YOGA POSE OF THE WEEK - Mountain Pose (Tadasana)

Mountain pose may not be as famous as Downward Facing Dog, but it is equally important. This is an excellent time to talk about alignment, which is how your body parts are ideally arranged in each pose.

The alignment in Mountain pose draws a straight line from the crown of your head to your heels, with the shoulders and pelvis stacked along the line. Every person's body is different, so focus on rooting down with your feet and lengthening up with your spine.

Remember to slide your shoulders down your back and keep weight on your heels.







We honor the most commonly packed camping snack by celebrating National S'mores Day on August 10. Summertime is finally here and with it comes camping and gathering around the firepit in the great outdoors. Originating right here in the U.S.A., the s'more has us salivating in anticipation of smashing those tasty toasted marshmallows with a slab of chocolate between two graham crackers. Read on for the latest trends in s'more-making and try a new twist on an old favorite tonight.

HISTORY OF NATIONAL S'MORES DAY

While the origins of National S'mores Day remain unknown, s'more, the great American camping treat, has a long, delicious history. The first mention of such a treat was in the 1920s in a book of recipes published by Campfire Marshmallows, home of the original marshmallow and still in business today. At that time, the recipe was called a 'Graham Cracker Sandwich' and suggested the treat had already been made popular by the Boy- and Girl Scouts.

Part of the fun is each person searching for their own long, sturdy stick capable of holding a mound of marshmallows over the fire for toasting.

Then comes the toasting debate — how toasted do you prefer your marshmallows? Of course, this leads to a full-on psychological evaluation. Do you set your marshmallow on the fire and blow the flame out once it is burnt? Do you allow your marshmallow to hover over the flame and toast to a less than charred yet caramelized state? Do you barely get the marshmallow tan?



If you have siblings, you know the rivalry can get real. Middle children often get less attention from busy parents. But despite the commonly held belief that their insecurity and resentment carries on into adulthood, middle children actually develop some critical skills that help them become successful adults.

Whether or not "Middle Child Syndrome" is real, it's true that middle children, particularly in large families, can get overlooked in the hustle and bustle of daily life. Started in 1986 by Elizabeth Walker, National Middle Child Day celebrates our middle siblings and reminds us that each child is precious and important.

National Middle Child Day is observed to honor that in-between child in the family. The interesting thing is even larger families celebrate more than one middle child, too! Like every other year, National Middle Child Day 2022 will be celebrated on August 12th.

HISTORY OF NATIONAL MIDDLE CHILD DAY

Middle children have a reputation for being ignored by their family, consequently growing up resentful, withdrawn, and disaffected. Although research shows little correlation between birth order and personality, the stereotype has persisted in pop culture characters like Jan Brady, who epitomizes the embittered middle child.

In fact, middle children might have some distinct advantages in adult life. The skills they develop as the "forgotten" sibling often translate into important qualities like empathy, diplomacy, and flexibility. In fact, over half of U.S. presidents were middle children, along with many other successful leaders.

Resourceful and independent but also cooperative and patient, middle children often grow up to be good leaders and helpful teammates. They can negotiate a variety of personalities but also do well on their own, and are known as risk-takers and independent thinkers. Because they're frequently left to their own devices, middle children develop a self-sufficiency less common in their older and younger siblings.

Until the 1970s, American families had an average of 2.5 children. Today, due to modernization and economic and environmental pressures, fewer and fewer families have middle children, with the average American family having just under two kids.

National Middle Child Day began in 1986 as a way to celebrate the siblings who feel left out or unseen and give them a special day of their own. Until now, it's been celebrated on August 12.

Not everyone agrees on the holiday's date: the International Middle Child's Union, founded by Bruce Hopman, wants to change National Middle Child Day to July 2, which falls in the exact middle of the calendar year.



You can reduce the house hold percentage by half on roulette by seeking out a single "O" machine instead of a double "OO" game.

Specialty games such as Spanish 21 will break your bank much faster than regular BJ.

Some table games with high-meter signs for a large win could be an advantage and chance for a big win, but you must shop around.

If you stick to the AC casinos offering the above table games, your gaming budget will last longer enabling more fun and perhaps some monetary reward, which is why we play in the first place. So dear readers, do enjoy this adult entertainment form, but do not become what P.T. calls a "sucker!"

INGREDIENTS:


- 12 Large Sea Scallops

Library Tennessee Avenue Improvement Project Has Begun

Construction work on the William K. Cheatham Building (Main Library) began Monday, June 27, as part of the Atlantic City Free Public Library Tennessee Avenue Improvement Project. The building, which opened in 1985 at 1 North Tennessee Ave., will receive extensive exterior repairs and upgrades this year as part of this project. The construction will begin with remodeling of the library's first-floor bathrooms and will later include cleaning the exterior limestone façade, demolition and replacement of the concrete stairs and sidewalk, improved lighting, signage, railings and new exterior doors.

The library will remain open during construction, with the exception of a few days when demolition will require closing. The project is scheduled to be completed in fall 2022. The library's doors on Tennessee Avenue will remain closed to the public during this time. Those who want to enter the building must go to the Atlantic County Office doors on Atlantic Avenue and inform a security guard they are going to the library. Also, the library's 15-minute parking area will be unavailable, and there will be a lane closure on Tennessee Avenue until the project has been completed.





HOMEMADE DOG TREAT RECIPE

EASY DIY SWEET POTATO DOG CHEWS

INGREDIENTS:

2 Sweet Potatoes



INSTRUCTIONS:

Preheat your oven to 250F (130C). Line two baking sheets with parchment paper. Use a knife or mandoline to cut the sweet potato into slices. I sliced mine into coins because my dog is small, but if you have a bigger dog you could slice them lengthwise for larger chews. You don't want the pieces to be too thin, or they will just get crispy and not chewy, so make sure they are no thinner than ¼ inch (see photos for reference). Arrange them in a single layer on the baking sheets and bake for 2 ½ to 3 hours flipping once half way through until they are shrunken, dried out, and some pieces are a bit crispy, while others are a bit chewy. Let cool, then store in an air-tight container in the fridge for about 3 weeks.







RIP CURRENTS HOW TO AVOID & SURVIVE

A rip current is a specific kind of water current that can occur near beaches with breaking waves. A rip curent is a strong, localized, and narrow current of water which moves directly away from the shore, cutting through the lines of breaking waves like a river running out to sea.



- Check water conditions before going in by looking at the local beach forecast before you leave for the beach and talking to the lifeguard at the beach.
- Only swim at a beach with lifeguards. The chances of drowning at a beach with lifeguards are 1 in 18 million (U.S. Lifesaving Association).
 Don't assume! Great weather for the beach does
- Don't assume! Great weather for the beach does not always mean it's safe to swim or even play in the shallows. Rip currents often form on calm, sunny days.
- Moving at speeds of up to eight feet per second, rip currents can move faster than an Olympic swimmer.
- Panicked swimmers often try to counter a rip current by swimming straight back to shore—putting themselves at risk of drowning because of fatigue.
- Lifeguards rescue tens of thousands of people from rip currents in the U.S. every year, but it is estimated that 100 people are killed by rip currents annually.
- If caught in a rip current, don't fight it! Swim parallel to the shore and swim back to land at an angle.



Memories of Oiscovering the Music of Motown

From as far back as I can remember, music has been a constant in my life. Those who regularly read this column are more than aware that some of my influences and discovery of genres, artists and songs have morphed into content that I share weekly.

However, this week the loss of an incredible songwriter is the catalyst for the column. I read with sadness this week that Lamont Dozier of the mega-hit song writing trio of Holland-Dozier-Holland had died at the age of 81. The team wrote some of the most classic Motown songs for some incredible motor city artists. The impact of the songs created as part of Motown's rise still bring enjoyment and music memories to fans around the world.

My personal discovery of Motown started in the late 70's since I was not alive or listening to music during the incredible run and success on the Charts for Holland-Dozier-Holland that took place from 1963 to 1967. The songwriters were responsible for penning over two dozen top 10 songs during that period. Not being around for the birth of Motown meant I had some catching up to do. I fully immersed myself in listening to and learning about the "assembly line" American soul music that was created at a time when the Beatles and the British invasion were dominating the charts.

When I first heard the Temps (The Temptations), the Tops (The Four Tops), Smokey Robinson and the Supremes I was hooked. Of course, the radio listening, record purchasing and deep music research dive was sometime after I first heard a Motown song. That would have occurred much earlier when I first saw the Saturday morning Jackson 5 cartoons. The songs of the Jackson 5 interwoven with cartoons gave me an appreciation and the basis for the lifetime love of Motown. The song, "ABC" as simple and easy as "1,2,3..." still reminds me that my continued musical journey is as much research, discovery and education as it is pleasure and enjoyment.

As time went on, I discovered Marvin Gaye, Stevie Wonder, the Martha Reeves and the Vandellas and more. Classics like the Supremes' "You Can't Hurry Love", "Where Did Our Love Go", "You Keep Me Hanging On", and "Stop, In the Name of Love" or The Four Tops "It's the Same Old Song", "I Can't Help Myself" and "Reach Out I'll Be There" are just a few of the songs written by Holland-Dozier-Holland. They also wrote one of the hottest summer songs of all time with "(Love is Like a) Heat Wave" by Martha and the Vandellas.

When I discovered the Isley Brothers, I ended up finding one of my favorites all time Motown songs written by none other than Holland-Dozier-Holland. "This Old Heart of Mine (Is Weak For You)", is that song. It can be debated and has been that the Temps or Tops songs, the Supremes, Marvin Gaye, Stevie Wonder offering or even the early Jackson 5 had more commercially successful songs. I am not even sure why that Isley Brothers song tops my list.

Perhaps it is something in the music itself or the lyrics that strikes a chord. The song speaks to me about a feeling so strong that no matter what occurs you are still committed to a person/partner. A feeling so strong that the connection remains and returns despite time or distance. Looking back on life there was definitely a time when there was a sizable distance between myself and the amazing woman that was at the time and still is my partner in life.

So no matter what you list as your favorite Motown song, while we mourn the passing of an incredible songwriter that helped create so many amazing songs, take some time to celebrate and revisit the Holland-Dozier-Holland catalog. Until next time, keep listening to and discovering music!




