FROM THE HEART OF ATLANTIC COUNTY MAGAZINE

South Jersey's largest Earth Day celebration returns this spring as the Atlantic County Utilities Authority hosts its 34th annual Earth Day Festival, bringing together environmental education, hands-on activities, and community organizations at the ACUA Environmental Park.

The festival will be held Sunday, April 26, 2026, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at 6700 Delilah Road in Egg Harbor Township. Admission is free and the event is held rain or shine.

What sets the event apart is access to the facility itself. The ACUA opens its working site to the public, offering tours of its recycling center, wastewater treatment plant, and renewable energy systems, including wind and solar. It's one of the few chances residents get to see how those operations function in real time and how waste, water, and energy are managed on a countywide level.

Across the grounds, more than 100 vendors, organizations, and exhibitors will be set up throughout the day alongside workshops, demonstrations, and live entertainment. Families can also expect touch-a-truck, landfill hayrides, a hay maze, crafts, bounce houses, live animal exhibits, and a recycled art display, giving the festival a mix of environmental programming and all-day family activity.

The Environmental Park itself is expansive, with parking, tours, exhibits, and activity areas spread throughout the property. Comfortable shoes are a good idea, and depending on the forecast, it would also make sense to bring sunscreen or a light rain jacket.

What has kept this event going for more than three decades is the balance it strikes between information and experience. It gives people a chance to spend the day with their families, support local groups, and leave knowing a little more about the systems and choices that shape everyday life in Atlantic County.

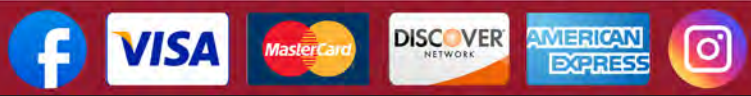

YOGA POSE OF THE WEEK - Triangle Pose (Utthita Trikonasana)

The Triangle can be modified like the Extended Side Angle, using a yoga block for your bottom hand if you aren't comfortable reaching your arm to the floor in this yoga pose. You can also rest your hand higher up on your leg—on your shin or thigh—but avoid putting it directly on your knee. Don't hesitate to micro-bend both knees if this yoga pose feels uncomfortable. It won't look or feel like a pronounced bend, but rather, just enough movement to unlock your knees and ease tension in your hamstrings. Triangle offers many benefits: Strength (in the legs), flexibility (in the groin, hamstrings, and hips), as well as opening the chest and shoulders, and balance.



VITAMIN HIGHLIGHT - Vitamin E

It's something called an antioxidant, which protects your cells from damage caused by cigarette smoke, pollution, sunlight, and more. Vitamin E also helps your cells talk to each other and keeps blood moving. Sunflower seeds and nuts including almonds, hazelnuts, and peanuts are good sources. If you're allergic to those, vegetable oils (like safflower and sunflower), spinach, and broccoli have vitamin E, too.

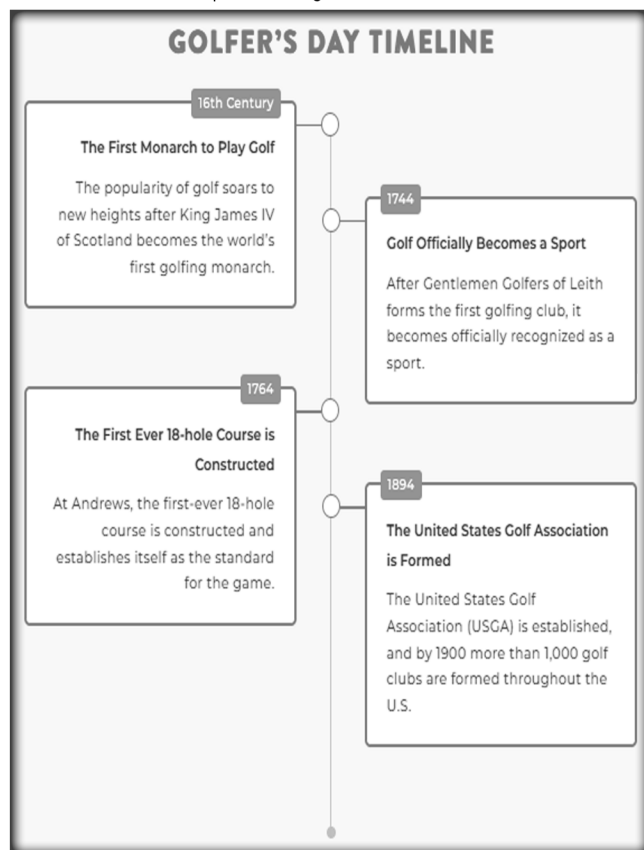
Golfer's Day is celebrated every year on April 10 to celebrate not just the game of golf but also the people who play and enjoy it. A possible source of origin of the word golf can be the Dutch word 'kolf,' which is a kind of stick or club, or it can be the Scottish word 'goulf,' which means to strike or cuff. From whichever word it might have originated from, Golfer's Day is best celebrated by playing with your loved ones and spreading the joy of the game.

History of Golfer's Day

Golf originated in Scotland from a game played close to the royal capital of Edinburg. The earliest form of golf used to be played by hitting a pebble over dunes around tracks. King James IV of Scotland became the world's first golfing monarch, and the popularity of the game soared throughout the 16th Century. The game reached England through King Charles I, and Mary Queen of Scots introduced the game to France when she studied there. The first international golf match was hosted at Leith near Edinburgh in 1682, and the Duke of York and George Patterson represented Scotland and beat two English noblemen.

After the Gentlemen Golfers of Leith formed the first club in 1744 and set up an annual competition, then golf officially became a sport. Rules were drafted by Duncan Forbes, which are still somewhat followed. In 1764, the first-ever 18-hole course was constructed at St Andrews, which established the standard for the game. The club was honored by King William IV in 1834 with the title of 'Royal & Ancient.' As the British Empire expanded, so did golf. The first golf club outside Britain was in Bangalore, India in 1870, which was followed by Royal Montreal, Cape Town in 1885, and St Andrew's of New York in 1888.

The United States Golf Association (USGA) was established in 1894, and by 1900 more than 1,000 golf clubs were formed throughout the U.S. The U.S. quickly became the center of the professional game.



Golfer's Day Activities

- Teach the sport to someone - Introduce this beautiful sport to someone and pass on your knowledge. Spread the beautification of the sport.
- Hit the links - Play a few shots yourself and enjoy the day. The best way to celebrate the day is by playing the sport, preferably with a few friends.
- Buy new equipment - It is time to buy more golf equipment and splurge a little. This day is the best occasion for you to let loose a little. Pass down your old gear to new golfers to spread the love.

5 Incredible Facts About Golf

- 1 - Golf was once banned - Golf was banned three times in Scotland between 1457 and 1744 because it interfered with military training.
- 2 - The first round of women's golf - The first round was played in Musselburgh, Scotland, and the first women's club was developed in 1867.
- 3 - Chances of making a hole-in-one - Chances of making a hole-in-one are so low that even professional golfers can go their whole career without making one.
- 4 - The first golf balls - During the initial days of the sport, golf balls were made by wetting feathers and wrapping them around the leather.
- 5 - Under 18 golfers and the handicap - Though professional golfers play to handicaps of four and six, most golfers are not this gifted and will not play a handicap under 18.

A Local Chapter in Golf's History

Golf's global roots trace back to Scotland, where the 18-hole standard was established at St. Andrews in 1764, but Atlantic County holds a unique place in American golf history. One of the oldest golf courses in the country sits right here in Atlantic County. The Atlantic City Country Club, founded in 1897, is not only one of the oldest U.S. courses, it is also widely credited as the birthplace of the term "birdie." According to club history, a player described a standout shot as a "bird of a shot," and the phrase quickly evolved into "birdie," now used worldwide to signify one under par.

Golf continued to take hold locally as the sport expanded across the United States. Seaview Golf Club, established in 1914, has a long competitive history and has hosted major professional events over the years, including early PGA Tour stops and now the LPGA ShopRite Classic, which brings one of the longest-running women's professional tournaments back to Atlantic County each summer. Public courses such as Ballamor Golf Club and Twisted Dune Golf Club, both opened in the early 2000s, added a different style of play to the area, with wide fairways, rolling terrain, and wind-influenced layouts designed to mirror traditional links-style golf rather than tight, tree-lined courses.

In Egg Harbor Township, McCullough's Emerald Golf Links is known for its layout, with each hole modeled after well-known designs from Ireland and Scotland, including St. Andrews and other historic courses. That concept makes it one of the more distinctive public courses in South Jersey. The property is also home to Vagabond, located right on-site - an easy stop after a round or even just to grab a drink or bite without leaving the course grounds.

Golfer's Day, celebrated each year on April 10, is simply about playing. Around here, that's easy - multiple public courses, a long playing season, and a mix of historic and modern layouts all within a short drive. Whether it's a quick nine, a full round, or time at the range, it's a perfect chance to get outside, enjoy the fresh air, and make the most of a perfect spring day.

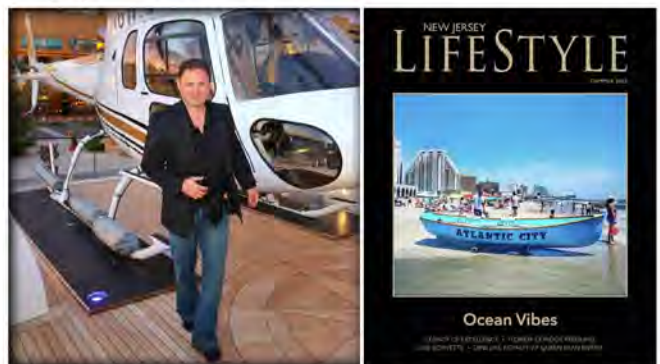

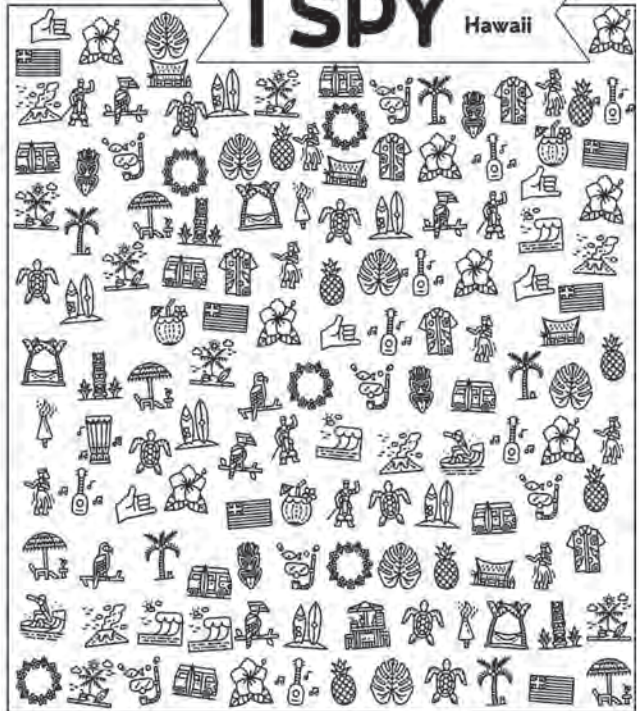

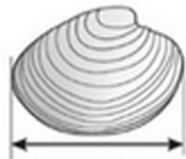

Fishing in Atlantic County

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at dep.nj.gov/njfw/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/. Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/.

SALTWATER FISHING

Atlantic City - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



Ventnor/Ventnor Heights - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

Somers Point - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

Brigantine - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Graveling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

FRESHWATER FISHING

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.
