Broadleaf. Evergreen. Conifer. How well do you really know your trees? National Arbor Day is a good reason to find out. More than just a date on the calendar, the holiday is a reminder to pay attention to the living things that shape our streets, parks, neighborhoods and memories. Trees cool us off, frame the seasons, soften busy places and serve their purpose every day, often without much notice until the first blossoms appear or the leaves begin to turn.

America's first Arbor Day took place toward the start of the 1870s - right around the time Congress established Yellowstone National Park. Coming just after Earth Day, National Arbor Day on April 24 offers another chance to celebrate the natural world in a hands-on, lasting way. More than 150 years later, the message still holds up: planting, protecting and appreciating trees remains one of the simplest ways to invest in the future of a community.

**National Arbor Day Activities**

- Plant a tree - What better way to celebrate Arbor Day than to plant your very own tree? It's an incredible experience watching a tree grow over the years, and it's an unbelievable feeling knowing that you made it happen.
- Don't print this! - Deforestation is a huge problem with many implications, and cutting down on our paper usage is the most immediate way to make a difference. You can go a step further by seeking out brands with sustainable business practices, and by adopting strong composting and recycling habits.
- Take a hike - The good kind! Hiking is a great escape from the doldrums of everyday life, and it's an activity that's great for people across a wide age range.

**Why We Love National Arbor Day**

- Natural beauty - With so much of our population living in big cities, it's easy to lose sight of nature's greatness and splendor.
- Our planet needs love - Despite some disagreement about global warming, there's no debating that keeping our planet healthy helps to keep us healthy. There's a lot to love about a holiday that helps make our planet a better place.

- A global movement - With over 40 nations having their own version of Arbor Day, it's safe to say that this holiday is global. We've got a lot to be thankful for when it comes to trees, so it's only natural that so many cultures have their own day to celebrate.

Here in Atlantic County, Arbor Day can be celebrated in a hands-on way in Atlantic City, where the city's Shade Tree Committee is inviting residents to an Arbor Day Tree Planting from 10 a.m. to noon Friday, April 24, at Pennsylvania Avenue School. The event gives neighbors a chance to do more than simply recognize the holiday - it lets them take part in beautifying the community in a direct and lasting way. Community plantings like this capture the real spirit of Arbor Day, turning a national observance into something local, visible and rooted in shared pride.

In Linwood, the Linwood Arboretum offers a quieter but equally meaningful way to reflect on the day's purpose. Located at Belhaven and Wabash avenues, the less-than-an-acre arboretum was created as an educational public space where visitors can become familiar with uncommon or rare woody plants especially suited to home landscaping. Small in size but highly visible, it stands as a reminder that appreciation for trees does not always have to come through a major event. Sometimes it grows through everyday exposure, curiosity and the simple presence of a thoughtfully planted green space.

That is part of what gives National Arbor Day its staying power. It is not just about naming tree types or planting a sapling for one afternoon. It is about recognizing how much trees contribute to daily life, and how communities benefit when people take the time to protect and appreciate them. Whether that means joining a planting in Atlantic City, visiting the Linwood Arboretum or just paying closer attention to the trees on your own block, Arbor Day offers a simple invitation: look up, learn more and give something back to the landscape that gives so much to all of us.

Smithville's spring calendar has no shortage of reasons to wander the village, but one of its most distinctive returns Saturday, April 25, when Art Walk takes over Historic Smithville from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., with a rain date of Sunday, April 26. Founded and hosted by Underground, Smithville Artwalk has grown into a biannual showcase built around pop and lowbrow art, bringing an unmistakably offbeat energy to one of South Jersey's most familiar destinations. This year's event will feature 75 artists, turning the day into a large-scale celebration of local creativity with a style that leans bold, playful, imaginative and anything but ordinary.

Set at Historic Smithville Village, the event invites visitors to browse original work while moving through one of the area's most walkable settings. According to Historic Smithville, more than 75 local artists will be set up on the Greene near the red-covered bridge, creating an open-air gallery atmosphere that blends naturally with the village's shops, paths and weekend foot traffic. The official Artwalk page describes it as a curated gathering celebrating pop and lowbrow art in all forms, but it is designed to be more than a simple vendor event. Organizers also promote live music and additional entertainment, helping make the day feel less like a traditional craft fair and more like an immersive community happening built around artists, collectors and curious passersby alike.

What makes Artwalk stand out is that it does not aim for safe or predictable. The event has built its identity around work that is proudly unconventional, and that spirit is part of the draw. Whether you are a serious collector, a casual browser or someone just looking for a different kind of Saturday outing, the appeal is in the range of voices and styles gathered in one place. It is a chance to meet working artists, discover pieces you would never find in a big-box setting, and spend the day around art that is meant to provoke, amuse, surprise or simply make you stop and look twice. In an era when so many events start to blur together, Smithville Artwalk keeps leaning the other way.

Admission and parking are free, which makes the event an easy add to the weekend for families, day-trippers and anyone already planning a stop in Smithville. For artists hoping to be part of a future show, organizers say those wishing to be considered can visit [SmithvilleArtwalk.com](http://SmithvilleArtwalk.com), where the vendor application is available at the bottom of the page. For everyone else, the message is simpler: come out, support local art and enjoy one of the Shore area's most original spring events. If ever there were a good excuse to shake off the routine, this is it. Fight the mundane. Art is a weapon.

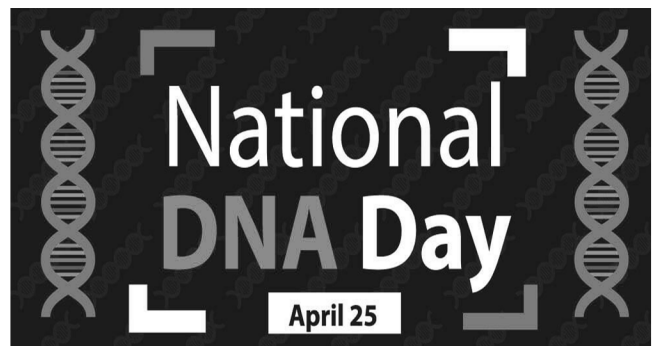
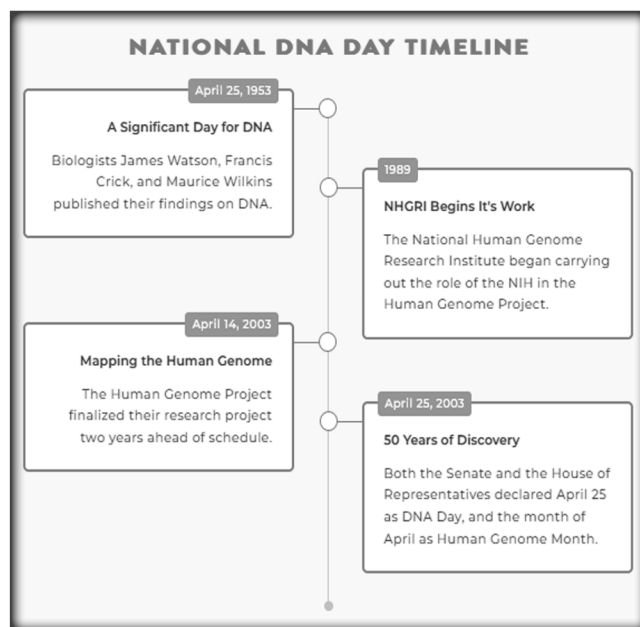
Every year on April 25 since 2003, scientists, biologists, and genetics enthusiasts come together to observe National DNA Day, celebrating the discovery and research into DNA and the scientific advancements that helped make progress possible. Organized annually by the Human Genome Research Institute, National DNA Day encourages people to learn more about the science that makes them genetically unique.

### History of National DNA Day

On April 25, 1953, molecular biologist James Dewey Watson's academic paper presenting DNA's double-helix structure (which he co-authored with British molecular biologists Francis Crick and Maurice Wilkins) was published in the scientific journal, *Nature*. Nine years later, the three scientists were awarded the Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine for unearthing the molecular structure of nucleic acids and its importance for genetic information transfer in living beings.

On April 14, 2003, the Human Genome Project, an international scientific research project with the goal of determining the base pairs that make up human DNA and identifying all genes of the human genome, was declared complete. The project lasted for 13 years, finishing two years ahead of schedule, and was publicly funded by the U.S. government. It originally set to map the nucleotides contained within a human haploid genome, but scientists quickly realized that the genome of any given individual is completely unique, so mapping the human genome involved mapping the DNA of a small number of individuals and then piecing them all together to create a complete sequence for each individual chromosome. Meaning the complete human genome is more-so a mosaic rather than representative of any one individual.

Following the completion of the Human Genome Project, both the Senate and the House of Representatives proclaimed April 25, 2003 DNA Day and April as Human Genome Month. The day marked 50 years since Watson, Crick, and Wilkins' academic paper was published and the month itself was considered significant in genome discovery. However, they only declared it a one-time celebration rather than an annual holiday. Since then, National DNA Day events and celebrations have been hosted by the National Human Genome Research Institute in order to encourage further research as well as celebrate and continue to acknowledge all of the hard work that has been dedicated to the study of DNA.



### National DNA Day Stats

- **25% genetically similar** - On average, siblings who share the same mother and father - excluding identical twins - appear to be 25% genetically identical and 50% half identical. This occurs because each child gets 50% of their genetic makeup from their mother and 50% from their father, meaning 25% from each has the potential to be genetically identical while the other 50% is a slightly different genetic pattern passed on to each child.
- **90% identifiable third cousin** - There is a 90% chance that third cousins will share enough DNA for the relationship to be detected but only a 50% chance that you will share enough DNA with a fourth cousin for the relationship to be identified. This is because of the random way that autosomal DNA is inherited, causing third, fourth, and more distant cousins to not necessarily have any detectable half-identical regions.
- **Between 20,000 and 25,000 genes** - The Human Genome Project estimated that humans have between 20,000 and 25,000 genes, however genes do not code for proteins. In humans, genes vary in size from a few hundred DNA bases to more than 2 million bases. Every person has two copies of each gene, one passed down from each parent. Most genes are the same in all people but less than 1% of the populations genes are slightly different. Alleles are forms of the same gene with small differences in their sequence of DNA bases, making up small differences to each person's unique physical features.

### How to Observe National DNA Day

- **Take a DNA test** - Due to the scientific breakthroughs by the HGP and Watson, Crick, and Wilkins, we now have programs such as 23&Me and Ancestry in order to track our family history through our DNA. Fulfill your curiosity and learn more about yourself and your family by investing in a DNA test.
- **Participate in a local event** - The National Human Genome Research Institute hosts annual National DNA Day Events. If you'd like to attend a local event, or host one for your city, check out their events page.
- **Have an open conversation with your family** - The fastest way to learn about your genetic history, with some added allegorical context, is through the stories of your family members. Though family stories are often like a decades long game of telephone, where some information may not be completely accurate, there's a sense of pride that comes from hearing the stories that lead to you being able to exist today.

For many people, DNA Day is not just about science in a lab. It is about roots, relatives and the thrill of learning something new about where you come from. In that way, the day speaks to something timeless: the desire to understand our place in a much larger story, one that stretches backward through generations and forward into discoveries still to come.

**BRIGANTINE** - Brigantine Beach offers lifeguards on duty, surfing beaches, showers, changing rooms and food permitted. Seasonal tags are \$20 through May 31 and \$25 during regular season. Daily tags are \$10 and weekly tags are \$15. Seniors 65 and older receive a free tag with identification, and there is also a preseason senior rate of \$10 for ages 60 to 64. Active military members receive free tags, with up to four free per family, and veterans receive a free tag for themselves. Visit [brigantinebeach.org](http://brigantinebeach.org)

**EGG HARBOR CITY** - Lake Park, 2300 Philadelphia Ave. Lifeguards and restrooms are available. Pre-season seasonal badges are \$15 for ages 5 and up through May 22. 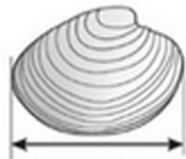

# Fishing in Atlantic County

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at [dep.nj.gov/njfw/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/](http://dep.nj.gov/njfw/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/). Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at [dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/](http://dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/).

## SALTWATER FISHING

**Atlantic City** - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



**Ventnor/Ventnor Heights** - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

**Margate** - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

**Somers Point** - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

**Brigantine** - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

**Leeds Point** - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Graveling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

## FRESHWATER FISHING

**Lake Lenape Park** - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

**Lake Lenape Park East** - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

**Lake Lenape Park West** - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.
