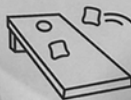

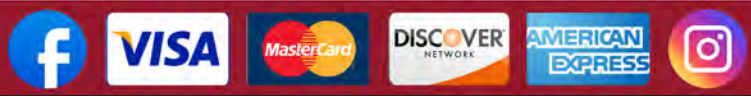

YOGA POSE OF THE WEEK - Standing Forward Bend (Uttanasana)

To do the Standing Forward Bend yoga pose, exhale and fold over your legs. If your hamstrings feel too tight, soften your knees to release your spine. Let your head hang heavy.

Keep your knees soft with feet hip-width apart for better stability (you can straighten your legs, but it is unnecessary). Clasp opposite elbows with opposite hands while swaying gently from side to side.

Engage your quads and avoid locking your knees as you let your head hang down.

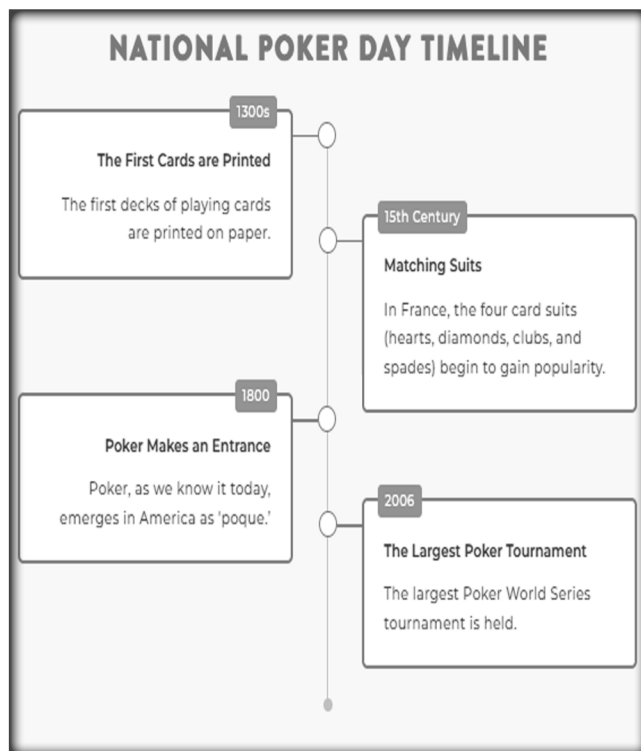

History of National Poker Day

Poker is a family of card games in which players take a bet on which is the best according to the rules of the game in ways similar to the rankings. The earliest forms used only 20 cards, now it is typically played with a standard deck, though nations with short packs may use 32, 40, or 48 cards. While the historical roots of poker are unknown, many game scholars point to the French game 'poque' and the Persian game 'As-Nas' as possible forerunners. However, gaming historians such as David Parlett began to challenge the notion that poker is a direct descendant of As-Nas in the 1990s.

Poker has grown in popularity since the early 20th century, progressing from being primarily a leisure sport limited to small groups of enthusiasts to a widely popular activity for both spectators and participants, including online platforms, with professional players and tournament prizes. In contrast to this variation of poker, the seven-card stud first appeared in the mid-nineteenth century and was widely popularized by the U.S. military. Following World War II, it became a fixture in many casinos, and its popularity grew with the introduction of the World Series of Poker in the 1970s.

Over the next few decades, Texas Hold 'em and other community card games came to dominate the gambling scene. Poker television was a particularly strong influence in increasing the game's popularity around the turn of the century, resulting in the poker boom a few years later. Today, the game has grown to be a hugely popular pastime all over the world.



National Poker Day Activities

- Take part in a game - What else are you supposed to do on National Poker Day? Gather your friends, deal the cards, and keep an eye out for sideways glances at your hand.

- 1 - Red is for luck - When playing poker, many Chinese players wear at least one red item for good luck.

- It's a part of history - The cards that we have today evolved. It's difficult to believe these were once completely hand-painted. Although playing cards have changed, we are still essentially using the same decks that were used years ago.

Poker's Place in Atlantic County

In Atlantic County, poker is part of a much bigger story about how casino gambling helped shape the region. When New Jersey's casino regulatory system was created in 1977 and the first Atlantic City casino opened in 1978, it launched an era of development, tourism and investment that changed the county for generations. The industry remains one of Atlantic County's defining economic forces, and poker has long played its own role in that legacy by helping give Atlantic City a reputation as a place where both serious players and casual visitors could find a seat at the table.

That tradition is still alive today at Borgata, Harrah's and Tropicana, the three Atlantic City casinos that continue to give poker a visible place in the local gaming scene. Harrah's promotes a 28-table poker room, Tropicana's poker room features 10 tables, and Borgata is giving National Poker Day an especially timely local tie-in this year with its April Mini Grind Series running April 16 through 19 and finishing on April 19 itself. It is a fitting reminder that in Atlantic County, poker is not just a game with a holiday attached to it. It remains part of the culture and history that helped build Atlantic City into the destination it became.

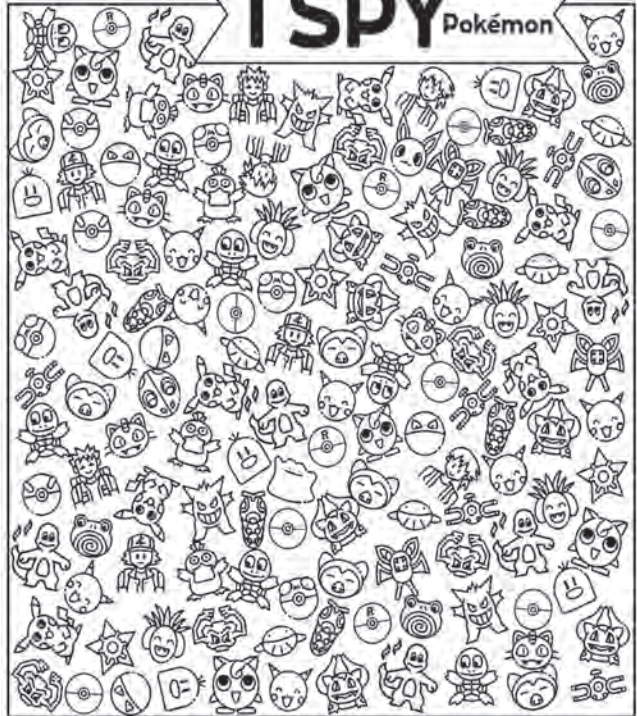

South Jersey's largest Earth Day celebration returns this spring as the Atlantic County Utilities Authority hosts its 34th annual Earth Day Festival, bringing together environmental education, hands-on activities, and community organizations at the ACUA Environmental Park.

The festival will be held Sunday, April 26, 2026, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at 6700 Delilah Road in Egg Harbor Township. Admission is free and the event is held rain or shine.

What sets the event apart is access to the facility itself. The ACUA opens its working site to the public, offering tours of its recycling center, wastewater treatment plant, and renewable energy systems, including wind and solar. It's one of the few chances residents get to see how those operations function in real time and how waste, water, and energy are managed on a countywide level.

Across the grounds, more than 100 vendors, organizations, and exhibitors will be set up throughout the day alongside workshops, demonstrations, and live entertainment. Families can also expect touch-a-truck, landfill hayrides, a hay maze, crafts, bounce houses, live animal exhibits, and a recycled art display, giving the festival a mix of environmental programming and all-day family activity.

The Environmental Park itself is expansive, with parking, tours, exhibits, and activity areas spread throughout the property. Comfortable shoes are a good idea, and depending on the forecast, it would also make sense to bring sunscreen or a light rain jacket.

What has kept this event going for more than three decades is the balance it strikes between information and experience. It gives people a chance to spend the day with their families, support local groups, and leave knowing a little more about the systems and choices that shape everyday life in Atlantic County.

Keep Guide Dog Teams Safe!



Guide dogs work to help people who are blind safely navigate the world. It is crucial that pet owners keep their dogs at a safe distance away from a guide dog team. While it may seem harmless for pets to visit with a guide dog at work, that dog is responsible for leading someone who cannot see. Distracting the guide dog could jeopardize the safety of the handler.

Please follow these tips to help keep guide dog teams safe:

- Please do not distract guide dogs. This includes calling the dog, making eye contact, feeding or petting the dog.
- Never let your pet be near a guide dog, even if leashed.
- It is helpful to greet a person who is blind and let them know you have a dog with you.
- Always speak to the handler directly and never touch the handler or the dog without the handler's permission.

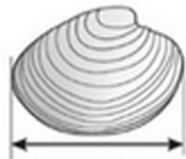

Fishing in Atlantic County

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at dep.nj.gov/njfw/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/. Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/.

SALTWATER FISHING

Atlantic City - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



Ventnor/Ventnor Heights - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

Somers Point - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

Brigantine - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Graveling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

FRESHWATER FISHING

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.
