National Donut Day falls on the first Friday in June each year and we are getting geared up to savor our best-loved fried dough confections. Have you ever resisted eating one? History of National Donut Day

At one point or another in our lives, we've found ourselves craving a donut. When we think about it, it's not really a surprise that this treat hits the spot like no other. The origins of National Donut Day are traced to the Salvation Army's involvement in World War I. During this time, a group of volunteers was dispatched to the frontlines with the mission of providing comforting meals for the troops. They soon found out that donuts were an effective way to provide food while navigating the difficulties of cooking in very dire circumstances. These brave volunteers would later be known as "donut lassies". They would even use war helmets as a utensil to fry up seven donuts at a time.

In 1938, National Donut Day was established as a way to honor the members of the Salvation Army that came to the aid of soldiers during World War I. Nowadays, National Donut Day is widely celebrated on the first Friday of June. Many donut shops are known to give them out for free, giving a good reason to take some time out of the day to enjoy this most cherished treat.

There is a lot of competition for cops at donut shops, with lines of people clamoring to get their donut fix. 

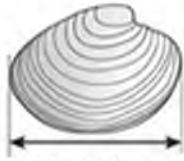

Fishing in Atlantic County

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at dep.nj.gov/nj-fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/. Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/.

SALTWATER FISHING

Atlantic City - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



Ventnor/Ventnor Heights - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

Somers Point - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

Brigantine - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Graveling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

FRESHWATER FISHING

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.

Grilled Zucchini & Fresh Pea Salad

INGREDIENTS

- 4 medium zucchini (*sliced lengthwise into planks*)
- 1½ cups fresh peas (*sugar snap or shelled English peas*)
- 3–4 scallions (*thinly sliced*)
- 2 tbsp olive oil
- 1–2 cloves garlic (*minced*)
- 2 tbsp fresh herbs (*dill, parsley, or basil*)
- Juice and zest of ½ lemon
- Salt & black pepper
- *Optional: crumbled feta and/or a handful of cherry tomatoes*



DIRECTIONS

Toss zucchini planks with olive oil, garlic, salt, and pepper. Grill 3–4 minutes per side until charred and tender. Cut into bite-sized pieces. In a large bowl, combine zucchini, fresh peas, scallions, and herbs. Add lemon zest and juice and a drizzle of olive oil. Toss and season to taste.

Strawberry Mint Sparkler



INGREDIENTS

- 1 pint strawberries (*hulled*)
- 8–10 fresh mint leaves
- 2 tbsp honey or simple syrup
- Juice of 1 lemon
- 2–3 cups sparkling water or club soda
- Ice

DIRECTIONS

Blend strawberries, mint, honey, and lemon juice until smooth. Strain if you prefer less pulp (optional). Pour over ice and top with sparkling water. Stir gently. Garnish with extra mint and strawberry slices.

National Homeownership Month is in June. It celebrates the value that owning a home brings to families, communities, and neighborhoods across America. History of National Homeownership Month

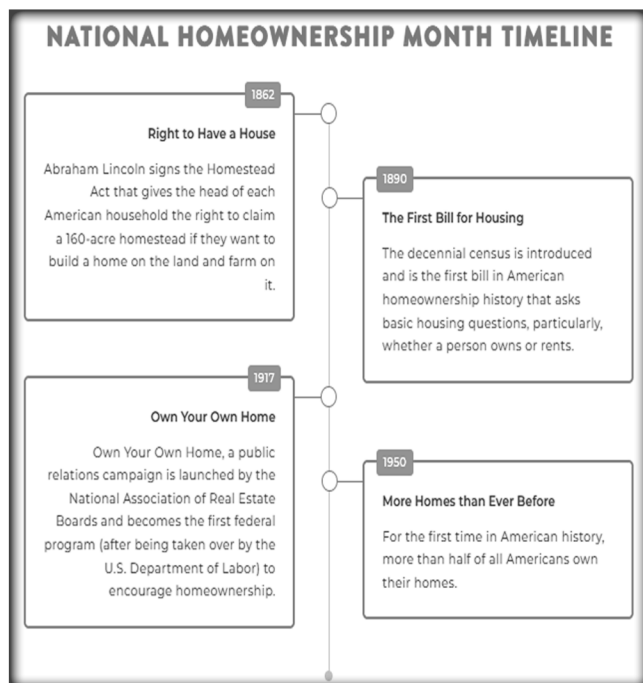
Most Americans had no way of really owning a home in the 1800s. Mortgages became common only after the U.S. banking system came into being after the 1860s National Bank Acts.

During the time of the Great Depression, the banks did not have any money to lend and the average borrower didn't have any cash. As a result, people couldn't afford to buy homes, while existing homeowners often failed to pay their debt. To stabilize the housing market, the U.S. government created the Home Owners' Loan Corporation in 1933, the Federal Housing Administration in 1934, and the Federal National Mortgage Association (now known as Fannie Mae) in 1938. All these institutions took homeownership to new heights and helped prevent a crash in the housing market.

What changed the face of the housing industry, along with that of the American economy, was the G.I. Bill of 1944. This bill provided subsidized mortgages for the veterans of World War II. Another milestone in the history of American housing came when Congress passed the Fair Housing Act of 1968. The Act was signed by President Lyndon B. Johnson and banned discrimination in housing based on religion, race, gender, and national origin. It came into being only a few days after the assassination of Martin Luther King, Jr.

In its 87 years of existence, the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) has saved America an almost \$4 trillion loss of household wealth. It has helped more than 44 million citizens to become homeowners.

National Homeownership Week began in 1995, which was a strategy of the administration under President Bill Clinton to increase homeownership across America. Later, in 2002, President George W. Bush expanded the period of observance from a week to the entire month of June. National Homeownership Month reinforces the belief that owning a home is one of the steps towards achieving the American dream.



How to Celebrate National Homeownership Month

- Showcase local projects to officials - Invite local officials, be it virtually or in person, to your area. Show them or let them know about the latest housing developments that are using eco-friendly building techniques and other new technologies.
- Educate local home buyers - Organize a housing forum (virtually or in-person) to bring together the public and housing experts to talk about the state of housing in your locality. It can be an economist from a nearby college, a mortgage banker, or a realtor.
- Get your community involved - Organize or participate in a community service project. Help build a shelter, host a donation venture, repair a playground, and carry out other similar acts that benefit your community.

5 Facts About Homeownership That You Didn't Know

- 1 - The burden of cost persists - One-third of America's 119 million households are cost-burdened, which puts more than 30% of their incomes towards housing charges and costs.
- 2 - Pay for housing - The average American family spends \$1,573.83 on housing expenses every month as stated by the 2016 Consumer Expenditure Survey.
- 3 - Equal then, more now - If the rate of black homeownership today was the same as it was in 2000, there would be 770,000 more black homeowners in America.
- 4 - More dropouts than graduates? - Homeownership in the U.S. is less for a black college graduate than for a white high school dropout.
- 5 - An average-sized move - In 2019, the average distance between the owned home and the newly purchased home of an American was 15 miles.

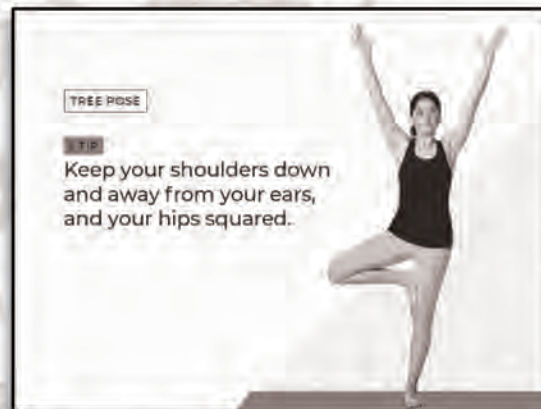

Formula 1 Returns to Monte Carlo for Racing's Most Glamorous Weekend

Formula 1 returns to the streets of Monte Carlo this weekend for the Monaco Grand Prix, one of the most famous and demanding races in motorsports. Officially known as the Formula 1 Louis Vuitton Grand Prix de Monaco 2026, the event runs June 4-7, with the main race scheduled for Sunday, June 7.

Unlike most modern racing circuits, Monaco is not built for speed in the traditional sense. The 3.337-kilometer Circuit de Monaco winds through city streets, past luxury hotels, apartment buildings, tight barriers and the famous harbor. Drivers complete 78 laps, but there is almost no room for error. A slight misjudgment that might cost a driver a few tenths of a second elsewhere can end a race instantly in Monaco.



That is what makes the event so compelling. Passing is notoriously difficult, which gives qualifying unusual importance. Saturday's session can feel almost as dramatic as race day itself, because starting position often shapes the entire outcome. A driver who puts together one perfect lap through Monte Carlo's narrow corners can give himself a major advantage before the lights even go out on Sunday.

The Monaco Grand Prix also carries a sense of history that few races can match. First held in 1929, it has become one of Formula 1's signature events, blending elite competition with the spectacle of the French Riviera. Superyachts line the harbor, balconies become grandstands, and the tight street circuit creates one of the most recognizable backdrops in all of sports.

This year's race arrives with plenty of storylines. Lando Norris is the defending Monaco winner, while Charles Leclerc returns to his home race after recently extending his future with Ferrari. Mercedes has opened the 2026 season in dominant form, and McLaren reaches a milestone weekend with its 1,000th Grand Prix start.

Fans in the United States can watch the Monaco Grand Prix on Apple TV, with race coverage beginning Sunday at 7:50 a.m. Eastern and the race scheduled for 9 a.m. Qualifying airs Saturday morning at 10 a.m., giving viewers a strong reason to tune in before race day. In Monaco, the fastest lap on Saturday can be nearly as important as the race itself.

For casual fans, Monaco is often the race that feels easiest to recognize and hardest to forget. It is less about long straights and more about precision, patience and nerve. Every lap threads past the same unforgiving walls, and every pit decision can reshape the race. In Monte Carlo, glamour may surround the circuit, but the racing itself is all discipline. That combination is what keeps the Monaco Grand Prix at the center of Formula 1's calendar year after year.

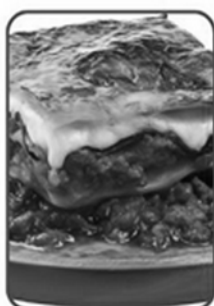
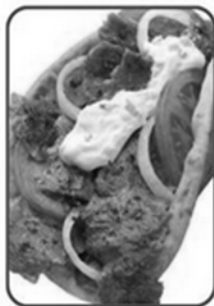

Keep Guide Dog Teams Safe!



Guide dogs work to help people who are blind safely navigate the world. It is crucial that pet owners keep their dogs at a safe distance away from a guide dog team. While it may seem harmless for pets to visit with a guide dog at work, that dog is responsible for leading someone who cannot see. Distracting the guide dog could jeopardize the safety of the handler.

Please follow these tips to help keep guide dog teams safe:

- Please do not distract guide dogs. This includes calling the dog, making eye contact, feeding or petting the dog.
- Never let your pet be near a guide dog, even if leashed.
- It is helpful to greet a person who is blind and let them know you have a dog with you.
- Always speak to the handler directly and never touch the handler or the dog without the handler's permission.



A bright wave of yellow shirts will return to the boards Saturday, June 6, as Le Tour de Downbeach brings riders together for one of the shore's favorite early-summer traditions. The family-friendly bicycle tour begins behind the Ventnor Library and rolls through Ventnor, Atlantic City, Margate and Longport, giving participants a relaxed, scenic way to celebrate the Downbeach communities from the seat of a bike.

This is not a race, and that is part of its charm. Le Tour de Downbeach is a 12-mile community ride designed for families, casual cyclists, longtime riders and anyone who wants to enjoy the ocean air, boardwalk views and hometown energy that make Absecon Island so special. The route starts in Ventnor, travels into Atlantic City with a turnaround near Showboat, then continues through Margate and Longport before finishing with a post-ride barbecue at Tomatoe's Restaurant on Amherst Avenue in Margate.

The event has grown into a signature seasonal tradition since it began as Le Tour de Ventnor in 2008. Today, it is presented through the collaboration of the Margate Business Association, Ventnor Business Association, Borough of Longport and Atlantic City, bringing together residents, visitors, local businesses and community supporters for a morning that feels both active and festive.

This year's ride will once again support a meaningful cause. A donation will be made to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital in memory of Ann Marie Wiesen, one of Le Tour's original organizers. Her connection to the event remains part of its heart, adding a deeper purpose to a day already built around community, family and summer tradition.

The first 200 riders will receive a commemorative Le Tour de Downbeach T-shirt, helping create the familiar "wave of yellow" that has become part of the event's identity. Riders also receive a happy face sticker at the start of the ride, and the day wraps up with barbecue at Tomatoe's and free water ice provided by Margate Dairy Bar & Burger.

Pre-registration is \$30 per rider, or \$25 each for groups of four or more family riders. Day-of registration is \$35 per rider, or \$30 each for groups of four or more family riders. Sponsorship opportunities are also available for businesses and community partners who want to support the event.

Le Tour de Downbeach takes place Saturday, June 6, with a rain date of Saturday, June 13. Riders should gather behind the Ventnor Library, with registration beginning in the morning before the ride. Belmont Stakes Brings Triple Crown Drama Back to Saratoga



The Belmont Stakes returns Saturday, June 6, bringing the final leg of horse racing's Triple Crown back to Saratoga Race Course for one more historic run. Traditionally held at Belmont Park on Long Island, the race is being staged at Saratoga for the third straight year while Belmont Park undergoes major renovations. This year's edition is expected to be the last at Saratoga before the race returns to its rebuilt home in 2027.

Known as the "Test of the Champion," the Belmont has long carried a reputation as the toughest and most demanding race in the Triple Crown series. Because of Saratoga's track configuration, this year's Belmont will again be run at 1¼ miles instead of the traditional 1½-mile distance, but the pressure remains the same. The race is still a Grade 1 event, still carries a \$2 million purse and still offers one of the sport's most prestigious prizes.

There will be no Triple Crown on the line this year, but there is no shortage of storylines. Kentucky Derby winner Golden Tempo enters as one of the most closely watched horses in the field after skipping the Preakness to train specifically for the Belmont. His trainer, Cherie DeVaux, already made history this spring as the first female trainer to win the Kentucky Derby and now has a chance to add another major Triple Crown victory to her résumé.



Golden Tempo will not have an easy path. Renegade, the Kentucky Derby runner-up, was named the morning-line favorite after the post-position draw and gives trainer Todd Pletcher another strong shot at a race he has already won multiple times. Chief Wallabee, trained by Hall of Famer Bill Mott, is another major contender after finishing fourth in the Derby. Mott won last year's Belmont with Sovereignty and is looking for back-to-back success.



The full Belmont field includes a mix of Derby-tested runners, fresh challengers and familiar racing names. Chad Brown brings three contenders - Emerging Market, Growth Equity and Otтинho - while Pletcher also sends Powershift. Commandment and Vitruvian Man round out a nine-horse field that gives fans plenty to watch beyond the favorites.



Five Things to Know About the Belmont Stakes

- The Belmont Stakes is actually older than both the Kentucky Derby and the Preakness. First run in 1867, it is the oldest of the three Triple Crown races.
- The first Belmont winner was a filly named Ruthless, who won the inaugural race in 1867. Only two other fillies have won since: Tanya in 1905 and Rags to Riches in 2007.
- Secretariat's 1973 Belmont remains one of the most famous performances in sports history. He won by 31 lengths and finished the traditional 1½-mile distance in 2:24, a record that still stands.
- The race is also known as the "Run for the Carnations." The winning horse is draped in a blanket made with about 700 white carnations, weighing roughly 40 pounds when finished.
- Even the trophy has a story. The August Belmont Memorial Cup was crafted by Tiffany & Co., and the silver bowl is topped by a figure of Fenian, winner of the 1869 Belmont Stakes.



Belmont Stakes Weekend & How to Watch

The Belmont Stakes is the centerpiece of the five-day Belmont Stakes Racing Festival, which runs June 3-7 at Saratoga and features major stakes races, entertainment and community events throughout the week. Belmont Stakes Day begins early, with gates opening at 9 a.m., and the main event is scheduled for a 7:04 p.m. post time. Fans can watch live on FOX or stream coverage through FOX One.

Whether the focus is history, horses, fashion or tradition, Belmont weekend remains one of the signature moments of the racing calendar. And with Saratoga hosting for what is expected to be the final time, this year's Belmont carries an added sense of occasion - one last chapter before the race heads home.
