Discovery Channel's annual feeding frenzy returns July 20–26, and local waters are part of the story.

By the time Shark Week hits your screen, some of the stars may already have passed by your beach chair. Discovery Channel's long-running ocean spectacle kicks off Sunday, July 20, with nightly premieres at 8 PM all week long. But for folks in Atlantic County, shark season isn't just on television—it's in the water.

This summer, two well-known sharks—Penny, a 528-pound juvenile white shark, and Hali, a 642-pound adult—were pinged off the coast near Atlantic County. Both were tagged and tracked by the marine research group OCEARCH, whose real-time maps show just how active the local coastline can be. While there's no reason to panic—these sharks aren't interested in swimmers—it's a fascinating reminder of just how wild our waters really are.

Want to follow along? You can track sharks like Penny and Hali in real time at shark-tracker.ocearch.org. Each shark's profile includes stats, photos, and a migration history, making it an engaging way for both kids and adults to connect with marine science.

The Jersey Shore plays a critical role in the shark world. Sandbar sharks, smooth dogfish, and sand tiger sharks are commonly found in our bays and estuaries, where they give birth and raise their young in shallow water nurseries. These species tend to steer clear of people, but they're vital players in a healthy marine ecosystem. Conservation groups like The Nature Conservancy have even highlighted Absecon Bay and surrounding marshes as essential shark habitat.

If you're looking to see a shark in real life, you don't have to go far. Several local fishing charters, including those out of Atlantic City, Somers Point, and Longport, occasionally encounter small sharks during offshore excursions—especially during summer months. Species like dogfish or even the occasional sandbar shark can turn up on deep

sea trips. Captains from outfits like AC Charters, Killer Instinct Sportfishing, or Starfish Boats are often happy to point out local marine life, and some offer eco-tours in addition to fishing. Just make sure to ask ahead of time if you're hoping for a chance encounter.

If you prefer dry land, the Atlantic City Aquarium is a hidden gem tucked into Historic Gardner's Basin. Open daily from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., the aquarium features over 100 species of marine life, including a Shark Touch Tank that allows visitors to get hands-on with small, gentle species. The facility also offers live animal talks, educational displays, and summer programs that dive into local ocean science. It's the perfect spot to fuel a budding marine biologist's curiosity—or just learn something cool before Shark Week begins.



So while Discovery Channel takes you to the deepest trenches and most remote islands on Earth, remember that some of the most fascinating action is happening right here in Atlantic County. Whether you're paddling through the back bays of Margate, casting a line off Longport, or cruising offshore from Absecon Island, chances are you're not alone out there.

They're not monsters. They're neighbors. And when Shark Week kicks off July 20, you'll know just how close the story really is.

ATLANTIC COUNTY

The Pride of Atlantic City: Soaring Above Barriers in 1933

Nearly a century ago, a quiet takeoff from Bader Field launched a cross-country flight that shattered racial barriers and put Atlantic County on the map.

On a warm July morning in 1933, two men climbed into a small orange airplane on the edge of Atlantic City and set their sights west. Their names were C. Alfred "Chief" Anderson and Dr. Albert E. Forsythe, and their goal was audacious: to fly across the United States and back - becoming the first Black pilots in American history to complete a round-trip transcontinental flight.



Their aircraft, a Fairchild 24 dubbed The Pride of Atlantic City, lifted off from Bader Field, then one of the busiest municipal airports on the East Coast. What they lacked in technology - they flew without radios, parachutes, or modern instruments - they made up for in skill, courage, and sheer determination. The route would take them over the Appalachians, across the plains, and into the deserts of the West, before turning back again. Every takeoff, landing, and refueling stop became a political act - challenging a nation that still largely refused to believe Black men belonged in the cockpit.


Before the flight that made them famous, both men had already overcome tremendous odds just to get in the air. Anderson, rejected by white-run aviation schools, taught himself to fly before eventually training under a German pilot and earning his license in 1932 - becoming the first Black American to earn a commercial transport license. Forsythe, a Bahamian-born physician living and practicing in Atlantic City, viewed flying as both a personal passion and a political act. He financed the flight himself, seeing it as a way to challenge racist assumptions and showcase what Black Americans were capable of when given the chance.



Their decision to launch from Bader Field was no coincidence. At the time, the airfield was a hub of innovation and pride for Atlantic City. It had opened in 1910 and was one of the first municipal airports in the country, hosting everything from mail runs to barnstorming air shows. With its prime location near the city's hotels and piers, it was a natural stage for spectacle - and the perfect launch pad for two men determined to command the sky. For Forsythe, who was living and practicing medicine in Atlantic City at the time, the choice was also personal.

When they touched down in Los Angeles, they had done what no Black Americans had ever done. And eleven days later, when they returned to Atlantic City, they were met with cheers and headlines. Mayor Harry Bacharach called their mission "a high type of courage and skill," and community members gathered at Bader Field to welcome the pilots home. Newspaper accounts describe children climbing fences for a glimpse of the returning aircraft and a crowd that spilled beyond the hangars. In an era when most headlines about Black Americans were steeped in limitation, this one was about excellence - and everyone knew it.

But their flight was more than a personal achievement. It was a cultural moment, one that defied the restrictions of the Jim Crow era and proved that talent and tenacity could soar above prejudice. Their story caught national attention and helped lay the foundation for the future of Black aviation in America.



Anderson would go on to train the Tuskegee Airmen during World War II, earning his place in history as the "Father of Black Aviation." Forsythe continued flying goodwill missions and remained a prominent advocate for inclusion in aviation throughout his life. Together, they blazed a trail through the sky - and through the boundaries of race and access.

Though Bader Field officially closed to air traffic in 2006, its legacy lives on. The cracked runways and overgrown tarmac along the bay may look forgotten, but they mark the place where something extraordinary began. Atlantic County didn't just host a historic flight - it helped launch a movement.

As the anniversary of that flight approaches on July 17, nearly 92 years later, the story of The Pride of Atlantic City deserves to be remembered not as a forgotten footnote, but as a proud chapter in our local - and national - history. From a small airfield by the water, two men looked west and dared to defy the odds.

And they didn't just make it. They made history.

ATLANTIC COUNTY

From the Derby stage in Atlanta to hometown watch parties in South Jersey, baseball's brightest week is here—and Phillies fans have plenty to cheer for.

The countdown is on to the 95th MLB All-Star Game, set for Tuesday, July 15 at Truist Park in Atlanta, but the festivities kick off long before the first pitch. All-Star Week officially begins on Friday, July 11, transforming baseball's summer lull into a celebration of power hitters, rising stars, and fan-fueled energy. And while the action is taking place down south, fans in Atlantic County have every reason to tune in, throw on their red pinstripes, and start warming up for what's coming next: Philadelphia 2026.

The Phillies may not be hosting this year, but their fingerprints are all over All-Star Week. As of press time, multiple Phils—most notably Bryce Harper and Zack Wheeler—have been named to the National League roster, with other players still in the mix as injury replacements. Whether you're a Harper devotee or just a fan of baseball done big, the week ahead offers something for everyone.

It all starts with Friday's HBCU Swingman Classic, a showcase of elite players from Historically Black Colleges and Universities. Saturday brings a doubleheader with the All-Star Futures Game, spotlighting top MLB prospects, followed by the ever-entertaining Celebrity Softball Game. On Sunday, the MLB All-Star 4.4 Miler honors Hank Aaron with a public run through Atlanta's streets. But the real headline events are still to come.

On Monday, July 14, eight of baseball's most explosive sluggers step into the box for the Home Run Derby, arguably the week's biggest crowd-pleaser. Then on Tuesday night, it's time for the main event: the All-Star Game itself, airing live on FOX at 8 p.m. ET.

All-Star Ambitions: MLB's Midsummer Classic Brings the Heat Ahead of Philly 2026

Back in South Jersey, plenty of local bars and fan hubs are expected to host viewing parties—especially Phillies-favorite spots in Somers Point, Margate, and Atlantic City. A few are even planning Phillies-themed specials and giveaways, like "Schwarbomb Sliders," "Wheeler's Curveball Cocktails," and fan trivia at halftime. For fans looking to stay in, it's the perfect excuse to fire up the grill and turn the backyard into a ballpark.

There's also something bigger brewing beneath the surface of this year's All-Star energy: anticipation. That's because next summer, the eyes of the baseball world will turn toward Citizens Bank Park, when Philadelphia hosts the 2026 MLB All-Star Game. With America's 250th birthday happening the same year, MLB has already hinted at a massive celebration in Philly, complete with historical tributes, fan festivals, and a likely appearance by the Phillie Phanatic in colonial attire.



In the meantime, Atlantic County fans can use this year as a warm-up—rooting for Harper, watching the Derby with friends, and maybe even organizing youth baseball clinics or local home run contests in the spirit of the game.

Because whether it's Truist Park or the South Jersey shore, baseball in July has a way of bringing everyone together. And for Phillies fans, the best part may be knowing the biggest show of all is headed our way next summer.














Stay Safe in the Surf: A Guide to Water Safety at the Jersey Shore

The Jersey Shore is synonymous with summer fun—sunny beach days, refreshing ocean dips, and thrilling surf. But as inviting as the Atlantic Ocean, bays, and inlets may seem, these waters demand respect. Each year, thousands of visitors flock to Atlantic and Cape May Counties to enjoy the shore, and knowing how to stay safe can mean the difference between a great day and a dangerous one.

Respect the Ocean's Power

The ocean at the Jersey Shore can change quickly, with shifting tides, sudden drop-offs, and powerful currents. Rip currents, in particular, pose a significant hazard. Often invisible from shore, these narrow channels of fast-moving water can pull swimmers out beyond the breaking waves. If caught in one, stay calm—don't try to swim directly back to shore. Instead, swim parallel to the beach until you're free of the current, then angle back toward land.

When possible, swim only at guarded beaches. Lifeguards are trained to spot hazards, assist swimmers in distress, and respond quickly in emergencies. Many Jersey Shore towns, including Ocean City, Wildwood, Cape May, Atlantic City, and Brigantine, staff their beaches with lifeguards daily during peak season, typically from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Know the Conditions

Before heading out, check the day's surf and weather reports. Local news, beach patrol websites, and flag systems provide updates on tide times, rip current risks, jellyfish sightings, and storm advisories. Be especially cautious after storms, when surf conditions can remain rough even if skies are clear.

Additionally, always be aware of boat traffic in bays and inlets, where swimmers, kayakers, and paddleboarders share the water with motorized

vessels. Wearing a U.S. Coast Guard-approved life jacket is essential for boating and recommended for inexperienced swimmers in deeper waters.

Supervise Children Closely

Even on calm days, waves can knock over small children or carry them farther out than expected. Stay within arm's reach of young swimmers, and consider outfitting them with brightly colored swimwear or rash guards for visibility. Teach children to recognize lifeguards and seek help if they feel unsafe.

Smart Shore Habits

- Stay sober while swimming or boating. Alcohol impairs judgment, balance, and reaction times.
- Obey posted signs and lifeguard instructions. Many towns prohibit swimming after hours, when no lifeguards are present.
- Don't overestimate your abilities. The ocean is not a pool. If you're not a strong swimmer, stay in shallower water where you can touch bottom.

Enjoy the Water, Respect the Risks

The Jersey Shore's waters offer unforgettable fun but a safe beach day starts with smart choices. By understanding the ocean's power, heeding local guidance, and watching out for one another, visitors can make the most of their time at the shore keeping memories joyful and worry-free.





YOGA POSE OF THE WEEK -Supine Spinal Twist (Supta Matsyendrasana)

A passive twist is a classic way to end a yoga session, although there's no rule against doing this yoga pose at the beginning of your practice. The position of the legs is up to you.







TO REGISTER

Fishing in Atlantic County

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at dep.nj.gov/njf-w/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/. Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/.

SALTWATER FISHING

Atlantic City - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



Ventnor/Ventnor Heights - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

Somers Point - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

Brigantine - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Gravelling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

FRESHWATER FISHING

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.




Part of the science behind the matching process requires our Seeing Eye instructors to be able to understand how fast a potential Seeing Eye student walks and how much of a pull from the harness they need. To do this, instructors will do a "Juno Walk" with the student, acting as the dog and leading the student with a shortened harness handle for a short walk. The instructor will work with the student to determine how fast or slow they want to walk and how much pull they feel comfortable with.

All this information is incredibly helpful for our instructors when deciphering which dog would work best for each student!






Books That Bite: Fierce Summer Reads to Prepare You for Shark Week

Shark Week airs July 20–26, but the thrills don't have to wait. Dive into these oceanic tales that sink their teeth in and don't let go.

Whether you're watching the water a little more closely this week or just looking for something gripping to read on the beach, these summer picks are perfect for readers who like their stories with a little bite. From deep-sea thrillers and historical shipwrecks to science writing that reveals just how much we don't know about what swims beneath us, these books are ideal companions for Shark Week—and may leave you second-guessing that dip in the Atlantic.

Jaws by Peter Benchley

It's the one that started it all. Long before the blockbuster film terrified beachgoers, Benchley's novel introduced readers to Amity Island, a sleepy resort town whose waters are stalked by a great white shark. The book is pulpier, darker, and more character-driven than the movie—less about spectacle and more about fear, politics, and the fragility of coastal life. And given that it was inspired in part by the 1916 shark attacks along the Jersey Shore, it hits close to home.

The Swell by Allie Reynolds

Reynolds, a former pro snowboarder and author of Shiver, trades icy peaks for tropical reefs in this taut thriller. Set on a secret Australian surf island, The Swell follows a tight group of adrenaline junkies whose idyllic paradise hides deadly secrets. Think The Beach meets Point Break, with undercurrents of obsession, betrayal—and yes, a few menacing fins offshore.

The Devil's Teeth by Susan Casey

This nonfiction stunner follows journalist Susan Casey's time with a group of scientists studying great white sharks off the coast of California's Farallon Islands. Casey's prose is

sharp and fast-paced, combining natural history with memoir and investigative reporting. If you're more fascinated than fearful of sharks, this one delivers real-world awe, mystery, and marine science at its most dramatic.

The House in the Cerulean Sea by TJ Klune

Okay—no sharks here. But this heartfelt fantasy, set beside a magical sea, is a gentle reminder that the unknown doesn't have to be terrifying. Klune's novel follows a lonely bureaucrat who's sent to a remote island to evaluate a group of "dangerous" magical children, and what he finds instead is love, transformation, and something like home. Think of it as an emotional life raft between thrillers.

Bonus Local Tie-In: Close to Shore by Michael Capuzzo

If you haven't read this one, now's the time. Capuzzo's riveting nonfiction account of the 1916 Jersey Shore shark attacks blends historical reporting with a novelist's touch. Set along the same stretch of coast we swim today, it documents how a rogue great white (likely the inspiration for Jaws) sparked panic from Beach Haven to Matawan—and changed how Americans saw the ocean forever.

From toothy fiction to sharp-eyed reporting, these reads are ideal for Shark Week's most daring fans. Whether you're sprawled on a blanket at the beach or curled up safely indoors, there's no better time to dive into stories that remind us how little we really know about the deep.

Because the truth is, sharks aren't the only things lurking beneath the surface—secrets, survival, and self-discovery are all waiting down there too. So crack open a good book, watch the tides, and enjoy the thrill of staying just one page ahead of the bite.
