Main Library Will Be Closed This Week

The Main Library will be closed the remainder of this week due to mechanical issues with the heating and sprinkler systems. All classes and training scheduled to take place at the Main Library this week have been cancelled. "We are working on getting these issues resolved as quickly as possible," Atlantic City Free Public Library Director Robert Rynkiewicz said. "We are working with contractors to repair the damaged systems and to reopen the library as soon as possible." Due to the Main Library being closed, the library will offer additional hours at the Richmond Branch Library – located at 4115 Ventnor Ave. The Richmond Branch will be open this week Tuesday through Saturday from 9:30 a.m.-5 p.m. Also, library members who wish to borrow materials – including books, movies, CDs, magazines and comics – are encouraged to check out items from the library's digital collections, such as hoopla, Overdrive, ComicsPlus and Axis 360. NOLAN MEMORABILIA ON DISPLAY

If you love baseball, you know the name Nolan Ryan. He brought joy to millions of fans over his 27-year career from 1966-1993. Ryan played on four teams, first with the Mets in 1968. Ryan still leads Major League Baseball (MLB) in strikeouts and no-hitters and was the first to earn a \$1 million salary. That seems pretty tame compared to today's superstar players, doesn't it?

Ryan is the only player in MLB history to have his uniform numbers retired by three different teams, including California Angels (30), Houston Astros (34) and Texas Rangers (34). These achievements drew the interest of area real estate investor Leo S. Ullman. Over almost 30 years, he amassed a collection of 15,000 individual items with an appraised value of more than \$1 million.

Ullman donated the entire collection of bats, puzzles, pennants, figurines, coins, and jerseys to Stockton University. It is considered the world's largest of its kind. The Nolan Ryan Pop-Up collection is on display through Sunday, 2/26/23 at the Noyes Arts Garage in Atlantic City. https://noyesmuseum.org/current-exhibitions?mc_cid=0fb3aea89d&mc_eid=0d3e5551d8

First up is the 2000 Malèna, released with English subtitles and running close to two hours. It profiles a teenage boy from a provincial Italian town during WWII who becomes enamored with Malèna, a sensual woman who resides there.

CHEF CHIP'S WILD GAME AND SEAFOOD RECIPE

BISON LASAGNA

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 Lb Lasagna Noodles
- 1 Tbs Olive Oil
- 1 Lb Ground Bison
- 1 Qt Tomato Sauce
- 1 Pt Ricotta Cheese
- 12-14 oz Shredded Mozzarella Cheese
- 6 Tbs Parmesan Cheese
- 1/4 cup Kosher Salt
- Kosher Salt & Pepper to Taste

PREPARATION:

Heat a pan with olive oil over medium high heat. Stir in ground bison. Season and cook bison through, strain and set aside. In a large pot, bring a gallon of water to a boil. Add salt and gently add in pasta. Stir gently for the first minute. Allow pasta to cook al dente. Strain pasta and cool with luke warm water. Grease an 11 x 7 oven-safe pan. Coat the bottom of pan lightly with tomato sauce. Lay 3 pieces of lasagna across the bottom of pan. Lay out another 3 pieces on top of the first 3. Now you have your base layer. Cover base layer with sauce. Add the meat and more sauce on top. Using a spoon, evenly distribute half of the Ricotta cheese. Sprinkle on 1/3 of the mozzarella cheese and 1/3 (2 Tbsp) of the parmesan cheese. Layer on 3 more pieces of noodles and repeat process. After second layer is done, place 3 more pieces of noodles down. Top with sauce and remaining mozzarella and parmesan. Wrap the top part of pan with plastic wrap. Next, cover with foil, shiny side out. Bake in a preheated 350° oven for 40 minutes. Remove foil and wrap from pan. Place back in oven and cook about 20 minutes. Allow to rest for 10 minutes. Cut and serve. Enjoy!

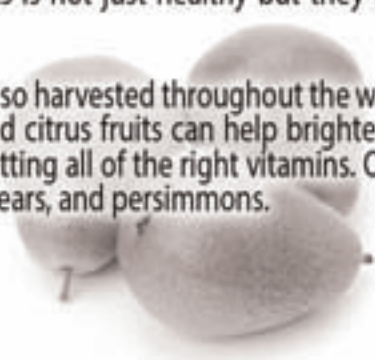

NEW YEAR'S FUN FACTS

- **LOOK BOTH WAYS** - Back to the Future. It's very fitting that the first month of the New Year is named after a god who looks to the future and the past. The month of January is named after the Roman god Janus, who has two faces, one looking forward and one looking backward.
- **"SHOULD AULD ACQUAINTANCE BE FORGOT"** - Say what? Does anybody really get the words right on that song people sing when the clock strikes 12? The traditional song sung at midnight on New Year's is called "Auld Lang Syne," which means "times gone by." It was written by Scottish poet Robert Burns in 1788. Great Scott!
- **DROPPING THE BALL** - Oooooo, shiny. The dropping of the New Year's Eve Ball on New York's Times Square is almost a century-old tradition. And the first ball, which weighed 700 pounds, was dropped on December 31, 1907. At midnight, approximately 3,000 pounds of confetti is dropped on the crowd in Times Square every year.
- **POSSUM KINGDOM** - Anything is "possible." Who needs a ball of lights when you have ... a rodent? The town of Brasstown, North Carolina traditionally lowers a possum instead of a giant ball of lights on New Year's Eve. That tradition is known as "The Possum Drop." ... Yes, a possum.
- **IT'S A ME, UNDIS** - Red underwear = good luck? That's right, apparently people in Italy wear red underwear on New Year's Day to bring them good luck throughout the year. So let's go buy some red undies and find out if it works!
- **BORICUA BEACH BASH** - Making a splash. In the Caribbean island of Puerto Rico, people flock to the beaches on New Year's Eve and drop backwards into the breaking waves as the clock strikes 12. This tradition is believed to keep bad spirits at bay throughout the new year.
- **DOUBLE SHOT OF VODKA** - Russians love to party! So much so that they celebrate the New Year twice. Once on January 1st and then again on January 14th! Guess there "ain't no party like a Russian party cause a Russian party don't stop!"
- **CHINA-MITE!** - Happy Moon Year. While firecrackers are traditional of pretty much any New Year's celebration, China does not celebrate a traditional New Year. Firecrackers in China symbolize "good luck in the coming year." But the Chinese New Year is celebrated during the second full moon after the winter solstice rather than on the first day of January.

"Rosh" is Hebrew for "head"; "ha" is the definite article ("the"); and "shanah" means year. So "Rosh HaShanah" means "head [of] the year", referring to the Jewish day of new year.
- **PENGUIN PARTY** - Happy Feet. A testament to how big a celebration New Year's Eve is globally would be the fact that it's even celebrated in Antarctica! That's right, there's a music festival every New Year's Eve in the Antarctic called "Icestock"! Because who wouldn't want to bring in the New Year with a bunch of penguins, right?!
- **NEW YEAR'S SMOOCH** - Kiss-kiss, hooray! Ready for some midnight loving on New Year's Eve/Day? It is said that the traditional midnight kiss when the clock strikes 12 on New Year's Eve has something to do with the first person you come across in the new year setting the tone for the next 12 months. So you better choose who you kiss wisely!
- **NEW YEAR'S THIEVES** - Lock em up! Before you start your New Year's festivities, make sure you set your vehicle's alarm and keep your keys with you. Because according to data from the National Insurance Crime Bureau, more vehicles are stolen on New Year's Day than any other holiday. So yeah, you might be saying "goodbye" to more than just the old year.
- **TOP PICKS** - Sin City, Mouse City and Big Apple City. Where are the best places in the United States to ring in the New Year? According to CBS.com, some of the top places in the United States to celebrate New Year's Eve include Las Vegas, Disney World and of course, New York City.
- **HAIL NEW YEAR!** - "When in Rome"? According to History.com, Roman Emperor Julius Caesar declared January 1st as a national holiday 4,000 years ago. So even when not in Rome, we're still doing as the Romans do.
- **NEW YEAR'S CHEERS** - A bubbly start. It is estimated that Americans drink close to 360 million glasses of sparkling wine during New Year's Eve celebrations. That's a lot of bottom's up!

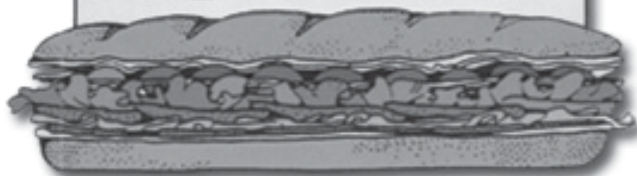
