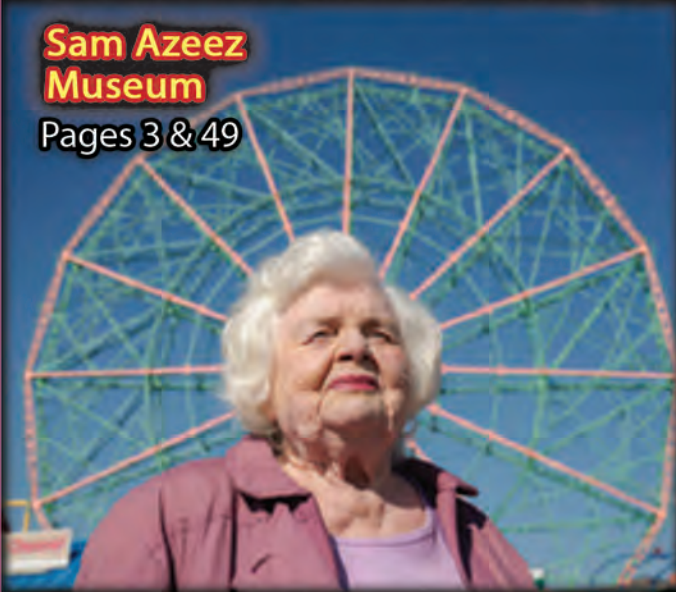

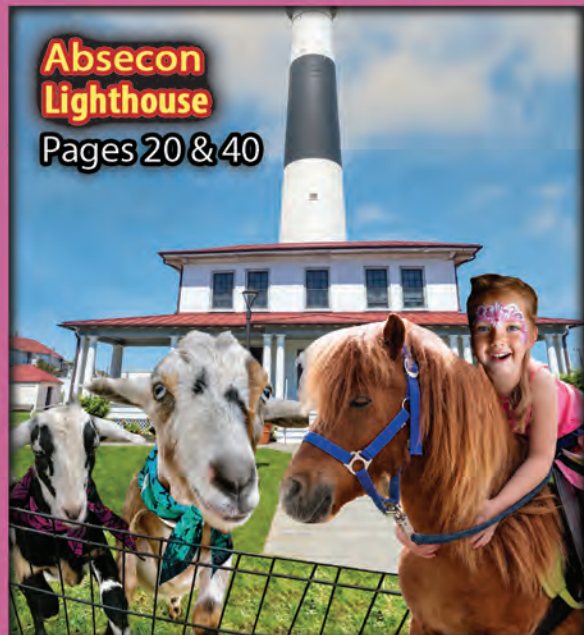

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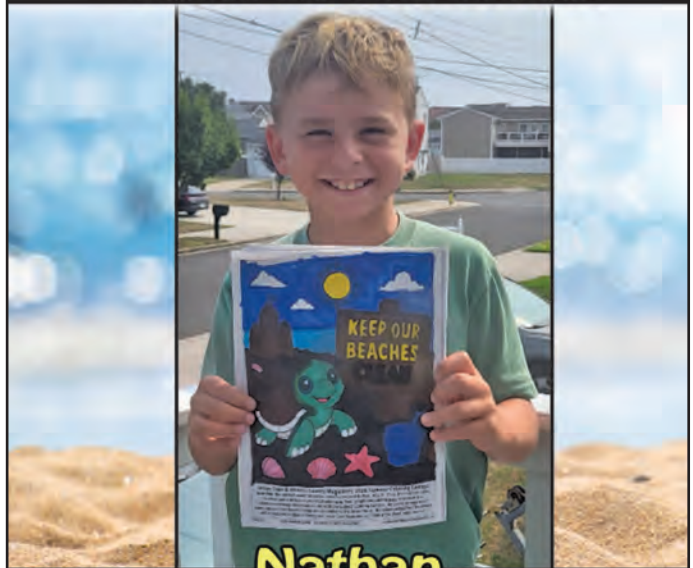

ATLANTIC CITY - Lifeguards on duty, showers, changing rooms, food permitted, free admission. Visit atlanticcitybeachpatrol.org



BRIGANTINE - Brigantine Beach offers lifeguards on duty, surfing beaches, showers, changing rooms and food permitted. Seasonal tags are \$20 through May 31 and \$25 during regular season. Daily tags are \$10 and weekly tags are \$15. Seniors 65 and older receive a free tag with identification, and there is also a preseason senior rate of \$10 for ages 60 to 64. Active military members receive free tags, with up to four free per family, and veterans receive a free tag for themselves. Visit brigantinebeach.org

EGG HARBOR CITY - Lake Park, 2300 Philadelphia Ave. Lifeguards and restrooms are available. Pre-season seasonal badges are \$15 for ages 5 and up through May 22. Senior citizens age 65 and older and active-duty military badges are \$5 with identification, and that rate remains in effect all season. Pre-season badges are sold at the Tax Office at City Hall, 500 London Ave., Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Cash only. The lake opens Saturday, May 23. Visit eggharborcity.org

HAMILTON TOWNSHIP - Cove Beach at Lake Lenape. Lifeguards on duty, open Thursday through Monday from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. from June 20 through Sept. 7. Daily wristbands are \$10 on weekdays and \$15 on weekends and holidays. Season tags are \$30 if purchased on or after May 1, and a Family Four Pack is \$100. Children 11 and younger are free. For information and reservations, call (609) 625-2700 ext. 592 or visit hamiltonatnj.gov.



MARGATE - Lifeguards on duty from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., with restrooms, surfing beaches and food permitted. Beach tags are accepted in Ventnor. Preseason regular badges are \$10, senior badges are \$3.50, and holiday tags are \$12, with regular badges \$20 starting June 1. Free seasonal tags are available to veterans and active military members with proper identification, and active military members may also receive one free spouse tag. Badges are sold at the Martin Bloom Pavilion at Granville Avenue and the beach, and MyBeach Mobile is also available for digital or physical tag purchases. Visit margate-nj.com

LONGPORT - Lifeguards on duty from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., with surfing beaches, showers and food permitted. Beach badges are required for ages 12 and older. Preseason seasonal tags are \$25 through June 1 and \$40 after June 1. Preseason senior tags are \$15 and \$20 after June 1. Beach badges are available at Longport Borough Hall, 2305 Atlantic Ave. For more information, call (609) 823-2731 ext. 100 or visit longportnj.gov

SOMERS POINT - William Morrow Beach, at Higbee and Bay avenues, offers a free beach experience overlooking the bay and across to Ocean City. Lifeguards are on duty. William Morrow Beach also hosts a free summer concert series. Bring your chairs and coolers, and check the current schedule at somerspointbeachconcerts.com. For more information, call (609) 927-9088 or visit somerspointgov.org.



VENTNOR - Lifeguards on duty from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., with surfing beaches, a fishing pier and food permitted. Beach tags are required for ages 12 and older. Seasonal tags are \$10 before June 1, senior tags are \$3.50 before June 1, and regular seasonal tags are \$20 after May 31. Tags are also accepted in Margate and may be purchased at Ventnor City Hall, from a beach tag checker, or online. Ventnor City Beach Patrol Headquarters is located at the Suffolk Avenue beach. Restrooms are located at the Ventnor Library and Cultural Arts Center on the beach side of Newport Avenue, Ventnor City Hall, the Ventnor Municipal Fishing Pier, the Ventnor Tennis Courts at Atlantic and Somerset avenues, and Cambridge Avenue and the Boardwalk. Accessible beaches are at Suffolk and Newport avenues, and the beach patrol also has accessible beach chairs available. Dogs are not allowed on the beach from May 15 through Sept. 30. From Oct. 1 to May 15, leashed dogs may be walked in areas washed by the high tide line. Visit ventnorchity.org



MALIBU BEACH WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREA - Malibu Beach is a free dog-friendly beach located on the Egg Harbor Township end of the Ocean City-Longport Bridge. Open daily from 5am-9pm. Dogs are welcomed year-round. Dogs must be kept on leash. Respect all posted areas in beach nesting season, April through October. Parking is available right next to the beach. Only requirement is to clean up after your pup. No permits required, you can enjoy your favorite beach activities while your dog socializes with other dogs.





National Lighthouse Day shines a light on these iconic structures every August 7. From their vital role in maritime safety to their enduring beauty, lighthouses have captivated hearts for centuries. Visit a local lighthouse, learn about its history, or support preservation efforts to keep their stories alive.

NATIONAL LIGHTHOUSE DAY HERO - GEORGE WASHINGTON

As the first President of the United States, George Washington signed the Lighthouse Act of 1789, which brought all existing lighthouses under federal control and established the U.S. Lighthouse Establishment. This act marked a pivotal moment in the nation's commitment to maritime safety and the development of its coastal infrastructure, ensuring the continued operation and maintenance of these vital navigational aids.

HOW TO CELEBRATE NATIONAL LIGHTHOUSE DAY

- Visit your local lighthouse - National Lighthouse Day calls for lighthouses, when possible, to be open to the public. If you're within driving distance to a coast, today's the day to make a trip to one of these beautiful structures.
- Help preserve a lighthouse - The American Lighthouse Organization is dedicated to preserving and protecting these historic structures. If you visit a lighthouse, consider making a small donation to its operating organization in order to continue providing public access.
- Paint a lighthouse - Lighthouses are beautiful and they make for great artwork. Paint or photograph a lighthouse and give your pic to that relative who has a collection of lighthouse postcards.

WHY WE LOVE NATIONAL LIGHTHOUSE DAY

- They've been a beacon of light even before electricity - Originally, burning coal or even fires were used as the "lamp" or the source of light in a lighthouse. Lighthouses later made use of oil-burning lamps and finally, electric lamps in 1875.
- The structures continue to stand the test of time - Located on coasts and cliffs, lighthouses are subject to storms, high winds and other extreme conditions. Yet, many remain viable and strong, even today. America's oldest operational lighthouse is the Boston Lighthouse on Little Brewster Island in Boston Harbor, MA built in 1716.
- Lighthouses are beautiful - The cylindrical shape, coupled with the scenery of the surrounding coast or bay, makes lighthouses a popular photographic destination. It's no surprise - there's a quiet comfort in seeing a lighthouse standing tall on the edge of the ocean.

A BEACON OF HISTORY IN ATLANTIC COUNTY

The festival is a wonderful opportunity to combine a little history with a lot of fun. Whether you're visiting for the first time or have climbed the lighthouse before, National Lighthouse Day offers a chance to experience this Atlantic County landmark in a whole new way.

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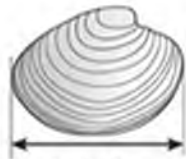

Fishing in Atlantic County

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at dep.nj.gov/njfw/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/. Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/.

SALTWATER FISHING

Atlantic City - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



Ventnor/Ventnor Heights - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

Somers Point - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

Brigantine - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Graveling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

FRESHWATER FISHING

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). 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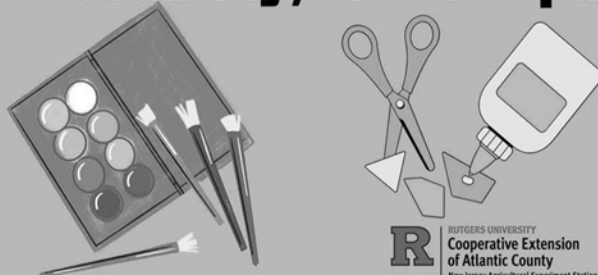

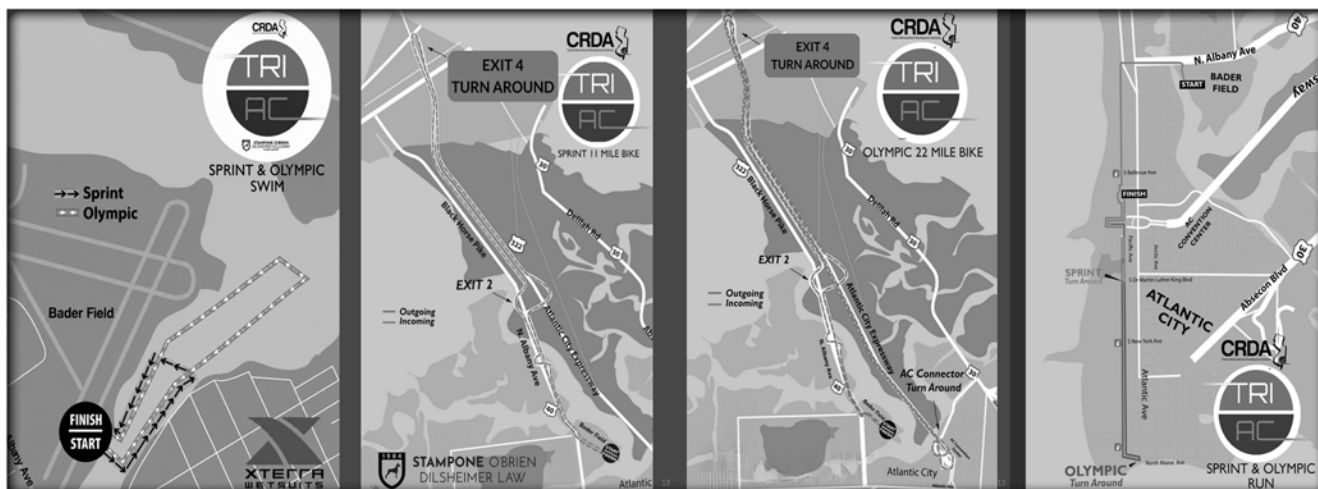

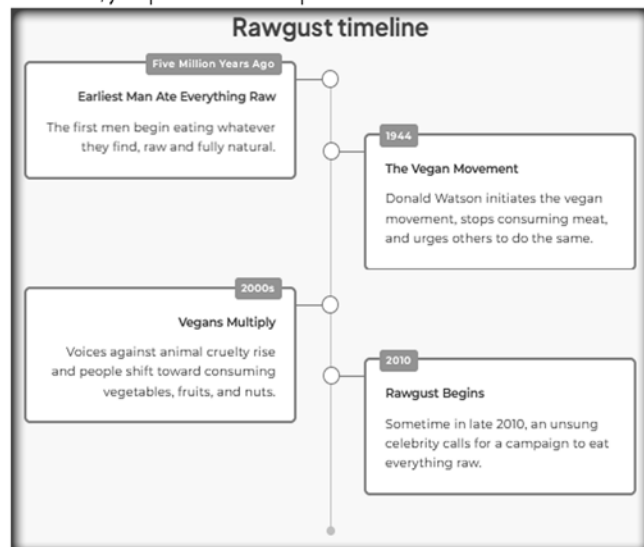
History of Rawgust

Rainbow Garden Gazpacho

INGREDIENTS

- 5 ripe Jersey tomatoes, *chopped*
- 1 cucumber, *peeled and chopped*
- 1 red bell pepper, *chopped*
- ½ green bell pepper, *chopped*
- ¼ red onion, *chopped*
- 2 cloves garlic
- 2 tablespoons red wine vinegar
- 3 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil
- 1 teaspoon sea salt
- ½ teaspoon black pepper
- ¼ cup fresh basil leaves
- *Optional: diced avocado, chopped cucumber, croutons, or fresh herbs for garnish*



DIRECTIONS

Reserve about ½ cup each of the chopped cucumber, pepper, and tomato for garnish. Add the remaining vegetables, garlic, basil, vinegar, olive oil, salt, and pepper to a blender. Blend until smooth or leave slightly chunky, depending on your preference. Refrigerate for at least 2 hours before serving. Top with the reserved vegetables and a drizzle of olive oil. Makes 4-6 servings.

INGREDIENTS

- 4 cups seedless watermelon cubes
- Juice of 1 lime
- 8-10 fresh mint leaves
- 1 tablespoon honey *(optional)*
- Sparkling water
- Ice



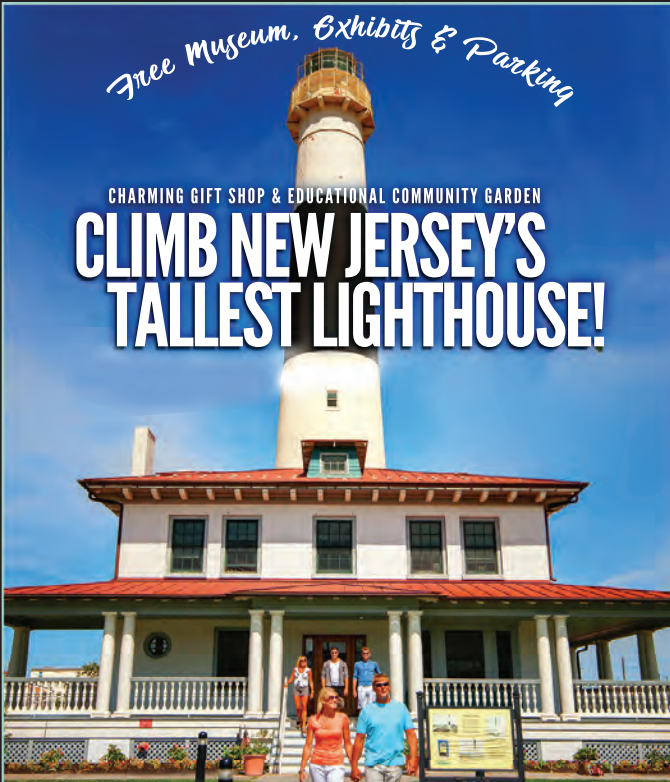
DIRECTIONS

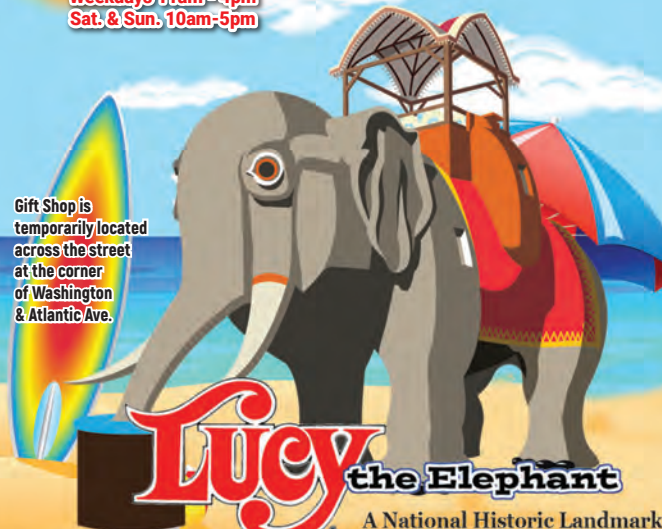

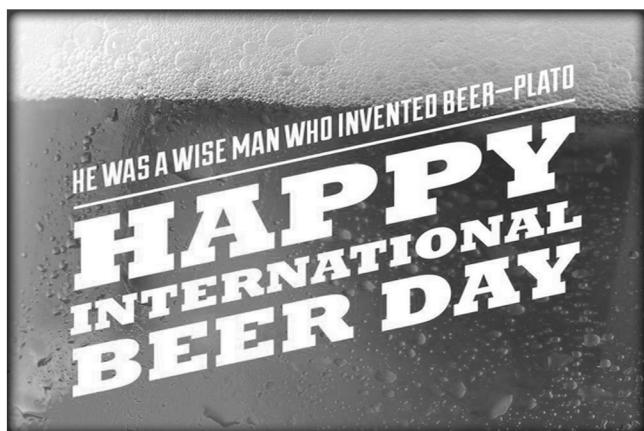

It's a day to gather with friends, explore new brews, and appreciate the craft behind every pint. Grab a cold one, visit a local brewery, or host a tasting party.

International Beer Day Hero - Louis Pasteur

Louis Pasteur, the French chemist and microbiologist, made groundbreaking discoveries in the mid-19th century that revolutionized brewing. His research into fermentation and pasteurization (heating liquids to kill bacteria) prevented spoilage, allowing beer to be stored and transported more effectively. This innovation was crucial for the industrialization and global spread of beer production, ensuring consistent quality and safety.

History of International Beer Day

Celebrating mankind's common thirst for what is likely the world's oldest and most beloved beverage is what International Beer Day is all about. Humans have been fascinated with beer since the first grains were accidentally discovered to have fermented, producing a bubbly aromatic product that someone dared to taste then drink, did not die but instead felt a lovely little buzz, smiled and said, "Wow." Mankind has been obsessed ever since with perfecting beer recipes and brewing processes in pursuit of the next "Wow."

Beer has been consumed by almost every culture throughout human history. The oldest evidence of man's obsession with brewing beer dates back to ancient Babylonia and Mesopotamia. Archaeologists have unearthed recipes for beer that were written on clay tablets in 4300 B.C., and ceramic vessels from 3400 B.C. that are still sticky with beer residue. Everyone drank beer in ancient Egypt: pharaohs, peasants, priests, even children, as part of their everyday diet.

What may be the first song about beer, "Hymn to Ninkasi" - an ode to the Sumerian goddess of beer - dates back to 1800 B.C. and includes a recipe for a beer brewed by female priestesses.

By the Middle Ages, Christian monks were brewing beers, and introduced the use of hops. Until then, beers were brewed with local additives like dates and olive oils to add flavor. Today's beers continue to be brewed with hops, herbs, or fruits that add flavor. Macro, micro, or craft, the art of brewing beer today remains a craft that employs age-old techniques carefully perfected over centuries and millennium.

Our collective love of beer is what Jesse Avshalomov no doubt had on his mind back in August of 2007 while he and a few friends enjoyed some conversation and brews in the beach community of Santa Cruz, California. Back then his reasons for founding International Beer Day were:

- Gather with friends and enjoy the taste of beer
- Celebrate those responsible for brewing and serving beer
- Unite the world under the banner of beer, by celebrating the beers of all nations together on a single day

Friends are convinced to buy a round of beer for the gang and, with some luck, a local bartender may offer some on the house. These memorable moments make their way to social media with popular hashtags for everyone to see.

Special deals and hours are set in pubs and breweries, with some places kicking it up a notch and presenting beer in custom-designed glasses. The bartenders and servers who work round the clock to provide great conversation and beer just the way we like it are appreciated and tipped generously.
