#### Memorial Day - May 26, 2025

Memorial Day on May 26 conjures images of hamburgers, hot dogs, swimming pools, and summertime for many Americans. But the last Monday in May serves, most importantly, as a time to honor those who died while fighting in the U.S. Armed Forces. It's a holiday steeped in somber American history and tradition. The day actually began as "Decoration Day," following the Civil War, when mourners placed flowers on the graves of Union and Confederate soldiers. Yes, Memorial Day has also come to signify the "unofficial" start of summer, but let's remember the heroes who made it all possible.

#### History of Memorial Day

The Civil War ended in the spring of 1865 when Robert E. Lee surrendered the last major Confederate army to Ulysses S. Grant at the Appomattox Court House on April 9. Over 620,000 soldiers died in the four-year conflict. General John A. Logan of the Grand Army of the Republic (an organization of Union veterans) would eventually select May 30, 1868, as a day to pay tribute to the fallen:


"The 30th of May, 1868, is designated for the purpose of strewing with flowers, or otherwise decorating the graves of comrades who died in defense of their country during the late rebellion, and whose bodies now lie in almost every city, village, and hamlet churchyard in the land..."

Logan apparently chose May 30 because flowers would be in bloom all over the country. By the end of the 19th century, Memorial Day ceremonies were being held on May 30 throughout the nation. States passed proclamations, and the Army and Navy adopted rules for proper observance at their facilities.

The crowd attending the first Memorial Day ceremony at Arlington National Cemetery was approximately the same size as those that attend today's observance — about 5,000 people. Small American flags were placed on each grave — a tradition still followed at many national cemeteries today. In recent years, the custom has grown in many families to decorate the graves of all departed loved ones.

By 1890, each Northern state had made Decoration Day an official holiday. But this was not the case in the South, where states continued to honor their dead on separate days until after the First World War.

The May 30 date held for decades. But, in 1968, Congress passed the Uniform Monday Holiday. Act, which established Memorial Day as the last Monday in May in order to create a three-day weekend for federal employees. The change took place in 1971. The same law also declared Memorial Day a federal holiday.



#### Traditions of the Day

Many Americans observe Memorial Day by visiting cemeteries or memorials, holding family gatherings, and participating in parades. It's the three-day weekend that kicks off the summer season and the time for hanging out at the beach and lakes, and barbecuing with friends and family. But Memorial Day is also the most solemn American holiday — a day to remember those who made the ultimate sacrifice while defending their nation.

Towns and cities across the country host grand Memorial Day parades every year, often featuring senior veterans and military personnel. Some of the biggest parades take place in New York, Chicago, and Washington, D.C. Cemeteries and memorials are also visited by Americans, with some citizens wearing or holding red poppies to symbolize those who have fallen in war. This tradition has been around since World War I. Weekend trips and parties are also arranged to balance out the somberness of the day and welcome the summer.

- 3 P.M. the time of day when a moment of silence is observed by Americans throughout the country on this day.

#### How to Observe Memorial Day

Pay your respects - Lay flowers on the grave of a family member or friend who died while serving. If you don't personally know any fallen soldiers, visit a local cemetery anyway. After all, they made the ultimate sacrifice for you.

Participate in the National Moment of Remembrance - By doing so, you'll be joining millions of Americans in national unity to honor Memorial Day for what it truly is — a day to remember those who laid down their lives in service of their country and its citizens.

Fly the flag - If you have an American flag at home, be sure to fly it at half-mast until noon, then raise it to full mast for the rest of the day. The practice of lowering and then raising the flag has been observed for over 100 years to symbolize America's persistence in the face of loss.

#### 5 CREATIVE WAYS TO DECORATE FOR MEMORIAL DAY

- 1. **Unfurl those flags** Often people store their American flags and raise them only during patriotic holidays. This is definitely one of those days.
- 2. Line your walkway with mini flags Nothing honors our deceased veterans like dozens (or even hundreds) of flags in your front lawn and entryway.
- 3. Red, white, and blue layered cake It's a decoration you can eat.
- 4. Stars and Stripes windsocks It's festive, fun, and patriotic. Need we say more?
- 5. Symbolic flowers Even if you haven't lost a loved one who served in the military, you can still honor the fallen with flowers at home. Red, navy, and blue dahlias combined with white rose silk flowers can make a stunning visual combination.

A CENTURY OF HONOR: ATLANTIC CITY'S ALL WARS MEMORIAL CELEBRATES 100 YEARS ON MEMORIAL DAY

This Memorial Day, Atlantic City will mark a powerful milestone in American history—the 100th anniversary of the All Wars Memorial Building, one of the country's oldest tributes to African American veterans. On Monday, May 26, 2025, at 12:00 PM, community members, local officials, and veterans will gather at 1510 Adriatic Avenue to honor those who have served and sacrificed for our nation.

This year's ceremony is not only a traditional Memorial Day observance, but a moment to celebrate the enduring legacy of a building that has stood as a symbol of honor, resilience, and recognition for a full century.

#### A Building Born from Purpose

Dedicated in 1925, the All Wars Memorial Building—often referred to locally as the "Soldiers Home"—was originally constructed to honor African American veterans who had been excluded from other memorials and social spaces due to segregation. Designed by Philadelphia architect Vivian B. Smith, the neoclassical structure was one of the few veteran halls in the nation built specifically to serve Black servicemen.

Over the years, it became more than a ceremonial venue—it functioned as a cultural center, a meeting place, and a symbol of dignity for African American communities in South Jersey. It is now listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

#### The 2025 Commemoration

This year's 100th anniversary ceremony will place special emphasis on Vietnam Era veterans, acknowledging a generation of soldiers who often returned home to a country deeply divided by war and racial tensions. The event will feature:

\* Keynote Speaker: Charles Garrett, a Vietnam veteran and former Atlantic County Freeholder, whose leadership and advocacy have helped elevate the voices of local veterans.



- Ceremonial Host: Councilman Kaleem Shabazz, a longtime civic leader and chairman of the Soldiers Home Centennial Committee.
- Musical Tribute by Rick Cason and the Vietnam Veterans, performing patriotic selections in tribute to their fallen comrades.
- \* A special centennial recognition of community elders and organizations who have supported the preservation and continued use of the All Wars Memorial.

The City of Atlantic City has also encouraged the public to contribute stories, photos, and memorabilia from past events at the Soldiers Home. These artifacts will be featured in ongoing centennial programming throughout 2025. Submissions can be sent to soldiershome 100@gmail.com.

More Than a Building

As Councilman Shabazz said in a recent press release, "The All Wars Memorial is not just bricks and mortar—it's a living record of the sacrifices made by men and women who served this country, often without receiving the recognition they deserved." This Memorial Day, the city invites residents and visitors to pause, reflect, and honor that legacy—while celebrating a full century of service and remembrance at a site that has stood for dignity, pride, and perseverance. 

## YOGA POSE OF THE WEEK -Cobbler's Pose (Baddha Konasana)

Let gravity work on stretching your inner thighs in Cobbler's pose. Props can help if you find this yoga pose challenging. Sitting on a block, cushion, or blanket raises your hips so your knees can open more naturally. If your knees are high, it takes a lot of effort to hold them up, and your legs need to be relaxed to enjoy the benefits of the stretch. The solution is to place a block (or something else supportive) under each knee to give them something to rest on. Since it's unusual to sit this way in everyday life, this yoga pose stretches neglected areas of the body, particularly the adductor groups of the groin.

#### Fire Up the Flavor: Hosting the Perfect Jersey Shore BBQ This Memorial Day

Memorial Day weekend at the Jersey Shore isn't just about beach chairs and boardwalk strolls—it's about gathering your favorite people, firing up the grill, and putting out a spread that celebrates the start of summer in true Garden State style. Whether your toes are in the sand or your backvard is your kingdom, this is your guide to hosting a Memorial Day BBQ that blends coastal comfort with seasonal flair.

#### The Flavors of the Shore

A Jersey Shore BBQ is all about unfussy food with big flavor. This is the land of blue crabs and buttered rolls, sweet corn and tomato vines, hoagies and hot sauce. When you combine salty air with a sizzling grill and a little bit of attitude, you've got the makings of something special.

Skip the overly formal or fussy presentation. Think paper plates, cold drinks, and long tables lined with trays of food that people actually want to eat: grilled, local, fresh, and filling.

#### What's in Season? Let It Shine

This is peak time for fresh Jersey asparagus, spring onions, radishes, arugula, spinach, strawberries, and rhubarb. Here are two knockout recipes to bring some of that in-season bounty to your table.

#### Grilled Jersey Asparagus with Lemon-Herb Ricotta

Serves 6 | Prep time: 15 minutes | Grill time: 5-7 minutes

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 2 bunches Jersey asparagus, ends trimmed
- 2 tbsp olive oil
- 1 cup whole milk ricotta cheese
- Juice of ½ lemon
- 1 tbsp chopped fresh parsley
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Zest of 1 lemon
- 1 tbsp chopped fresh mint
- Crushed red pepper (optional)

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Toss asparagus in olive oil, salt, and pepper. Grill over medium-high heat for 2-3 minutes per side until lightly charred but still crisp. In a bowl, mix ricotta with lemon zest, lemon juice, herbs, and a pinch of salt. Spread ricotta mixture on a platter, pile grilled asparagus on top, and finish with a drizzle of olive oil and a sprinkle of crushed red pepper if you like heat. Serve warm or room temp.

#### Strawberry-Rhubarb Slab Pie

Serves 12 | Prep time: 20 minutes | Bake time: 45 minutes

#### **INGREDIENTS:**

- 1 ½ cups chopped rhubarb
- 3 cups sliced fresh Jersey strawberries
- 1 cup sugar
- ¼ cup cornstarch
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 1 egg, beaten (for egg wash)
- 1 pre-made pie crust package (2 crusts) or homemade if you're ambitious
- Coarse sugar for sprinkling

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Preheat oven to 375°F. Roll out one crust and fit it into a 9x13 baking dish. Mix fruit, sugar, cornstarch, and vanilla in a bowl. Let sit 5 minutes. Pour mixture into crust, then top with second crust. Crimp edges and cut slits or make a lattice pattern. Brush with egg wash, sprinkle with sugar, and bake for 40–45 minutes or until golden and bubbling. Cool slightly before serving. Serve with vanilla ice cream or whipped cream.







Join Holocaust Survivor Michael Bornstein as we honor local survivors, incorporate community connections through Jewish peoplehood, and explore generational wisdom for Holocaust Survivor Day on Wednesday, June 4 at 5pm in the Katz JCC Auditorium, 501 North Jerome Avenue in Margate.

As co-author of the New York Times best-selling book, Survivors Club: The True Story of a Very Young Prisoner of Auschwitz, Bornstein was four-years-old when he was liberated from a concentration camp and made his way to the United States six years later.

For 70 years, Bornstein opted not to speak of his Holocaust experience, despite his image being one of the most recognizable where he is seen showing his tattoo in the iconic WWII footage. However, his second-generation Holocaust Survivor children, Debbie Bornstein Holinstat and Scott Bornstein, encouraged their father to share his powerful story of survival and resilience.

Iso speaking at the event is Holinstat, a veteran television news producer and co-author of her father's book, and Scott Bornstein, Executive Vice President of Greenberg Traurig, who dedicates his expertise combatting antisemitism on behalf of Israeli and American victims of the October 7th terrorist attacks.

"I was shocked, I was surprised, I was humbled... and to some degree, I still am. It is nice to be recognized by your peers. But you do this work because you want to help people, not for awards or recognition."

## **Fishing in Atlantic County**

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at dep.nj.gov/njf-w/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/. Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/.

#### SALTWATER FISHING

Atlantic City - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



**Ventnor/Ventnor Heights** - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

Somers Point - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

**Brigantine** - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Gravelling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

#### FRESHWATER FISHING

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.

Hammonton State Park - White Horse Pike (Route 30), Hammonton. Car top launch. No outboard motors allowed

Maple Lake - Off Maple Avenue, Estell Manor. Car top launch. No boat ramp. No outboard motors allowed

Mill Pond - Off Mill Road, Port Republic. Car top launch. No boat ramp. Outboard motors allowed

Makepeace Lake - Off Weymouth Elwood Road, Hammonton. Car top launch. No boat ramp. Outboard motors allowed

**Ventnor and Brigantine: Traditions That March On** - Ventnor's Memorial Day Parade steps off at 10:00 a.m. from Ventnor Avenue and Lafayette Avenue, heading down to the boardwalk. Known for its seaside charm, Ventnor's parade includes appearances by the Ventnor City Beach Patrol, local dignitaries, marching bands, and vintage military vehicles. 


