Soar & Shore Airshow Returns to Atlantic City



Three days of jets, warbirds, and beachfront viewing along the Boardwalk

Atlantic City's Soar & Shore Airshow presented by Visit Atlantic City returns May 29-31, 2026, bringing three full days of flying over the beach and Boardwalk. The event is being promoted as the second annual Soar & Shore weekend and the unofficial start of the summer season, with performances scheduled daily from noon to 3 p.m. and no practice days built into the program. General admission is free, and Show Center will again be set in front of Bally's Atlantic City Hotel & Casino, between Michigan Avenue and Park Place, putting spectators right in the center of the flight line.

That three-day format is part of what sets the event apart. Rather than building everything around a single afternoon, Soar & Shore turns the airshow into a full weekend attraction, giving visitors multiple chances to catch the action and businesses a longer runway for boardwalk activity, sponsorships, and exhibitor opportunities. Visit Atlantic City is promoting not only the performances themselves, but also partner, vendor, sponsor, and exhibitor opportunities tied to the event.



What's in the Sky

The 2026 lineup blends modern military hardware with aerobatics and vintage aircraft. Among the announced performers are the USAF F-22 Raptor Demo, USAF F-16C Fighting Falcons, and the USMC F-35B Lightning II Demo Team, giving the show a strong front-line military presence. On the civilian and heritage side, the current roster also includes Wingwalker Sam, Wolf Pitts Pro flown by Paul Bennet, Nathan Hammond-GhostWriter, Warbird Thunder, the MiG-17F, P-40 Warhawk "Jacky C," and P-51 Mustang "Jacqueline." Visit Atlantic City notes that more announcements are still to come, so the lineup may continue to grow closer to race weekend.

That mix should give the weekend a little of everything: high-speed military jet demonstrations over the ocean, precision aerobatics, formation flying, and classic warbirds that bring a different kind of roar to the beachfront. The F-22, F-35B, and F-16 will likely be the biggest draws for many spectators, but the historic aircraft and aerobatic acts are what give the show texture and keep it from feeling like one long sequence of flyovers.

Premium Seating and VIP Options

For people who want more than a beach blanket and a view from the sand, the airshow's premium ticket options add comfort and a few practical perks. Both ticketed hospitality areas are located on the beach at Show Center, directly in front of Bally's, and both operate daily from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., opening two hours before the flying begins and staying open after the performances end. Visit Atlantic City describes them as limited-capacity, tented seating areas with premium sightlines to the main event area.



The Dolphin Club is the simpler of the two packages. It includes a spacious tented shade area with tables and chairs, complimentary non-alcoholic beverages, premium viewing along the flightline, and access to non-public portable washrooms. Children four and under are free when accompanied by a ticketed adult.

The Viper Club is the more upgraded option. It includes the same shaded seating, flightline viewing, and access to non-public washrooms, but adds a catered premium lunch served from noon to 1 p.m. and complimentary beer, hard seltzers, and non-alcoholic beverages. The current posted Viper Club menu includes a taco bar with adobo pulled chicken, seasoned beef, and pork carnitas, along with a cheesesteak bar with ribeye and chicken options. Like the Dolphin Club, children four and under are admitted free with a ticketed adult. Both ticket types are sold by day, space is limited, and the site states that all sales are final.

Beyond the Boardwalk

The weekend is not limited to the beach. On Friday, May 29, the airshow will also host a free Meet & Greet at the Signature Area of Atlantic City International Airport from 5 to 7 p.m. The event will feature civilian airshow performers, photo opportunities with pilots and aircraft, food trucks, giveaways, and complimentary parking. For anyone who wants more than a distant view from the shoreline, it is a chance to connect with the people behind the performances and see some of the aircraft up close.

Taken together, the airshow is shaping up as more than just a few hours of flying. It is a three-day beachfront event with free public viewing, two levels of premium seating, a separate airport meet-and-greet, and a lineup that balances military firepower with aerobatic showmanship and warbird nostalgia. For Atlantic City, that means another big visual weekend on the Boardwalk.

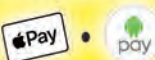

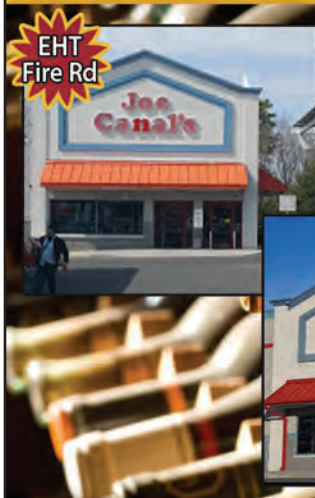

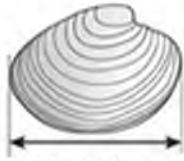

Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



Ventnor/Ventnor Heights - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

Somers Point - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

Brigantine - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Graveling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Memorial Day on May 25 conjures images of hamburgers, hot dogs, swimming pools, boating, and summertime for many Americans. But the last Monday in May serves, most importantly, as a time to honor those who died while fighting in the U.S. Armed Forces. It's a holiday steeped in American history and tradition. The day actually began as "Decoration Day," following the Civil War, when mourners placed flowers on the graves of Union and Confederate soldiers. Over time, Memorial Day has also come to signify the "unofficial" start of summer.

History of Memorial Day

The Civil War ended in the spring of 1865 when Robert E. Lee surrendered the last major Confederate army to Ulysses S. Grant at the Appomattox Court House on April 9. Over 620,000 soldiers died in the four-year conflict. General John A. Logan of the Grand Army of the Republic (an organization of Union veterans) would eventually select May 30, 1868, as a day to pay tribute to the fallen:

"The 30th of May, 1868, is designated for the purpose of strewing with flowers, or otherwise decorating the graves of comrades who died in defense of their country during the late rebellion, and whose bodies now lie in almost every city, village, and hamlet churchyard in the land..."

Logan apparently chose May 30 because flowers would be in bloom all over the country. By the end of the 19th century, Memorial Day ceremonies were being held on May 30 throughout the nation. States passed proclamations, and the Army and Navy adopted rules for proper observance at their facilities.

The crowd attending the first Memorial Day ceremony at Arlington National Cemetery was approximately the same size as those that attend today's observance - about 5,000 people. Small American flags were placed on each grave - a tradition still followed at many national cemeteries today. In recent years, the custom has grown in many families to decorate the graves of all departed loved ones.

By 1890, each Northern state had made Decoration Day an official holiday. But this was not the case in the South, where states continued to honor their dead on separate days until after the First World War.

The May 30 date held for decades. But, in 1968, Congress passed the Uniform Monday Holiday Act, which established Memorial Day as the last Monday in May in order to create a three-day weekend for federal employees. The change took place in 1971. The same law also declared Memorial Day a federal holiday.



Traditions of the Day

Many Americans observe Memorial Day by visiting cemeteries or memorials, holding family gatherings, and participating in parades. It's the three-day weekend that kicks off the summer season and the time for hanging out at the beach and lakes, and barbecuing with friends and family. But Memorial Day is also the most solemn American holiday - a day to remember those who made the ultimate sacrifice while defending their nation.

Towns and cities across the country host grand Memorial Day parades every year, often featuring senior veterans and military personnel. Some of the biggest parades take place in New York, Chicago, and Washington, D.C. Cemeteries and memorials are also visited by Americans, with some citizens wearing or holding red poppies to symbolize those who have fallen in war. This tradition has been around since World War I. Weekend trips and parties are also arranged to balance out the somberness of the day and welcome the summer.

By the Numbers

- 620,000 - the number of soldiers who died on both sides of the Civil War.
- 1868 - the year when President James Garfield delivered a very long speech on Memorial Day.
- \$1.5 billion - the number of dollars typically spent on meat and seafood in preparation for Memorial Day weekend.
- 60% - the percentage of American households who attend or host a BBQ on this day.
- 1.5 million - the number of people who watch the National Memorial Day Parade.
- 2500 - the number of motorcyclists who participated in the first Rolling Thunder rally.
- 900,000 - the number of people who gathered for the Rolling Thunder Memorial Day motorcycle rally in 2019.
- 260,000 - the # of graves at Arlington National Cemetery adorned with flags.
- 45 million - the # of men and women who have served in a time of war for the U.S.
- 3 P.M. - the time of day when a moment of silence is observed by Americans throughout the country on this day.

How to Observe Memorial Day

- Pay your respects - Lay flowers on the grave of a family member or friend who died while serving. If you don't personally know any fallen soldiers, visit a local cemetery anyway. After all, they made the ultimate sacrifice for you.
- Participate in the National Moment of Remembrance - By doing so, you'll be joining millions of Americans in national unity to honor Memorial Day for what it truly is - a day to remember those who laid down their lives in service of their country and its citizens.
- Fly the flag - If you have an American flag at home, be sure to fly it at half-mast until noon, then raise it to full mast for the rest of the day. The practice of lowering and then raising the flag has been observed for over 100 years to symbolize America's persistence in the face of loss.

Ingredients:

Cake:

- 15.25 oz box of white cake mix
- 1 cup boiling water
- 3 oz box of strawberry flavored Jell-o
- 1/2 cup cold water

Frosting:

- 8 oz tub Cool-Whip whipped topping
- 8 oz package cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup powdered sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla

Keep Guide Dog Teams Safe!



Guide dogs work to help people who are blind safely navigate the world. It is crucial that pet owners keep their dogs at a safe distance away from a guide dog team. While it may seem harmless for pets to visit with a guide dog at work, that dog is responsible for leading someone who cannot see. Distracting the guide dog could jeopardize the safety of the handler.

Please follow these tips to help keep guide dog teams safe:

- Please do not distract guide dogs. This includes calling the dog, making eye contact, feeding or petting the dog.
- Never let your pet be near a guide dog, even if leashed.
- It is helpful to greet a person who is blind and let them know you have a dog with you.
- Always speak to the handler directly and never touch the handler or the dog without the handler's permission.

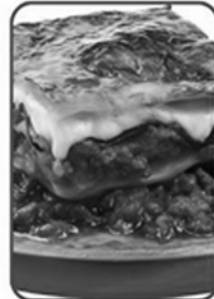
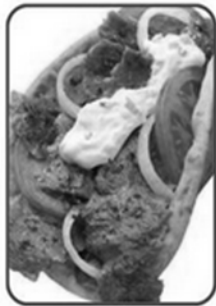

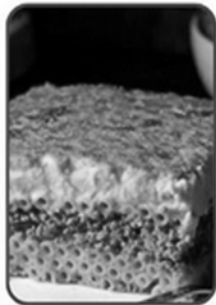

ARE ESSENTIAL OIL DIFFUSERS OR INCENCE SAFE AROUND PETS?

I had a concern about our pets and so I did some research and one of the essential oils that could be dangerous was tea tree oil. Now I have extended my research.

According to Dr. Tina Wismer, medical director, ASPCA Animal Poison Control Center, there are several warnings in relation to essential oils. She said the following:

“unless pets have respirator issues, skin exposure is more dangerous than inhalation. Pets can absorb topically applied oils through the skin or ingest them orally when they groom themselves. While there are some products made for pets, like flea control products that contain essential oils, these are low concentrations that are safe for pets, usually .1% to 1%. Use those products only as directed. Cats are much more sensitive to toxins because they have fewer metabolizing enzymes in their liver compared to dogs.” (I just discovered that unopened tiger lily buds are edible for humans. They are actually considered an Asian delicacy. However, every part of a tiger lily plant is toxic to cats. If you think that your cat has ingested any part of the plant check with poison control. It can cause kidney failure.)

Some companies make dog specific or cat specific products that can be used on both cats and dogs. Unless you verify with the company, never use a dog specific product on a cat. Dr. Wismer points out that cats are especially sensitive to essential oils, subjecting them to possible gastrointestinal upset, central nervous system depression and even liver damage if ingested in significant quantities. Inhalation of the oils could lead to aspiration pneumonia. The signs that a dog or cat may be experiencing distress are drooling, vomiting, coughing, and sneezing. Diffusing oils can be fatal to dogs or cats who have asthma or other serious respiratory conditions.

Various oils have degrees of toxicity. The ones in particular to avoid around pets are wintergreen, citrus, pine, cinnamon, pennyroyal, eucalyptus, and tea tree. It is advisable to use your diffuser in a well-ventilated area and not for long periods of time. (<https://lifehacker.com>). Another source “daily read” lists the following oils to be avoided around cats or dogs and to test by using a few drops for fifteen-minute intervals to see if the pet has a reaction. For cats; citrus, grapefruit, lemon, orange, birch, cinnamon, clove, oregano, tea tree, thyme, and wintergreen. For dogs; garlic, horseradish, clove, wintergreen, thyme, juniper, and anise.

I presently do not use any diffusers. Once in a while I will burn a stick of Nag Champa incense. Sadly, I just checked with google and the smoke and aromatic compounds can cause severe respiratory irritation, especially with pets that have asthma or other respiratory issues. Ingestion can be poisonous. The compounds can trigger headaches, nausea, or even seizures in small animals. I use a superior quality product “free from metal and harmful chemicals.” Still, I am advised to use it only in a well-ventilated area with the aid of a fan to disperse the smoke. Apparently, one needs to check everything!

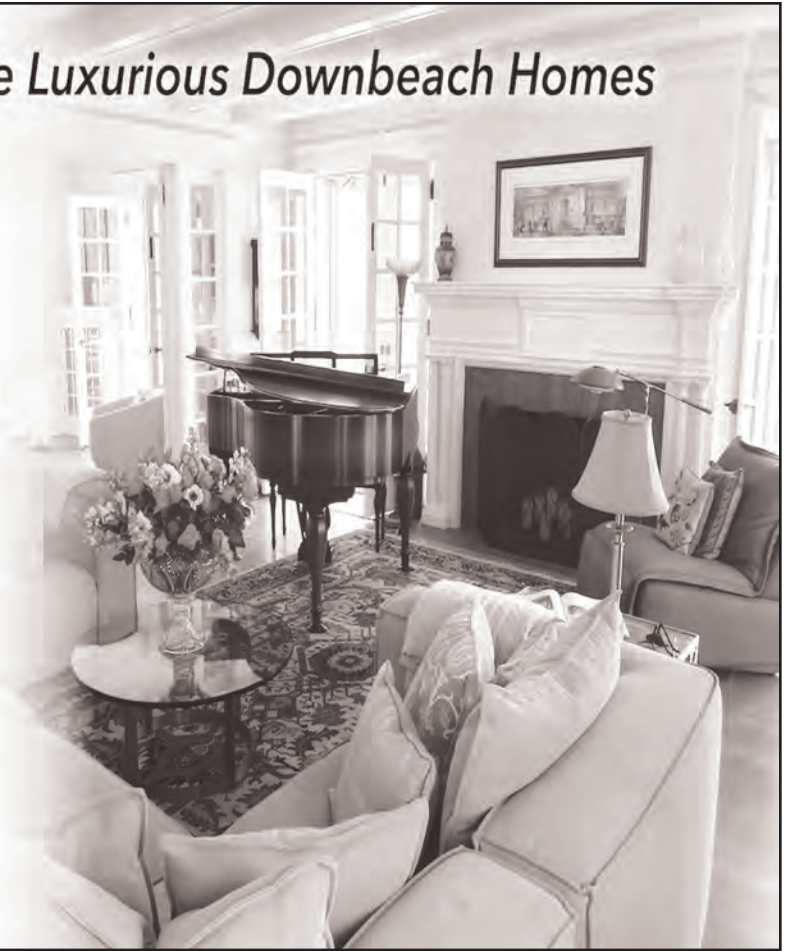
