## The Atlantic City Sports Offshore Grand Prix returns June 26–28



The thunder of offshore powerboats will once again return to the Jersey Shore as the Atlantic City Sports Offshore Grand Prix takes over the Atlantic City waterfront June 26–28, 2026. Presented by Race World Offshore, the event serves as the opening race of the 2026 APBA National Series and is part of the XINSURANCE UIM World Championship Series.

Teams from around the country will compete in multiple offshore classes, including Class 1, Class 2, Super Cat, Super Stock, and several bracket divisions. Racing takes place on an ocean course set directly offshore from Atlantic City's beaches and Boardwalk, giving spectators an opportunity to watch some of the sport's fastest boats from public viewing areas along the shoreline.

Race headquarters, dry pits, and team operations are based at the Golden Nugget Atlantic City in the Marina District, while official launching and marine operations take place from the public ramp at 400 West Shore Drive in Brigantine.



### Friday: The Race Weekend Begins

Friday serves as the official kickoff to race weekend. Teams complete registration, technical inspections, and final preparations as race boats fill the dry pits at the Golden Nugget. For spectators, this is one of the best opportunities to see the boats up close and watch crews prepare the high-performance machines before they reach the water. The dry pits remain active throughout the day as teams make final adjustments and complete inspections before competition begins.

Friday evening's Welcome Party at the Golden Nugget features tribute performances celebrating the music of Van Halen and Journey, officially launching the weekend's entertainment schedule.

### Saturday: Testing, Qualifying, and Opening Races

Saturday begins with driver meetings, physicals, and safety briefings before teams head to the race course. Official offshore testing takes place from 10 a.m. to noon, followed by qualifying sessions for Class 1, Class 2, Super Cat, and Super Stock teams.

Afternoon racing includes bracket competition, Class 1 racing, and Super Stock action as teams begin earning valuable championship points. The 2026 season also introduces an expanded Super Stock format that spreads qualifying and race activity across both days of competition, providing additional opportunities for one of offshore racing's most competitive divisions.

Following the day's racing, teams and fans gather at the Deck at the Golden Nugget for the Racer's Party featuring an AC/DC tribute concert.

### Sunday: Championship Day

Sunday features the weekend's main race program with multiple classes competing throughout the afternoon. Bracket divisions, Factory Stock, Mod V, Super V, Class 1, Super Stock, and Super Cat teams all return to the course as the opening event of the National Series concludes.

Helicopter operations, crane activity, and boat movement between the Brigantine launch area and the race course continue throughout the day, adding to the atmosphere surrounding the event.

The weekend concludes with the official awards ceremony and after-party on the Deck at the Golden Nugget, accompanied by a Led Zeppelin tribute performance.



### Where to Watch

One of the most appealing aspects of the Atlantic City Sports Offshore Grand Prix is its accessibility. Spectators can watch the races free of charge from Atlantic City's public beaches and Boardwalk, where the offshore course provides excellent views of the competition.

Many visitors begin the day at the Golden Nugget to visit the dry pits and observe the teams before heading to the beach for the afternoon races. The combination of marina activities and oceanfront viewing gives fans access to both the technical side of the sport and the excitement of the competition itself.

### More Than a Race

The Atlantic City Sports Offshore Grand Prix combines world-class offshore racing with one of the country's most recognizable waterfront destinations. The beaches, Boardwalk, Marina District, and nearby Brigantine launch site all play important roles in the weekend experience.

For fans unable to attend in person, Race World Offshore plans live coverage of qualifying sessions and race action through its official Facebook and YouTube channels.

**VENTNOR** - Lifeguards on duty from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., with surfing beaches, a fishing pier and food permitted. Beach tags are required for ages 12 and older. Seasonal tags are \$10 before June 1, senior tags are \$3.50 before June 1, and regular seasonal tags are \$20 after May 31. Tags are also accepted in Margate and may be purchased at Ventnor City Hall, from a beach tag checker, or online. Ventnor City Beach Patrol Headquarters is located at the Suffolk Avenue beach. Restrooms are located at the Ventnor Library and Cultural Arts Center on the beach side of Newport Avenue, Ventnor City Hall, the Ventnor Municipal Fishing Pier, the Ventnor Tennis Courts at Atlantic and Somerset avenues, and Cambridge Avenue and the Boardwalk. Accessible beaches are at Suffolk and Newport avenues, and the beach patrol also has accessible beach chairs available. Dogs are not allowed on the beach from May 15 through Sept. 30. ### The Seed Keeper by Diane Wilson

Set in Minnesota, *The Seed Keeper* tells the story of Rosalie Iron Wing, a Dakhota woman who returns to the place where she was taken as a child to finally face what happened to her family decades earlier. 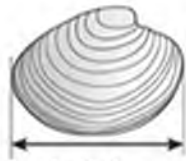

## Fishing in Atlantic County

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at [dep.nj.gov/nj-fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/](http://dep.nj.gov/nj-fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/). Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at [dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/](http://dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/).

### SALTWATER FISHING

**Atlantic City** - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



**Ventnor/Ventnor Heights** - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

**Margate** - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

**Somers Point** - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

**Brigantine** - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

**Leeds Point** - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Graveling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

**Lake Lenape Park East** - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

**Lake Lenape Park West** - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. ## YOGA POSE OF THE WEEK - Cat-Cow Stretch (Chakravakasana)

It's the best of both worlds: spinal extension followed by spinal flexion. Moving back and forth warms your back, improves body awareness, and is a basic introduction to doing a vinyasa sequence by coordinating your movements with your breath.

**Summer Corn, Tomato & Burrata Salad**

**INGREDIENTS**

- 3 ears fresh sweet corn
- 2 cups cherry tomatoes, halved
- 1 large heirloom tomato, chopped
- 8 ounces burrata cheese
- ¼ cup fresh basil leaves
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 tablespoon balsamic glaze
- Salt and freshly ground pepper
- Optional: grilled sourdough bread



**DIRECTIONS**

Bring a pot of water to a boil and cook the corn for 3 to 4 minutes. Cool slightly and cut the kernels from the cob. In a large bowl, combine the corn, tomatoes, and basil. Arrange the burrata in the center of a serving platter and spoon the vegetables around it. Drizzle with olive oil and balsamic glaze, then season with salt and pepper. Serve immediately with toasted bread for a simple summer lunch or light dinner. **Quick Tip:** Grilled corn adds a smoky flavor and makes this dish even more colorful.

**Peach Basil Lemonade**

**INGREDIENTS**

- 3 ripe peaches, sliced
- 1 cup fresh lemon juice
- ½ cup honey or simple syrup
- 8 fresh basil leaves
- 4 cups cold water
- 2 cups sparkling water
- Ice
- Peach slices and basil sprigs for garnish




**DIRECTIONS**

Blend the peaches with the lemon juice and honey until smooth. Strain if desired for a smoother drink. Add the basil leaves and gently muddle them in the pitcher. Stir in the water and chill until cold. Fill glasses with ice, pour the lemonade over the ice, and top with sparkling water. Garnish with peach slices and fresh basil. **Quick Tip:** Freeze peach slices ahead of time and use them instead of ice to keep the drink cold without diluting the flavor.

## LYME'S DISEASE IN PEOPLE AND PETS

One disease that adversely affects the joints is Lyme disease caused by ticks. (A few days ago, I pulled a tick head out of my stomach skin; I will itch for weeks.) Lyme's disease attacks both humans and dogs but it is not transmittable between species. It is transmitted from an infected black-legged tick, known also as the deer tick. Deer ticks usually affect rodents and birds, but the prey may also include white-footed mice, chipmunks, squirrels, voles, shrews and larger animals like raccoons, skunks, opossums-though how they transmit the disease varies-and white-tailed deer. A deer tick that has fed on the blood of an infected rodent or bird attaches itself to a human or dog and while they engorge on the blood of the host, its saliva enters the bloodstream. It takes about 24-48 hours for the process, so if you check your dog and yourself regularly and properly dislodge the tick just post-attachment there is less chance of infection. The only "safe" season is winter. New Jersey ranks high in Lyme's disease cases. Dogs that are companion hikers or frequent wooded areas are more susceptible. Ticks also like lawns, shrubs, long grasses, BEACH DUNES, and moist, shady areas like piles of leaves and stone walls.

90-95% of dogs may not show signs for five months after transmission, or never. A lot depends on the dog's immune system. Dogs with auto-immune diseases like Ebby and Zoey are at a higher risk. The infection left undetected or untreated can affect the joints, heart, brain and spinal cord. The most common is renal failure. Lyme disease was first identified in humans in Lyme, Connecticut, in 1975. Not until 1984 was the bacterium *Borrelia burgdorferi* officially identified as the cause in both people and pets. Because of its relatively new appearance, we, in general, were not as keen on recognizing the symptoms or understanding how to protect ourselves and our pets in the 80s. When my standard white poodle, Abby Road, was eleven and acted like her joints ached, I just assumed it was her age. And then she went into renal failure while I was away for the weekend. I got back in time to say goodbye. Losing Abby, as she went everywhere with me, including The Wagging Tail, was a heartbreak that remains to this day. Cats rarely get Lyme's and may not show any symptoms if they do. If your cat has a fever, joint pain, or loss of appetite, your vet may use antibiotics to avoid more serious complications.

The symptoms that dogs exhibit-which can be a sign of Lyme's-are numerous, including joint pain or swelling, lameness, lethargy, fever, decreased appetite, increased thirst and urination, diarrhea and vomiting. Vets today easily identify the disease. They also have prophylactic medicines such as Bravecto, NexGard and Simparica Trio. I mostly use monthly Frontline or Avontix. I also spray my yard with a pet safe flea and tick killing substance that easily attaches to the hose. It will come out as clear water when it is done. Repeat a few times during season.

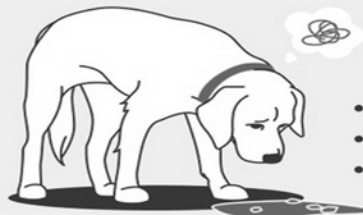

## World Cup Turns Up the Pressure as Group Stage Ends and Knockout Soccer Begins



The easy part is over. After two weeks of group-stage chaos, the 2026 FIFA World Cup is officially entering the stretch where every match starts carrying real consequences. Blowouts have faded, surprises have piled up, and by the end of this week, the tournament will begin separating genuine contenders from teams whose World Cup dream is about to end.

For fans in South Jersey, the excitement stays close to home with Philadelphia hosting one final group-stage showdown this weekend, East Rutherford preparing for knockout soccer, and Atlantic City continuing to lean fully into its role as one of the East Coast's unofficial World Cup party destinations.

### Final Group Matches Bring Last Chances

The final days of group play begin Thursday, June 25, with several teams fighting for survival. One of the biggest matches for American fans comes when the United States men's national soccer team faces Türkiye in Los Angeles. After a strong tournament start, the U.S. now has a chance to lock up its place in the knockout rounds and continue building momentum as host nation.

Closer to home, Philadelphia hosts one of the final group-stage matches on Saturday, June 27, when Croatia faces Ghana at Lincoln Financial Field. Both teams remain in the middle of a tightly contested group, making this one of the last true do-or-die games before the bracket officially begins.

Other major group-stage matches this week include Norway taking on France on Friday, Uruguay facing Spain in what could be one of the tournament's best technical matchups, and Argentina returning Saturday against Jordan as Lionel Messi looks to continue one of the strongest starts of the tournament.

### The Knockout Stage Officially Begins

Beginning Sunday, June 28, the World Cup enters the Round of 32 - and suddenly there are no second chances.

The expanded 48-team format means more nations survived the group stage than ever before, but now every mistake becomes magnified. The first knockout match begins Sunday in Los Angeles before the schedule quickly ramps up.

For local fans, one of the biggest dates to circle is Tuesday, June 30, when East Rutherford's MetLife Stadium hosts a Round of 32 matchup featuring one of the tournament group winners against a third-place qualifier. Another knockout match follows on Wednesday, July 1, continuing the region's role as one of the tournament's busiest host areas.

This is where tournaments can change instantly. A favorite dominates for two weeks, then disappears after one bad ninety minutes.

### Stars Are Delivering - But New Names Keep Emerging

The expected superstars continue making headlines.

Lionel Messi has already reminded everyone why this may be one of his final great World Cup runs, while Kylian Mbappé continues looking every bit like the tournament's most dangerous attacking player.

But one of the biggest stories of the second week has been Norway, with Erling Haaland quickly turning into one of the breakout stars after another multi-goal performance. Colombia has also quietly become one of the tournament's surprise teams, securing its knockout place earlier this week and proving this expanded format has created far more unpredictability than past World Cups.

Even tournament organizers have found themselves making headlines after new hydration breaks sparked debate among players and coaches, with FIFA defending the mandatory stoppages introduced because of extreme summer heat across several host cities.

### No Ticket? Atlantic City Still Has Plenty of Action

For Shore residents staying local, Atlantic City continues serving as one of the easiest ways to experience the World Cup atmosphere without driving to a stadium.

The Beach Soccer AC Summer Series remains active on weekends on the beach near Stockton University's Esports Innovation Center, combining youth clinics, pickup games, beach soccer exhibitions, family activities and live World Cup watch parties during tournament match windows.



The giant display of Trionda, FIFA's official 2026 match ball, remains on the Boardwalk outside Bally's Atlantic City, giving visitors one of the tournament's biggest local photo opportunities.

Several casino sportsbooks and bars continue running game-day viewing events, including Tennessee Avenue Beer Hall, Borgata Hotel Casino & Spa and Ocean Casino Resort, giving fans plenty of options to catch matches in a packed atmosphere.

### How to Watch From Home

For English-language coverage, matches continue airing on FOX and FS1, with streaming through the FOX Sports app. Spanish-language broadcasts remain available through Telemundo, Universo, and Peacock.

But beginning this weekend, the tournament changes completely.

The group stage gave fans drama. The knockout round brings something far more brutal: survive and advance, or go home.

And after three weeks of nonstop soccer, the World Cup is no longer building momentum.

It has officially become the biggest show of the summer.
