#### Atlantic City Fight Nights: The Brawls Are Back on the Boardwalk

#### Boxing, grappling, and next-gen MMA light up the Shore July 25–26

There's something in the air on the Atlantic City boardwalk this summer - and it's not just the sea breeze or the sizzle of street vendors. It's the unmistakable energy of a fight town returning to form. From world-class boxing to elite submission grappling and a brand-new MMA showcase, July 25 and 26 mark a full-fledged combat sports takeover in America's original fight capital.

Whether you're a fan of fists flying, submissions snapping, or scouting the sport's next breakout star, this is the weekend Atlantic City fights back - and invites the crowd to scream along.

#### Friday, July 25 – Two Fight Cards, Two Different Worlds

#### Boxing Insider Fight Night @ Tropicana Showroom - 7:00 PM

At the Trop, the gloves come off - and then they go right back on. Boxing Insider Promotions returns to the Tropicana with a stacked lineup of professional bouts that bring both international firepower and homegrown heart.

In the main event, undefeated American flyweight Andy Dominguez (11–0) puts his perfect record on the line against seasoned Nicaraguan former world champion Byron "Gallito" Rojas (29–6–3). The WBC Silver Junior Flyweight Title is on the line in what promises to be a fast-paced, high-skill battle. Dominguez fights with the confidence of a prospect on the rise, while Rojas—gritty, technical, and battle-tested—has upset more than one unbeaten fighter before.





The undercard features familiar names for local fans. Bruce Seldon Jr., son of Atlantic City's own former heavyweight champ, looks to continue his journey in the sport his father once ruled from the very same town. Meanwhile, Julio Sanchez III, a proud product of Atlantic City's boxing scene, brings his signature aggression and fan-friendly style back to the local spotlight.

Also on the bill: Daiyaan Butt, a sharp Philly talent with slick hands and rising momentum, Jacob Solis, and heavyweights Roney Hines vs. Devin Vargas, a classic puncher's matchup that could end in a single swing.

#### CFFC BJJ 14 @ Hard Rock's Sound Waves - 7:00 PM

Just a few blocks away, things get quieter - but no less brutal.

Cage Fury Fighting Championships (CFFC) hosts its 14th Brazilian Jiu-Jitsu showcase in the intimate Sound Waves venue inside Hard Rock. Unlike MMA, there's no striking here - only the purest form of combat: grappling.

21 no-gi submission matches are scheduled, headlined by a marquee bout for the inaugural CFFC Light Heavyweight BJJ Championship. Wrestling legend Pat "PD3" Downey brings his explosive, unpredictable style against rising technician Luke Fernandez. Downey, a former NCAA All-American and world freestyle medalist, has taken the grappling world by storm with his aggressive flair. Fernandez, on the other hand, is all patience and precision - exactly the kind of game that can frustrate a brawler like Downey.




The card also includes black belts, brown belts, and top amateurs, with every match fought under submission-only rules and a focus on finishes. It's not a backyard tournament - it's jiu-jitsu dressed for the main stage, complete with walkouts, lighting, and a roaring crowd.

#### Saturday, July 26 — The Next Generation Takes the Stage CFFC Next Gen 1 @ Hard Rock's Sound Waves — 6:00 PM

On Saturday, CFFC returns to Sound Waves with a brand-new series aimed at spotlighting the future stars of MMA. Dubbed Next Gen, the promotion's debut installment features multiple amateur title fights, giving top young fighters a platform with pro-level production and real stakes.

While most amateur MMA shows are held in high school gyms or small civic halls, CFFC Next Gen 1 elevates the experience—giving fans a polished, fight-night atmosphere and giving athletes real exposure. Titles on the line include cruiser-weight, light heavyweight, and welterweight belts, with fighters drawn from elite regional gyms across the Northeast.

The promotion also offers fighters something rare at the amateur level: travel assistance, lodging, medical coverage, and the chance to compete on a platform that regularly feeds talent into the UFC. For many of these athletes, this night marks the beginning of something much bigger.



#### Atlantic City: Still a Fight Town

There was a time when boxing royalty walked the Boardwalk like kings. Tyson, Holmes, Gatti - they all fought here. And while the national spotlight may have dimmed, events like this prove the fire never really left. What's happening this weekend isn't just entertainment - it's a revival, powered by promoters who know Atlantic City's legacy and believe in its future.

In one weekend, you can witness a world-title boxing eliminator, a nationally streamed jiu-jitsu championship, and a full slate of future UFC contenders breaking in their gloves for the first time.

Three events. Two nights. One fighting town.

#### Stay Safe in the Surf: A Guide to Water Safety at the Jersey Shore

The Jersey Shore is synonymous with summer fun—sunny beach days, refreshing ocean dips, and thrilling surf. But as inviting as the Atlantic Ocean, bays, and inlets may seem, these waters demand respect. Each year, thousands of visitors flock to Atlantic and Cape May Counties to enjoy the shore, and knowing how to stay safe can mean the difference between a great day and a dangerous one.

#### Respect the Ocean's Power

The ocean at the Jersey Shore can change quickly, with shifting tides, sudden drop-offs, and powerful currents. Rip currents, in particular, pose a significant hazard. Often invisible from shore, these narrow channels of fast-moving water can pull swimmers out beyond the breaking waves. If caught in one, stay calm—don't try to swim directly back to shore. Instead, swim parallel to the beach until you're free of the current, then angle back toward land.

When possible, swim only at guarded beaches. Lifeguards are trained to spot hazards, assist swimmers in distress, and respond quickly in emergencies. Many Jersey Shore towns, including Ocean City, Wildwood, Cape May, Atlantic City, and Brigantine, staff their beaches with lifeguards daily during peak season, typically from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Know the Conditions

Before heading out, check the day's surf and weather reports. Local news, beach patrol websites, and flag systems provide updates on tide times, rip current risks, jellyfish sightings, and storm advisories. Be especially cautious after storms, when surf conditions can remain rough even if skies are clear.

Additionally, always be aware of boat traffic in bays and inlets, where swimmers, kayakers, and paddleboarders share the water with motorized

vessels. Wearing a U.S. Coast Guard-approved life jacket is essential for boating and recommended for inexperienced swimmers in deeper waters.

#### Supervise Children Closely

Even on calm days, waves can knock over small children or carry them farther out than expected. Stay within arm's reach of young swimmers, and consider outfitting them with brightly colored swimwear or rash guards for visibility. Teach children to recognize lifeguards and seek help if they feel unsafe.

#### **Smart Shore Habits**

- Stay sober while swimming or boating. Alcohol impairs judgment, balance, and reaction times.
- Obey posted signs and lifeguard instructions. Many towns prohibit swimming after hours, when no lifeguards are present.
- Don't overestimate your abilities. The ocean is not a pool. If you're not a strong swimmer, stay in shallower water where you can touch bottom.





### Ocean City's Night in Venice Celebrates 70 Years with Parade, Fireworks, and Philly Sports Legends



Ocean City's signature summer celebration turns 70 this weekend, and the bayfront is set to shine. The Night in Venice boat parade returns Saturday, July 26, with a full lineup of events before and after, including a themed 5K race, a waterfront concert, decorated home and boat contests, and a fireworks finale over the bay.

This year's parade theme - "70 Years of Champions" - pays tribute to the sports heroes and summer traditions that have defined the region for decades. Leading the parade as grand marshals are three Philadelphia icons:

Bernie Parent is best known as the Hall of Fame goaltender who helped bring home back-to-back Stanley Cup victories for the Flyers in 1974 and 1975. Regarded as one of the greatest goalies in NHL history, he won both the Vezina Trophy and Conn Smythe Trophy in each of those championship seasons. He's also no stranger to the Shore - Parent is a longtime resident of Avalon and a familiar face at community events along the coast.

Vince Papale, a former Philadelphia Eagle, became a household name after walking on to the team in the 1970s with no college football experience. His story inspired the 2006 Disney film Invincible, starring Mark Wahlberg. Papale, a New Jersey native, remains active in the region as a motivational speaker and frequent guest at local fundraisers and youth sports events.

Ruben Amaro Jr. is a former Phillies outfielder and front-office executive who played a key role in building the 2008 World Series championship team. After retiring from baseball operations, he transitioned into broadcasting and is now part of the Phillies' TV booth. Amaro has deep family roots in Philadelphia baseball - his father, Ruben Sr., played short-stop for the Phillies in the 1960s - and remains a dedicated ambassador for the sport across the region.

Rounding out the lineup is Gritty, the high-energy, high-chaos mascot of the Flyers who has become a national pop culture figure. Expect him to be out on the water and in full form, drawing cheers from fans young and old.

The parade begins at 6:30pm, launching near the Ocean City-Longport Bridge and following a course through the back bay lagoons to Tennessee Avenue. Boats will be decorated to match the theme, competing for cash prizes and bragging rights in multiple categories. Meanwhile, bayfront homeowners and condo associations will vie for top honors in the annual decorated house contest, adding color and creativity to the shoreline.



Although many of the parties and gatherings take place dockside, public viewing stands are set up at several street ends along the bay, including 1st Street, 6th, 11th, 13th, 15th, and Tennessee Avenue. For those looking for a more comfortable option, the Bayside Center at 520 Bay Avenue offers ticketed seating for \$10 (adults) and \$6 (kids), with family activities, food vendors, music, and restrooms on site. Tickets can be purchased through OceanCityVacation.com or in person at the City Hall Welcome Center, Roy Gillian Welcome Center, and Aquatic & Fitness Center while supplies last.

Parking is limited near the route, but free shuttle service begins at 4:00pm from three designated lots: the Ocean City Municipal Airport, the Community Center at 17th Street, and the Tennessee Avenue sports fields. Visitors may also cross the 9th Street Bridge on foot, using the designated pedestrian path - note that chairs and alcohol are not permitted on the bridge walkway.



The celebration begins early Saturday with the Night in Venice 5K Run and 1-Mile Walk, starting at 8:00am at 19th and Haven Avenue. The course is flat and family-friendly, following the Haven Avenue bike path. Participants receive an event t-shirt, and awards will be given to top male and female finishers in several age groups. Online registration is open through RunSignUp.com and costs \$35. In-person registration and packet pickup will be available Friday evening from 5–8pm and Saturday morning starting at 6:30am near the start line.

On Friday night, the celebration kicks off at the Ocean City Music Pier with a live concert by Boat House Row, a Philadelphia-based tribute band known for high-energy takes on soft rock hits from the late '70s and early '80s. The group covers artists like Hall & Oates, Christopher Cross, Toto, and Steely Dan - what fans lovingly call "yacht rock." The concert begins at 7:30pm on Friday, July 25. Tickets are \$30 for adults and \$25 for children and seniors, available through oceancityvacation.com/boxoffice or at the Music Pier box office while supplies last.

The Miss Night in Venice Pageant will also return this year, with local contestants representing area youth programs, organizations, and boating families. The pageant takes place aboard one of the lead boats in the parade, a tradition that dates back decades. Contestants are judged on community involvement, presentation, and spirit. Winners are announced at the conclusion of the parade.




The event concludes with a fireworks display around 9:30pm, launched from a barge near the 9th Street Bridge and visible from most bayfront areas. For many families, it's the biggest weekend of the summer - one that blends pageantry and nostalgia with dock parties, sports pride, and good old-fashioned fun on the water.

From longtime residents decorating their porches to first-time visitors watching from folding chairs along the bay, Night in Venice remains one of the most festive, high-energy traditions anywhere on the Jersey Shore.

Place oven rack 6 inches from broiler and preheat to high. In a large bowl, combine beef, salsa, salt and pepper. Shape mixture into 4 equal patties, each a half inch thick and place on baking sheet. Broil for 6-7 minutes or until burgers are browned. Flip and repeat on second side until burgers are firm to the touch and no longer pink in the center and to your temperate liking. Place the avocado in a small bowl and mash to a chunky consistency with a fork or potato masher. Add red pepper, cilantro, lime juice, garlic powder, a pinch of salt, and black pepper to taste; stir and combine. To serve, spread avocado mixture to each before finishing with top halves of buns.



#### **Fishing in Atlantic County**

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at dep.nj.gov/njf-w/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/. Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/.

#### SALTWATER FISHING

Atlantic City - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



**Ventnor/Ventnor Heights** - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

**Somers Point** - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

**Brigantine** - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Gravelling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

#### FRESHWATER FISHING

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.





#### Jersey Fresh Corn & Peach Summer Salad

- 2 ears sweet corn, kernels cut off
- 2–3 ripe peaches, sliced or wedged
- 1 cup cherry or heirloom tomatoes, halved
- 1/4 cup red onion, thinly sliced
- ¼ cup fresh basil, chopped
- 2 Tbsp white balsamic vinegar (or lemon juice)
- 3 Tbsp extra-virgin olive oil
- Salt & pepper, to taste
- Optional: ¼ cup crumbled feta cheese

Combine corn, peaches, tomatoes, onion, and basil in a bowl. Whisk together vinegar and olive oil; drizzle over salad. Toss gently, then season with salt and pepper. Sprinkle feta if using, and serve immediately.

#### Jersey Fresh Blueberry Margarita

- ½ cup fresh Jersey blueberries (plus extra for garnish)
- 1½ oz silver tequila (per drink)
- 1 oz triple sec or Cointreau
- 3/4 oz lime juice (fresh)
- 1/2 oz simple syrup (adjust to taste)
- Ice
- Salt or sugar for rim (optional)
- · Lime wedge & mint for garnish

Muddle the blueberries in a shaker until juicy and broken down. Add tequila, triple sec, lime juice, simple syrup, and ice. Shake well, then strain into a salt- or sugar-rimmed glass over fresh ice. Garnish with a few whole blueberries, lime wedge, and mint sprig. t Tip: For an extra burst of flavor, add 1 basil leaf to the shaker before shaking. The herbal note complements the blueberries beautifully.










#### WHEN PHILLY PLAYS FOR KEEPS

A Wild Walk-Off, a Quiet Comeback, and the City That Never Sleeps on Sports

By late July, the sports world often naps in the haze between baseball's dog days and the first snap of NFL preseason. But in Philadelphia, this week proved there's no such thing as an offseason when the stakes - and the storylines - are this high.

#### THE RULE YOU'VE NEVER SEEN - AND MAY NEVER SEE AGAIN

On Monday, July 22, the Phillies pulled off a win so rare that most fans at Citizens Bank Park didn't even realize it was possible. In the bottom of the 10th inning against the Red Sox, with the bases loaded and two outs, Edmundo Sosa checked his swing - barely. But his bat clipped the mitt of Red Sox catcher Connor Wong, violating MLB Rule 6.01(c): catcher's interference.

The play initially went unnoticed. Red Sox fans began celebrating what they thought was a routine third out. But Phillies manager Rob Thomson challenged the call, and after a brief review, umpires reversed the ruling, Just like that, Brandon Marsh was awarded home plate. The Phillies walked it off, 3–2, without the ball ever leaving Sosa's bat.



Not since 1971 had a Major League game ended on that call. That one - between the Yankees and Senators - faded into trivia lore. This one became a highlight reel almost no one saw coming. Phillies players poured onto the field, confused at first, then euphoric once the reality set in: they'd won on a rule so obscure even some pros needed a postgame refresher.

The moment was quirky, no doubt - but fitting. This year's Phillies team is opportunistic, fundamentally sharp, and as comfortable grinding out a low-scoring win as they are launching back-to-back homers. With a record that has them firmly in the NL East hunt and the pitching staff finding its late-summer form, these are the kinds of games that make "Red October" feel less like a dream and more like a plan.

#### EAGLES CAMP: RELOADING, NOT REBUILDING

Just across Pattison Avenue, the Eagles kicked off their first full week of training camp at NovaCare with none of the drama or dysfunction that tends to define NFL storylines in July - and that's exactly how head coach Nick Sirianni wants it.





Quarterback Jalen Hurts has kept his offseason businesslike. The newly extended franchise QB has been the quiet center of an operation built on confidence and chemistry. He's not just running drills; he's setting the tone.

This week, the team added veteran pass rusher Ogbo Okoronkwo, a savvy move to bolster an already dangerous front. At the same time, they waived RB Lew Nichols and DL K.J. Henry - small names, maybe, but a clear sign that even the bottom of the roster is under pressure. Competition is tight. Standards are high.

And the defense? It's younger, faster, and quietly drawing league-wide attention. Pro Football Focus ranked the Eagles' secondary 8th in the NFL, thanks to the return of stars like Darius Slay and the injection of rookie energy from Cooper DeJean, Quinyon Mitchell, and a healthy Sydney Brown. Together, they give defensive coordinator Vic Fangio a deeper, more versatile lineup than the patchwork crew that struggled late last season.

Even players outside the NFC East are watching. Rams defensive lineman Kobie Turner told reporters this week that the Eagles are already circled on his calendar. "That's the team to beat," he said, referencing not just Philly's dominant O-line, but new addition Saquon Barkley - a rare divisional flip who could redefine the Birds' backfield if healthy.



#### A PHILADELPHIA STATE OF MIND

What connects these two stories - baseball's weirdest walk-off and a championship-caliber football team quietly sharpening its knives - isn't just geography. It's a mindset.

Philly doesn't need a headline to be relevant. It doesn't crave chaos. This is a sports town built on sharp eyes and steady nerves. The Phillies didn't panic in the 10th they waited for a rule to break their way. The Eagles didn't blow up the roster - they made tweaks, added depth, and kept their core intact.

In the process, they reminded fans that July isn't just for beach chairs and vacation-mode. It's when real contenders stay ready. While other cities coast through the offseason, Philadelphia is already playing for keeps.

#### AN UPDATE ON EBBY'S RECUPERATION FROM ACL SURGERY

Bob and I just returned from a two-week vacation that was planned a year ago. Ebby, our 8-year-old rescue (August will mark four years with us) had to have patella luxation surgery on her knee in December. It is very common for dogs who have knee surgery to later incur a completely torn ACL (also known as the cranial cruciate ligament or CrCL). And that is what Ebby did in June. Our neighbors who moved in in 2024 and have three dogs, butted their fenced-in yard partly against our existing privacy fence. Ebby, I had been told by people who knew her in the Villas, had a history of running and barking at everyone and every dog that she could see from her cyclone fenced yard. The years of doing that before I took her in, I'm certain caused some degeneration in her joints. Privacy fences often have a very slight opening between the panels, and Ebby could see the dogs behind it, and she would jump at them like a maniac. Bob cut thin boards and placed them in the cracks and that helped a bit. Obviously not enough.

I was hoping to delay surgery until around the 21st of July when we would be home. But I was advised that that was too long to wait considering her discomfort. I opted to have her teeth cleaned at the same time, as she won't let me put my fingers in her mouth (except when playing) and I have not been able to apply dental gel like I do with Zoéy. Her operation was on July 2, and we left on July 6th. It was a stressful few days with my dismay at her pain, both with the fact that she had an incisor extracted (almost three inches long) plus her ACL. I had to take her back before I left for another pain shot. My pet sitter and I stayed in touch as much as possible and she kept in touch with the professionals involved. Every possible measure was taken to ensure protection of her surgical area and eliminating her going up and down steps and on sofas. Ebby seemed to have the sense to keep that back leg elevated when she moved around. As of July 23, today, she still does not put much pressure on her leg, and once she was able to remove her puffy soft post operative collar, we left it off. I will see the doctor tomorrow morning when Zoey and Ebby get their monthly Addison shots and will know if I can start taking Ebby in the pool for physical therapy. I read that there are range of motion exercises to do with ACL post-op but it is doubtful that Ebby would let me. If necessary, I will muzzle her (she is not mean, just reactive if she feels threatened). I got a 3-step wide set of stairs for my high bed which has made it possible for even Zoey to get up and down without me lifting her, which she is very excited about.

Based on the dog's size-Ebby's only twenty pounds-age (she is eight) and extent of tear (Ebby's was extensive), recovery can take three or more weeks, or even months. The treatments for both her knee, ACL, and teeth, and Addison's diagnosis and treatments, have now cost nearly eight thousand dollars! A very expensive rescue dog that we love.

SUMMER SOUNDTRACK: HOW TO DO FREE CONCERT NIGHTS RIGHT

There's no ticket, no dress code, and no bad seat if you show up prepared. South Jersey's weekly summer concert scene - stretching from Somers Point to the Ventnor bay to the Atlantic City Boardwalk - offers some of the best live music in the state, and it won't cost you a dime. But showing up unprepared? That could cost you your patience. From parking to packing, here's how to do these concerts right.

Let's start in Ventnor, where not one but two concert series run weekly during the summer. The first is staged bayside at Ski Beach, just off Dorset and Burk Avenues. This setting is quieter, a little more low-key, and prone to some of the best sunsets you'll see all summer. There's a small parking lot at the venue, but it fills fast - most people wind up grabbing free street parking nearby and walking in. Don't leave your bug spray in the car; the bayfront location practically demands it once the sun dips. You'll want to bring a chair - the folding kind, not a soft beach one that sinks into the grass - and maybe a hoodle or light blanket for the breeze. Some nights you'll find food trucks, but not always, so picking up takeout beforehand or packing a cooler with snacks and drinks is a smart move.

Just a few blocks over, the Newport Avenue concert series puts the stage on the ocean side, drawing bigger crowds and a beachier vibe. This one feels more like a neighborhood block party - with families, couples, and groups of friends toting chairs and setting up early on the lawn in front of the library. Parking can be a little tight on concert nights, but Atlantic Avenue and its side streets usually have open spots if you're not too close to start time. Ventnor does enforce parking rules, so watch the signage and don't block driveways. The shows often feature big-name tribute acts and local legends, so if you want a good spot close to the stage, you'll need to show up early. And don't forget, you're just a block off the Boardwalk-perfect for an after-show stroll.

In Atlantic City, the music gets louder and the crowds get bigger. Two concert series take over Kennedy Plaza each week, right between Boardwalk Hall and the ocean. The Mardi Gras series, known for high-energy performances and dancing crowds, fills the plaza

midweek with a festival-like feel. The Chicken Bone Beach Jazz series takes over later in the week with nationally known jazz performers and a more relaxed, sit-and-listen kind of energy. Either way, it's smart to park in one of the casino garages - Bally's or Caesars are your best bets - if you don't want to circle Pacific Avenue for a metered space. You'll be walking at least a couple blocks to get to the Plaza, so pack light. Bring a sturdy folding chair for the paved seating area, sunscreen for early-evening sun, and cash if you want to grab a snack or drink from one of the Boardwalk vendors.

Just a few blocks north, the city's Gardner's Basin concerts offer a completely different vibe - more afternoon than evening, more lawn than concrete. The free lot at the Basin tends to fill early, especially on nice weekends, but there's often room nearby on side streets. This is the spot to bring a cooler, grab a spot on the grass, and settle in for the day. Shows usually feature multiple acts, so plan to stay awhile. Pack sunscreen, a chair or picnic blanket, and maybe an umbrella for shade if you're there for the long haul.

Down the road in Somers Point, the beloved Friday night series at Kennedy Park is a tradition for locals and summer regulars allke. The venue, also known as William Morrow Beach, offers a sweeping bay view and plenty of space, but parking is still a challenge. The small on-site lot fills fast, and by 6:30 p.m., most people are lining the side streets along Bay Avenue. There's also a public lot across from Gregory's Bar that's an easy walk. This is very much a bring-your-own-everything kind of event: folding chairs, coolers, snacks, bug spray, and maybe even your own table setup if you're feeling fancy. It's informal but organized, with food trucks often parked near the entrance and regulars claiming the same patch of grass week after week. If you're new, show up early and follow the crowd.

Every one of these concerts is free, but the experience you have depends on how well you plan. Show up without a chair, a sweater, or a parking strategy, and you'll learn the hard way. But bring what you need, find your spot, and let the music take it from there and you'll wonder why you ever paid for lawn seats in the first place.


