HELPING THE KIDS HEAL

There is disagreement about whether kids were emotionally damaged these past two years. If so, then how much and what does a community do about that?

An alliance has formed between Jewish Family Service (JFS) of Atlantic & Cape May Counties and the Somers Point School District to tackle the increasing mental health issues of children and preteens. They will offer weekday onsite counseling and therapy sessions for individuals and families at the Dawes Avenue and Jordan Road schools.

The unprecedented quarantines, closures and isolation stunted social interaction and personal development and often created severe anxiety, depression, peer pressure and grief among many elementary and middle school children.

JFS Senior Director of Outpatient Services Naomi Jones, Ph.D. claims JFS has counseled 224 children so far this year via confidential in-person or tele-health therapy. The JFS Resource Center at the Jordan Road School is also providing group weekday sessions from 10 a.m.-2 p.m.

The program will also offer educational and support groups, plus resources on destressing and coping skills. The American Rescue Plan Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund is underwriting the costs.

This program could be the blueprint that motivates other districts to create programs for children and families in their own schools. It would be most welcome and helpful for many parents with kids who are struggling.

Up in Galloway, Stockton University will hold a free public panel discussion on youth mental health issues from 4 p.m.-6 p.m. on Tuesday, 5/31 at the Campus Center Theatre. The William J. Hughes Center for Public Policy at Stockton, the Atlantic County Council of Education Associations and The Kennedy Forum will cosponsor the seminar, which is called "Investing in New Jersey Families: Building School and Community Youth Mental Health Services."

Hughes Center polling last month stressed the increased toll of the pandemic for New Jersey residents of all ages since 2020. All are not health-related, but also include education, employment and housing.

Panelists include an impressive group like Amy Kennedy from The Kennedy Forum, Dr. Brian Isaacson from AtlanticCare, Greater Egg Harbor School District Superintendent James Reina, Leesa Seymour from Atlantic County Youth Services Commission, Kathi Granato from Children's Inter-Agency Mental Health Council, school nurse Victoria Druding and Professor of Psychology Dr. Sara Martino from Stockton University.

A BUENO MEAL AT BUONO VITA

I may be mixing the Spanish and Italian languages, but good is good in any language.

Norman and I recently enjoyed a delicious meal at Buona Vita (<https://buonavitarestaurant.com/>) in Somers Point. The charming two-story venue, located across from the bay, looks like a small home. Inside, the lovely décor includes great artwork and furnishing.

We met friends for a weeknight dinner. I suggest you do that, especially as the summer approaches. Bay Avenue is very busy and



parking can be tough. Buona Vita has a small parking lot that is shared by a few businesses. It is empty after business hours, so parking is easier on weeknights.

The a la carte menu lists great choices, but you MUST include the calamari appetizer. We all know the small breaded rings that you typically receive, and you can still order that version. However, I recommend the grilled version with six large pieces of tender calamari that is great for sharing.

Most entrees are in the \$20s. Portions aren't huge, but more than enough to satisfy. My Chicken Marsala was delicious and everyone else really enjoyed their platters.

SHOWBOAT HOSTING 2022 BLACK EXCELLENCE FESTIVAL

In recent years, June 19 has received national attention for its historic significance. Now known as Juneteenth National Independence Day, this commemorates the emancipation of enslaved African-Americans in 1865.

Next month, Showboat Atlantic City will host the Black Excellence Festival (BE), among the largest in the U.S., from June 17-19. Brooklyn Media Publishing will sponsor the two-day event that will include informative discussions, plus educational workshops.

While this recognition originated in Galveston, Texas and has been celebrated in various parts of the U.S. ever since, President

Joe Biden signed the Juneteenth National Independence Day Act into law last June 17. It is now a federal holiday.

The weekend will feature thought-provoking, informative discussions, as well as educational workshops. Attendees will enjoy live music, vendors, food trucks, a beauty pavilion, author's pavilion and film festival.

BE will also celebrate Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU). The HBCU designation amended The Higher Education Act of 1965. It defined an HBCU as: "...any historically black college or university that was established prior to 1964, whose principal mission was, and is, the education of black Americans, and that is accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting agency or association..."

Brooklyn Media Publishing is a 100% Black-owned media, marketing and music company. This event merges the "Women of Color" and "Men of Color" expos. Organizers believe the combination will positively impact Black America by providing tools, information, and resources to navigate and address critical community issues.

Ergo, during customary gas wars from competition between local gas stations 16 9/10 cents seem to be a better deal than 17 ¢. Mrs. "Wiz" and her teenage girlfriends like Bunny N., Marie N., and Joanne K. use to pool their money to come up with fifty cents enabling them to tool around NE Philly in her father's 57' Chevy. The bottom line is that our beloved country is blessed with abundant fossil fuel which is much safer and cleaner than that being purchased from countries that hate us and our way of life. The answer is our politicians must increase supply and reduce demand. When will they ever learn?

LUCY'S LIFE PRESERVER CAMPAIGN LAUNCHES AS LUCY PREPARES TO RE-OPEN FOR TOURS AFTER NINE

Lucy the Elephant, America's Oldest Roadside Attraction, has been closed and hidden behind containment scaffolding since September 2021 when work began. Over the course of several months, scaffolding was erected around Lucy. Next, her rusted metal skin was removed, and any rotted wood sheathing was repaired or replaced. As this work progressed, a waterproofing layer was added; and finally, her new metal skin was attached. The new metal is an alloy called Monel 400 which is made of primarily nickel and copper. The last step will be to paint Lucy with a three-layer coating of Acrymax and at 141 years old, the elephant will look brand new! "This has been an enormous financial undertaking" said Richard Helfant, Executive Director of the Save Lucy Committee. "We are so fortunate to have been awarded a grant from the Preserve NJ Preservation Fund administered by the New Jersey Historic Trust and the Save America's Treasures Grant program administered by the National Park Service. Originally estimated at \$1.4 million; costs have skyrocketed to more than \$2 million."

The "Lucy's Life Preserver" campaign is seeking out 800 people to donate \$1000; similar to what was done back in 1970 when Lucy was minutes away from the wrecking ball. "Back in 1970, Ed & Sylvia Carpenter, along with Josephine Harron and their brand-new Save Lucy Committee, convinced 62 people to donate \$1000; the funding necessary to move Lucy from Cedar Grove Avenue to her new home on Decatur Ave; now proudly known as 1 Lucy Plaza. "The people in our community are very generous and we feel confident there are enough who will want to come to Lucy's aid at this critical time in her storied life". Donors who pledge \$1000 or more will have their name inscribed on a permanent bronze plaque that will be displayed at Lucy, receive a gold plated "Lucy's Life Preserver" commemorative pin, and will receive life membership into the "Friends of Lucy", Helfant went on to say. "We realize not everyone will be able to contribute \$1000. We deeply appreciate every donation, no matter the amount. Lucy stands today as a National Historic Landmark, because of the nickels, dimes, and dollars that have been donated over the years". All donations to Lucy are tax deductible.

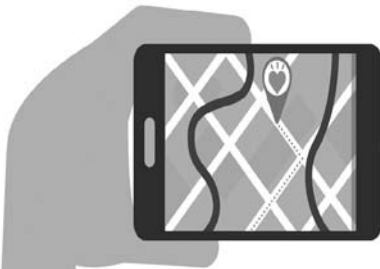

**CHEF CHIP'S WILD GAME
AND SEAFOOD RECIPE
BISON BURGERS W/ CRAB**

INGREDIENTS:

- 16 oz Ground Bison
- 2 Tbs Worcestershire Sauce
- 2 oz Boursin Cheese
- 1 Tsp Whole Grain Mustard
- 4 oz Lump Crab Meat
- 2 Tbs Ketchup
- 1/4 Tsp Balsamic Vinegar
- 1 Tsp Sriracha Sauce
- Kosher Salt & Fresh Cracked Black Pepper to Taste
- 4 (1/4 in) Slices Jersey Tomatoes
- 2 Brioche Burger Buns
- 1 Handful Arugala



PREPARATION:

Preheat grill to medium high heat. In a bowl, mix ground Bison, Worcestershire sauce, salt & pepper. Form 2 thin 8oz patties. Next, make the ketchup. In a small bowl, whisk ketchup, vinegar, sriracha sauce, salt & pepper. Grill your patties to desired doneness. Place burgers on a plate & allow to rest while assembling components. Toast the insides of the brioche buns on the grill. Divide ketchup evenly on the bottom of the buns. Place burgers on the bottom buns w/ ketchup. Divide crab meat evenly on top of each burger. Next lay 2 slices of tomato on top of each crab topper. In a small bowl, mix Boursin cheese & mustard together. Now, smear the mixture on the inside top part of each bun. Divide arugala evenly & press onto Boursin cheese mixture. Place the top of bun on the bottom half of burger. Serve w/ fried pickles or pickles & chips. Enjoy!
Hint: You can make great sliders w/ these. Just divide everything in smaller portions & get smaller buns. Hawaiian rolls work great for these too.

On a recent date at Hard Rock Hotel and Casino in Atlantic City, Southside and the band played to an energetic crowd full of fans that wanted to sing and dance along to some of the band's most loved music. Their blues infused stylings of rock and roll with rhythm and blues influences make for a diverse live show. From the opening note through the playful banter with both the audience and the band members, Southside Johnny held court in the venue he has worked in for over fifty years. As a performer, Southside Johnny has developed the perfect balance of stage presence and audience connection. Sprinkling in glimpses into his lifetime love of music and what has seemed to be an endless tour throughout his entire career.

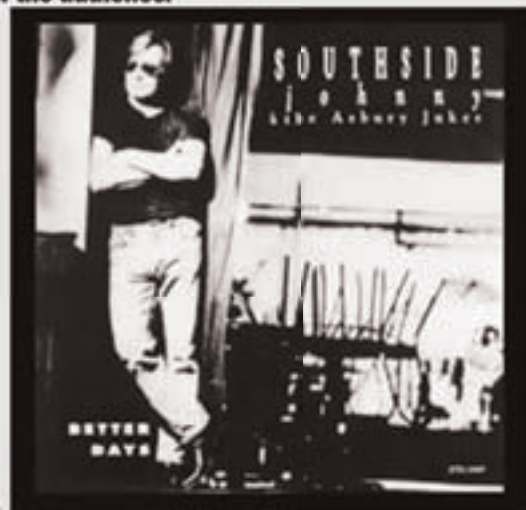


The songs the band has created, cover and choose to play are always well received. Whether playing a Bruce Springsteen or Little Steven cover, paying homage to the music he grew up with or playing one of the songs he has penned either solo or with writing partners, Southside is authentic in his approach to music. Show staples like "The Fever", "I Don't Want to Go Home", and "Walk Away Renee" are still performed in a way that draws attention to the strength and of the band. The song "Trapped Again" co-written by Southside, Springsteen and Van Sant is a true testament to the power of working and writing with people that experienced a similar growth and development as artists coming up when they did on the Jersey Shore in the 1970's. Along with the music, there are always a historic music nugget shared. The fact that Southside was a part of a very interesting area and region of music history is a big part of his backstory. In interviews, Southside has said that he knows fans are looking to hear certain songs that will get the crowd singing and dancing. One of the keys to having success and longevity in touring is surrounding himself with solid musicians and also reading an audience and creating set lists and/or modifying set lists to meet the moment.

Of course, it would not be a Southside Johnny & the Asbury Jukes show without a big closing sing along song. The band's cover of the Sam Cooke classic "We're Having a Party" is always a crowd pleasing fan favorite that goes on and on with the band having a good time along with the audience.

The songAfter seeing Southside Johnny dozens of times at multiple venues during the past 25 years, one thing remains clear Southside Johnny is a true music man that seems to appreciate every opportunity that has come his way.

That of course comes through in every not the band plays and that Southside Johnny sings. After all these years, it is still a "party" I want to attend.

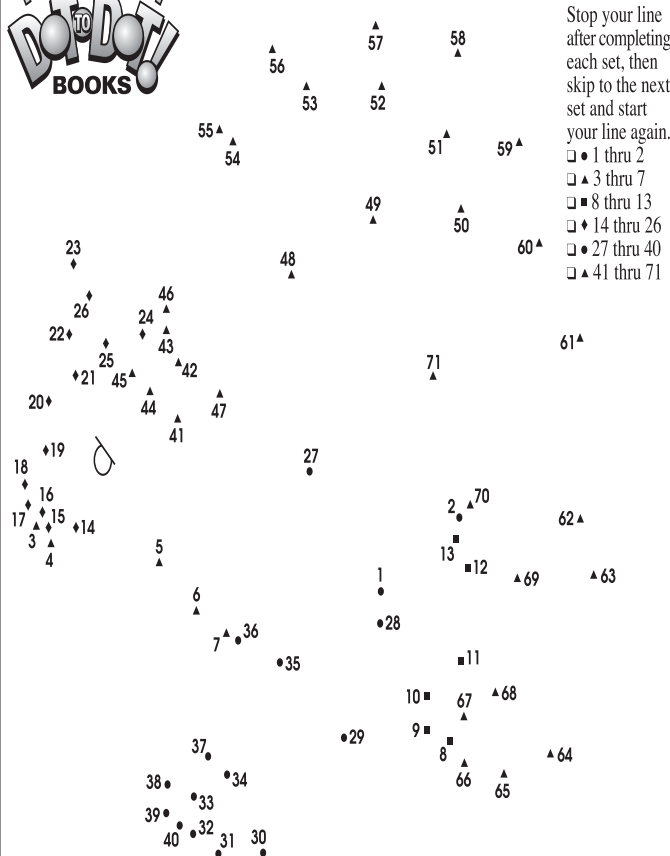

Statewide Digital Literacy Certification Program for Adult Residents

The New Jersey State Library announced that the Atlantic City Free Public Library has been selected to participate in its Hub & Spoke Libraries pilot project, a statewide effort that will provide uniform digital literacy training and credentialing for adult residents at 14 public libraries across the state. Through a competitive grant process, the State Library selected three hub libraries that will serve as regionally-based training labs, and 11 spoke libraries that will provide additional digital literacy support. The Atlantic City Free Public Library will participate in the program as a hub library. The Atlantic City Free Public Library will connect with its local Workforce Development Board and One-Stop Career Center, as well as other libraries in the area, to create a referral and sending system that accounts for client intake, record keeping and data sharing. Participants will have access to free, high quality training materials, videos, classroom aides, and mini lessons. "This project has allowed the library to expand its services by constructing a second computer lab with 16 computers," Atlantic City Library Director Robert Rynkiewicz said. 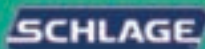

Bernie Friedenberg World War II Memorial



Who Was Bernie Friedenberg?

Bernard I. "Bernie" Friedenberg grew up in Atlantic City and attended area schools. He was a freshman at Temple University on December 7, 1941, when the U.S. Naval Base at Pearl Harbor was attacked, drawing the United States into World War II. The very next day, Friedenberg attempted to enlist in the military services (Marines, Navy, and Army) but was rejected by all three services due to poor vision. Undeterred, he persisted and was eventually inducted into the Army as a non-combatant. Friedenberg received training as a medic, attained the rank of Staff Sergeant, and was assigned to the Medical Detachment, 1st Battalion, 16th Regiment, 1st U.S. Infantry Division.

Friedenberg was deployed in many of the major battles of the War: Operation Torch in Algeria in November 1942; as a member of the "Fighting First" in the campaign for Sicily in 1943; Omaha Beach on D-Day 1944; through the fields and hedgerows of France into Germany in 1944, and the Battle of the Bulge in December 1944. In these and other battles, it was Friedenberg's job to remove or supervise the removal of wounded soldiers from the front lines to secure aid stations where he and others would render initial medical care to them.

Friedenberg received a Silver Star for his heroism on Omaha Beach on D-Day. Passing a minefield, Friedenberg heard moans and observed wounded soldiers lying there. Using his trench knife to probe for mines, Friedenberg crawled into the minefield and pulled five soldiers out, one at a time. Friedenberg narrowly escaped death after a mine exploded killing a sixth soldier, whom Friedenberg was attempting to save.

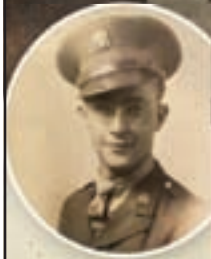
Friedenberg received a second Silver Star for his heroism in evacuating and rendering first aid to wounded soldiers while under heavy machine gun and mortar fire in Munsterbusch, Germany. Friedenberg was also awarded two Bronze Stars for valor, and two Purple Hearts for wounds sustained in combat.

Upon returning home to Atlantic City after the war, Friedenberg became a staunch advocate for veterans' affairs. Friedenberg served for many years as a member of the Atlantic County Veterans Advisory Board, and as the Commander of a Jewish War Veterans Post. Friedenberg authored a book, "Of Being Numerous: World War II as I Saw It," in which he wrote about the misery, horror, and suffering he had witnessed. Friedenberg regularly spoke at high schools and colleges in southern New Jersey on the perils of war and the true cost of freedom up until his death in 2018. Many donors have made donations to the Friedenberg WWII Memorial recounting the tremendous impact that Friedenberg's talks had on their children's lives.

Friedenberg raised significant funds for veterans' causes, and the Vinland, NJ Veterans Home (VVH) was one of the chief recipients of Friedenberg's benevolence. Friedenberg and his family, over many years, provided the VVH with numerous items that improved the quality of life of veterans residing there. These items included electric shavers for Parkinson's patients, robes for residents, and furnishings for the VVH TV Room.

ABOUT THE MEMORIAL

The Bernie Friedenberg World War II Memorial is being erected to remember and honor the sacrifices of U.S. Army Staff Sergeant Bernard (Bernie) I. Friedenberg and all other Americans who served their country during World War II.



Where and When

The Bernie Friedenberg World War II Memorial will be erected at Captain O'Donnell Park in Atlantic City, NJ, close to the World War I Memorial and Stockton University on Albany Avenue. The memorial will be unveiled and dedicated on D-Day, June 6, 2023.

HOT WEATHER SAFETY FOR PETS

We all love spending the long, sunny days of summer outdoors with our furry companions, but being overeager in hot weather can spell danger. To prevent your pet from overheating, take these simple precautions provided by ASPCA experts:

- Visit the vet for a summer checkup. Make sure your pets get tested for heartworm if they aren't on year-round preventative medication.

- Pets can get dehydrated quickly, so give them plenty of fresh, clean water when it's hot or humid outdoors. Make sure your pets have a shady place to get out of the sun, be careful not to over-exercise them, and keep them indoors when it's extremely hot.

- Know the symptoms of overheating in pets, which include excessive panting or difficulty breathing, increased heart and respiratory rate, drooling, mild weakness, stupor or even collapse. Symptoms can also include seizures, bloody diarrhea and vomit along with an elevated body temperature of over 104 degrees.

- Animals with flat faces, like Pugs and Persian cats, are more susceptible to heat stroke since they cannot pant as effectively. These pets, along with the elderly, the overweight, and those with heart or lung diseases, should be kept cool in air-conditioned rooms as much as possible.

- Never leave your animals alone in a parked vehicle. Not only can it lead to fatal heat stroke, it is illegal in several states!

- Do not leave pets unsupervised around a pool—not all dogs are good swimmers. Introduce your pets to water gradually and make sure they wear flotation devices when on boats. Rinse your dog off after swimming to remove chlorine or salt from his fur, and try to keep your dog from drinking pool water, which contains chlorine and other chemicals.

- Open unscreened windows pose a real danger to pets, who often fall out of them. Keep all unscreened windows or doors in your home closed, and make sure adjustable screens are tightly secured.

- Feel free to trim longer hair on your dog, but never shave your dog: The layers of dogs' coats protect them from overheating and sunburn. Brushing cats more often than usual can prevent problems caused by excessive heat. And be sure that any sunscreen or insect repellent product you use on your pets is labeled specifically for use on animals.

- When the temperature is very high, don't let your dog linger on hot asphalt. Being so close to the ground, your pooch's body can heat up quickly, and sensitive paw pads can burn. Keep walks during these times to a minimum.

- Commonly used rodenticides and lawn and garden insecticides can be harmful to cats and dogs if ingested, so keep them out of reach. Keep citronella candles, tiki torch products and insect coils out of pets' reach as well.

- Remember that food and drink commonly found at barbecues can be poisonous to pets. Keep alcoholic beverages away from pets, as they can cause intoxication, depression and comas. Avoid raisins, grapes, onions, chocolate and products with the sweetener xylitol.

By following safety guidelines, you and your pet are sure to enjoy these dog days of summer!

WHY DO WE FIND ROSEMARY EXTRACT IN PET FOODS AND TREATS?

I certainly learned a lot about Rosemary in researching this article. I got so excited that I am purchasing a plant, and I updated my jar of Rosemary leaves which had been neglected in my spice drawer for years. Rosemary is an aromatic Mediterranean evergreen plant, used in culinary seasoning, herbal teas, essential oils, fragrances and for health care. IT IS NOT TOXIC TO CATS OR DOGS, although it is possible for a pet to have an adverse reaction to the herb (symptoms listed later.) Rosemary has been used throughout history as a medicinal aid for brain function, joint inflammation and to relieve stress. Rosemary does have antimicrobial properties, which means that it kills microorganisms or stops their production, and it is used as a natural preservative in pet food. Rosemary also functions as an antioxidant (especially the rosmanol) helping to eliminate the free radicals in a pet's body that can cause long-term harm as in cancer. In short, rosemary's antibacterial, antifungal and antiseptic qualities help to "combat infections, decrease inflammation and swelling, promote digestion and preserve and enhance vision." Rosemary is high in vitamin A and C, magnesium, calcium, folate (folic acid-vitamin B9) and iron. Rosemary can act as a bug deterrent (it contains camphor) and can be diluted in oil form and used as a spray outdoors. Always be careful when using rosemary extract on a pet's skin, a cat's skin is particularly very thin, so it must be diluted and applied sparingly and with due diligence. You can research how to make a safe tincture. Pets can nibble on a live plant (it is not likely that they would ingest too much) or you can sprinkle some on their food at mealtime. It is rare that a pet would be allergic but do look for the following possible signs and consult with your veterinarian.

SYMPTOMS IN DOGS

*Itchy skin *Dry, flaky skin *Hair loss *Lethargy *Bumps/tash *Chronic *Labored breathing *Swelling *Obsessive licking/chewing of feet *Inflamed, red paw pads *Gastrointestinal upsets

SYMPTOMS IN CATS

*Drooling *Trouble walking *Puking ear infections *Gastrointestinal upsets *Seizures

Rosemary can cause cats to seem "high" because of the nepetalactone in the rosemary's flowers and leaves. They may appear more playful and energetic, before dozing off. But if your pet displays any of the symptoms of an allergic reaction, and the above do occur with other allergens, you can try removing the rosemary or eliminating diets that have a trace amount in them, usually the last item in the ingredient panel. As in most possible allergens, Rosemary is harmless, but the pet's body does not recognize it as such and will set up "an unneeded immune response against the rosemary ingredient." It could be a quick response, or it may take years to develop. Not all vets use the Biocom testing to determine allergies, but this tests your pet's blood's reaction to different possible allergens. If the response is positive, your pet's blood wavelength will show stress, i.e., an incompatibility to that item. Since there are so many possible allergens, I have been getting Ebby and Zoey the once-a-month Cytopoint injection. After the initial exam and injection, you only pay for the monthly shot which can be given by a vet tech.

(NewsUSA) - Memorial Day is approaching, and with it comes a simple opportunity for everyone to honor past military personnel – wear or display a poppy. The simple red poppy flower has symbolized the ultimate military sacrifice since World War I, and National Poppy Day is gaining more attention in the United States every year. National Poppy Day falls on the Friday before Memorial Day, which this year is May 27.


The choice of a poppy was inspired by the poem, "In Flanders Fields," written by Canadian Lt. Col. John McCrae, M.D., while serving on the front lines in World War I in Europe. Since then, the poppy has become a symbol to raise awareness and recognize the sacrifices of military personnel and their families.

The American Legion Auxiliary (ALA), a community of volunteers serving veterans, military, and their families, adopted the poppy as its memorial flower in 1921, and, in 1924, in conjunction with The American Legion, instituted the national Poppy Program. Each year, American Legion Auxiliary volunteers distribute millions of poppies, especially on veteran-related holidays.

"National Poppy Day is a time for Americans to come together and show their support for our servicemembers and veterans by wearing a red poppy – an unforgettable and historic symbol of remembrance, sacrifice, and hope," says Kathy Daudistel, ALA national president. "The American Legion Auxiliary is proud to make and distribute poppies each year for this solemn tradition. I invite communities across the country to join the American Legion Auxiliary to honor

the fallen and support the living by wearing a red poppy on May 27.

"Everyone can participate in National Poppy Day to honor the fallen and support the living. Wear a poppy or a poppy-themed item, such as a pin, T-shirt, bracelet, or even a poppy sticker, and tell people what it means. Share poppies with friends, family, and colleagues. Accept a poppy if you see American Legion Auxiliary members distributing the special flower. Poppies are never "sold," but donations are encouraged. All donations received are used by the American Legion Auxiliary to support veterans, active-duty military personnel, and their families with medical and financial needs. Storied Clubs Face-Off in Champions League Final: Odds on the Move

(NewsUSA) - The most-anticipated match of the club soccer season approaches, as Liverpool takes on Real Madrid in the Champions League Final, May 28th at the Stade de France. Combined, these two have won the Champions League an astounding 19 times. Liverpool currently sit as -170 favorites to hoist the trophy, while Real Madrid offer Champions League odds of +140.

Money Moving In on Madrid La Liga champions Real Madrid proved themselves as the comeback kings of the Champions League this season. They stunningly overturned a last-minute, two-goal deficit in the second leg of the semifinal vs. Manchester City. In one of the most enthralling matches in the tournament's history, striker Karim Benzema scored the winning penalty to clinch Real's first UCL final since 2018. Now, the 90-minute odds are gradually moving in Real Madrid's favor - opening at +275. Real dropped in price to +250. (Another extra-time thriller is viewed as slightly less likely at +270.) Los Blancos have one of the winningest managers in Champions League history, Carlo Ancelotti. His side have been on cruise control since clinching La Liga with four games to spare. Currently, Madrid's entire starting eleven is available for selection.

Fatigue, Injuries Cause Line Movements Liverpool opened at -105, but have been expending energy in search of an unprecedented quadruple trophy haul. Liverpool's boisterous German manager, Jürgen Klopp, has constantly rotated his squad while juggling multiple concurrent competitions. On the other hand, Madrid should have fresh legs, and analysts at the sports-betting

website PointSpreads.com suggest that is why money backing Madrid has flooded in, moving Liverpool down to their current +105 winning odds. Liverpool won the FA Cup final last weekend - a penalty shootout victory over Chelsea - but their second trophy of the season came with a cost. Leading scorer Mohamed Salah and key center back Virgil van Dijk left early with injuries.

Ballon d'Or Contenders on Both Sides Real Madrid's Benzema, the imminent La Liga golden boot winner, will undoubtedly be on the shortlist for the prestigious Ballon d'Or. Liverpool's Salah and Sadio Mane have also played themselves into the conversation and Salah is the Premier League's joint-leading scorer. With no shortage of world class talent on display, bettors responded by taking the over. Despite over 27 goals sitting at -135 odds, the last three Champions League finals finished with two or fewer goals.

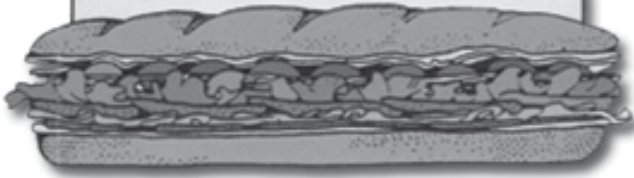

MEMORIAL DAY

Memorial Day is an American holiday, observed on the last Monday of May, honoring the men and women who died while serving in the U.S. military. Memorial Day 2022 occurs on Monday, May 30.

Originally known as Decoration Day, it originated in the years following the Civil War and became an official federal holiday in 1971. Many Americans observe Memorial Day by visiting cemeteries or memorials, holding family gatherings and participating in parades. Unofficially, it marks the beginning of the summer season.

Early Observances of Memorial Day

The Civil War, which ended in the spring of 1865, claimed more lives than any conflict in U.S. history and required the establishment of the country's first national cemeteries.

By the late 1860s, Americans in various towns and cities had begun holding springtime tributes to these countless fallen soldiers, decorating their graves with flowers and reciting prayers.

Did you know? Each year on Memorial Day a national moment of remembrance takes place at 3:00 p.m. local time.

It is unclear where exactly this tradition originated; numerous different communities may have independently initiated the memorial gatherings. And some records show that one of the earliest Memorial Day commemorations was organized by a group of freed slaves in Charleston, South Carolina less than a month after the Confederacy surrendered in 1865. Nevertheless, in 1966 the federal government declared Waterloo, New York, the official birthplace of Memorial Day.

History of Memorial Day

Memorial Day, as Decoration Day gradually came to be known, originally honored only those lost while fighting in the Civil War. But during World War I the United States found itself embroiled in another major conflict, and the holiday evolved to commemorate American military personnel who died in all wars, including World War II, The Vietnam War, The Korean War and the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan.

For decades, Memorial Day continued to be observed on May 30, the date Logan had selected for the first Decoration Day. But in 1968 Congress passed the Uniform Monday Holiday Act, which established Memorial Day as the last Monday in May in order to create a three-day weekend for federal employees; the change went into effect in 1971. The same law also declared Memorial Day a federal holiday.

Memorial Day Traditions

Cities and towns across the United States host Memorial Day parades each year, often incorporating military personnel and members of veterans' organizations. Some of the largest parades take place in Chicago, New York and Washington, D.C.

Americans also observe Memorial Day by visiting cemeteries and memorials. Some people wear a red poppy in remembrance of those fallen in war—a tradition that began with a World War I poem. On a less somber note, many people take weekend trips or throw parties and barbecues on the holiday, perhaps because Memorial Day weekend—the long weekend comprising the Saturday and Sunday before Memorial Day and Memorial Day itself—unofficially marks the beginning of summer.
