Step Inside Lucy the Elephant - Margate

Step inside Lucy the Elephant – Margate
Start your weekend with a visit to one of New Jersey's quirkiest and most iconic landmarks: Lucy the Elephant. This six-story roadside marvel in Margate offers guided interior tours with sweeping views from atop her howdah. Located in a cozy fenced park with picnic tables, Lucy makes for a perfect family stop. Admission is \$9 for adults, \$8.50 for teens (13–18), \$5 for children (3–12), and free for kids under 3 and active-duty military. Tours run daily. See Lucy's ad on page 37. lucytheelephant.org

Climb the Absecon Lighthouse – Atlantic City
Ready to climb 228 steps? New Jersey's tallest lighthouse, located in Atlantic City,
is open Thursday through Monday from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. (last climb at 3:30). The
view from 171 feet up is worth every step. Climbing fees are \$10 for adults, \$9 for
seniors and students (with ID), \$6 for kids ages 4–12, and free for children under
4 and active-duty military. Atlantic City residents get a discounted rate of \$5.
Access to the Keeper's House museum and exhibits is free. abseconlighthouse.org

Explore Estell Manor Park – Mays Landing For fresh air and forest trails, head to Estell Manor Park. Nestled along the Great Egg Harbor River, the park features 27 miles of walking and biking paths, including a 1.8-mile accessible boardwalk through the wetlands. The Warren E. Fox Nature Center offers interactive environmental displays, and there are ample picnic areas, playgrounds, and river access for canoeing and kayaking. It's free to enter and enjoy!

Lake Lenape Park West - Mays Landing Also in Mays Landing, Lake Lenape Park West is ideal for a peaceful day outdoors. Amenities include hiking and biking trails, playgrounds, picnic spots with grills, and a lake perfect for boating and fishing (with permits). Wildlife sightings are a bonus for curious kids.

Birch Grove Park – Northfield

Tucked away in Northfield, Birch Grove Park is a 271-acre gem offering a blend of nature and history. Families can explore scenic walking trails, cross a charming covered bridge, and visit the Northfield Museum and Casto House to learn about local heritage. The park features playgrounds, picnic areas, and fishing lakes stocked in spring and fall. While camping is no longer permitted, day visits are welcome. Entry fees are \$1 per person and \$7 per grill, with free admission for Northfield residents.

Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge – Galloway Township Nature lovers and birdwatchers will find a haven at the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge in Galloway Township. Spanning over 48,000 acres of coastal habitats, the refuge is a critical stopover for migratory birds along the Atlantic Flyway. Visitors can enjoy several scenic trails through salt marshes and woodlands, as well as the 8-mile Wildlife Drive, ideal for observing a variety of bird species and other wildlife. The refuge is open daily from sunrise to sunset. Entrance fees are \$4 per vehicle or \$2 for pedestrians and bicyclists. The Visitor Information Center in Oceanville is open Wednesday to Sunday, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Beach Day in Atlantic City
Don't forget the beaches! Atlantic City's beaches are open, clean, and free. Pack a towel, grab a snack from the boardwalk, and enjoy a laid-back day by the ocean.

Name of venue: Setaara

Where are you located? 2322 Arctic Avenue in Atlantic City.

Hours of operation: We are open Wednesday and Thursday from 4-9pm, and Friday through Sunday from 4-10pm.

Can you offer any parking tips? There is free parking available at St. Michael's Church at 21 N. Georgia Avenue, half a block away.

Tell us about the overall style of your cuisine and if possible, your inspiration for the menu: Located in the heart of Atlantic City, Setaara brings together the best of Afghan and French Cuisine. The theme of the restaurant revolves around the golden age of Afghanistan from the 1920s-1970s. In designing the restaurant and its dishes, Abdullah and Homa used their experience traveling throughout the Middle East and Europe to provide the most authentic restaurant possible. The beauty of Afghan food is that it stands as a testament to the various empires that have crossed the country from the Greeks to the Mongols to the Mughals and Persians.







What is the current reason one MUST visit your venue? The interior ambiance is exceptionally distinctive. Upon entering through our hand-crafted wooden door, guests are immediately transported from Atlantic City to the ancient Silk Road. The lighting, which is a form of art unto itself, and artwork depicting Afghanistan in the 1960s, introduces visitors to a version of Afghanistan that predates the wars and is largely unfamiliar to many. All the artwork within the restaurant has been crafted by local Atlantic City artists, including Christian Correa, Leah Morgan, and Edwin Riviera. Inside, patrons have the option to sit in their own private alcove with traditional floor seating, a booth, or at a table.

We also offer a semi-outdoor space, with a courtyard design reminiscent of a historic Silk Road town, with a glass domed garden, that is climate controlled with year-round foliage, marble floors, and plush velvet furniture with a replica of the Eiffel Tower in the center.

Tell us about your founders, Abdullah Panah and Homa Bazyar. Having grown up in Atlantic City, Abdullah had always loved this city. He is a Stockton University graduate and completed medical school in 2021 at Rowan SOM currently in his residency training at Jefferson Health NJ. He has travelled extensively throughout the world and always misses this beautiful city within days of being in a new destination. Throughout these years, the one disappointment he has had is the lack of diverse cuisine in a city with so many amazing restaurants. Having travelled to dozens of countries, he realized the potential that Atlantic City has if it offers new experiences beyond casinos. The first such thing the city could use is diverse cuisine and he sought out to create not only an Afghan restaurant, but to create a whole new unique dining experience.

Since 2014, he began encouraging his aunt, Homa, to sell her restaurant in Colorado and to come create a brand-new dining experience in the Atlantic City area. Homa, having immigrated to the United States from Afghanistan in the 1970s, had always loved creating new dishes and incorporating different cuisines into a single dish. Shortly after immigrating to America, she began training under a French chef in the Denver area. By 2017, she had visited Atlantic County countless times and ultimately sold her restaurant in Colorado, venturing into opening this new concept in Atlantic City.



Fishing in Atlantic County

Any angler 16 and older must have a valid license to fish the fresh waters of New Jersey. This includes privately owned lakes and other waters. For more information visit the NJ DEP Division of Fish and Wildlife Fishing License Information website at dep.nj.gov/njf-w/fishing/freshwater/buy-a-license/. Remember that all saltwater anglers 16 and older must register with the state. Go to NJ Saltwater Recreational Registry Program for registration information at dep.nj.gov/saltwaterregistry/.

SALTWATER FISHING

Atlantic City - Gardner's Basin Marina, North New Hampshire Avenue and the bay, is home to charter boats, sightseeing and fishing cruises. For more information call (609) 348-2880. Fishing is permitted on the beaches, outside of guarded areas, and from the jetties. The seawall along Sunset Avenue is a popular area for crabbing or fishing from land in the back bay. A municipal boat launch (fee required) is located at Albany Avenue and Boulevard Avenue.



Ventnor/Ventnor Heights - The Ventnor City Fishing Pier is located at Cornwall Avenue and the Boardwalk. The fishing pier offers seasonal rates for fishing or sightseeing. For additional information, call the piermaster at (609) 823-7944. Along the back bay, a seawall the length of Winchester Avenue is perfect for the family to fish or crab from land. A free boat ramp is located on the bay on Dorset Avenue, where there is plenty of free parking. For more information call (609) 823-7900.

Margate - Amherst Avenue, between Decatur and Monroe avenues, is home to several marinas and bait and tackle shops, including small boat rentals. Within the marinas are dozens of charter boats available on a daily basis throughout the summer and shoulder seasons. For more information on charters call Capt. Andy's at (609) 822-0916, or for a family outing on a pontoon rental boat call Ray Scott's Dock at (609) 822-6819. Surf fishing is permitted during non-guarded hours.

Somers Point - John F. Kennedy Park, located on Broadway, offers a boat ramp (fee required) granting access to Great Egg Harbor Bay. Another ramp (fee required) is located at Smith's Marina, 910 Bay Ave. Along the Bay Front Historic District on Bay Avenue there are several marinas which are home to many party and charter boats. There is also a crabbing and fishing pier located on the bay off New Jersey Avenue. Restrooms are located nearby.

Brigantine - Surf fishing is permitted on non-guarded beaches and at the seawall, Seventh Street north to 14th Street. The old Brigantine Bridge, across Absecon Inlet from Harrah's Marina, is used as a fishing pier. A public boat ramp (fee required) is located at Sixth and Bayshore avenues on the bay. For more information, call (609) 266-1122.

Leeds Point - Seasonal fishing and crabbing are permitted in designated areas of both the Brigantine and Barnegat Divisions of the Edwin B. Forsythe National Wildlife Refuge. These areas include saltwater fishing (from land) at the following locations: Gravelling Point, Little Beach (with permit), Parkertown Dock Road, Cedar Run Dock Road, and Stafford Avenue. Boats may be launched at the Brigantine Division's Scotts Landing boat ramp, located at the end of Scotts Landing Road, off Moss Mill Road at Leeds Point. Freshwater fishing is permitted on Lily Lake in Oceanville. For more information call (609) 652-1665.

Lake Lenape Park - Lake Lenape Park East and Lake Lenape Park West are located in Hamilton Township and together encompass nearly 2,000 acres of land. Each park offers a variety of activities and facilities for residents and visitors to enjoy with its own entrance and access points. Boating is allowed on the lake with proper permits as required. All boaters must comply with state regulations and laws. No personal watercraft are permitted. For information on obtaining a boating permit and the associated fees contact the Lake Lenape Park office at (609) 625-8219.

Lake Lenape Park East - 753 Park Road, Mays Landing. This park is located on the eastern side of Lake Lenape and offers the most scenic views of the lake. Recently completed renovations include a new fishing pier, pickle ball courts, additional pavilions, landscaping enhancements and ADA accessibility improvements. The refurbished catering hall, Lakeside Manor, is a unique and picturesque lakefront venue that is available for special events and weddings for more than 250 guests. Lake Lenape Amenities: Fishing, Softball, Pickle Ball, Playground, Picnic Tables, Pavilions, Catering Hall, Historic Lighthouse, Restrooms, Convenient Parking.

Lake Lenape Park West - This park is located on the western side of Lake Lenape (note that some land on the eastern side and the entire lake surface is controlled by the county). The park entrance is located at 6303 Harding Highway in Mays Landing and encompasses nearly two-thousand acres of land, all the way up to the Black Horse Pike (Route 322). Things to Do at Lake Lenape West: Mountain Biking, Boathouse, Boating Access, Boat Ramp, Camping, Kayak/Canoe Access, Cross-county Skiing, Fishing, Gazebo (reservations required and may be made online or in person), Hiking, Unimproved Trails, Hunting, Nature Trails, Playground, Picnic Tables, Scenic Views, Playground. Call the reservation office at 609-625-8219 for more information.

National Homeownership Month June 2025

National Homeownership Month is in June. It celebrates the value that owning a home brings to families, communities, and neighborhoods across America. By becoming a homeowner, people get a step closer to the American dream. This month also shares the joys of being a homeowner, which can encourage others to achieve the same thing.

History of National Homeownership Month

Most Americans had no way of really owning a home in the 1800s. Mortgages became common only after the U.S. banking system came into being after the 1860s National Bank Acts.

During the time of the Great Depression, the banks did not have any money to lend and the average borrower didn't have any cash. As a result, people couldn't afford to buy homes, while existing homeowners often failed to pay their debt. To stabilize the housing market, the U.S. government created the Home Owners' Loan Corporation in 1933, the Federal Housing Administration in 1934, and the Federal National Mortgage Association (now known as Fannie Mae) in 1938. All these institutions took homeownership to new heights and helped prevent a crash in the housing market.

What changed the face of the housing industry, along with that of the American economy, was the G.I. Bill of 1944. This bill provided subsidized mortgages for the veterans of World War II. Another milestone in the history of American housing came when Congress passed the Fair Housing Act of 1968. The Act was signed by President Lyndon B. Johnson and banned discrimination in housing based on religion, race, gender, and national origin. It came into being only a few days after the assassination of Martin Luther King, Jr.

In its 87 years of existence, the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) has saved America an almost \$4 trillion loss of household wealth. It has helped more than 44 million citizens to become homeowners.

National Homeownership Week began in 1995, which was a strategy of the administration under President Bill Clinton to increase homeownership across America. Later, in 2002, President George W. Bush expanded the period of observance from a week to the entire month of June. National Homeownership Month reinforces the belief that owning a home is one of the steps towards achieving the American dream.



How to Celebrate National Homeownership Month

 Showcase local projects to officials - Invite local officials, be it virtually or in person, to your area. Show them or let them know about the latest housing developments that are using eco-friendly building techniques and other new technologies.

Educate local home buyers - Organize a housing forum (virtually or in-person) to bring together the public and housing experts to talk about the state of housing in your locality. It can be an economist from a nearby college, a mortrage banker or a realter.

mortgage banker, or a realtor.

 Get your community involved - Organize or participate in a community service project. Help build a shelter, host a donation venture, repair a playground, and carry out other similar acts that benefit your community.

 The burden of cost persists - One-third of America's 119 million households are cost-burdened, which puts more than 30% of their incomes towards housing charges and costs.

Pay for housing - The average American family spends \$1,573.83 on housing expenses every month as stated by the 2016 Consumer Expenditure

Survey.

Equal then, more now - If the rate of black homeownership today was the same as it was in 2000, there would be 770,000 more black homeowners in America.

 More dropouts than graduates? - Homeownership in the U.S. is less for a black college graduate than for a white high school dropout.

An average-sized move - In 2019, the average distance between the owned home and the newly purchased home of an American was 15 miles.





Taste the Season: Fresh Produce & Easy Recipes in Atlantic County This Weekend

As May gives way to summer, Atlantic County is bursting with fresh, local produce. From crunchy radishes to sweet strawberries, this is the perfect time to enjoy the flavors of the season. Whether you're gathering ingredients from a roadside stand or your favorite farmers market, now's the time to embrace local bounty with simple, delicious recipes your whole family will love.

What's in Season in Atlantic County

According to the New Jersey Crop Harvest Calendar, late May offers a vibrant variety of fresh produce:

- ~ Asparagus A spring favorite, asparagus is tender and packed with flavor—perfect for grilling or tossing in salads.
- ~ Spinach & Lettuce Leafy greens are at their peak right now and make a refreshing base for seasonal salads or wraps.
- ~ Radishes Crisp and peppery, radishes add a satisfying crunch to tacos, salads, or slaws.
- ~ **Strawberries** Sweet and juicy, strawberries mark the start of berry season and are irresistible in both sweet and savory dishes.

Strawberry Spinach Salad

Ingredients:

- 4 cups fresh spinach leaves
- 1 cup sliced fresh strawberries
- ¼ cup sliced almonds
- ¼ cup crumbled feta cheese
- 2 tablespoons balsamic vinaigrette

Instructions: In a large bowl, combine spinach and strawberries. Sprinkle with almonds and feta cheese. Drizzle with balsamic vinaigrette and toss gently. Serve immediately and enjoy the fresh flavors of spring.

Grilled Asparagus with Lemon Zest

Ingredients:

- 1 bunch fresh asparagus, trimmed
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 1 teaspoon lemon zest
- 1 tablespoon grated Parmesan cheese (optional)

Instructions: Preheat grill to medium-high heat. In a bowl, toss asparagus with olive oil, salt, and pepper. Grill asparagus for 5-7 minutes, turning occasionally, until tender and slightly charred. Remove from grill and sprinkle with lemon zest and Parmesan cheese, if desired. Serve warm as a side dish or appetizer.

Lettuce & Radish Tacos

Ingredients:

- 1 head butter or romaine lettuce (leaves used as shells)
- ½ cup thinly sliced radishes
- ½ avocado, diced
- 1 cup cookéd shredded chicken or black beans
- 2 thsp sour cream or Greek yogurt Salt, pepper, and chopped cilantro to taste Juice of ½ lime

Instructions: Layer chicken or beans in each lettuce leaf. Add radishes and avocado. Mix sour cream with lime juice and drizzle over tacos. Top with cilantro and a pinch of salt and pepper. Eat cold for a crunchy, refreshing treat.

Join Holocaust Survivor Michael Bornstein as we honor local survivors, incorporate community connections through Jewish peoplehood, and explore generational wisdom for Holocaust Survivor Day on Wednesday, June 4 at 5pm in the Katz JCC Auditorium, 501 North Jerome Avenue in Margate.

As co-author of the New York Times best-selling book, Survivors Club: The True Story of a Very Young Prisoner of Auschwitz, Bornstein was four-years-old when he was liberated from a concentration camp and made his way to the United States six years later.

For 70 years, Bornstein opted not to speak of his Holocaust experience, despite his image being one of the most recognizable where he is seen showing his tattoo in the iconic WWII footage. However, his second-generation Holocaust Survivor children, Debbie Bornstein Holinstat and Scott Bornstein, encouraged their father to share his powerful story of survival and resilience.

Iso speaking at the event is Holinstat, a veteran television news producer and co-author of her father's book, and Scott Bornstein, Executive Vice President of Greenberg Traurig, who dedicates his expertise combatting antisemitism on behalf of Israeli and American victims of the October 7th terrorist attacks.
