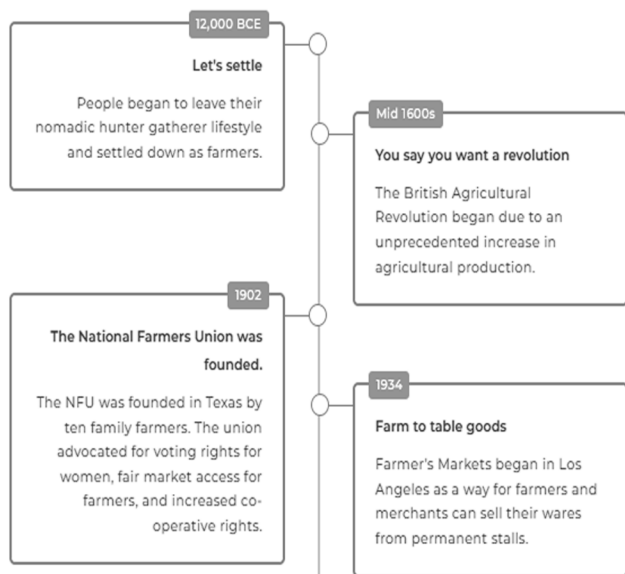
Farmers Day is celebrated every year on October 12. The profession of farming began around 12,000 years ago with the domestication of livestock as hunter/gatherers settled down and started to plant their own food. In short, farming is one of the oldest jobs around. So let's take a moment to give some love to all the farmers who work tirelessly to feed us year round.

History of Farmers Day

Agriculture is one of the world's oldest and vital professions. Farmers have remained one of the highest contributors to economic growth while consistently feeding the people who rely on their goods. Originally referred to as Old Farmer's Day, National Farmers Day was cultivated to celebrate the hard work farmers put into growing their crops. The date of October 12 came about as it lands at the end of the traditional harvesting period, allowing farmers to participate in festivities, which can sometimes last the entirety of the month. Additionally, every three years, the Harvest Moon will fall in early October, preceding and leading up to National Farmer's Day on the 17th.

Usually, in states in the northern US, the first frost would occur in the beginning of October, if not the middle, requiring many farmers to harvest their crops beforehand to prepare for the winter. Now, because of scientific developments in farming techniques, the traditional growing period can be prolonged to increase yield and profit, part of the reasoning why National Farmer's Day tend to extend its celebrations in rural areas to National Farmer's Month.

R & J Farm in Galloway Township offers classic hayrides, a corn maze, and pumpkin picking through late October (more info at randjfarm.com). In Mays Landing, the Pumpkin Patch at 553 South Frankfurt Avenue hosts weekend hayrides, food trucks, craft vendors, and a family-friendly fall festival atmosphere. Nearby, Sahl's Father Son Farm in Egg Harbor City features its own corn maze, farm animals, and pumpkin patch for families looking to spend a day outdoors (visit sahlsfarm.com).

These farms aren't just seasonal attractions - they're working reminders of what National Farmers Day celebrates: hard work, heritage, and harvest. Whether you're sipping local wine, picking your own pumpkins, or simply buying Jersey Fresh produce at a roadside stand, every gesture keeps the spirit of Atlantic County farming alive and thriving for generations to come.

Each October, Historic Smithville transforms into a sea of green and gold for one of South Jersey's most beloved fall traditions - the Smithville Irish Festival. This year's celebration takes place Saturday, October 11 from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Sunday, October 12 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., filling the village with the sounds of bagpipes, fiddles, laughter, and cheer.

Families will find plenty to keep little ones entertained, with a Kids' Fun Zone offering crafts, games, and interactive activities, plus local non-profits sharing how they're making a difference throughout Atlantic County. For adults, the Thatch Pub returns as one of the festival's highlights - a cozy, thatched-roof gathering place where guests can reserve an hour to relax, raise a pint, and enjoy the warm camaraderie that defines Irish hospitality.

Parking is plentiful around Historic Smithville, with lots managed by the Galloway Township Lady Warriors Softball Team, who accept small donations for their program. Designated accessible parking and a convenient drop-off area are available near the entrance, and the festival grounds remain wheelchair-friendly with paved paths, gentle bridges, and shaded rest areas throughout.

From the music to the marketplace, the laughter to the lasting impact, the Smithville Irish Festival continues to be more than a weekend of entertainment - it's a heartfelt celebration of heritage, community, and kindness. As the Irish saying goes, Céad Míle Fáilte - one hundred thousand welcomes await you in Smithville this October.

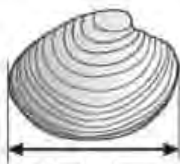

Fishing in Atlantic County

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at dep.nj.gov/njfw/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/. Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/.

SALTWATER FISHING

Atlantic City - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



Ventnor/Ventnor Heights - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

Somers Point - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

Brigantine - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Graveling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

FRESHWATER FISHING

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.

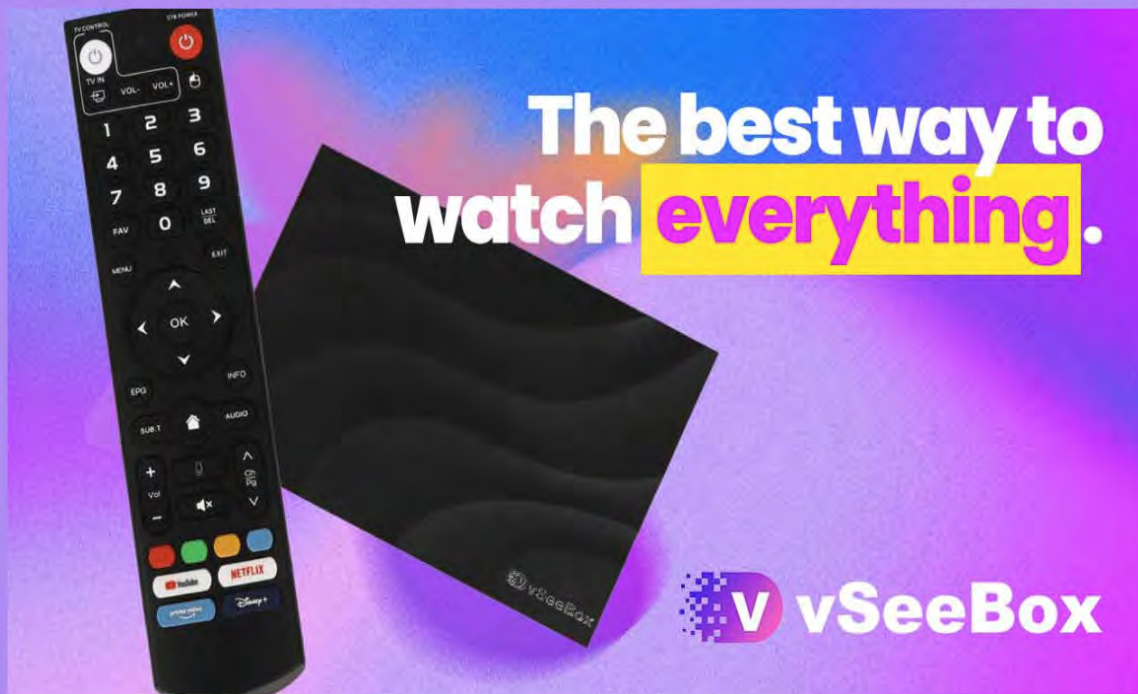

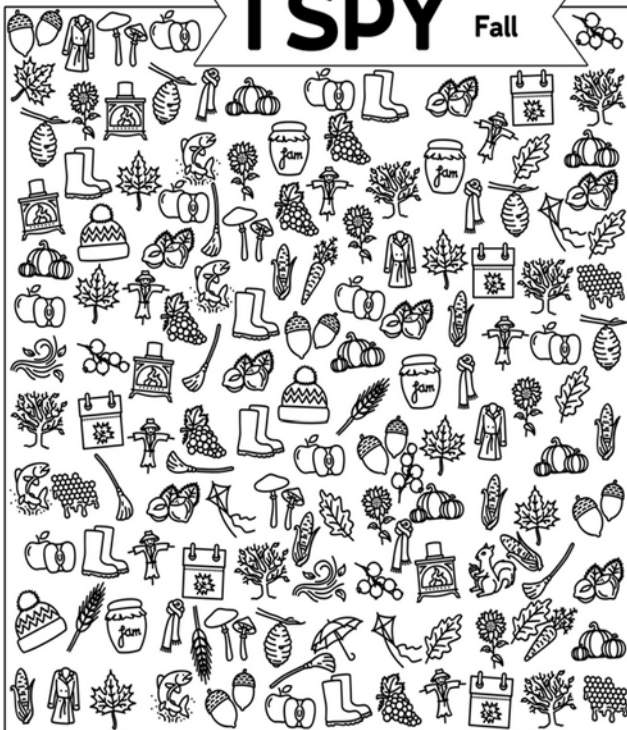

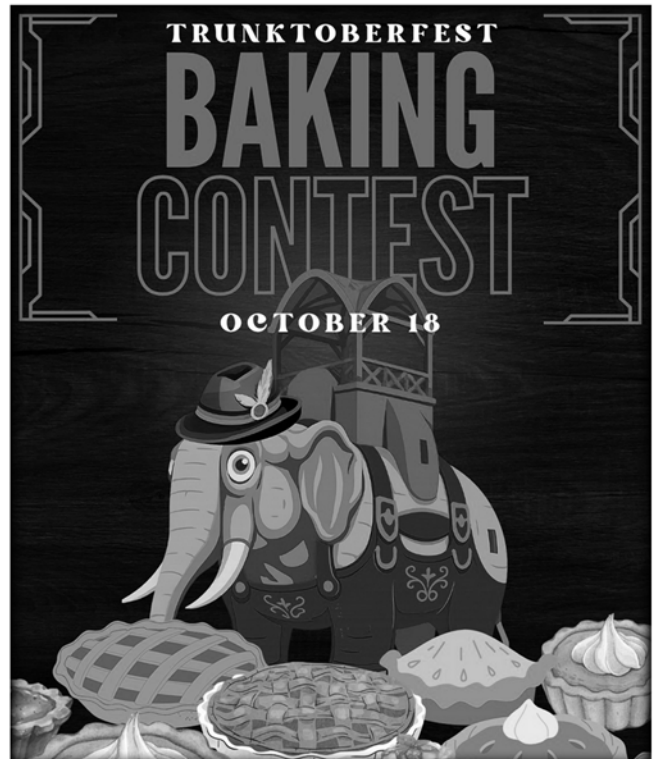

Marina was born in Berlin in 1937, and her father, a well-known actor, was imprisoned for his criticism of the Nazis. As a teenager, Marina came to the United States, where she eventually married Mark Peacock and had her own practice as a clinical social worker.



Marina's incredible experiences with her Seeing Eye dogs is told in a book, *Gretel and Andy, God's Gift: The Lives of Two Seeing Eye Dogs*.

“The book is written from the dogs’ standpoint. I feel like I understand dogs very well, and cats too. Dogs talk to me, and these dogs talk through me,” Marina said.

Philadelphia's fall sports calendar just got real. The Eagles finally tasted defeat after a month of narrow escapes, the Phillies find themselves on the brink after stumbling early in the NLDS, the Union are resting and refining ahead of their postseason run, and the Sixers are crossing the ocean to start answering their preseason questions. October has arrived with fewer celebrations and more tests - and the city's mood has shifted from comfortable to clenched.

Eagles: First Taste of Fall

The Eagles' perfect start dissolved in Week 5 with a 21-17 home loss to the Broncos, a defeat that revealed the gaps between talent and timing. It wasn't a collapse as much as a sequence of small mistakes - dropped passes, missed tackles, red-zone stalls - that snowballed into frustration. Jalen Hurts looked sharp early but couldn't find rhythm late, the offensive line bent more than usual, and the play calling occasionally lost its balance. The Broncos' secondary disguised coverages well enough to limit explosive plays, and the Eagles never quite found the counterpunch.

On defense, the night belonged to the young corners. Rookie Quinyon Mitchell earned NFC Defensive Player of the Week honors for holding his assignment to a handful of yards, flashing the coverage instincts that made him a first-round pick. Still, the front seven couldn't dictate the line of scrimmage the way it had in September. Denver's short-yardage persistence and late-game poise drained clock and forced Philadelphia into uncomfortable angles.

Depth was tested across the roster. With Adoree' Jackson available but limited, Kelee Ringo drew his second straight start and continued to show progress in man coverage. Nakobe Dean's practice window finally opened, and his return should stabilize a run defense that showed its first cracks of the season. The question is whether this group can absorb injuries and still play at the disciplined level that defines championship teams.

The turnaround is short. A Thursday night trip to the Giants offers a quick shot at redemption, but also a stress test for recovery and focus. The Eagles have won ugly and lost close - the next step is to win clean. The 4-1 mark still leads the division, but now comes the stretch where good teams separate from merely talented ones.

Phillies: On the Brink

The Phillies entered October with swagger, but the postseason has humbled them fast. Down 0-2 in the NLDS after dropping both games at home, they now face elimination on the road. Aaron Nola draws the start in Game 3, with Ranger Suárez waiting in the bullpen - a move that signals urgency more than strategy. For all their firepower, Philadelphia's offense has gone quiet, and the bullpen usage that once looked methodical now feels desperate.

It's been a stunning turn for a team that led wire to wire in the division. The September fireworks - Schwarber's 50th homer, Suárez's strikeout masterpiece - have faded into memory as timing and pressure shifted. Rob Thomson has been forced to manage like every night could be the last, leaning on matchups and praying for rhythm from a lineup that suddenly feels tight. The margin for error is gone; the margin for character remains.

In Los Angeles, the assignment is simple: win one, then win again. Every inning now carries weight, every pitch a postseason echo. The Phillies have been here before - they know what a road spark can do. Whether experience translates to execution will decide if this run ends with heartbreak or defiance.

Union: Breathing Room, But Not Complacency

The Union continue to enjoy something few teams ever earn - the chance to polish before the pressure hits. With their playoff ticket long punched, Philadelphia has used recent matches to tighten mechanics rather than chase results. Bruno Damiani's steady finishing and Andrew Rick's calm presence in goal have anchored a run defined by composure.

Set-piece precision remains the week's obsession, as does managing substitution timing for travel and fatigue. The right-flank overlap remains a work in progress, but the framework is there: patience in buildup, discipline in transition, and maturity in late-game execution. With Subaru Park poised for another deep October, the focus now is simple - sharpen edges, stay healthy, and be ready when the lights brighten.

Sixers: Still Waiting to Be Defined

Training camp has begun with a quieter, more deliberate tone than years past. Jared McCain's steady progress toward full participation gives Nick Nurse more creative flexibility in the backcourt, adding pace to an offense that too often leaned on Embiid's gravity alone. The next two preseason games, both in Abu Dhabi against the Knicks, are less about results and more about data - closing combinations, pace management, and defensive chemistry.

The lingering questions feel familiar but sharper. Who earns closing minutes beside Embiid? Can the wings toggle between size and speed without bleeding rebounds? And how will Nurse preserve his MVP's efficiency without running the tank dry by spring? For now, the mood around the team is focused, quieter, and workmanlike - the kind of environment where roles are built, not debated.



Looking Ahead: Reset and Response

The Eagles have their first bruise but plenty of backbone. The Phillies are playing for survival, with October urgency already in full roar. The Union are fine-tuning rather than chasing, a welcome change in rhythm. And the Sixers are trading noise for structure, shaping a roster that will need cohesion more than headlines. Philadelphia's early autumn swagger has turned into a test of endurance - and the next week will show which teams can steady themselves when the lights get brightest.
