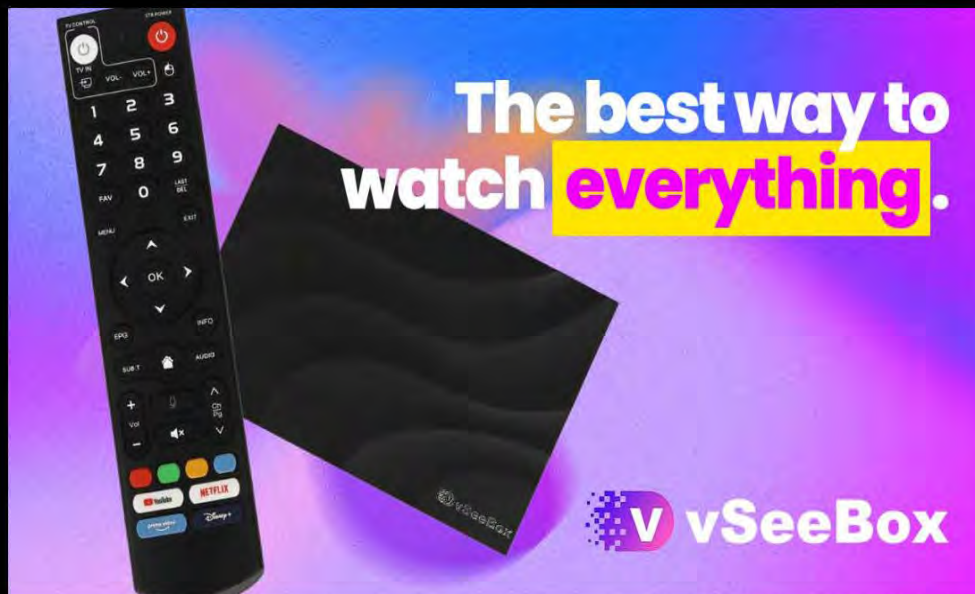

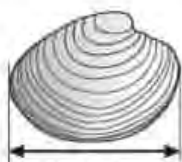

Fishing in Atlantic County

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at dep.nj.gov/njfw/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/. Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/.

SALTWATER FISHING

Atlantic City - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



Ventnor/Ventnor Heights - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

Somers Point - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

Brigantine - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Graveling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

FRESHWATER FISHING

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-country Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.

D-Day, observed annually on June 6, brings overwhelming memories of the brave men and women who fought a strategically planned and well-executed battle that ultimately led to the end of the Second World War. More than 75 years after the end of World War II, these memories remain fresh to the over 300,000 living U.S. veterans of the war. The rest of us look to their legacy and the rich history of events told through museums and memorials. There is not a more important time than today for us to remember and honor them as we reflect on D-Day, June 6, 1944.

HISTORY OF D-DAY

The morning of June 6, 1944, American troops and their allied forces landed on the beaches of Normandy, France in an invasion, code-named Operation Overlord, during World War II, which began the liberation of France, and ultimately other areas of Europe, from Hitler's Nazi regime. This day, known as D-Day, and the strategically planned landing of 156,000 British, Canadian and American troops at 6:30 A.M. on the five beaches of Normandy was code-named Operation Neptune.

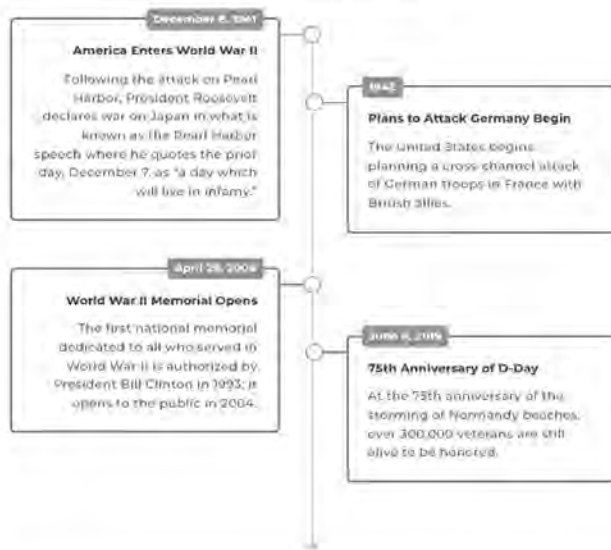
Earlier in the morning of June 6, 24,000 airborne troops were dropped into battle by parachute in order to close exits and overtake bridges slowing the advancement of Nazi reinforcements. Troops entering the beaches by land and sea were met with Hitler's 'Atlantic Wall,' 2,400 miles of bunkers, landmines, and beach obstacles (metal tripods, barbed wire, and wooden stakes) established in anticipation of a French coast invasion. Nazis planted 4 million landmines along Normandy beaches.

Planning for our invasion of German-occupied France began in 1942. In an attempt to mislead the Germans and maintain the secrecy of the details of the D-Day invasion, the Allies conducted a military deception, code-named Operation Bodyguard. It included fake radio transmissions, double agents, and a 'phantom army' commanded by American General George Patton.

June 5 was originally chosen as D-Day due to predictions of weather and high tide, based on the phase of the moon. Bad weather conditions ultimately interfered with the established plans and D-Day moved to June 6.

Ultimately, over 4,400 identified soldiers, sailors, airmen, and coastguardsmen died on D-Day with an estimated 5,000 or more were lost at sea, in an air battle, or otherwise were not identified. Their sacrifice and the valiant efforts of all troops turned the tide of the entire war that day.

D-DAY TIMELINE



WAYS TO OBSERVE D-DAY

- **Thank a veteran** - Our World War II veterans, as with all veterans of our active military, sacrificed greatly during their times of battle. It is difficult for those of us who have not served our country in the same manner to understand the full measure of their service and sacrifice. But, today, we listen, learn and thank the men and women who protected our freedom at such a critical time in our world's history.
- **Visit the museum in New Orleans** - Opening in 2000, the World War II Museum in New Orleans, Louisiana offers briefings throughout the day explaining events as they occurred in 1944. Step onto one of the boats that took our soldiers to the beaches of Normandy.
- **Watch a WWII movie** - Over 50 movies have been created depicting aspects of World War II — detailing battles, showcasing heroes, and remembering victims of the Holocaust. You can learn about the war and the events at Normandy from a variety of angles to understand the true scope of this war and what our victory has meant to the world.



5 INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT D-DAY

1. **The weather** - Predicted poor weather conditions caused General Eisenhower to delay the start of the battle by one day to June 6.
2. **The son of a president** - Brigadier General Theodore Roosevelt Jr., son of President Theodore Roosevelt, was the oldest soldier to land on the beaches of Normandy at 56 — he was posthumously awarded with the Medal of Honor for his heroic actions at Utah beach.
3. **Setting the stage** - A staging area was established in England, the launch site of Operation Overlord, where the U.S. military stocked seven million tons of supplies, including 450,000 tons of ammunition.
4. **The swimming Sherman** - These tanks were operational in water and on land and were used on all five beaches to support the landing troops on D-Day.
5. **The five beaches** - Operations sectioned the 50 miles of coastline into five beaches given code names: Utah, Omaha, Gold, Juno, and Sword.

WHY WE HONOR D-DAY

- **It was a key moment in our world's history** - Looking back at the circumstances surrounding the Second World War, we understand the criticality of the outcome. Historians' views of what could have happened if the Allied forces had not been victorious paint the trajectory of the world in a clearly different light.
- **We love our freedom** - The ongoing protection of our freedom is paramount to the American dream. Our Constitution and several of its amendments spell out our specific freedoms, which is what sets us apart from other countries around the world. Our freedom of religion, speech, the press, and to assemble and petition are only a few that are protected daily by our active military and those who fought before them.
- **We love to honor real-life heroes** - Not all heroes wear capes — some wear camo. Numerous stories continue to be told of men and women who endured the unthinkable and achieved the unbelievable during D-Day and World War II. Their stories are inspiring and allow us to put names and faces to the stories we heard in history class.

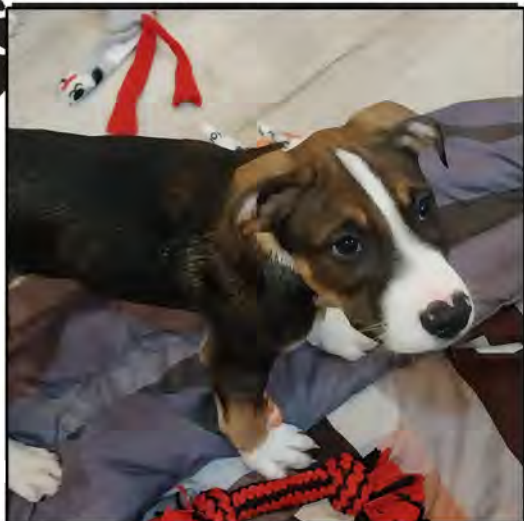
Berna, who said Rex will soon be retiring, couldn't pick a favorite from among her six Seeing Eye dogs.

What's in Season in Atlantic County

- Strawberries – sweet, ripe, and ready for snacking or baking
- Spring peas – crisp and perfect raw, sautéed, or blended
- Zucchini and yellow squash – mild, tender, and versatile
- Lettuce and arugula – perfect salad bases
- Beets – earthy and sweet, great roasted or raw

Pea & Mint Crostini

Bright and herby, this quick appetizer is ideal for summer gatherings.

Ingredients:

- 1 cup fresh peas, blanched
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- Salt and pepper to taste
- Optional: ricotta cheese for spread
- 1 tablespoon chopped fresh mint
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- Baguette slices, toasted

Instructions: Blend peas, mint, lemon juice, and olive oil in a food processor until slightly chunky. Spread ricotta (if using) on toasted baguette slices. Top with the pea mixture and a sprinkle of flaky salt.

Zucchini Ribbon Salad with Lemon-Parsley Vinaigrette

A no-cook, elegant way to use summer squash.

Ingredients:

- 2 small zucchini, shaved into ribbons with a peeler
- 1 tablespoon chopped parsley
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- Salt, pepper, and grated Parmesan (optional)

Instructions: Toss zucchini ribbons with olive oil, lemon juice, and parsley. Season with salt and pepper. Let sit for 10 minutes to soften; top with Parmesan if desired.

Roasted Beet & Kale Bowl with Garlic Scape Dressing

Hearty, earthy, and satisfying with tons of local flavor.

Ingredients:

- 2-3 medium beets, peeled and cubed
- 1 bunch kale, stemmed and chopped
- 1 tablespoon apple cider vinegar
- 2 tablespoons olive oil (divided)
- 1-2 garlic scapes or spring onions, chopped
- Salt and pepper

Instructions: Roast beets with 1 tablespoon olive oil at 400°F for 25 minutes. Sauté kale in 1 tablespoon oil until wilted. Blend garlic scapes with vinegar, salt, pepper, and a splash of water to create dressing. Toss kale and beets together, drizzle with dressing, and serve warm or chilled.

Whether you're cooking for your family or entertaining outdoors, these market-fresh recipes are a delicious way to celebrate June in Atlantic County.
