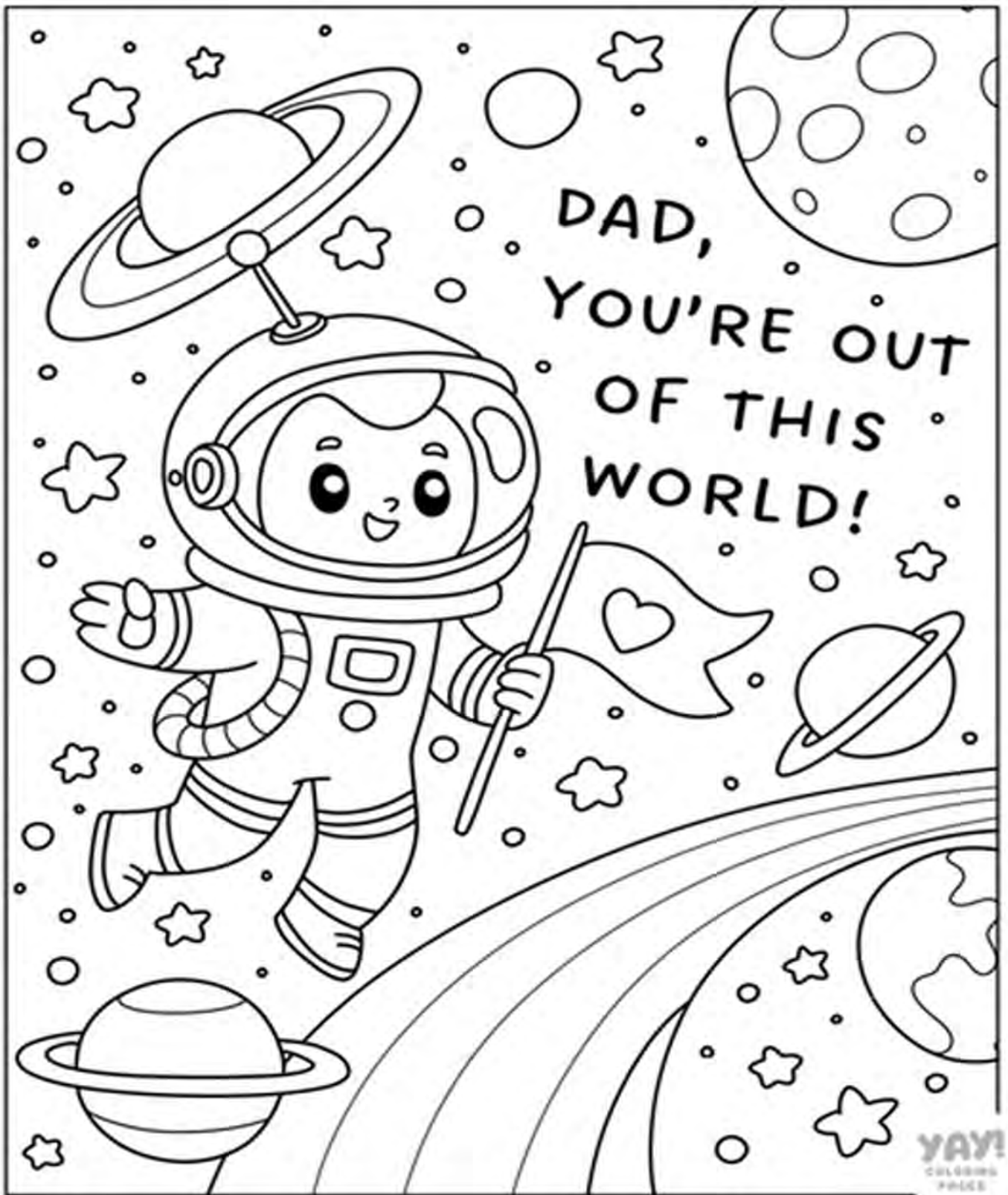

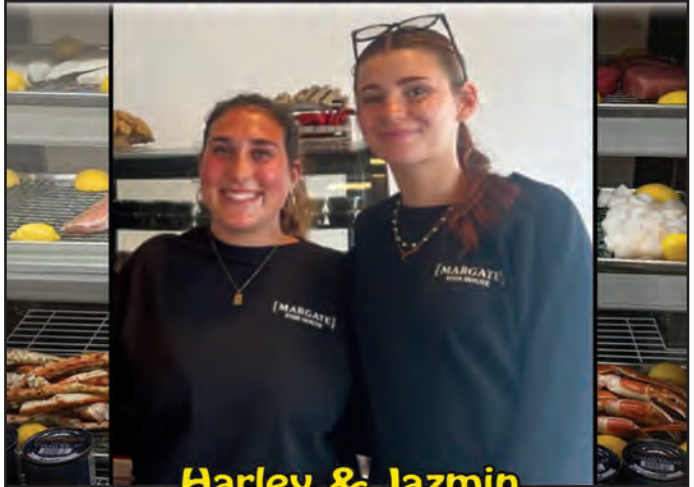

The World That We Knew by Alice Hoffman

Peek below the surface of history and in every corner, you will find hidden stories of women with extraordinary gifts. Books that bring these women into the light haunt and delight readers, and one master of this craft is Alice Hoffman. In *The World That We Knew*, she weaves a story set against the backdrop of World War II. Ettie, the daughter of a Jewish rabbi, creates a mystical golem named Ava to protect Lea, a 12-year-old girl being sent away by her mother to protect her from the Nazis. The stories of Lea, Ava and Ettie intertwine as they move through a dangerous world, protected by the power of love and a bit of magic.

The Cemetery of Untold Stories by Julia Alvarez

Julia Alvarez's 2024 novel literally brings hidden stories to life as Alma Cruz, an aging author, returns to her homeland in the Dominican Republic to find peace and a sense of completion as she ends her literary career. She builds a graveyard where she buries her unfinished manuscripts, hoping to put them to rest, but the characters and stories come to life in unexpected ways. Filomena, a local woman who cares for the grounds, listens to them, joining Alma and the unforgettable characters in an interwoven tale of love, loss and the redemptive power of telling the stories that must be told.

The Vanishing of Josephine Reynolds by Jennifer Moorman

A young widow carelessly wishes to disappear and finds herself transported back to 1927 where she meets her great-grandmother and learns pieces of her family's history that break open her world. The instrument for this time travel is a door in the house where her great-grandmother lived, and Josephine quickly realizes that she must make choices in her own life in order to save her great-grandmother - and herself - from being erased from history. The book brings love stories, wonderful details of the 1920s and haunting characters together in a tale that lingers long after the last page.

Magic and Mystery in Six Stories of Extraordinary Women

The Edge of Water by Olufunke Grace Bankole

The prophecy received by a Yoruban woman about her daughter, Amina, sets the frame for this debut novel. Amina moves from Nigeria to New Orleans even though her mother was shown that her daughter would experience tragedy and hardship in this new land. The story unfolds across time and space, with layers from the past influencing the present. As a single mother, Amina struggles in this city rich with culture and history, finding herself among those stranded after the devastation of Hurricane Katrina. The prophecy received by Esther, Amina's experiences and Yoruban cosmology give this story a rich and complex backdrop of mystery as it explores issues of immigration, family, power and identity.

Conjure Women by Afiya Atakora

Set before and after the U.S. Civil War, this novel centers around the lives of a mother, Miss May Belle, and her daughter, Rue. Miss May Belle passes on the gifts of healing and "conjuring" to Rue, and the story reveals both the deep impacts of slavery and the power of generational gifts passed between women in a family. Rue learns to navigate her changing relationship with Varina, the daughter of the plantation owner, after the war ends, as issues of power, differing spiritual and cultural beliefs and resiliency surface. This is a moving and magical story that chronicles this chapter in American history through the lives and voices of strong and gifted women.

Claire of the Sea Light by Edwidge Danticat

Many lives are impacted on the day that Claire, a young girl in the fictional Haitian town of Ville Rose, disappears. Her father's plans to send her away at age seven to give her a better life set this day in motion, and many people in the seaside community join in the search to find her. The spirit world is always close by, along with the natural world around them. Claire's eyes are the color of the sea, and nature serves as an important backdrop for what unfolds, sometimes acting as a character itself that moves the story forward. The tale moves like the changing tide of the ocean, drawing the reader in with each new revelation, ultimately revealing the power of deep relationships and of love itself.



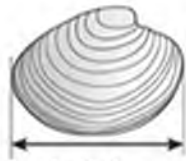

Fishing in Atlantic County

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at dep.nj.gov/nj-fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/. Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/.

SALTWATER FISHING

Atlantic City - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



Ventnor/Ventnor Heights - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

Somers Point - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

Brigantine - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Graveling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

FRESHWATER FISHING

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.



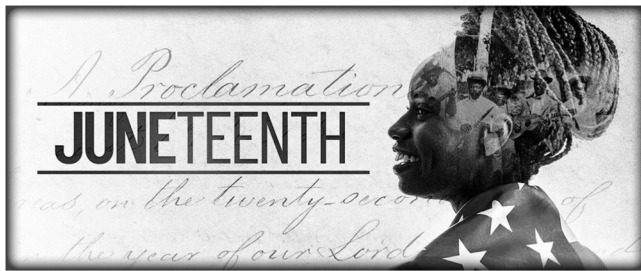

Juneteenth commemorates the emancipation of enslaved African Americans in the U.S. every June 19. This federal holiday invites reflection on the journey to freedom, the resilience of a people, and the ongoing pursuit of equality. Join in community celebrations, educate yourself on Black history, and support Black-owned businesses.

History of Juneteenth

According to the official website of the historical event, Juneteenth is 'the oldest nationally celebrated commemoration of the ending of slavery in the United States.' Other than marking a pivotal date of significance in American history, Juneteenth also serves as an opportunity for African Americans to cherish their culture and heritage.

More than 155 years old, Juneteenth celebrates the liberation of African Americans from slavery in the U.S. The reason for it being celebrated on June 19 is because, on this day in 1865, when Major General Gordon Granger of the Union Army landed in Texas, he brought the news that the Civil War had ended and all slaves were free.

The proclamation declaring the abolishment of slavery was issued by President Abraham Lincoln on January 1, 1863, in the nation's third year of an ongoing civil war. Known as the Emancipation Proclamation, it declared that 'all persons held as slaves within any State or designated part of a State [...] shall be then, thenceforward, and forever free.' Granger's arrival at Texas was to enforce this decree, which had originally gone into effect two years earlier.

The news had come as a shock to more than 250,000 slaves in Texas who were unaware of it. On June 19, in the city of Galveston, Granger publicly read General Order No. 3, which stated: 'The people of Texas are informed that, in accordance with a proclamation from the Executive of the United States, all slaves are free.'

As to why the news of the abolition of slavery reached Texas so late, there are varying accounts. One story states that the messenger bearing the news was assassinated on his journey. Some historians believe that the report on the Emancipation Proclamation was withheld by slave owners in Texas on purpose so that they can go about their business as usual and keep the labor force working. Historians also note that, until 1865, Texas remained a Confederate State, so Lincoln's proclamation could not have been enforced until Robert E. Lee surrendered to the Union Army and they took over.

Either way, Granger's arrival with the grand news stirred the air with jubilation and massive celebrations across the state. A former slave named Felix Haywood gave his recount of the first celebration in 1865 in the book "Lone Star Past: Memory and History in Texas" - 'We was all walkin' on golden clouds [...] Everybody went wild [...] We was free. Just like that, we was free.'

5 Courageous Americans Who Fought For Equality

- 1 - Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. - Perhaps the most widely recognizable name associated with the civil rights movement, Dr. King gave us the famous "I have a Dream" speech in August 1963 - his 1968 murder proved that the movement still had a lot of work to do.
- 2 - Rosa Parks - With a simple refusal to surrender her seat on a public bus, Parks made a bold statement for African Americans in the South - her December 1955 arrest inspired the Montgomery Bus Boycott.
- 3 - Mildred Loving - Loving and her husband, Richard, were jailed for unlawful cohabitation in Virginia where interracial marriage was illegal in 1958 - their case reached the Supreme Court in 1967, which ruled unanimously in their favor.
- 4 - Frederick Douglass - An escaped slave, Douglass became an advocate for the abolition of slavery as well as women's rights.
- 5 - Dred Scott - Enslaved African American Dred Scott sued for his family's freedom in 1857 - the Supreme Court ruled against him, finding that no person of African ancestry could claim U.S. citizenship.

Why Juneteenth is Important

- Learning from the past - Acknowledging history helps us understand how far the country has come and how much work still remains. Juneteenth reminds us of the importance of equal access to education, freedom of speech, civil rights and non-discrimination in every area of life.
- Empathy - For many Americans, it is difficult to imagine a time when freedom could be delayed, denied or ignored. Juneteenth marks the day in 1865 when enslaved people in Texas finally received word of emancipation, more than two years after the Emancipation Proclamation. The holiday encourages reflection on both the pain of that history and the ongoing effects of racial injustice.
- Recognition - Juneteenth began as a deeply meaningful community celebration and has grown into a national day of remembrance. Texas became the first state to recognize Juneteenth as a state holiday in 1980, and it became a federal holiday in 2021. Today, it stands as both a celebration of freedom and a reminder that freedom must be protected, honored and shared by all.

Atlantic County Commemorates Juneteenth

As Juneteenth arrives, Atlantic County residents have several opportunities to gather, reflect and celebrate the holiday's meaning. In Atlantic City, the city's flag raising ceremony at Lt. Sheila Oliver Plaza will offer a public moment of recognition, while the Juneteenth Cookout: The Ubuntu Way at Oscar McClinton Park will bring the community together with food, games and cultural celebration. The African American Heritage Museum of Southern New Jersey will also continue the observance at the Noyes Arts Garage with music, speakers, storytelling, vendors and reflection. Together, these events help bring Juneteenth off the page and into the community - honoring history while celebrating freedom, resilience and unity today.

It might seem strange to call plank a balancing yoga pose since the risk of falling over is minimal, but it gets to the heart of this pose—core strength.

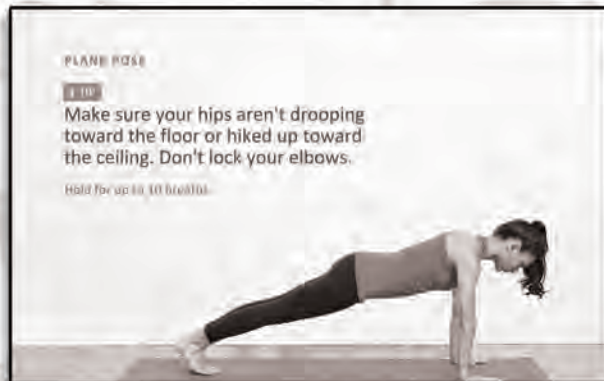

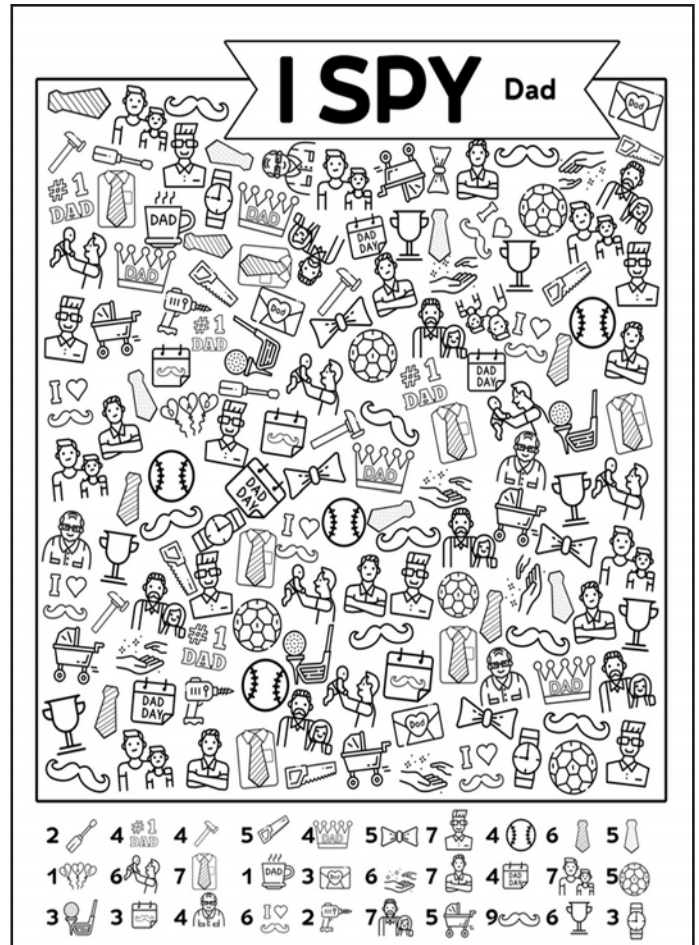

Zucchini Ribbon & Strawberry Summer Salad

INGREDIENTS

- 2 small zucchini or yellow squash
- 1 cup fresh strawberries, sliced
- 3 cups arugula, spring mix or chopped romaine
- ¼ cup thinly sliced radishes
- 2 scallions, sliced
- ¼ cup crumbled feta or goat cheese
- 2 tablespoons chopped basil or mint
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon honey
- Salt and pepper, to taste



DIRECTIONS

Use a vegetable peeler to shave the zucchini into thin ribbons. In a large bowl, combine the greens, zucchini ribbons, strawberries, radishes, scallions, cheese and herbs. Whisk together the olive oil, lemon juice, honey, salt and pepper, then drizzle over the salad just before serving. Toss gently and serve chilled or at room temperature. Quick tip: Add grilled chicken, shrimp or toasted walnuts to make it a light summer dinner.

Strawberry Cucumber Mint Cooler

INGREDIENTS

- 1 cup fresh strawberries, hulled
- ½ cucumber, sliced
- 8 to 10 fresh mint leaves
- Juice of 1 lemon or lime
- 1 to 2 tablespoons honey or simple syrup
- 3 cups cold sparkling water or still water
- Ice
- Extra strawberries, cucumber slices and mint, for garnish



DIRECTIONS

In a pitcher, muddle the strawberries, cucumber, mint, lemon or lime juice and honey until the fruit releases its juices. Add cold sparkling water and stir well. Fill glasses with ice, pour the cooler over top and garnish with extra berries, cucumber and mint. Pro Tip: For a slushy version, blend the strawberries, cucumber, citrus juice and honey with a handful of ice, then top with sparkling water.

PEDAL FOR PUPPIES SUPPORTS THE SEEING EYE

And they're off!

Pedal for Puppies has officially begun, sending three cyclists on a coast-to-coast ride in support of The Seeing Eye and the life-changing guide dogs who help people who are blind or have low vision live with greater independence, confidence and mobility.

The ride is led by Jim Freiss, Glenn Morse and Victor Fassano of Puppy Ride Long Island. Their journey is also a personal tribute to Jim's late brother, John, a graduate of The Seeing Eye, and John's Seeing Eye dog, Hero. After seeing the freedom and confidence his brother gained through that partnership, Jim turned his love of endurance cycling into a way to give back.

This year's Pedal for Puppies effort is the team's most ambitious ride yet, covering more than 4,000 miles from Seaside, Oregon, to Montauk, New York. The cross-country ride is expected to take nearly two months, with supporters able to follow along, cheer the riders on and take part in related events throughout the journey.

Pedal for Puppies is designed so anyone can join the team, no matter where they live or how they ride. Cyclists can participate outdoors, on trails or roads, indoors on a stationary bike, or through platforms such as Peloton. Supporters can also start a fundraiser, make a donation, share their own riding progress or join the Pedal for Puppies community online.

Founded in 1929 and based in Morristown, New Jersey, The Seeing Eye breeds, raises and trains Seeing Eye dogs to guide people who are blind or have low vision. The organization also teaches graduates how to properly handle and care for their dogs, creating partnerships that support active, independent lives.

What began as a personal tribute has grown into a major fundraising effort. Through Puppy Ride Long Island, riders have logged more than 15,500 miles and raised more than \$305,000 to support The Seeing Eye's mission. Those who join Pedal for Puppies are helping continue that mission one mile at a time. Riders and supporters are encouraged to tag The Seeing Eye and use #PedalForPuppies to share their progress and help spread the word.

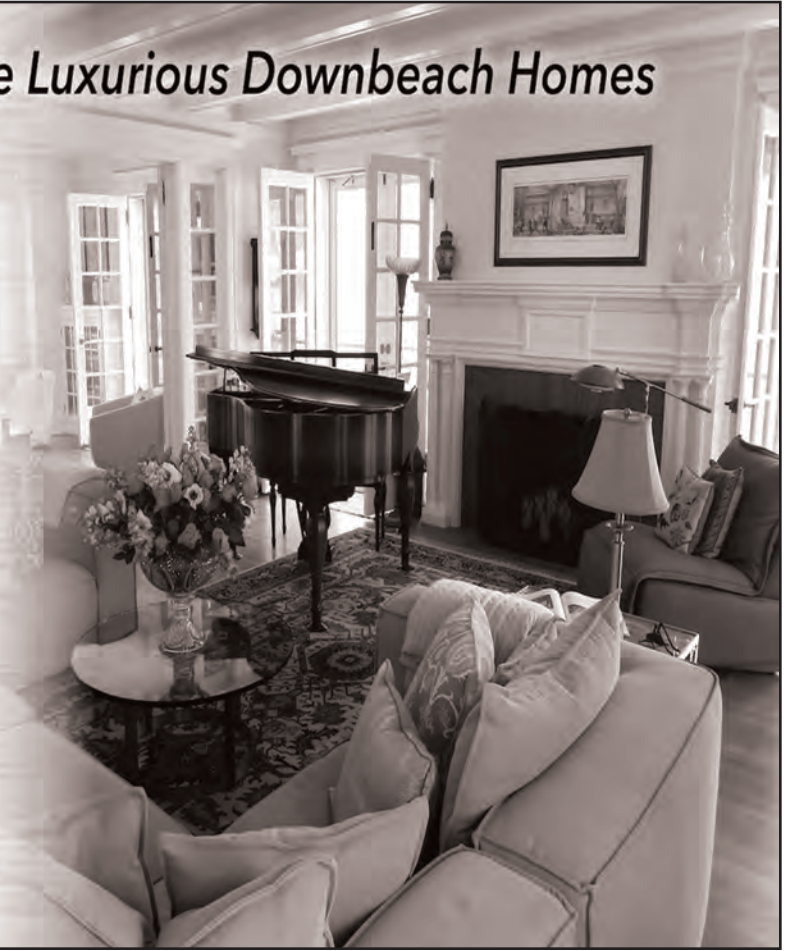

Atlantic City will be loud, proud and full of color on Saturday, June 20, as the Atlantic City Great Pride Festival returns to O'Donnell Memorial Park for a free, family-friendly celebration of music, entertainment, food, vendors, community resources and Pride.

Presented by the Atlantic City Great Pride Committee and hosted by AC Pride, the third annual festival will take place from noon to 6 p.m. in Atlantic City's Chelsea neighborhood. The event is free and open to all, with VIP tickets available for guests who want access to the exclusive VIP tent, premium seating, complimentary food and beverages and dedicated restrooms.

This year's festival will feature a full day of live entertainment, drag performances, DJs, food trucks, local vendors, community organizations, giveaways and activities for all ages. The celebration begins with a Pride processional walk, opening ceremony, welcome remarks, sponsor recognition and a special appearance by Miss'd America Miss Cherry Poppins.

The headline entertainment is one of the biggest draws of this year's festival. Jade Starling of Pretty Poison will top the bill, while the Pride Tribute Band

brings a high-energy performance featuring Tina Turner tribute artist Mona Lisa, Pretty Ricky and local favorites Angela Burton and Judah Dorrington. Sandy Beach and Miss Ten'e will host the day's festivities, with additional drag performances and DJs keeping the crowd entertained throughout the afternoon.

Families will find plenty to enjoy beyond the main stage, including a dedicated kids zone, crafts, face painting, rock painting, tie-dyeing and other hands-on activities. Guests can also browse local vendors, visit community resource tables and enjoy food and drinks from participating food trucks.

An official afterparty will follow at ByrdCage from 6:30 to 9 p.m. Whether guests come for the music, the performances, the food, the vendors or simply to celebrate love and inclusion, the day offers a reminder of what Pride is all about: being proud, being loud and being exactly who you are.

The World Cup is no longer a coming attraction. After one week of group-stage play, the tournament has already delivered blowouts, surprises, superstar moments and a few reminders that no favorite gets an easy ride for long. For South Jersey fans, the best part is that some of the biggest storylines are happening close enough to drive to - or watch from the Boardwalk.

The First Week: Favorites Flexed, Underdogs Pushed Back

The United States gave fans an early reason to believe with a 4-1 win over Paraguay, a statement start for the host nation before Friday's match against Australia. Germany also came out roaring with a 7-1 win over Curaçao, while Sweden's 5-1 victory over Tunisia showed how quickly a group can tilt after just one match.

But the first week was not all smooth sailing for the giants. Brazil, one of the tournament's most-watched teams, was held to a 1-1 draw by Morocco at New York New Jersey Stadium, making Friday's Philadelphia match against Haiti feel less like a showcase and more like a test. Brazil remains the favorite, but Haiti now gets a chance to turn belief and emotion into one of the tournament's most talked-about results.

Spain's 0-0 draw with Cape Verde may have been the biggest surprise so far. Cape Verde is making its World Cup debut, while Spain entered as one of the tournament favorites. A scoreless draw does not knock Spain off course, but it does prove how dangerous this expanded 48-team format can be.

The superstars have done their part, too. Lionel Messi opened Argentina's tournament with a hat trick against Algeria, Kylian Mbappé scored twice in France's 3-1 win over Senegal, and Erling Haaland made a loud World Cup arrival with two goals in Norway's 4-1 win over Iraq. Those three names alone are enough to make this week's schedule worth watching.

Matches to Watch This Week

For local fans, the biggest nearby game is Friday, June 19, when Brazil faces Haiti at Lincoln Financial Field in Philadelphia. Brazil is still the team expected to control the match, but after the draw with Morocco, the pressure is higher. Haiti comes in as the underdog, and that is exactly the kind of setup that can turn a group-stage game into a memory.

That same day, the United States faces Australia at 3 p.m. It is not a local stadium match, but it is one of the most important games of the week for American viewers. After the U.S. opened with a convincing win, this is the match that can either keep the momentum rolling or tighten up the group.

Monday, June 22, brings another major Philadelphia match when France faces Iraq at 5 p.m. France is one of the tournament favorites and looked dangerous in its opener, especially with Mbappé already in form. Iraq lost to Norway, but showed enough flashes to make the matchup more interesting than it may look on paper.

Later that night, New York New Jersey Stadium in East Rutherford hosts Norway vs. Senegal at 8 p.m. Norway has Haaland, who wasted no time making his mark, while Senegal needs a response after falling to France.

Other games worth circling include England vs. Croatia on Wednesday, June 17; Mexico vs. South Korea on Thursday, June 18; Germany vs. Côte d'Ivoire on Saturday, June 20; Belgium vs. Iran on Sunday, June 21; Argentina vs. Austria on Monday, June 22; and England vs. Ghana on Tuesday, June 23. By Wednesday, June 24, the stakes rise again with Brazil facing Scotland, Haiti meeting Morocco, and Mexico taking on Czechia as early groups start moving toward decision time.

No Ticket? No Problem.

World Cup tickets may be out of reach for plenty of fans, but there are still plenty of ways to feel part of the tournament close to home. Atlantic City has been named an official viewing destination for the World Cup, with watch parties, Boardwalk activations and beach soccer programming running throughout the summer.

In Atlantic City, the Beach Soccer AC Summer Series continues on weekends on the beach in front of Stockton University's Esports Innovation Center. The free series runs through the tournament and includes beach soccer, youth clinics, pick-up games, family activities, esports and World Cup watch parties when games are scheduled. For Shore families, it is one of the easiest ways to catch the World Cup atmosphere without driving to Philadelphia or North Jersey.

The celebration also spills onto the Boardwalk. Trionda, the official FIFA World Cup 2026 match ball, is on display in front of The Yard at Bally's Atlantic City all summer, giving fans a photo-ready stop between matches. Atlantic City also has a direct connection to the tournament through Haiti's national team, which is using Stockton University as its official base camp. That makes Haiti's upcoming games against Brazil on June 19 and Morocco on June 24 especially meaningful for the Shore.



Several casino resorts, sportsbooks and local bars will be showing matches, including Tennessee Avenue Beer Hall, Borgata, Ocean Casino Resort and America's Birthday Bar at 1927 Lounge. From bar watch parties and big-screen viewing to resort sportsbooks and game-day specials, fans have plenty of ways to watch without a stadium ticket.

In Philadelphia, the FIFA Fan Festival at Lemon Hill in East Fairmount Park is another major option for fans without stadium tickets. The free festival runs throughout the tournament, with big-screen match broadcasts, food and beverage vendors, entertainment, fan activities and cultural programming. Registration is required for match-day entry, so fans should plan ahead before making the trip.

How to Watch From Home

For English-language coverage, World Cup matches are airing on FOX and FS1, with streaming available through FOX One and the FOX Sports app. Spanish-language coverage is available on Telemundo, Universo and Peacock. Because games are split across channels, viewers should check the listing for each match before kickoff.

The group stage runs daily, which means the next week will start separating the true contenders from the teams simply trying to survive. Whether fans are watching from Atlantic City, heading to Philadelphia, making the trip to East Rutherford or streaming from the couch, the World Cup has officially become the summer sports story close to home.
