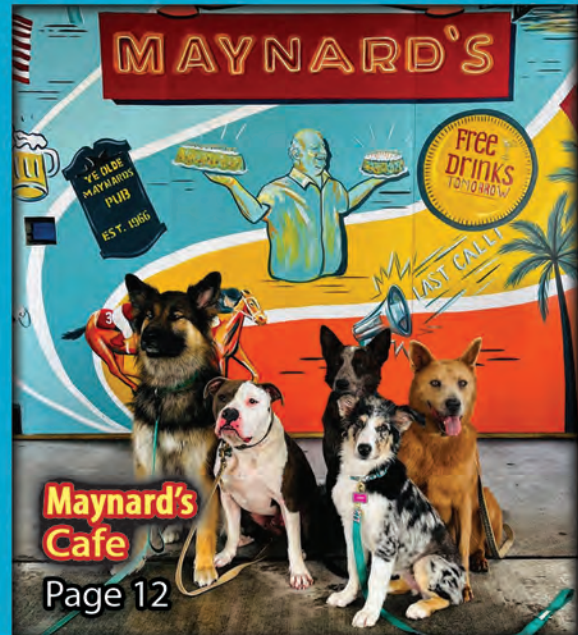

Join the celebration of the U.S. Army Birthday on June 14 as we remember its creation in 1775. The army originally consisted of volunteer soldiers with roots to the Continental Army - and was formed to fight the Revolutionary War. Today, as the largest branch of the U.S. military, the proud men and women of the U.S. Army continue to provide peace and security for all of us.

**History of Army Birthday**

The U.S. Army is 245 years old, and counting. That's a LOT of birthday candles! The annual celebration marks the date in history in 1775 when the Continental Army was formed by the Second Continental Congress and commanded under General George Washington to fight against Britain.

Of course, the U.S. Army wasn't always the strongest military in the world as it is today. The original 'army' was formed from volunteer soldiers, amateur troops, and minutemen, who just had the passion and dedication to defend their land against the British. Actually, military forces existed in the United States before the country even formally existed. Independent colonial armies commanded inexperienced militia.

The Revolutionary War started in America on April 19, 1775, with exchanges of musketry between Massachusetts militiamen and British regulars at Lexington and Concord. As soldiers were alerted in Connecticut, Rhode Island, and New Hampshire, they responded to the alarm, and a state of war was in the air between the British government and the four colonies. Called the Army of Observation, a force of New Englanders surrounded Boston and had the British troops who occupied it under siege, but they needed help. Delegate representatives of all 13 colonies were approached and requested to join them in the battle for American liberty.

When the Continental Army delegates assembled on May 10 in Philadelphia, they learned that British forts at Ticonderoga and Crown Point on Lake Champlain in New York were captured by armed men led by Benedict Arnold and Ethan Allen. The situation quickly turned into a crisis, as the delegates realized that the military coup would need to be addressed if the desired reconciliation was to happen. The next step was taken by the Congress, which eventually transformed the small rebellion into a full war for independence. The establishment of the Continental Army resulted in the U.S. Army that we know today.

There was a time when there were never more than 48,000 Continental soldiers. Today, the United States Army boasts over one million soldiers on duty, with an additional 800,000 Reserve- and National Guard members.

The resilience of the U.S. Army and its history is a testimony to how integral the military is in peacekeeping. Gratitude is expressed tremendously on the Army's Birthday with events and ceremonies.

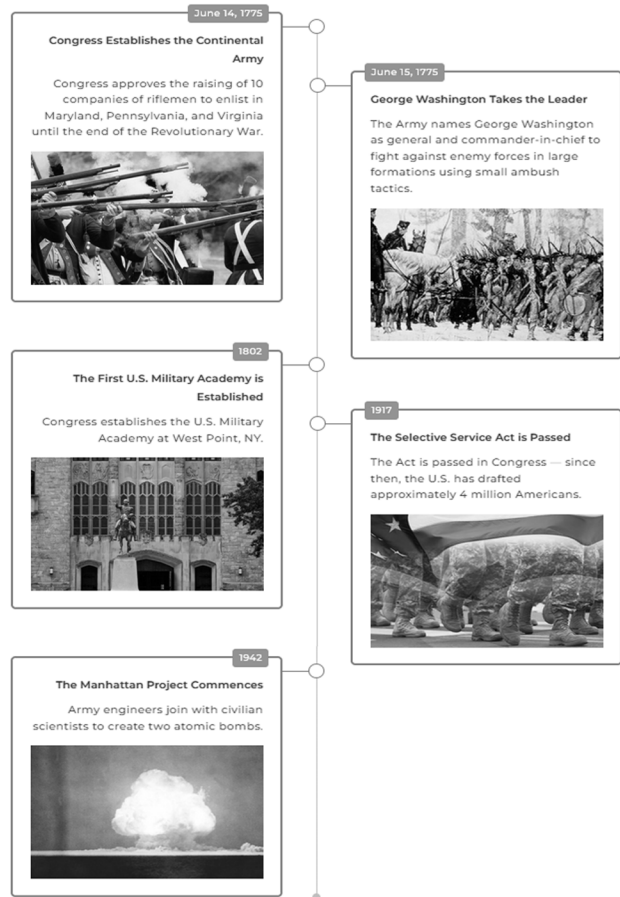
**Traditions of the Day**

There are many annual traditions and ceremonies that honor the past and salute the efforts of the U.S. Army. The sacrifices of soldiers who put their lives on the line to protect the country are recognized and re-enacted in schools, and some local theatres.

Cake cutting ceremonies are hosted at both Capitol Hill and the Pentagon, a tradition that has been honored over time. An Army saber is used for cutting the cake by the highest and lowest ranking officials. This is to set in stone the teamwork and brotherhood of the Army. The cake cutting tradition is a fun one, with the cake cutters getting extra enthusiastic - broken tables and flying icing are not uncommon.

It is also tradition to show the world how solid the U.S. Army is. Formation runs take place around the world, with units carrying their colors on parade fields at dawn before beginning work for the day.

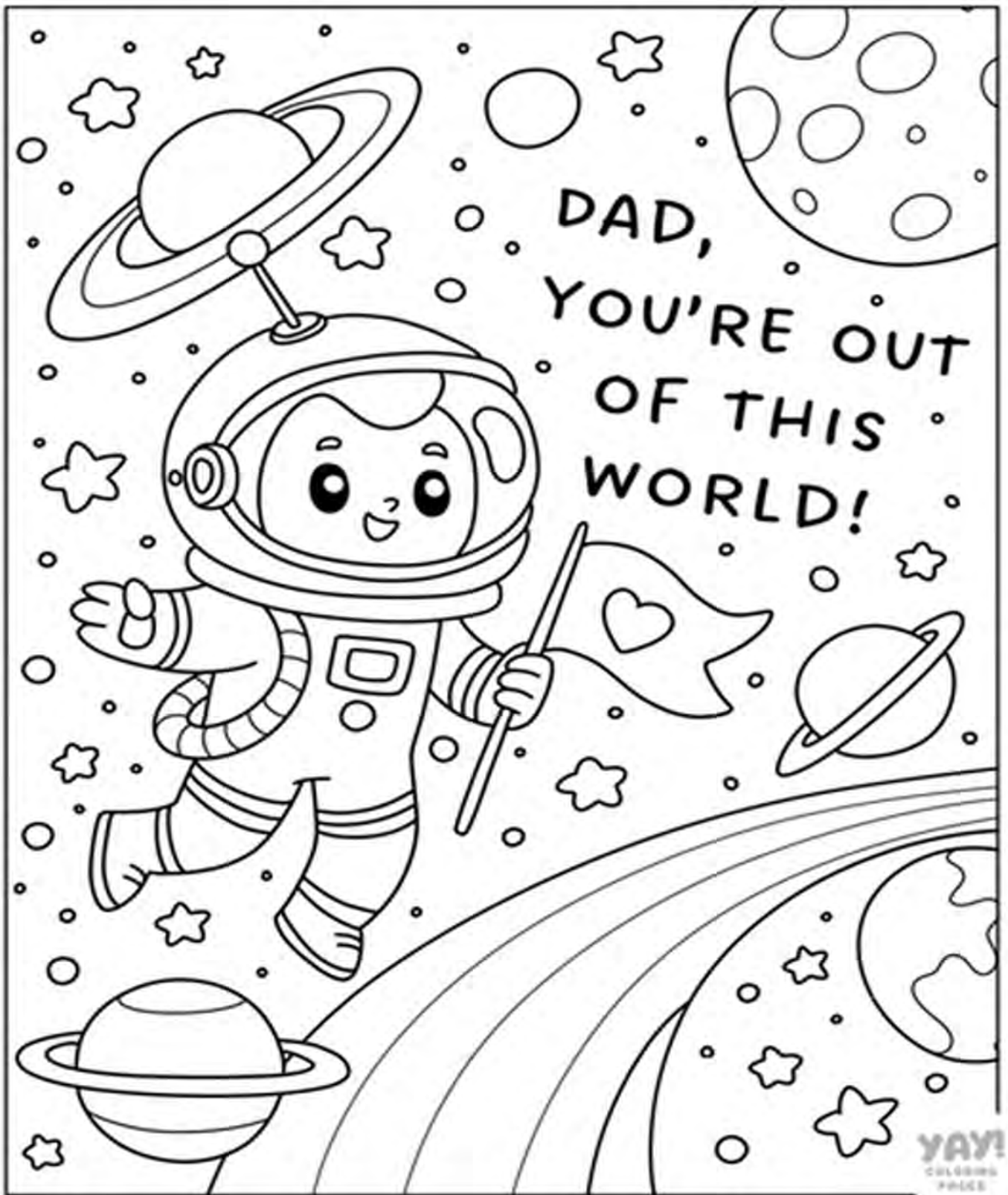

- Just say "hello" - You might know one or two of the 20.4 million living U.S. veterans. Even if you don't, take the opportunity to seek out a veteran and offer gratitude for their service.

Greater Atlantic City Concierge Association's Spotlight:  
**Golfing Around Atlantic City**

Many avid golfers engage in year-round golfing, with some even traveling to warmer climates solely for the purpose of playing. However, as the warmer weather arrives, it may be beneficial to have a list of golf courses in Atlantic County where you can practice your swing. While there are nine golf courses available in this region, here are highlights of the top four.

Harbor Pines Golf Club in Egg Harbor Township is a favorite among public golfers in southern New Jersey since its opening in 1996. Located 15 miles from Atlantic City's boardwalk and casinos, the course offers a beautiful, challenging layout designed by Stephen Kay and Doug Smith. The parkland-style course features five sets of tee boxes and generous fairways, ensuring an enjoyable round for all skill levels. The holes play in various directions, providing plenty of variety. Hole no. 9, "Escape," is the toughest par 4 due to its length and precision required to avoid water and trees. The course's distinctive bunkering includes the long Sand Creek bunker on the par-5 7th hole and the enormous half-acre sand pit on the par-4 17th hole. The undulating greens present big targets with multiple pin placements. Harbor Pines Golf Club also boasts extensive practice facilities and a lively Grill Room restaurant, making it a premier place to play in Atlantic County.



Seaview Golf Resort, a Troon Golf-managed facility, in Galloway, is a premier golf destination in the Northeast. Steeped in history and tradition, it offers 36 holes of Championship Golf on two historic courses. The Bay Course, designed by Donald Ross, has undergone a bunker restoration, re-turfed fescue mounds, and improved drainage. The Pines Course, with its scenic parkland setting, also benefited from a bunker restoration, tree removal, and a cart path upgrade. The resort's vibrant golf shop, recognized as one of the top golf shops in the country, received a facelift. It offers a wide selection of equipment, apparel, and accessories for golfers of all ages. Seaview provides an unmatched golfing experience for various occasions, including day trips, weekend getaways, group outings, and bachelor parties. Its unique Family Golf Program allows families to play 9 holes together from the "family tees," offering a fun and cost-effective alternative to other entertainment options.



Brigantine Golf Links, a historic and unique links course owned by the City of Brigantine Beach, New Jersey, is a must-play for anyone near Atlantic City. Built in 1927 by Wayne Stile and Jon Van Kleek, it spreads out on a barrier island just across the bay. It's the closest layout to the iconic Boardwalk and casinos. Renowned for its value, the course has been restored to its original links heritage. The nearly treeless course features four sets of tee markers, offering distance options from 5,053 to 6,507 yards. The wide open, gently rolling terrain includes natural dunes, berms, marshes, creeks, ponds, and tidal inlets. Wind significantly impacts the game. The course boasts par 3s and reachable par 5s for scoring. Its small, undulating greens are praised for being among the finest putting surfaces in Southern New Jersey. Brigantine Golf Links is a shot maker's course that truly captures the essence of the original Scottish game. Opportunities to hit creative bump-and-run shots on the land's mounds and contours add to the fun. You'll see plenty of birdlife and wildlife on this National Audubon Sanctuary. Walking in historic footprints, you'll be on the course where legendary golfers Walter Hagen and Harry Vardon practiced before competing in the Open Championship. The course lacks a driving range but has a putting green for practice. The clubhouse features a pro shop and snack area. For an authentic links experience near the Atlantic City Boardwalk, make a tee time at Brigantine Golf Links.



Blue Heron Pines Golf Club, a celebrated South Jersey golf destination since 1993, located in Egg Harbor City, was designed by Stephen Kay to complement the natural beauty of Atlantic County's Pinelands. The course features majestic tree lines, water features, strategic bunkering, and scenic depth, making each round unique. Recognized as one of the best 18-hole courses at the Jersey Shore, it challenges experienced players while welcoming golfers of all skill levels. As a semi-private club, it's open to both members and public players. Each hole presents a different challenge, from tree-lined fairways requiring accuracy to water hazards demanding thoughtful club selection and course management. Strategically placed sand traps protect the greens and reward correct approaches, while consistently smooth and well-maintained greens offer a true roll that rewards golfers who control their speed and trajectory. With each visit, players learn to know where to miss, which pins to attack, and when to play conservatively, gaining a genuine advantage.

Located in Northfield, NJ, just 6 miles from the Boardwalk, the historic Atlantic City Country Club is a premier, semi-private daily-fee course. Opened in 1897 and updated by Tom Doak in 1999, it stretches to 6,577 yards (Par 70) and is famously known as the "Birthplace of the Birdie." It has hosted six USGA Championships and has seen legends like Arnold Palmer, Bob Hope, and Frank Sinatra walk its fairways. It features challenging marshland carries, large undulating greens, and deep bunkers, all framed by the skyline of Atlantic City in the background.

Now get out there and enjoy the links!



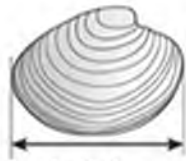

## Fishing in Atlantic County

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at [dep.nj.gov/nj-fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/](http://dep.nj.gov/nj-fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/). Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at [dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/](http://dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/).

### SALTWATER FISHING

**Atlantic City** - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



**Ventnor/Ventnor Heights** - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

**Margate** - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

**Somers Point** - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

**Brigantine** - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

**Leeds Point** - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Graveling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

### FRESHWATER FISHING

**Lake Lenape Park** - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

**Lake Lenape Park East** - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

**Lake Lenape Park West** - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.

## YOGA POSE OF THE WEEK - Downward Facing Dog Split

Keep your hips squared with the floor, while reaching the opposite heel toward the ground.



## VITAMIN HIGHLIGHT - Vitamin A

One type comes from animal sources of food. It helps you see at night, make red blood cells, and fight off infections. The other type is in plant foods. It helps prevent damage to cells and an eye problem called age-related macular degeneration. (But too much vitamin A can hurt your liver.) Eat orange veggies and fruits like sweet potato and cantaloupe, spinach and other greens, dairy foods, and seafood such as shrimp and salmon.

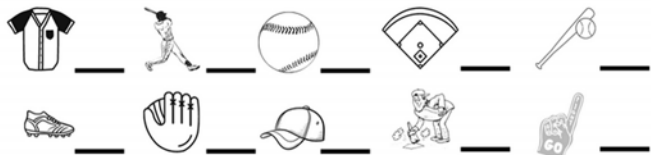

## Jersey Strawberry & Snap Pea Salad

### INGREDIENTS

- 4 cups mixed greens or baby arugula
- 1 cup Jersey strawberries, hulled and sliced
- 1 cup sugar snap peas, trimmed and sliced in half
- ½ cup crumbled goat cheese or feta
- ¼ cup chopped pecans, walnuts or almonds
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 tablespoon balsamic vinegar
- 1 teaspoon honey
- Salt and pepper, to taste



### DIRECTIONS

In a large bowl, combine the greens, strawberries and snap peas. In a small bowl, whisk together the olive oil, balsamic vinegar, honey, salt and pepper. Drizzle over the salad and toss gently. Top with cheese and nuts just before serving. **Quick tip:** Add grilled chicken, shrimp or a scoop of quinoa to turn it into a light lunch or dinner.

## Strawberry Basil Lemonade Spritzer

### INGREDIENTS

- 1 cup Jersey Fresh strawberries, hulled and sliced
- 6 fresh basil leaves
- 1 tablespoon honey or sugar
- ½ cup lemonade
- ½ cup sparkling water or club soda
- Ice
- Lemon slices, for garnish



### DIRECTIONS

In a glass or small pitcher, muddle the strawberries, basil and honey until the berries release their juices. Add lemonade and stir well. Fill a glass with ice, pour the strawberry mixture over top and finish with sparkling water. Garnish with a lemon slice and extra basil. **Pro Tip:** Make it a cocktail: Add a splash of vodka or prosecco for an easy farmers market happy hour drink.

## Paddle For A Cause Celebrates 20th Anniversary on June 13th



The Dean Randazzo Cancer Foundation will celebrate a major milestone on Saturday, June 13, when its 20th anniversary Paddle For A Cause returns to Ski Beach in Ventnor City.

One of the foundation's signature fundraisers, Paddle For A Cause brings together paddlers of all skill levels for a day of endurance, community and support for individuals and families affected by cancer. The event is held alongside the foundation's other major fundraiser, Surf For A Cause, which takes place each September.

Racers will set off at 7 a.m. for the signature 22.5-mile paddleboard journey around Absecon Island. A shorter, beginner-friendly course will also be offered, giving more participants the chance to take part. Throughout the day, spectators and participants can enjoy live entertainment, food, giveaways, vendors and a festive waterfront atmosphere at Ski Beach. The 2026 event is presented by DeSatnick Real Estate, whose continued support helps make the milestone fundraiser possible.



The Dean Randazzo Cancer Foundation was founded after professional surfer Dean Randazzo was diagnosed with Hodgkin's lymphoma while at the height of his surfing career. Randazzo, widely recognized as New Jersey's most successful surfer, struggled with whether to share his diagnosis publicly out of concern that it could affect the sponsorships supporting his career. In 2001, he told the world at the U.S. Open of Surfing and decided to dedicate his efforts to helping others.

The Dean Randazzo Cancer Foundation was established on Sept. 5, 2001. Just 10 days later, the inaugural Surf For A Cause was held in Margate, raising more than \$20,000. Dean's mother, Mary Lou Randazzo, hosted the first after party in her backyard.

Since then, the foundation has grown into a year-round nonprofit dedicated to promoting cancer awareness and providing financial support to people battling cancer and their families. Over the years, events including Paddle For A Cause, Surf For A Cause, Freeze For A Cause and Golf For A Cause have helped keep that mission active in the community.

Since its inception, DRCF has donated more than \$500,000 to individuals battling cancer and their families. The foundation also provides grants to local organizations, including the Ruth Newman Shapiro Cancer Fund, Shore Medical Center Cancer Center, Gilda's Club of South Jersey, The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society of South Jersey, Cape Regional Cancer Center and AtlantiCare Cancer Center.

More than 90 percent of funds raised go directly to the purposes for which the organization was formed, and the foundation remains volunteer-run, with no paid board members or employees.

This year, the mission is also reaching supporters in a new way. The foundation recently announced a collaboration with Yards Brewing Company and Harrison Beverage called Buy A Beer For A Cause. Through the partnership, a portion of Yards Philadelphia Pale Ale sales at participating bars, restaurants and liquor stores across Atlantic and Cape May counties will benefit DRCF. For each case sold, Yards and Harrison Beverage will each donate 50 cents to the foundation.



The campaign gives supporters another simple way to give back. Whether someone is paddling around Absecon Island, cheering from Ski Beach, volunteering, sponsoring or ordering a pint at a local establishment, each effort helps support families facing cancer.

For the paddlers, the event is a physical challenge. For the families helped by the foundation, it is something much bigger. Paddle For A Cause turns a day on the water into direct support, carrying forward the foundation's mission one paddle stroke at a time.

## GUIDE DOG AT WORK

Keep Guide Dog Teams Safe!



Guide dogs work to help people who are blind safely navigate the world. It is crucial that pet owners keep their dogs at a safe distance away from a guide dog team. While it may seem harmless for pets to visit with a guide dog at work, that dog is responsible for leading someone who cannot see. Distracting the guide dog could jeopardize the safety of the handler.

### Please follow these tips to help keep guide dog teams safe:

- Please do not distract guide dogs. This includes calling the dog, making eye contact, feeding or petting the dog.
- Never let your pet be near a guide dog, even if leashed.
- It is helpful to greet a person who is blind and let them know you have a dog with you.
- Always speak to the handler directly and never touch the handler or the dog without the handler's permission.

### PEDAL FOR PUPPIES SUPPORTS THE SEEING EYE

And they're off!

Pedal for Puppies has officially begun, sending three cyclists on a coast-to-coast ride in support of The Seeing Eye and the life-changing guide dogs who help people who are blind or have low vision live with greater independence, confidence and mobility.

The ride is led by Jim Freiss, Glenn Morse and Victor Fassano of Puppy Ride Long Island. Their journey is also a personal tribute to Jim's late brother, John, a graduate of The Seeing Eye, and John's Seeing Eye dog, Hero. After seeing the freedom and confidence his brother gained through that partnership, Jim turned his love of endurance cycling into a way to give back.

This year's Pedal for Puppies effort is the team's most ambitious ride yet, covering more than 4,000 miles from Seaside, Oregon, to Montauk, New York. The cross-country ride is expected to take nearly two months, with supporters able to follow along, cheer the riders on and take part in related events throughout the journey.

Pedal for Puppies is designed so anyone can join the team, no matter where they live or how they ride. Cyclists can participate outdoors, on trails or roads, indoors on a stationary bike, or through platforms such as Peloton. Supporters can also start a fundraiser, make a donation, share their own riding progress or join the Pedal for Puppies community online.

Founded in 1929 and based in Morristown, New Jersey, The Seeing Eye breeds, raises and trains Seeing Eye dogs to guide people who are blind or have low vision. The organization also teaches graduates how to properly handle and care for their dogs, creating partnerships that support active, independent lives.

What began as a personal tribute has grown into a major fundraising effort. Through Puppy Ride Long Island, riders have logged more than 15,500 miles and raised more than \$305,000 to support The Seeing Eye's mission. Those who join Pedal for Puppies are helping continue that mission one mile at a time. Riders and supporters are encouraged to tag The Seeing Eye and use #PedalForPuppies to share their progress and help spread the word.

## THE USE OF STEROIDS LIKE PREDNISONE IN DOGS

I had an epiphany the other day about my Maltese and what happens to her skin approximately once a month. Zoey's skin gets quite inflamed, hot, and very itchy. Was it something the groomer used? But that was every 6 to 8 weeks. And then I realized it was the 28-day shot of Prednisone that both Zoey and Ebby are given for their Addison's Disease. They also take oral Prednisone every day as prescribed. When Zoey started reacting this time, I generously wetted her back and belly with Dr. Richard's Incredible Skin Spray, patted her with a clean towel just to remove any excess, and put a light cotton doggy tee shirt over her. (see pic) Then I gave her a small piece of Benadryl. I repeated this the next morning and night. She got relief and the heat, redness, and itching subsided. Then I googled the following: Could there be a connection between my Maltese getting her monthly Prednisone shot and having a terrible skin reaction?

The answer: Yes, there is a strong connection between the Prednisone injection and your Maltese's symptoms. While steroids are used to treat itching, they can cause paradoxical reactions or significant secondary issues in susceptible dogs, particularly in breeds like the Maltese. Potential reasons for her terrible itching, redness, and heat include:

**\*STEROID-INDUCED SKIN THINNING:** Corticosteroids can cause the epidermis and dermis to thin out, making the skin highly sensitive and prone to scaling or peeling, which leads to intense itching. (I haven't noticed this with Zoey. Ebby does get dry skin even though I give them daily doses of Ultra Oil skin supplement.)

**\*SECONDARY INFECTIONS:** Prednisone suppresses the immune system. In the days or weeks following a shot, this suppression can unmask or worsen hidden bacterial skin infections or yeast overgrowth, which causes severe itching, redness, and inflammation. (Bingo!)

**\*CALCINOSIS CUTIS:** This is a known, though less common, adverse reaction where calcium crystals deposit into the skin due to high levels of steroids. It causes firm sometimes pink or yellowish plaques (crystal deposits) that are highly irritated, red, and warm. (I have not seen.)

**\*HEAT INTOLERANCE & INCREASED BLOOD FLOW:** Steroids like Prednisone can cause water retention, hot flashes, and noticeable heat sensations. I asked Google for more information on noticeable heat sensations. Heat intolerance, elevated metabolic rate, higher resting temperature, and heavy restless panting. (This would be more Ebby's reaction than Zoey's.)

Other symptoms apparent in varying degrees are increased thirst and urination (both Ebby and Zoey), increased appetite and gaining weight (Ebby more.) Also, one may see behavioral changes like increased anxiety, lethargy, or aggression, and urinary infections. I have not.



The biggest sporting event in the world is here, and this time, South Jersey fans do not have to watch it from a distance.

The 2026 FIFA World Cup kicks off Thursday, June 11, in Mexico City, launching a 39-day tournament across the United States, Mexico and Canada. This year's tournament is the largest in World Cup history, expanding to 48 teams and 104 matches. For American fans, it is also a rare chance to experience the excitement of the world's game on home soil.

The United States opens play Friday, June 12, against Paraguay in Los Angeles. That match will be one of the early highlights for local fans, especially with Atlantic City hosting a free community celebration the same night. From 6 to 11 p.m., the Atlantic City Soccer Celebration will take over the green turf outside Showboat Resort at New Jersey Avenue and the Boardwalk. The family-friendly event includes a USA vs. Paraguay watch party, a large outdoor screen, sound system, pee-wee soccer, face painting, arts and crafts, inflatables, giveaways, music and more. Parking at Showboat will be waived for the first 75 vehicles that check in at the event.

For this region, the excitement gets even closer on Sunday, June 14, when Philadelphia hosts its first match of the tournament. Lincoln Financial Field, better known as The Linc, will be referred to during the World Cup as Philadelphia Stadium under FIFA's tournament naming rules. The first Philadelphia match features Côte d'Ivoire against Ecuador at 7 p.m., giving local fans a chance to see international soccer just over the bridge.



Philadelphia will host six matches total, including five group-stage games and a Round of 16 knockout match on Saturday, July 4. That Independence Day match is expected to be one of the city's signature sports moments of the summer, combining World Cup elimination soccer with the nation's 250th birthday celebration.

Even fans without tickets will have plenty of ways to be part of the atmosphere. Philadelphia's official FIFA Fan Festival will run at Lemon Hill in East Fairmount Park for all 39 days of the tournament. The free festival will include live match broadcasts, food and beverage vendors, music, cultural programming, interactive experiences and a marketplace featuring local makers. Registration is required, and access is first come, first served.

Atlantic City is also leaning into the tournament with soccer-themed events along the Boardwalk and beach. Beginning June 13, the Beach Soccer AC Summer Series will run weekends through July 19 in front of Stockton University's Esports Innovation Center, with no event on July 4. The free series will include beach soccer, pick-up games, youth clinics, skills stations, esports activations and match watch parties when games are scheduled.

Later in the tournament, Atlantic City Beach Festival & World Cup Watch Party will bring the action to the sand July 18 and 19 for the third-place match and World Cup Final. The beachfront event at 1 Atlantic Ocean will include giant screens, live Latin music, food trucks, concerts and a high-energy festival setting for the tournament's biggest weekend.



South Jersey fans can also look toward Camden later in June. SoccerFest26 will take place June 25-27 at Wiggins Waterfront Park, with large-screen match viewings, live music, international food, vendors, youth soccer activities and South Jersey wine and beer offerings. Additional activations are planned in nearby towns including Haddon Heights, Haddon Township, Glassboro, Collingswood, Burlington City and Haddonfield.

For those watching from home, every match will be available in English on FOX or FS1, with streaming through FOX One and the FOX Sports app. Spanish-language coverage will be available through Telemundo, Universo and Peacock.



The tournament runs through July 19, when the final will be played at New York New Jersey Stadium in East Rutherford. By then, the World Cup will have traveled across three countries, 16 host cities and countless watch parties, parks, beaches, bars and living rooms.

For South Jersey, the 2026 World Cup is more than a tournament on television. It is a summer-long celebration happening close enough to feel personal - in Philadelphia, on the Atlantic City Boardwalk, along the beach and wherever fans gather to cheer for the world's game.

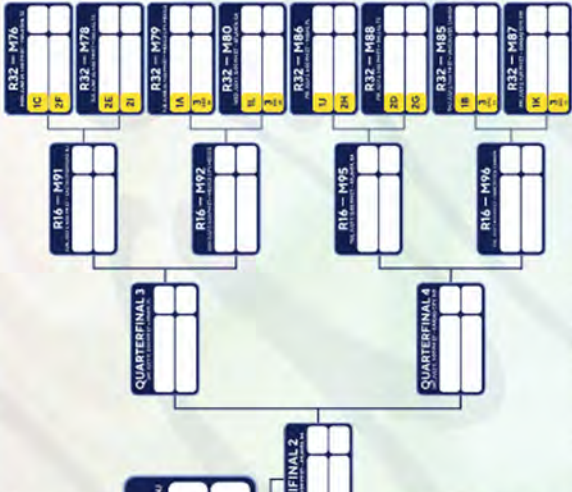
