2 tsp. Olive oil
1 lb. Sea scallops
Pinch of salt
Freshly ground pepper
1/2 c. Minced shallots
1/2 c. Dry white wine
10 oz bag baby spinach
1 tbsp. Fresh lemon juice

Heat oil on a medium-high heat in a large heavy skillet. Add scallops and cook undisturbed for 2 minutes per side. Remove scallops and keep warm. ATLANTIC CITY - Lifeguards on duty, showers, changing rooms, food permitted, free admission. Visit atlanticcitybeachpatrol.org



BRIGANTINE - Brigantine Beach offers lifeguards on duty, surfing beaches, showers, changing rooms and food permitted. Seasonal tags are \$20 through May 31 and \$25 during regular season. Daily tags are \$10 and weekly tags are \$15. Seniors 65 and older receive a free tag with identification, and there is also a preseason senior rate of \$10 for ages 60 to 64. 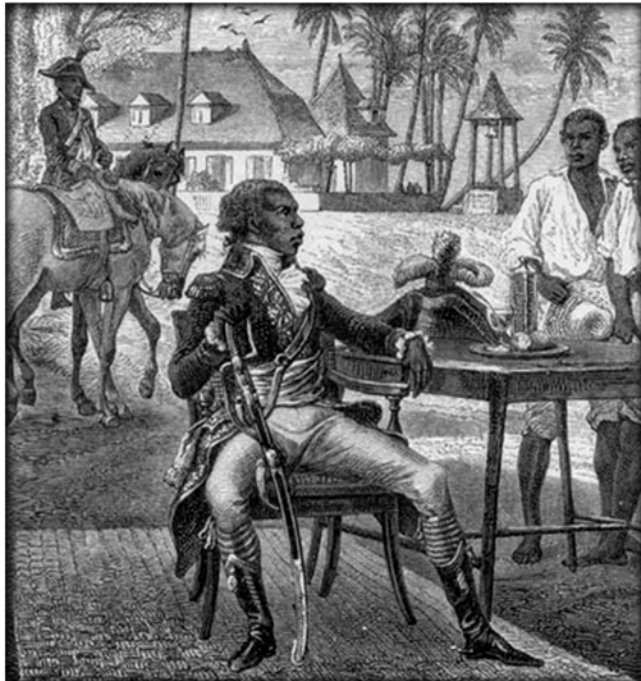


International Day for the Remembrance of the Slave Trade and its Abolition August 23, 2026

International Day for the Remembrance of the Slave Trade and its Abolition is observed every August 23. This solemn day calls for global reflection on the transatlantic slave trade, its devastating impact, and the enduring fight for freedom. Take time to learn about this history, support anti-slavery initiatives, and advocate for human rights.

International Day for the Remembrance of the Slave Trade and its Abolition Hero - Toussaint Louverture

François-Dominique Toussaint Louverture (1743–1803) was a formerly enslaved man who rose to become the leader of the Haitian Revolution. His military genius and political acumen transformed an uprising into a successful independent nation, making Haiti the first free black republic and the only nation established by a slave revolt. His leadership on August 22-23, 1791, marked a pivotal moment in the fight for abolition and inspired countless others.

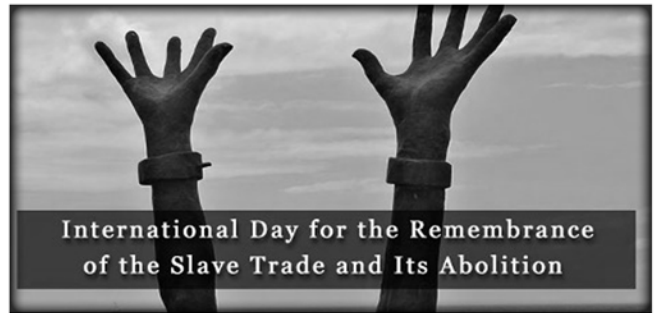


History of International Day for the Remembrance of the Slave Trade and its Abolition

The transatlantic trading patterns were established in the mid-17 century. It involved trading ships from Europe, sailing from Europe with manufactured goods to the west coast of Africa, where the goods would be exchanged for people captured by African traders. The transatlantic slave trade benefited the colonial powers of Western Europe primarily. The slave trade brought men, women and children who had been kidnapped, mainly from Africa, to labor as slaves in colonial settlements in Haiti, the Caribbean, and other regions of the world in inhumane conditions. During the final leg of the route, these ships returned home with cargoes of sugar, rum, tobacco, and other items.

More than 480,000 people were enslaved in the British Colonies by the 1790s. Enslaved people were forced to toil on plantations in the Caribbean and the Americas. These plantations produced products such as sugar or tobacco meant for consumption in Europe.

Towards the end of the eighteenth century, people started campaigning against slavery. Still, as it made significant contributions to the country's economy, these Abolitionists (people who campaigned for the abolition of the slave trade) were fiercely opposed by the pro-slavery West Indian lobby. These enslaved people themselves resisted the end of slavery. Resistance for commons in the Caribbean and the slaves in the French colony of St. Domingue seized control of the island and was declared the Republic of Haiti. In 1807, the British government passed an Act that abolished the slave trade throughout the British Empire, but slavery persisted in the colonies until it was finally abolished in 1838. International Day for the Remembrance of the Slave Trade and its Abolition is observed to commemorate the uprising on August 23, 1791, in Santo Domingo, Haiti, and the Dominican Republic today, which played a crucial role in the abolition of the transatlantic slave trade.



How to Observe International Day for the Remembrance of the Slave Trade and its Abolition

- Learn history - Learn about the history of the slave trade and its negative consequences. Find out when and why it began.
- Spread awareness - Spread awareness about the horrifying history of the slave trade. Let people know how people fought against which led to its abolishment.
- Attend events - Many countries hold various events on this day, such as seminars, plays, poetry events, etc. Attend these events and learn more about the day.

5 Facts About International Day For The Remembrance Of The Slave Trade And Its Abolition

- 1 - Slave trade began much earlier - The Slave trade started way earlier when the Portuguese began trafficking African captives in the 1440s.
- 2 - The U.S. was not a major destination - Less than 5% of people ended up in the U.S., whereas most were enslaved in the Caribbean or Brazil (45% each).
- 3 - It lasted long - Even though the British abolished it in 1807, it continued till 1850, and the last known slave ship is said to have sailed in 1866.
- 4 - The number of people remains unknown - The number of persons transported from Africa is uncertain due to a lack of reliable records, although it is estimated to be between 9 and 11 million.
- 5 - Push for Abolition Came from the Church - In the late 1700s, Christians in North America and Western Europe began rallying to abolish the transatlantic slave trade.

Why International Day for the Remembrance of the Slave Trade and its Abolition is Important

- It celebrates freedom - This day celebrates the freedom of people enslaved. It also remembers and honors all the victims of this terrible practice of slavery.
- It is a celebration of human rights - This day is a celebration of human rights. This day is proof that people eventually do get justice.
- It brings people together - This day brings people together to fight for a common goal. People come together to fight for justice and the greater good.

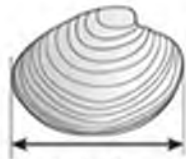

Fishing in Atlantic County

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at dep.nj.gov/nj-f-w/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/. Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/.

SALTWATER FISHING

Atlantic City - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



Ventnor/Ventnor Heights - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

Somers Point - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

Brigantine - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Graveling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-country Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. National Coconut Week invites us to celebrate the incredible versatility of coconuts every year from August 23 to August 30. Originating in the Philippines, this week-long observance highlights the fruit's economic importance and cultural significance. Explore new recipes, learn about its many uses, and discover why coconuts are a global staple.

National Coconut Week Hero - Philippine Coconut Authority (PCA)

While no single individual is credited with founding National Coconut Week, the Philippine Coconut Authority (PCA) is the driving force behind its celebration. Established in 1973, the PCA is a government agency dedicated to the development and promotion of the Philippine coconut industry. Its efforts have significantly boosted the country's status as a major global coconut producer and exporter, creating this holiday to highlight the fruit's vital role in the national economy and culture.



History of National Coconut Week

This holiday is all about coconuts! If that fact alone doesn't excite you, we don't know what will. Coconuts make us reflect on happier, more relaxed times because of the tropical feelings attached to the palm fruit. They are a multi-faceted fruit because they provide us with milk, water, and even oil. These resourceful fruits are even more important in the Philippines.

Coconuts are one of the most important crops in the country, playing a major role in their agricultural and economic sectors. The Philippines are the second largest coconut producer in the world - coming closely after Indonesia. Now that we have established the importance of this versatile fruit, it should come as no surprise that there would be a governing body set in place to monitor its production.

The first such body was the National Coconut Corporation (N.A.C.O.C.O.), established in 1940 to promote the growth and development of the coconut industry and was renamed 14 years later the Philippine Coconut Administration (P.H.I.L.C.O.A.), where its operation scope was further expanded.

After its formation, the Coconut Coordinating Council (C.C.C.) was created to supervise and coordinate the coconut self-sufficiency program for the government. However, they still lacked a single governing body centered on the development of the coconut industry, which placed farmers as the focal point.

Hence, the Philippine Coconut Authority (P.C.A.) was established, absorbing all other bodies' functions and powers as the single governing body of coconut and palm produce production, distribution, and development. The P.C.A. founded National Coconut Week, to be observed within National Coconut Month under Presidential Proclamation 142 to recognize the substantial benefits of the crop to the country.

5 Coco Facts About Coconuts

- 1 - Its name is ghoulie - The 'coco' in the term 'coconut' was derived because the shell was similar to a ghost from Portuguese folklore called 'coco.'
- 2 - The variety never ends - There are over 150 species of coconuts across 80 countries.
- 3 - Not all about health and beauty - Coconuts are used in the production of wooden items in the construction industry, as well as fuel.
- 4 - It had a different title - Some time ago, coconuts were spelled as 'cocoanuts.'
- 5 - They keep the insects away - Coconuts husks when burned, can be used as an insect repellent, specifically for mosquitoes.

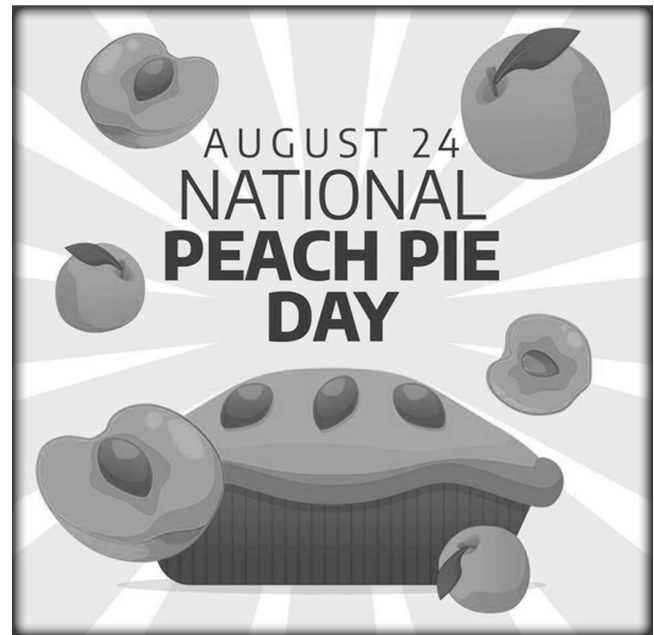
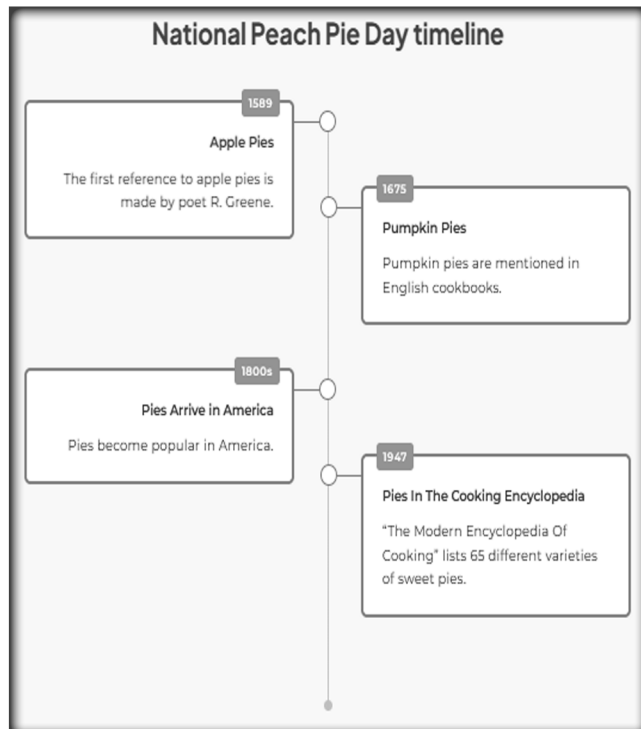
National Peach Pie Day Hero - Georgia Peach Council

INGREDIENTS

- 2 cups fresh peaches, diced
- 2 tbsp brown sugar
- ½ tsp ground cinnamon
- 1 tsp lemon juice
- 2 frozen or homemade waffles
- 2 scoops vanilla ice cream
- ½ cup granola or crumble topping
- Whipped cream, for topping
- Caramel sauce, for drizzling

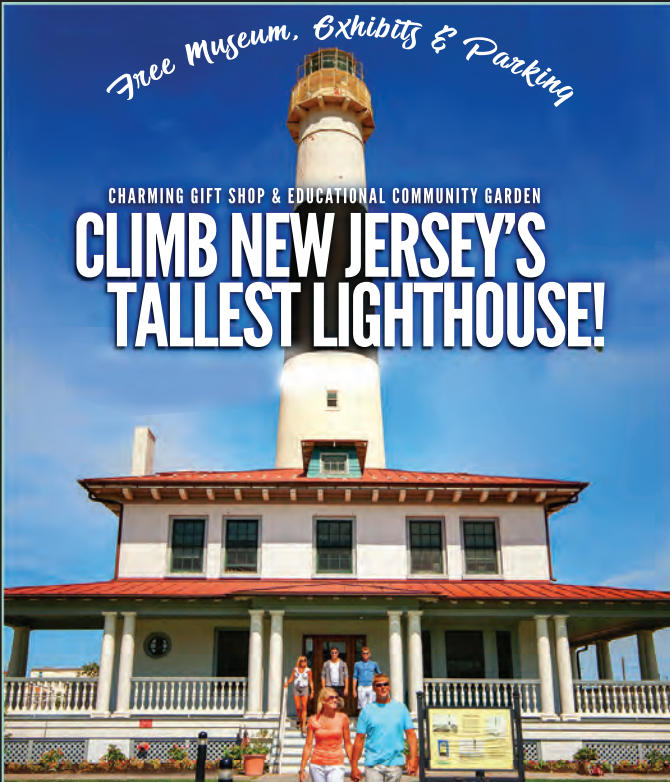
- 1 Preheat oven to 375°F. Cut pie crust into rounds and press into 6 greased muffin cups.

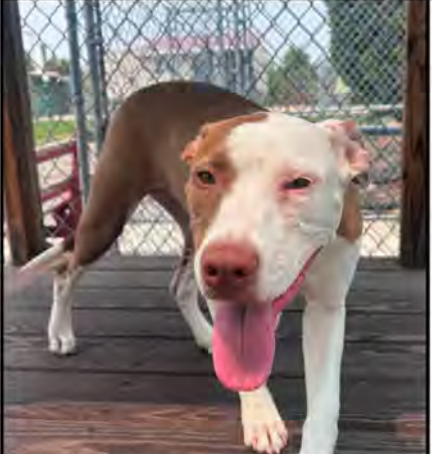

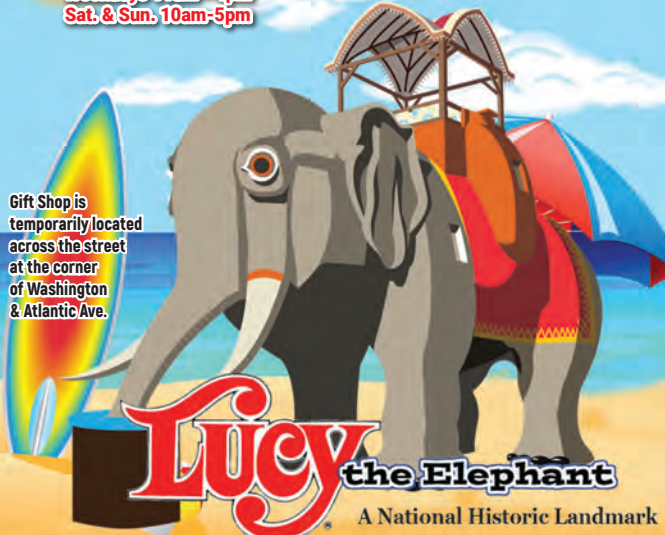

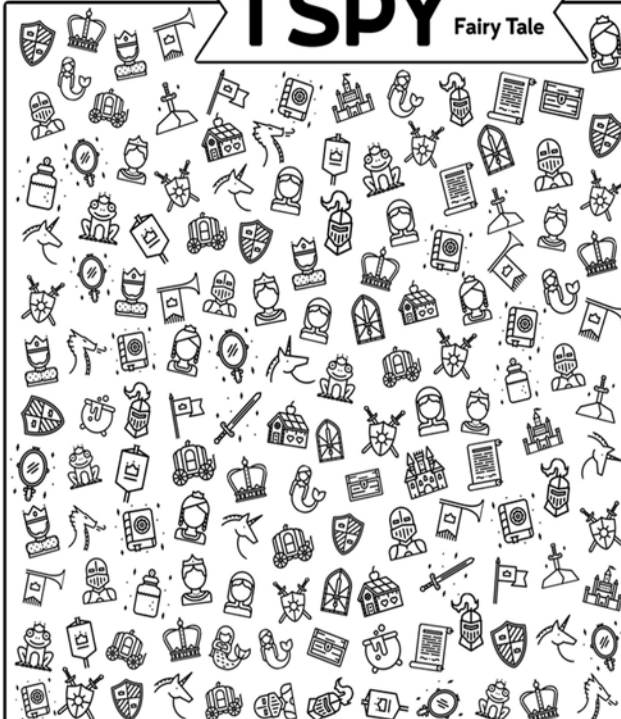

AUGUST 22 AT STOCKTON UNIVERSITY IN GALLOWAY BRINGS PARANORMAL INVESTIGATORS, HORROR FILMMAKERS, FOLKLORE & THE UNEXPLAINED TO SOUTH JERSEY

The Pine Barrens have long been a place where history, folklore and stories of the unexplained intersect. On August 22, that atmosphere becomes the backdrop for THE HOLLOW: Paracon & Film Fest, presented by Nine Lives Paranormal. The one-day event brings together paranormal investigators, filmmakers, podcasters, artists, scholars and fans for a celebration of the strange, the mysterious and the creative work inspired by it.

With independent film screenings, guest speakers, panels, interactive experiences and a curated vendor marketplace, The Hollow offers attendees several ways to explore the paranormal and horror communities. The event is designed not only for experienced investigators and longtime fans, but also for anyone interested in the stories, history and folklore behind some of the world's most enduring mysteries.

A DAY OF PARANORMAL & HORROR PROGRAMMING

The Hollow combines the traditional elements of a paranormal convention with an independent film festival. Throughout the day, attendees can meet investigators and creators, visit vendors, attend presentations and panels, and watch a selection of independent horror and paranormal films.

The film lineup includes multiple blocks of independent productions, giving emerging filmmakers an opportunity to put their work in front of an audience that appreciates the genre. The schedule also features a screening of *The Point Pleasant Tapes*, bringing one of New Jersey's most famous modern legends - the Mothman - into the festival's programming.

THE JERSEY DEVIL & THE PINE BARRENS

No discussion of South Jersey folklore would be complete without the Jersey Devil. The legend is deeply associated with the Pine Barrens, where generations of residents and visitors have shared stories of a mysterious winged creature said to inhabit the region.

The best-known version of the legend dates to 1735 and involves Mother Leeds and her thirteenth child. According to the traditional story, the child was born with unusual features, transformed into a winged creature and disappeared into the Pine Barrens. Over time, the story evolved into the legend of the Jersey Devil that is familiar today.

The historical origins of the legend are more complicated. Researchers have connected the story to the Leeds family of colonial South Jersey, including Daniel Leeds, whose publications featured winged imagery and whose religious and political conflicts contributed to the family's controversial reputation. Whether regarded as folklore, history or something more mysterious, the Jersey Devil has become one of New Jersey's most recognizable legends - and one of the defining stories of the Pine Barrens.

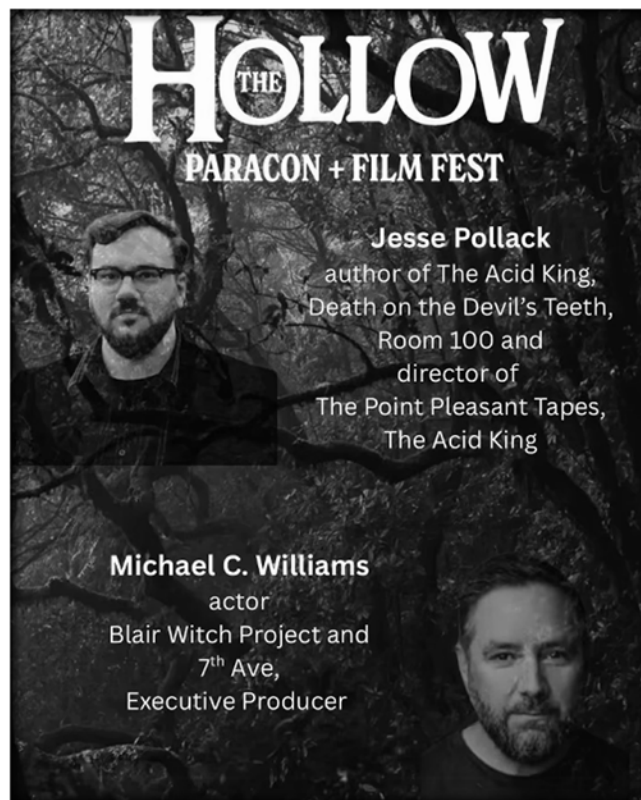
WHERE FOLKLORE BECOMES STORY

The Hollow explores more than whether a particular ghost story or unexplained encounter is true. It also looks at why these stories continue to fascinate us. Folklore changes as it is passed from one generation to another, while modern technology has given today's storytellers new ways to document, investigate and reinterpret the unexplained.

That intersection of old and new is reflected throughout the festival. Paranormal investigators bring firsthand experiences, filmmakers turn supernatural themes into visual stories, podcasters share ongoing conversations about unexplained phenomena, and artists create work inspired by the darker side of folklore and popular culture.

AN EVENT WITH A PURPOSE

The Hollow also has a charitable mission. Partial proceeds from the Paracon & Film Fest will support mental-health organizations and suicide-prevention efforts, giving the event a community purpose beyond its programming. By attending, sponsoring or participating, guests can support independent creators and paranormal investigators while also contributing to organizations working to provide mental-health awareness, advocacy and resources.

Casey Dancer: A Memoir About Dating, Stripping, and a Little Hot Yoga by Kristin Casey

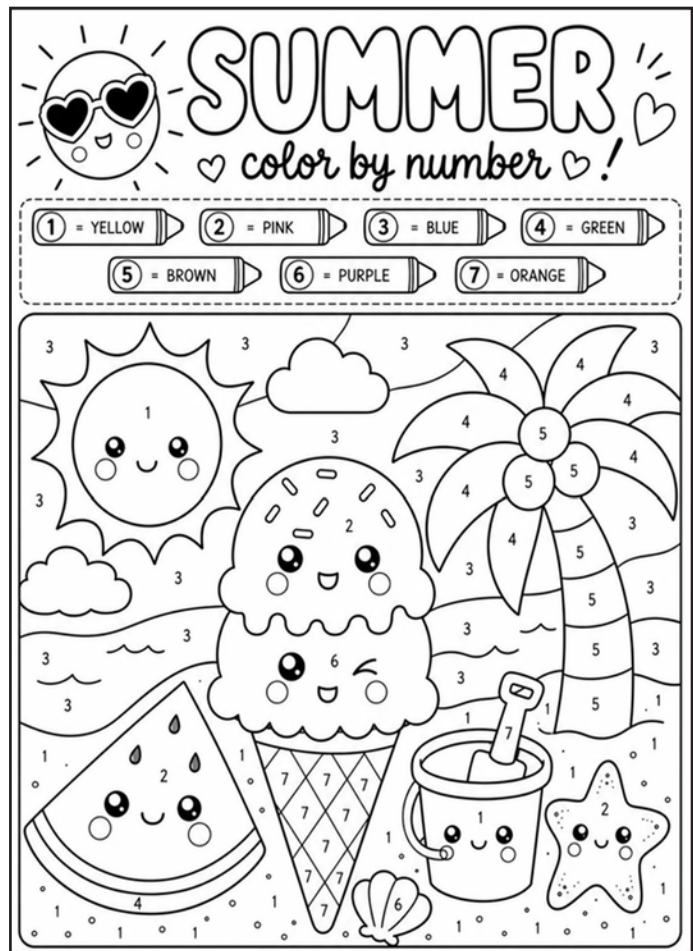
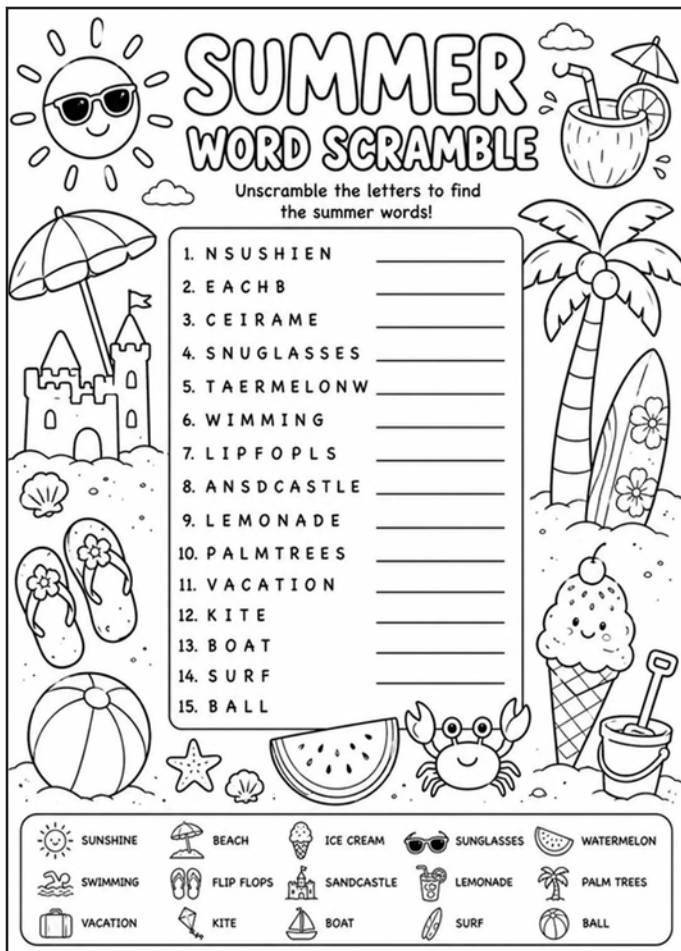
