If you've spent a summer near the Jersey Shore's salt marshes, you've likely encountered one of its most remarkable residents—the diamondback terrapin. With their striking, patterned shells and determined crawl, these turtles are as much a part of the Shore's natural landscape as dune grasses and bay breezes. Each year, from late spring through summer, terrapins embark on a perilous journey that plays out along our back roads, bridges, and barrier islands.

A Journey for Survival - Diamondback terrapins are unique to coastal salt marshes and estuaries, making places like Atlantic and Cape May Counties critical habitat. From late May through July, female terrapins leave the safety of the marshes in search of sandy ground to lay their eggs. This often means crossing busy causeways, bridges, and bayfront roads—putting them at great risk.

You'll spot them most often after rainstorms or during high tides, when nesting instinct kicks into high gear. Brigantine, Ocean City, Sea Isle, and Wildwood Crest are among the many Shore towns where terrapins frequently attempt these crossings.

A Turtle with a History - In the 19th and early 20th centuries, diamondback terrapins were hunted nearly to extinction. Terrapin stew was a luxury dish, and demand was so high that East Coast populations—including those in New Jersey—were decimated. Fortunately, as tastes changed and conservation efforts took hold, terrapins gained protection and became a symbol of the Shore's natural heritage rather than a menu item.

Why Terrapins Matter - Terrapins play a key role in maintaining healthy salt marsh ecosystems. They help control snail and crab populations and serve as prey for larger animals. Their presence reflects the health of our wetlands—critical natural buffers that protect our coastlines.

### Turtle Etiquette: How You Can Help

Slow down and stay alert in terrapin crossing zones - Reduce your speed on causeways, marsh roads, and near posted crossing signs. Be especially watchful for the subtle sight of a turtle slowly moving along the shoulder or just starting to enter the roadway. Their low profile and slow pace make them easy to miss at a glance.

If you see a turtle crossing, stop safely - Put your car in park, engage your hazard lights, and ensure it's safe before exiting your vehicle.

Make eye contact with oncoming drivers - Confirm that drivers in both

directions are aware you're assisting and have stopped.

Assist confidently and securely - Gently grasp the turtle by the sides of its shell, keeping your fingers in the center, away from its claws. Be aware that some terrapins will retreat into their shells, making for an easy carry, while others will flail their legs and "run" in the air. Their spiky claws can scratch or startle you, so be prepared and hold on firmly. The key is not to drop the turtle - move it calmly and steadily across the road.

Move it in the direction it was headed - Even if it's going away from the

water, that's where it needs to go to nest.

Place it on a natural surface - Grass or sand beyond the road's edge is ideal. Never relocate or take a terrapin home - These are wild animals with

specific nesting and habitat needs.

A Shared Responsibility - Diamondback terrapins are resilient survivors with a remarkable history. But today, their greatest threats come from cars and habitat loss. By staying alert, showing care, and helping safely, we can ensure these ancient mariners continue to grace our marshes for generations to come.



This Sunday, June 22, Atlantic City will mark its first-ever Great Pride Festival, a vibrant celebration of love, identity, and community set against the familiar backdrop of O'Donnell Park and The ByrdCage on Atlantic Avenue. Brought to life by organizers from The ByrdCage, the City of Atlantic City, and the Miss'd America Pageant, the event—running from noon to 7 p.m.—showcases the city's LGBTQ+ heartbeat with music, vendors, artistry, and empowerment in full technicolor.

As parade-goers arrive, a ribbon of color spills from The ByrdCage—the city's first LGBTQ+ owned restaurant and lounge since 2002—onto Atlantic Avenue. The centerpiece? With Atlantic Avenue pedestrianized between Boston and Providence Avenues, the festival transforms into an outdoor celebration corridor. Attendees can dance to live bands, take in DJ sets, browse craft vendors, enjoy a children's zone, and sample fare from local food trucks. A series of drag performances—produced by Miss'd America—serves up laughter and flair for audiences of all ages.

According to the festival's organizers, "This festival is more than a party—it's a powerful symbol of visibility, love, and community," speaking to the event's deeper purpose. In a national climate where LGBTQ+ rights face growing challenges, this gathering offers affirmation made loud, colorful, and collective.

### Afterparty at The ByrdCage

The celebrations continue after dark back at The ByrdCage—an evening gathering promising music, dancing, and camaraderie. The space, opened early in 2025 as Atlantic City's first permanent gay-owned venue, pulses with intentional inclusivity and pride-fueled energy.

With free admission and street parking available on Boston Avenue, festival coordinators are emphasizing accessibility—welcoming families, allies, and visitors in a show of open, open-hearted celebration.

A Moment in History - Atlantic City has long been a haven for LGBTQ+people—ranging from its days as a summer destination for queer revelers to the emergence of venues like The ByrdCage. The launch of this festival marks a new chapter in its history, rooted in pride, resilience, and shared experience.





### YOGA POSE OF THE WEEK -Seated Forward Bend (Paschimottanasana)

There are many hamstring stretches in beginning yoga for a good reason. The hamstrings tend to get short and tight in people who sit a lot, which can contribute to lower back pain. Stretching them as you do in the Seated Forward Bend is helpful.

This yoga pose offers a stretch to the entire back of the body. Bend at your hips, not your waist, and keep your neck aligned with your spine.



### VITAMIN HIGHLIGHT -Vitamin A

One type comes from animal sources of food. It helps you see at night, make red blood cells, and fight off infections. The other type is in plant foods.

It helps prevent damage to cells and an eye problem called age-related macular degeneration. Eat orange veggies and fruits like sweet potato and cantaloupe, spinach and other greens, dairy foods, and seafood such as shrimp and salmon.

### Summer Solstice – June 21, 2025

The Longest Day (Summer Solstice) is observed on either June 20, 21, or 22, but this year, it falls on June 21. The timing shifts because it depends on when the Sun reaches its northernmost point from the celestial equator.

As the sun creeps up over the hills and into your town on June 21, you'll know it's here. That blessed time of year when barbecues and beach trips reign, when work slows and summer holidays mean getting together with friends and family. Just thinking about it likely brings up the smell of fresh cut grass and the taste of cold lemonade. Summer Solstice — also known as the first day of summer — has arrived.

It signals the start of astronomical summer. As a result, the days get shorter as summer progresses, first gradually but then at increasingly larger daily intervals as the September equinox approaches and ushers in the beginning of fall. Because the Sun travels across the sky in its most elongated path during the summer solstice, that day has the most daylight hours. (We interrupt this poetic paragraph to remind you that this applies only to those living north of the equator.)

Now then — people have celebrated this day for thousands of years. Some of the earliest party animals were the ancient Mesopotamians, Celtic Druids, Chinese, and Egyptians, and all of these cultures had their own ways of celebrating that make even our craziest backyard barbecues look tame. When was the last time you had a multi-story bonfire and danced around it naked? That's what we thought. But cultures have had good reason to celebrate since ancient times right up until today.

It's the longest day of the year. Enjoy!

### History of Summer Solstice

The day of the summer solstice, which occurs when the Sun is at its farthest distant point from the equator, is also the day that is considered to be the longest of the year. Since the Neolithic era, this day has been observed as the summer solstice, also known as the summer's midpoint.

In the Neolithic cultures of Northern and Central Europe, the dates of the crop cycles were associated with the summer solstice. People in Celtic, Slavic, and Germanic cultures traditionally celebrated it by lighting bonfires to bolster the Sun's vigor for the duration of the crop season and ensure a healthy harvest.

Numerous Neolithic stone circles appear to have been constructed around the Sun's movement at solstices. However, because there are no written accounts from this time period, determining the exact purpose of these rock edifices is difficult. On the other hand, the stones appear to be carefully positioned to align with the Sun's movements, framing solar motion on the summer and winter solstices.

Stones at specific solstice axes were even hammerstones to frame the sunrise for those standing in the center of the circle. This suggests that the alignment of the stones with the Sun's motions was intentional. The summer solstice was regarded as a significant cultural event in many ancient communities.

In Ancient Egypt, June Solstice helped the Egyptian tribes predict the annual flooding, as this day corresponded to the rise of the Nile River. They used this day as a marker to schedule their planting and harvesting of crops.

Different tribes and religions around the world also observed June Solstice in cultural and faith-based traditions. In Northern Europe, they refer to it as 'midsummer,' while other neo-pagan religions such as Wiccans refer to it as 'litha.' Christians and Catholics used this day to commemorate St. John's Day in observance of John the Baptist's birthday. On the other hand, Ancient Romans counted the days leading up to June Solstice for the celebration of Vestalia, a religious festival to honor Vesta, the goddess of the hearth.

In modern times, June Solstice marks the one-month countdown to the Olympic games opening. This was based on the ancient Greek calendars, where Summer Solstice marked the beginning of the year.

### **Summer Solstice Activities**

• Don't miss a minute - Yes, this requires waking up early — very early — but don't let that stop you. This actually starts the day before by making a list of everything you want to accomplish on June 21. Try to wake up before the sunrise, and find a place to watch it. Then, go about completing your list. Don't rush too much; you've got plenty of time today. Then, find a spot to watch the sun go back down. It may only be by a few seconds, but you just successfully spent the longest day of the year being extremely productive.

- Get outside - All over the world, one of the most common ways to celebrate Summer Solstice is to spend it outside. Take the family camping, have a cookout with your best friends, make a slip'n slide in the yard for the kids. All of these are surefire ways to take full advantage of the prolonged sunlight. Eat outside and enjoy the beauty of the world around you. An outdoor gathering might be joyous, but a change of location can be just as enjoyable. Get the family together and visit a park or the beach for a barbecue or a picnic.

- Do as the ancients did - If you're up for a crazy party, do some research into how ancient cultures welcomed the summer season, and host a party with more or less the same celebrations. For example, if you wanted to emulate Northern European culture, you could throw a Litha party. Eat fresh fruit and vegetables that are ready for picking at this time of year, have a giant bonfire of oak and dance wildly around a maypole. Encourage ancient-era clothing for a really memorable, albeit strange, Summer Solstice celebration. You can stay up and gaze at the stars. If this is your first time, you can borrow a book or download an app to assist you in spotting







### **Fishing in Atlantic County**

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at dep.nj.gov/njf-w/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/. Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/.

### SALTWATER FISHING

Atlantic City - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



**Ventnor/Ventnor Heights** - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

**Somers Point** - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

Brigantine - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Gravelling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

### FRESHWATER FISHING

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.

### International Surfing Day – June 21, 2025



International Surfing Day is celebrated on the third Saturday in June and takes place on June 21 this year. It is an environmentally-conscious holiday that celebrates surfing and the sustainability of ocean resources. It also promotes surfing and encourages more people to dive into this fun sport. Surfing can be traced back about 5,000 years and is not just a sport but a hobby and a lifestyle; it's a pastime found on all populated continents.


### HISTORY OF INTERNATIONAL SURFING DAY

International Surfing Day was initiated in 2005 by "Surfing Magazine" and the Surfrider Foundation. The holiday was created to promote the sport of surfing, as well as educate people about the negative impact of their activities on the ocean and the environment. On International Surfing Day, various activities are held, such as surfing contests, barbecues, and other fun surf-centered activities. Several groups also organize beach clean-ups and other restorative activities as a way of contributing positively to the environment.

Body-surfing has likely existed since humans began swimming in the ocean. However, surfing with the assistance of apparatus has been traced to the ancient cultures of Peru, where people surfed on reed watercraft for recreational and fishing purposes. Modern surfing with the use of surfboards, however, originates from pre-colonial Hawaii, which was introduced to the innovation by the Polynesians. Written evidence of surfing in Polynesia can be found in the journal of Joseph Banks during his stay in Tahiti in 1769. In Hawaii, surfing became more than a hobby or sport, moving into the realm of religion, culture, and art. It was referred to as 'he'e nalu,' meaning "wave sliding." Before surfing, the people would pray to the gods for protection and strength. The making of surfboards also required the assistance of a priest.

According to historians Kim Stoner and Geoff Dunn, surfing made its debut in the United States in July 1885 when four teenage Hawaiian princes arrived in California. David Kawananakoa, Edward Keli'iahonu, Jonah Kūhiō Kalaniana'ole, and Elle Mancini all surfed at the San Lorenzo River on redwood boards. In 1961, the United States Surfing Association was established, arguably becoming the first professional surfing contest organization in the world. Today, surfing is not just a sport but a lifestyle, which can now be found on all populated continents.

# "MEET THE PACK!"

#### 97 YEARS AGO...

97 years ago, on June 11, 1928, Morris Frank stepped off a ship in New York City with Buddy, the first Seeing Eye® dog, and made history. Just weeks earlier, Frank had traveled to Switzerland to train with Buddy at a pioneering guide dog school founded by Dorothy Harrison Eustis, an American dog trainer and philanthropist living abroad. Inspired by her article about guide dogs in The Saturday Evening Post, Frank had written to her with a simple goal: to prove that blind Americans could live independent lives.


In front of a crowd of skeptical reporters, Frank and Buddy successfully navigated a dangerous Manhattan street crossing—demonstrating not only Buddy's training, but the revolutionary potential of the human-canine partnership. Afterward, Frank sent Eustis a one-word telegram that said it all: "Success."

The moment helped launch The Seeing Eye, co-founded by Frank and Eustis in 1929, becoming the first guide dog school in the United States—and a lasting symbol of independence, dignity, and trust.



#### Fresh Picks & Flavorful Finds: Atlantic County's Peak Season This Week

Atlantic County farmers' markets are exploding with summer's bounty this week. Sun-ripe strawberries and blueberries lead the charge, with leafy greens, tomatoes, corn, and herbs in vibrant abundance. There's no better time to visit the open-air stalls—from Ventnor's Friday market to Linwood and Somers Point—than right now, when every vendor brims with Jersey Fresh goodness.

Blueberry season is officially underway in nearby Hammonton, known as the "Blueberry Capital of the World." Pick-your-own farms are open June 15–July 15—harvest ripe, plump berries at just \$3 per pound. Strawberries are still shining bright, their fleeting sweetness at its peak. And don't overlook corn, squash, peppers, and fresh basil—summery staples making a strong market presence.

To celebrate the harvest, here are two recipes that highlight local ingredients in fresh and inventive ways:

#### Blueberry-Lime Shrub Mocktail

This vibrant, non-alcoholic shrub delivers summer in a glass—bright, tangy, and deeply refreshing.

#### Ingredients:

• 1 cup Atlantic County blueberries

Zest and juice of 1 lime

• ½ cup sugar

• ½ cup apple cider vinegar

Club soda

**Instructions:** In a saucepan, combine blueberries, lime juice, zest, and sugar. Muddle gently. Heat over low until the sugar dissolves, then cool. Stir in vinegar and réfrigerate until chilled. Strain into a pitcher. To serve, fill glasses with ice, mix 2 this shrub with club soda, and garnish with a lime wheel.

Why it shines: Strawberry and blueberry season? Shrub is a perfect use—preserving peak fruit in a sipable, sophisticated format. It's local flavor beyond smoothies or sorbet—and bursting with vitamin C and antioxidants.

#### Multi-Grain Tomato & Herb Galette

Rustic, handheld, and bursting with summer flavors—a savory tribute to peak-season tomatoes and herbs.

#### Ingredients:

- 1 sheet pre-made whole-wheat puff pastry
- 1 cup heirloom tomatoes, sliced
- 1 small zucchini, thinly sliced
- 1/4 cup ricotta or chèvre
- 1/4 cup chopped fresh basil
- 1 tsp fresh thyme
- Salt, pepper, olive oil

Instructions: Preheat oven to 400°F. Roll pastry on parchment, leaving a 1" border. Mix ricotta with half the basil, herbs, salt, and pepper. Spread ricotta base over pastry, then layer tomatoes and zucchini. Fold edges over filling, brush crust with olive oil, and bake 25–30 min until golden. Sprinkle remaining basil before serving.

Why it works: This galette showcases midsummer heirloom tomatoes and fresh herbs in a flaky, hand-held form. It's easy dinner material—perfect for pairing with local markets or a summer cocktail.
