



Philadelphia Teams Show Their Range as Winter Pressure Builds

Philadelphia's sports week reflected the volatility that defines late January. The Sixers swung from statement wins to sobering losses, while the Flyers showed resilience on the road before being pulled back by a shutout at home. Even with the Eagles finished for the season, the NFL calendar remains relevant, with Super Bowl LX now set and attention turning fully toward Santa Clara.

76ers: Big highs, bruising lows, and a reminder of the ceiling

Philadelphia's strongest recent performance came last Thursday in an overtime win over Houston, powered by Tyrese Maxey's 36 points, six of them in overtime. Joel Embiid anchored the night with a triple-double - 32 points, 15 rebounds and 10 assists - as the Sixers closed out a 128-122 victory that showcased their ability to execute in pressure moments.



Two nights later, the Sixers dropped a tight 112-109 decision to the Knicks. Embiid again carried the offense with 38 points and 11 rebounds, but New York's timely shooting and a late turnover on Philadelphia's final possession sealed the outcome in a game that carried playoff intensity throughout. The swing turned sharply in Charlotte, where the Hornets took control early and never relented. Brandon Miller scored 30 points as Philadelphia fell 130-93, exposing defensive lapses and a lack of resistance once the game tilted.

The response came quickly back home against Milwaukee. The Sixers erupted for a 139-122 win behind Paul George's 32 points on nine three-pointers. Embiid added 29, Maxey chipped in 22 points and nine assists, and Philadelphia maintained offensive pressure across four quarters - a clear reminder of the team's upside when spacing and shot selection align. Philadelphia's next stretch tests consistency. The Sixers host Sacramento Thursday night and New Orleans on Saturday, then head west to face the Clippers on Monday and Golden State on Tuesday.

Flyers: A collapse, a statement, and a shutout reset

The Flyers' week opened with a difficult road loss in Utah. Philadelphia built a three-goal lead before surrendering it and falling 5-4 in overtime, with Clayton Keller scoring twice, including the winner - a game that underscored ongoing issues with closing.

The response was emphatic in Colorado. The Flyers dismantled the Avalanche 7-3 behind Owen Tippett's hat trick and two goals from Matvei Michkov, controlling the pace and dictating play in one of their most complete performances of the season. That momentum stalled at home against the Islanders. New York shut out the Flyers 4-0 behind Ilya Sorokin, while Jean-Gabriel Pageau scored twice, including a short-handed goal. Philadelphia struggled to generate clean looks, a reminder of how quickly offense can disappear when structure breaks down.



The schedule remains unforgiving. The Flyers travel to Columbus Wednesday, Boston Thursday, return home to face the Los Angeles Kings Saturday, then host Washington on Tuesday, with defensive discipline and depth scoring again central concerns.

The Super Bowl is set, and the odds have spoken

The AFC Championship was decided in survival conditions, with New England edging Denver 10-7 in the snow. Drake Maye scored the Patriots' lone touchdown on a 6-yard keeper, and New England controlled field position and tempo to close out a low-margin win.

The NFC title game delivered the opposite script. Seattle outlasted the Rams 31-27, staying aggressive throughout and sealing its Super Bowl berth in a matchup that played close to betting expectations, with the Seahawks closing as a slight favorite.

That sets the stage for Seahawks-Patriots in Super Bowl LX at Levi's Stadium in Santa Clara. Early lines favor Seattle, with bettors weighing whether New England can slow the pace or whether the Seahawks' tempo forces the Patriots into a higher-scoring game. Before kickoff on Sunday, February 8th, the league pauses for the Pro Bowl Games, highlighted by the AFC-NFC flag football matchup Tuesday night at 8 p.m.



Looking forward: What steadies, what slips

This stage of winter is less about potential and more about reliability. The Sixers must determine whether explosive performances can become routine rather than corrective. The Flyers face a similar test - whether their Colorado showing is a blueprint or an outlier. Around it all, the NFL's final march toward the Super Bowl underscores how quickly seasons narrow from possibility to outcome. The coming week will reveal which habits hold.

The activities and events that take place during this month are organized by the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (N.C.C.A).

Though the N.C.C.A was designated as the lead agency in charge of National Arts Month on January 28, 1991, it wasn't until 1992 - through the enactment of "Republic Act 7356" - that the Commission was formally established. The N.C.C.A is the government body charged with the responsibility of policymaking and implementation, grant-giving, and coordination, concerning preserving, promoting, and developing Philippine culture and arts. The official vision of the Commission is: "A Filipino people with a strong sense of nationhood and deep respect for cultural diversity."

Its key powers and functions include facilitating a network of local and regional councils for culture and the arts and coordinating all existing government cultural agencies to implement activities and programs. The body also has the power to create committees. Its core values are found in the acronym of its name: N.C.C.A stands for 'Nationalistic,' 'Committed to Service,' 'Competent,' and 'Artistic and Culture Sensitive.' Its current executive director - appointed by President Rodrigo Duterte in January 2022 - is Oscar Casaysay.

WET FOOD BETTER THAN DRY FOOD FOR YOUR CAT OR DOG?

According to the whole dog journal (which is an expert source for all things dog) wet, raw, or dehydrated food, is far better than any dry food, even the most expensive.

Many vets will push dry food as a way of maintaining good dental health. But how many dogs or cats (or humans for that matter) truly spend more than a few seconds masticating their food? Most pets usually inhale their food. Slow feeders have been invented for that reason although the Fromm company recommends adding cold water to your dog's dry food-as much as the dog can accept-to allow the food to move quickly through the gut for better gut health. Imagine yourself eating a beer pretzel without a beverage! Adding water is not possible if a dog grazes all day as you do not want the kibble to soften which will increase how slowly it makes its way through the intestinal tract. But there may be a reason your dog grazes- boredom with the food.

Some customers have been hesitant to change their dog's diet. I've had much success with dogs that have been found lost, or given up, like Zoey, or fostered-turned-rescue, Ebby. If your dog or cat gets lost, and then found by someone else, even for a short time, it will be fed whatever that person chooses. (too many pets don't carry identification, and no pet carries medical or feeding instructions.) It's truly healthier and more appealing to a cat or dog to alter or mix the proteins that they are given as long as you know that they do not have an allergy problem with a specific protein, like chicken or beef, which have been targeted for that. I am amazed how many of our reputable pet food companies carry canned foods that contain chicken or beef which leads me to believe that a majority of pets don't have problems with either. Today there are numerous other protein options that pets have not consumed that can be safely added. Kangaroo, Goat, Guinea Fowl, Venison, Pork, Rabbit, Fish, among others, can be slowly introduced, although I never slowly introduced anything. I am always trying something new on my cats and dogs and then monitor their stool, or amount of licking or scratching for indications of a problem. Feeding the same protein all the time can result in an allergy to that protein. Adding canned food, or freeze-dried food, can greatly enhance your pet's interest in eating, and overall physical health.

Unless your pet eats all of its food at feeding time, it is best not to mix wet and dry food together. I know that Ebby will eat just about anything I give to her. But Zoey is a bit more hesitant. When I add a new can to their nightly meal, I put some in a separate bowl for both so that if they do not take to it, I have not ruined the main dish of gently cooked raw sprinkled with Dr. Marty's small breed freeze dried food. Last night Zoey would not touch Evanger's chicken thighs which Ebby gobbled up. Yet Zoey has eaten it in the past. I have stopped feeding kibble, although for many who have bigger dogs, the kibble is more affordable, but still better with some canned food and cold water. Don't use warm water as it softens the kibble. As mentioned above, the Fromm family foods recommends that your dog should literally drink down its food, the quicker the better, for optimum gut health.




YOGA POSE OF THE WEEK - Seated Wide Angle Straddle (Upavistha Konasana)

Opening your legs wide creates a slightly different stretch from Paschimottanasana. To do this yoga pose: Separate your legs into a wide position. Flex both feet and engage both legs on the floor, coming into Upavistha Konasana. Forward bend to the center, extending your spine on inhale and deepening the yoga pose on exhale. Though it may look like the mandate is to bring your chest to the floor, it's not about that. Instead, keep your back flat, rotate your pelvis forward instead of crunching through your spine, and keep your feet flexed. If you do all three of these things, it doesn't matter how far forward you lean.

WIDE ANGLE STRADDLE

As you move into the forward bend, make sure to keep your knee caps pointing toward the ceiling.

To help combat food insecurity, JFS will collect canned and packaged soups for community members to enjoy during the cold winter months.

"At JFS, we are committed to meeting the needs of our community, especially by ensuring access to nutritious, hearty food," said Andrea Steinberg, JFS Chief Executive Officer. "The donated soups will make a meaningful difference for individuals and families who rely on our Margate pantry and food truck, the latter which serves residents of Atlantic City."

In 2025, JFS' pantry distributed more than 411,925 pounds of food including fresh fruits, vegetables, dairy, poultry, frozen, and non-perishable products to 13,435 adults, including 5,128 children. With the need for food and basic necessities continuing to escalate, JFS has become a 'go-to' pantry for residents.

The Souper Bowl collection encourages donors to drop-off hearty soups. Cans with pop-tops are appreciated and make for easy opening, especially for people with limited access to can openers.


