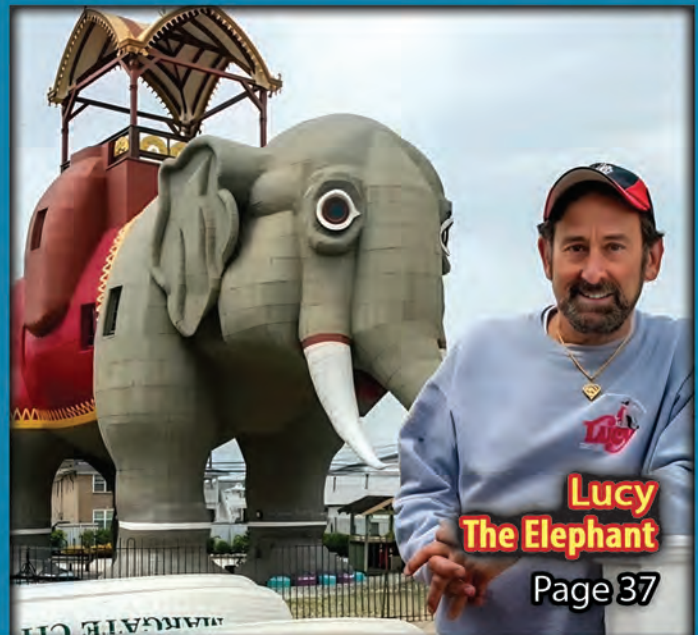

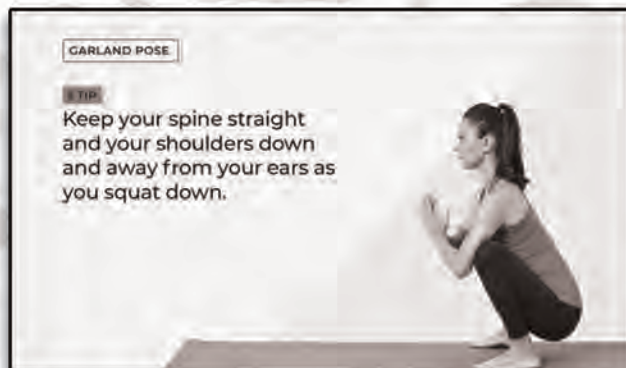

## YOGA POSE OF THE WEEK - Garland Pose (Malasana)

Squatting is an excellent stretch for the muscles around your pelvis, often called a hip opener yoga pose.

Perhaps surprisingly, it's also good for your feet, which are often neglected. If squatting is challenging, props can help: Sit on a block or roll a yoga towel or blanket under your heels. Press your heels down toward the floor.



## VITAMIN HIGHLIGHT - Iodine

Your thyroid uses iodine to make hormones that control metabolism. The first symptom of a deficiency is usually a goiter, a lump in your neck caused by an enlarged thyroid gland. It's rare in the U.S., largely because iodine is added to table salt. Other top sources include fish and seaweed. Too much iodine can be harmful though, and supplements interact with some medications.

National Mahjong Day is celebrated annually on April 30. Mahjong is a tile-based game that has been around since its advent in the 19th century in China, and it remains popular all over the world, but especially so in Asian countries. Traditionally, it's a four-player game, though there are some three-player variations in China, Japan, South Korea, and Southeast Asia. The game is played with a set of 144 tiles originally based on Chinese characters and symbols. In the beginning, each player is given 13 tiles, and their objective is to draw and discard tiles until they complete a legal hand, using the 14th drawn tile to form four sets and a pair (known as 'melds' and 'eye'), respectively.

### History of National Mahjong Day

Mahjong is based on card games popular in China in the 18th and 19th centuries, such as Khanhoo and Penghu, which are mahjong's most likely ancestors. They've been compared with the western card games Conquian and Rummy, as they all involve drawing and discarding cards to make melds. Nobody is sure when the conversion from cards to tiles happened, but it's estimated to have happened in the middle of the 19th century. The earliest surviving tilesets date from around 1870 and were found in Fuzhou, Shanghai, and Ningbo. These sets were different from the ones used today in several ways — some tiles were missing and some were placed differently, others shared the titles of the leaders of the Taiping Rebellion. (It's believed that they were removed after the rebellion ended.)

On October 1, 1949, the People's Republic of China was founded. One of their new laws was a ban on gambling, which resulted in a decline in the game. The game became altogether illegal during the Cultural Revolution of 1966. The ban wasn't lifted until 1985. Nowadays, the game has become a favorite pastime in China.

In the West, the first records about Mahjong come from the papers of British Consul General F. E. B. Harvey, from when he served as consul in Ningbo, in the 1860s. He became an acquaintance of an English-fluent official under the Daoguang Emperor, who taught him the game. He then described the rules of the game in a series of papers.

In 1920, Mahjong sets began to be imported to the U.S., and it became a fad for the rest of the decade. It became a central part of cultural bonding for Chinese Americans in the 1920s and '30s, in Chinatown, Manhattan, and was part of community building for suburban American Jewish women in the 1940s and '50s. Mahjong nights in America often involved dressing and decorating rooms in Chinese style. The rules of the American variant became standardized with the formation of the National Mah Jongg League in 1937. In 1986, the N.M.J.L. conducted its first Mah Jongg Cruise Tournament. In 1999, a second organization was formed, the American Mah Jongg Association, which currently hosts tournaments all across North America.

### National Mahjong Day Activities

- Learn to play Mahjong - It doesn't matter if you've never played before — you too can celebrate by just giving it a try. Destination Mah Jongg is an online community that connects you with fellow players in your area, and they host a Learn to Play Mah Jongg Clinic on National Mahjong Day. You can also learn on your own for free through YouTube videos and through playing Mahjong on your browser or smartphone.
- Join an event - Find out which place near you is hosting an event for National Mahjong Day, and join them. It doesn't have to be a competitive tournament; they probably also have tables for casual play, which is a good opportunity to meet new people with similar interests.
- Teach Mahjong to others - It's not just about playing — you can also offer to teach your friends and family. Share this wonderful game with more people! You can also offer to teach beginners at an event. Just ask the organization hosting if they need any more instructors!

### 5 Little-known Facts About Mahjong

- 1 - There are 25 recognized variations - Some of these include American Mahjong, Competition Mahjong, and Pussers bones.
- 2 - Tiles were originally made out of bone - Nowadays, they are mostly made out of plastic.
- 3 - The first world tournament was in Japan - The World Mahjong Championship was held in Iidabashi, Tokyo, over three days in 2002, and the winner was the Japanese player Mai Hatsuue.
- 4 - The longest mahjong marathon lasted 33 hours - On December 16, 2012, Oleg Petrov, Anton Khantimirov, Nickolay Demyanov, and Mark Efremov from Russia played for 33 hours, three minutes, and 45.8 seconds.
- 5 - Some believe Confucius invented the game - Historians say that the three dragon tiles represent the philosopher's teachings on the three essential virtues: sincerity, filial piety, and humaneness.

### Why We Love National Mahjong Day

- The game encourages many skills - Tactics, observation, memory, pattern recognition, and adaptive strategies are some of them. Playing and getting better at it can help us improve these skills, which can be very useful for our daily life.
- It's a chance to share Mahjong with others - Let's be honest: when you first look at the tiles, it seems way more complicated than it really is. But a good teacher can break that barrier. Teaching your friends and family how to play is a good bonding experience, and if they get good, you might get new rivals too!

- Mahjong is a way of connecting to Chinese culture - Broadening your horizons and learning about other cultures is always a great thing. You don't even need to read up on the history of Mahjong. Just by looking at the tiles, you're exposed to so much of China's culture, such as the Chinese language characters, flowers, landscapes, symbols, etc.

Want to play locally? Check out Mahjong Madness Mondays at the Ventnor Library, held May 4, 11 and 18 from 12:30 to 2:30 p.m., with beginner guidance provided for those who need it. The Mays Landing Library hosts Mahjong on Wednesday, May 6 from 12:30 to 4:30 p.m., or you can join in at Somers Point's Bored? Games! program, which includes Mahjong at the Somers Point Senior Center on May 6 and May 20 from 1 to 3 p.m. For the most current schedule and registration details, visit [atlanticcountylibrary.org](http://atlanticcountylibrary.org). On National Mahjong Day, it's worth finding out why this centuries-old tile game still inspires such loyal players: once the tiles hit the table, it's easy to see how strategy, luck and a little friendly competition can keep people coming back.

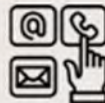

### Smithville Art Walk Returns Sunday, May 3rd

Smithville's spring calendar has no shortage of reasons to wander the village, but one of its most distinctive returns Sunday, May 3, when Art Walk takes over Historic Smithville from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Founded and hosted by Underground, Smithville Artwalk has grown into a biannual showcase built around pop and lowbrow art, bringing an unmistakably offbeat energy to one of South Jersey's most familiar destinations. This year's event will feature 75 artists, turning the day into a large-scale celebration of local creativity with a style that leans bold, playful, imaginative and anything but ordinary.

Admission and parking are free, which makes the event an easy add to the weekend for families, day-trippers and anyone already planning a stop in Smithville. For artists hoping to be part of a future show, organizers say those wishing to be considered can visit [SmithvilleArtwalk.com](http://SmithvilleArtwalk.com), where the vendor application is available at the bottom of the page. For everyone else, the message is simpler: come out, support local art and enjoy one of the Shore area's most original spring events. If ever there were a good excuse to shake off the routine, this is it. Fight the mundane. Art is a weapon.

Set at Historic Smithville Village, the event invites visitors to browse original work while moving through one of the area's most walkable settings. According to Historic Smithville, more than 75 local artists will be set up on the Greene near the red-covered bridge, creating an open-air gallery atmosphere that blends naturally with the village's shops, paths and weekend foot traffic. The official Artwalk page describes it as a curated gathering celebrating pop and lowbrow art in all forms, but it is designed to be more than a simple vendor event. Organizers also promote live music and additional entertainment, helping make the day feel less like a traditional craft fair and more like an immersive community happening built around artists, collectors and curious passersby alike.

What makes Artwalk stand out is that it does not aim for safe or predictable. The event has built its identity around work that is proudly unconventional, and that spirit is part of the draw. Whether you are a serious collector, a casual browser or someone just looking for a different kind of Saturday outing, the appeal is in the range of voices and styles gathered in one place. It is a chance to meet working artists, discover pieces you would never find in a big-box setting, and spend the day around art that is meant to provoke, amuse, surprise or simply make you stop and look twice. In an era when so many events start to blur together, Smithville Artwalk keeps leaning the other way.

We can't wait to experience the horse racing and historical traditions during the Kentucky Derby, which is held every first Saturday in May and falls on May 2 this year. On the face of it, the Kentucky Derby is just a horse race, however, it has gained legions of fans over the past 147 years that it has been running! As one of America's oldest sports, the Kentucky Derby is also known as the 'Most Exciting Two Minutes in Sports'. Spectators wear the most elaborate and unique outfits and indulge in a drink of mint julep. The winners of the race are awarded a trophy and prize money, as well as a huge garland of roses that weighs approximately 40 lbs!

### History of Kentucky Derby

The Kentucky Derby was first held in Churchill Downs in Louisville, Kentucky in 1875. Not only has the location of the race remained the same over the years but also the date on which it is held. The first Saturday of May is reserved for the races, and this year's Derby will be taking place on May 1. The week before the main races start is designated for preparing the horses, players, and the crowds, and it is called the Kentucky Derby Week.

The horses, which are three-year-old thoroughbreds, qualify for the Kentucky Derby by competing in races held all over the country. These races are also known as the Road to the Kentucky Derby and the top four competing horses are each awarded Derby qualifying points. Horses with the most qualifying points are entered into the Derby races with the top two spots reserved primarily for the European and Japanese Derby qualifying events.

Kentucky Derby traditions are quite quirky. Many show up to the event and its related activities wearing colorful hats. There's even a special display of Derby fashion at the Kentucky Derby Museum! Apart from this, people enjoy drinks of mint julep on this day, and it is estimated that around 120,000 mint juleps are consumed. Attendees sing and listen to 'My Old Kentucky Home' blaring on the event's speakers. The Kentucky Derby is considered a local holiday and its sister race, the Kentucky Oaks, taking place a day before the Derby, is also considered a holiday. The Kentucky Oaks is mainly centered around races between three-year-old fillies.

### Kentucky Derby Activities

- Go to the Kentucky Derby - Every year, hundreds of people turn up to watch the exciting races live. If you can, you should immerse yourself in the experience of the races by going to Kentucky and taking part in the traditions.
- Watch the Kentucky Derby - If you can't make it in person, no need to fret, as the Derby is televised every year. Gather your friends and family, bring out the snacks and the mint juleps, and just enjoy the races in the comfort of your own home.
- Read up on the history - There's much to be learned about the Kentucky Derby and the history attached to it. In addition to the general fanfare surrounding the jockeys and their horses, there are many traditions besides the mint juleps and the hats that you can learn about.



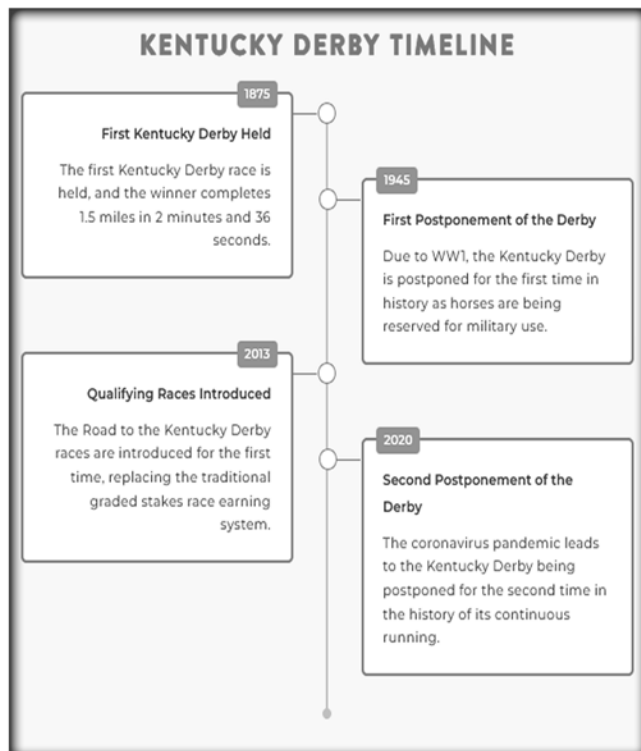
### 5 Facts About Horses That Will Blow Your Mind

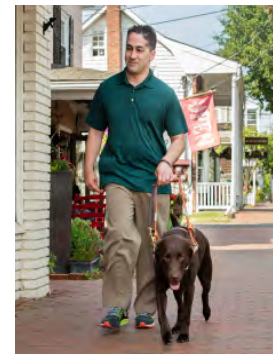
Keep Guide Dog Teams Safe!



Guide dogs work to help people who are blind safely navigate the world. It is crucial that pet owners keep their dogs at a safe distance away from a guide dog team. While it may seem harmless for pets to visit with a guide dog at work, that dog is responsible for leading someone who cannot see. Distracting the guide dog could jeopardize the safety of the handler.

### Please follow these tips to help keep guide dog teams safe:

- Please do not distract guide dogs. This includes calling the dog, making eye contact, feeding or petting the dog.
- Never let your pet be near a guide dog, even if leashed.
- It is helpful to greet a person who is blind and let them know you have a dog with you.
- Always speak to the handler directly and never touch the handler or the dog without the handler's permission.



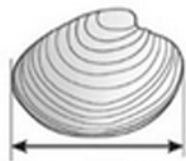

# Fishing in Atlantic County

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at [dep.nj.gov/njfw/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/](http://dep.nj.gov/njfw/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/). Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at [dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/](http://dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/).

## SALTWATER FISHING

**Atlantic City** - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



**Ventnor/Ventnor Heights** - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

**Margate** - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

**Somers Point** - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

**Brigantine** - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

**Leeds Point** - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Graveling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

## FRESHWATER FISHING

**Lake Lenape Park** - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

**Lake Lenape Park East** - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

**Lake Lenape Park West** - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.
